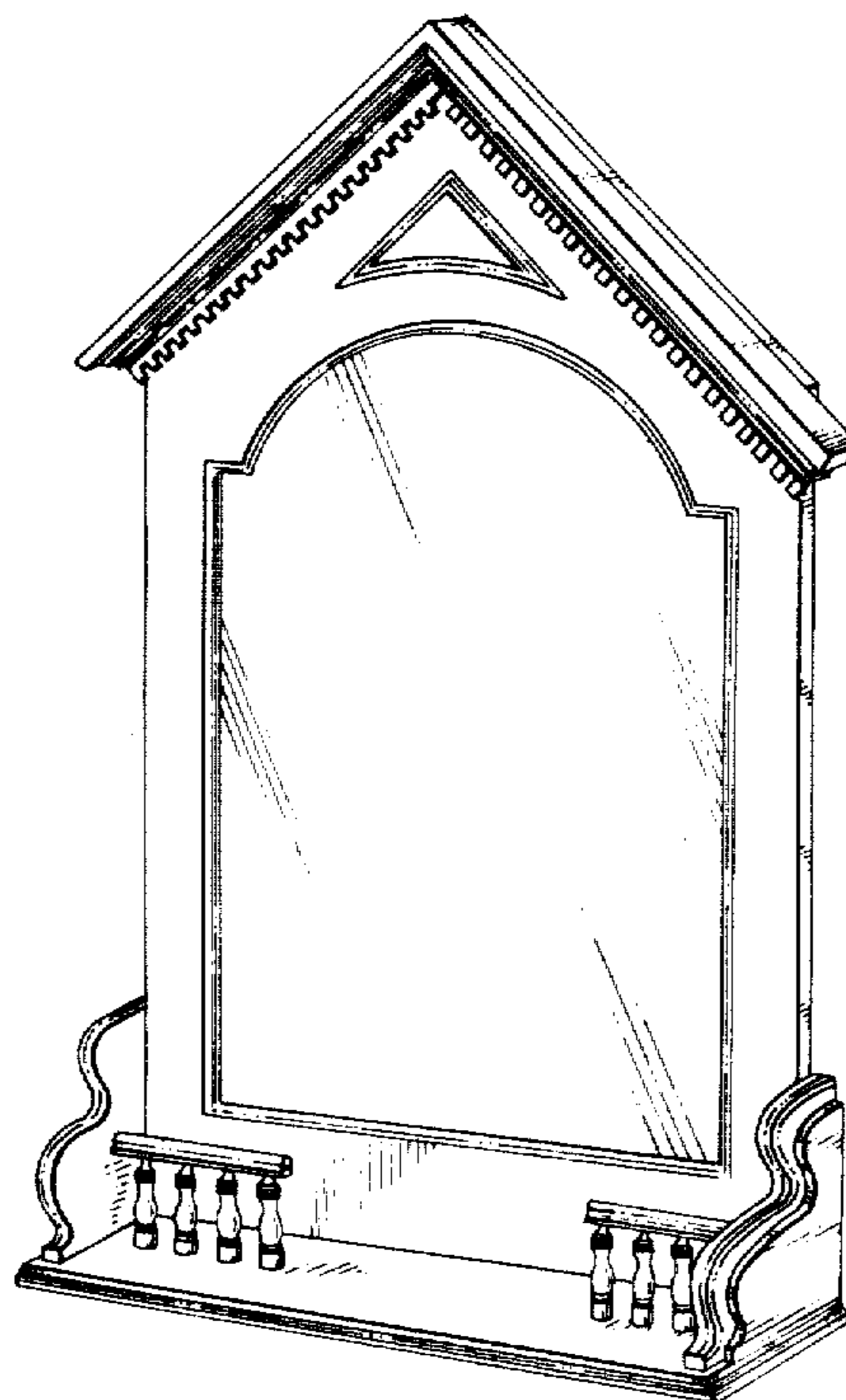

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 6 is a left side elevational view.



