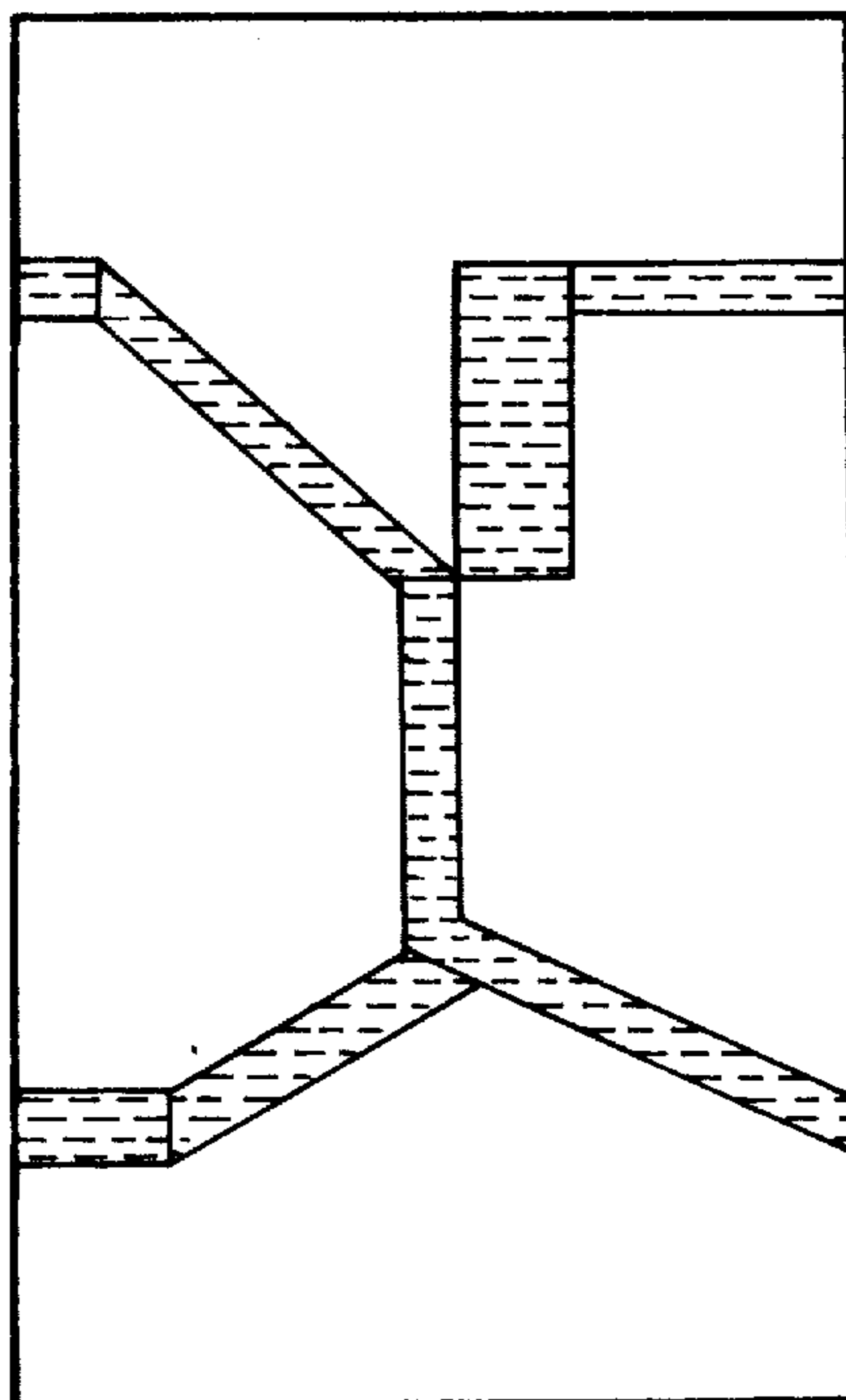

[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for plastic sheet material for surfacing a wall panel or similar article, as shown and described.