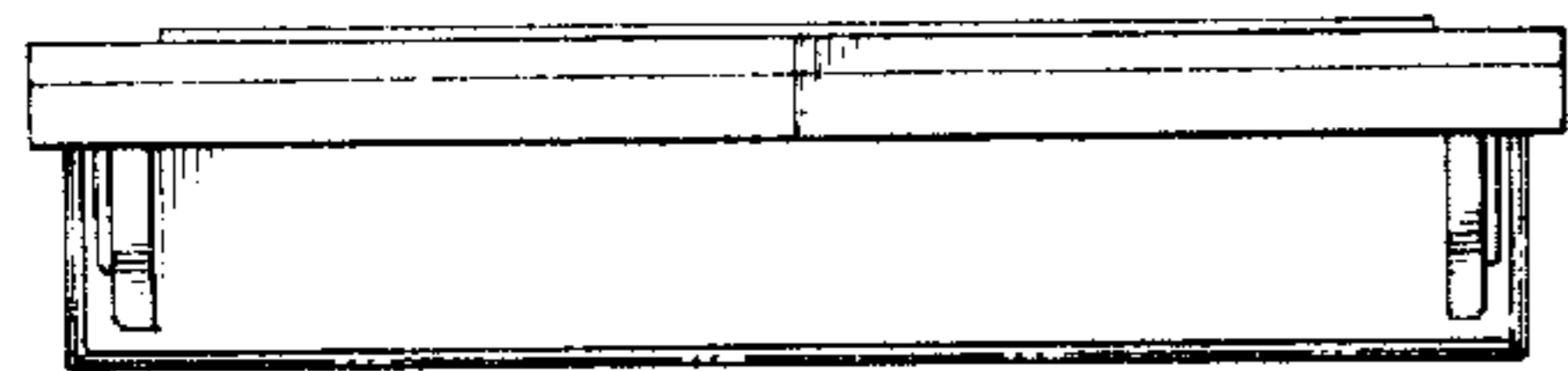