FIG. 1 is a top plan view of plastic sheet material for surfacing a wall panel or similar article showing my new design; and FIG. 2 is a top plan view of a modified form thereof, a mirror image thereof.



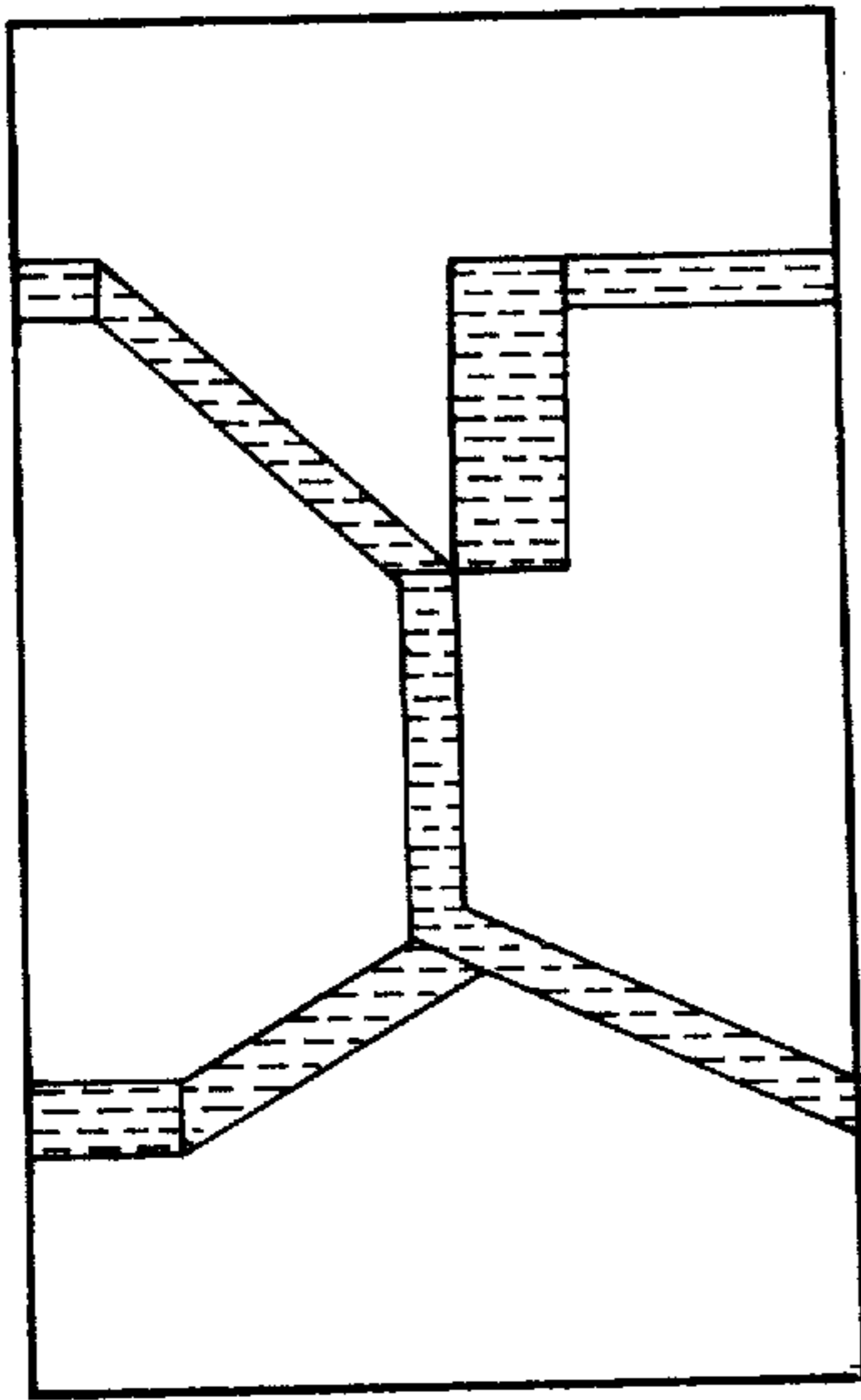

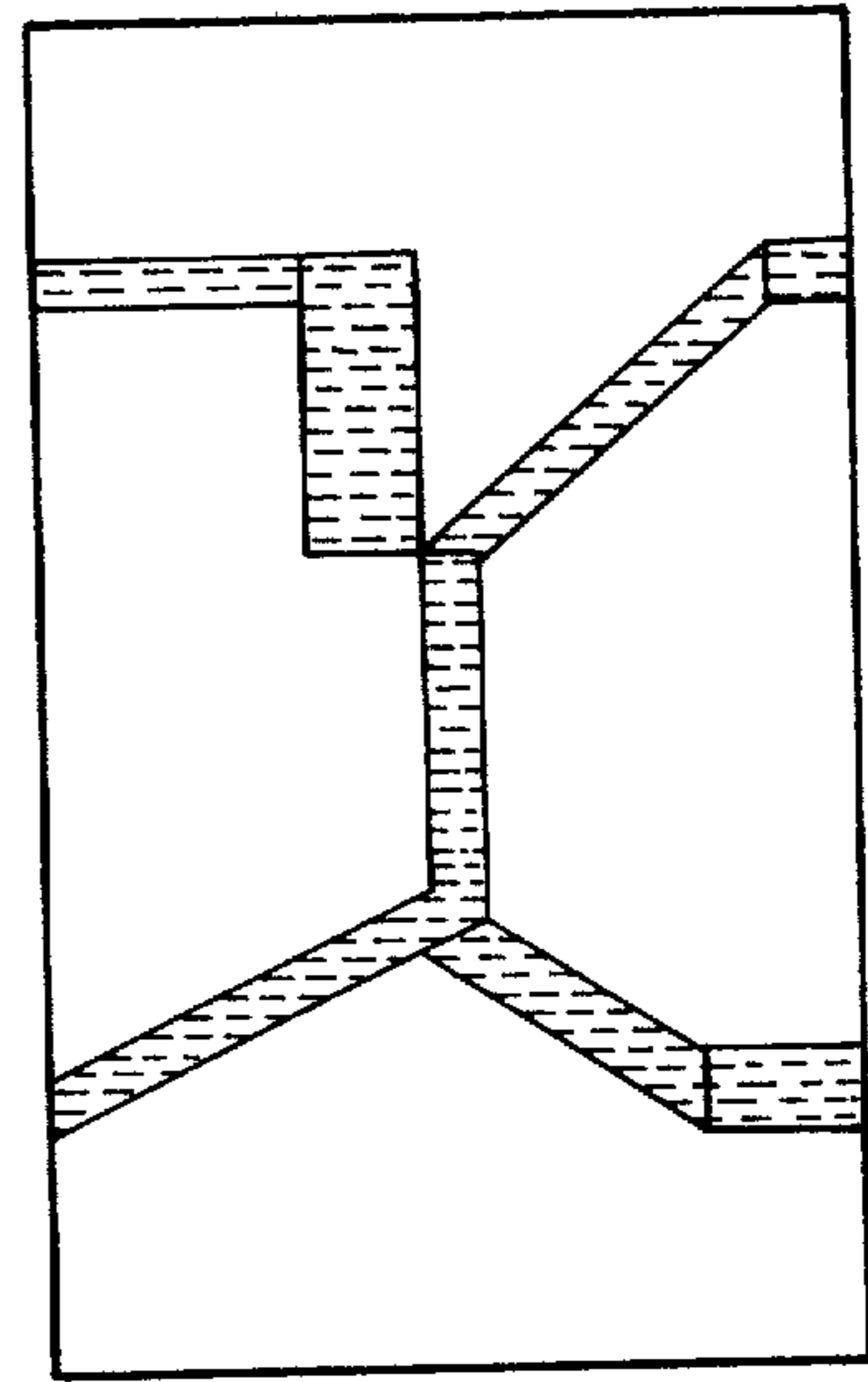