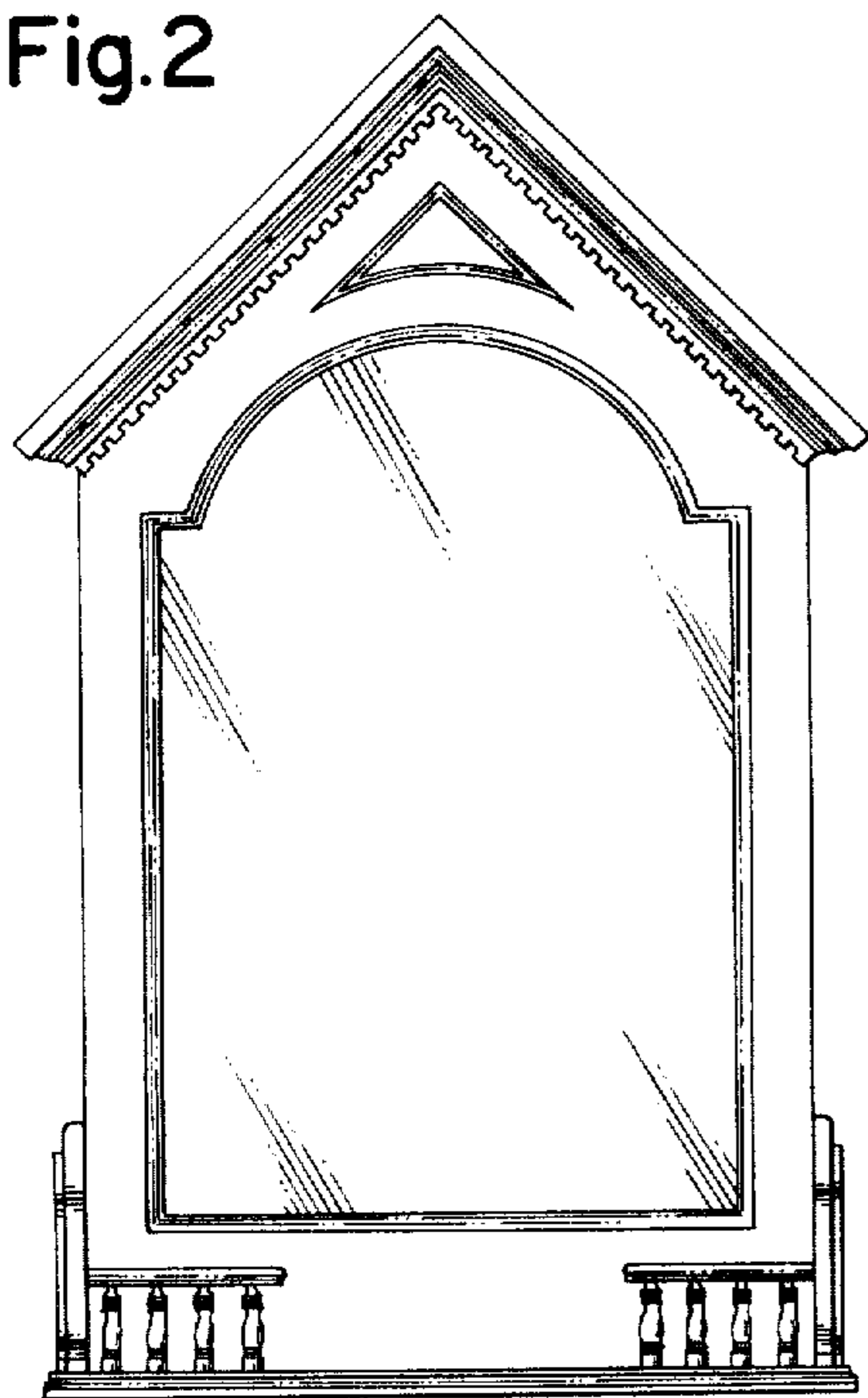

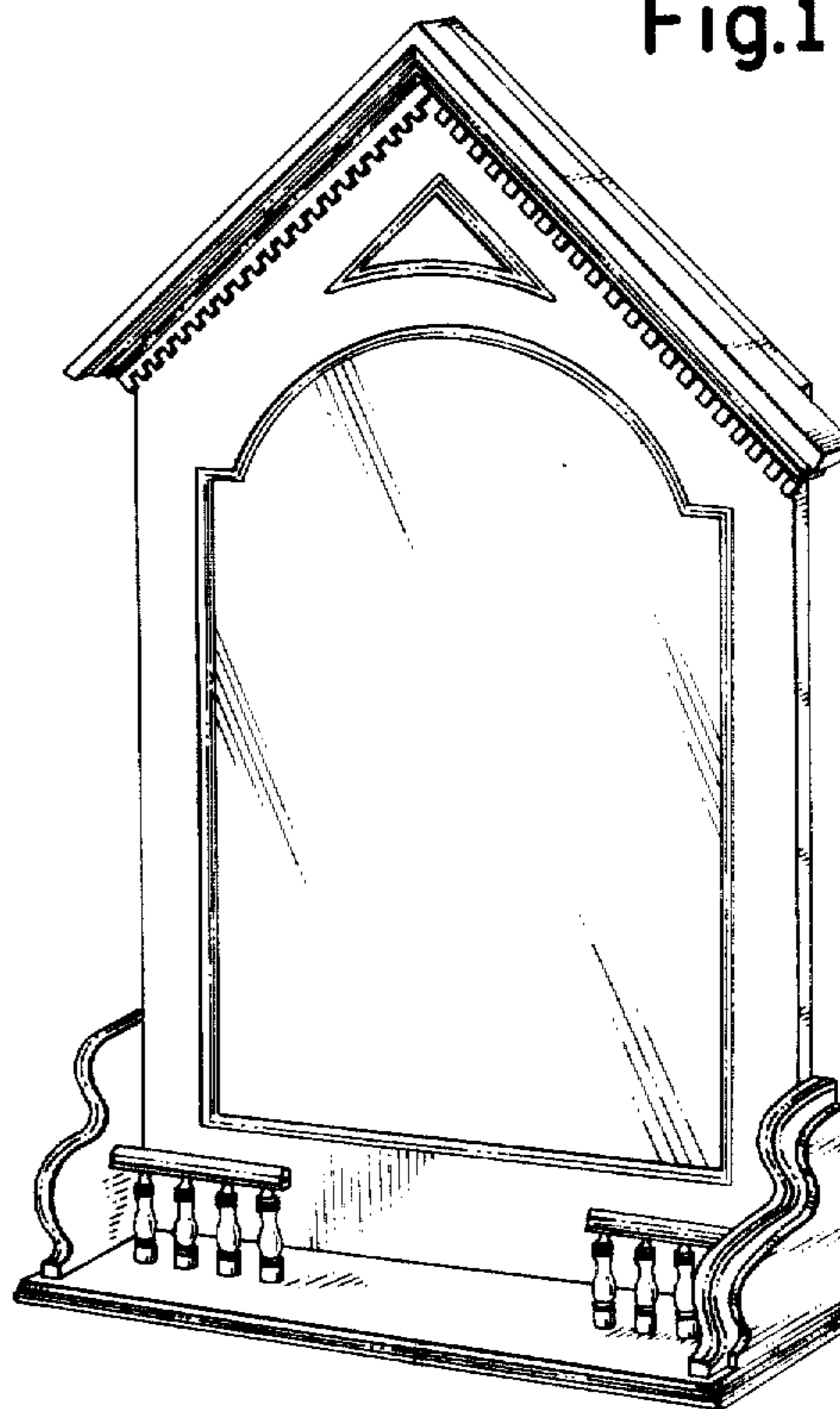

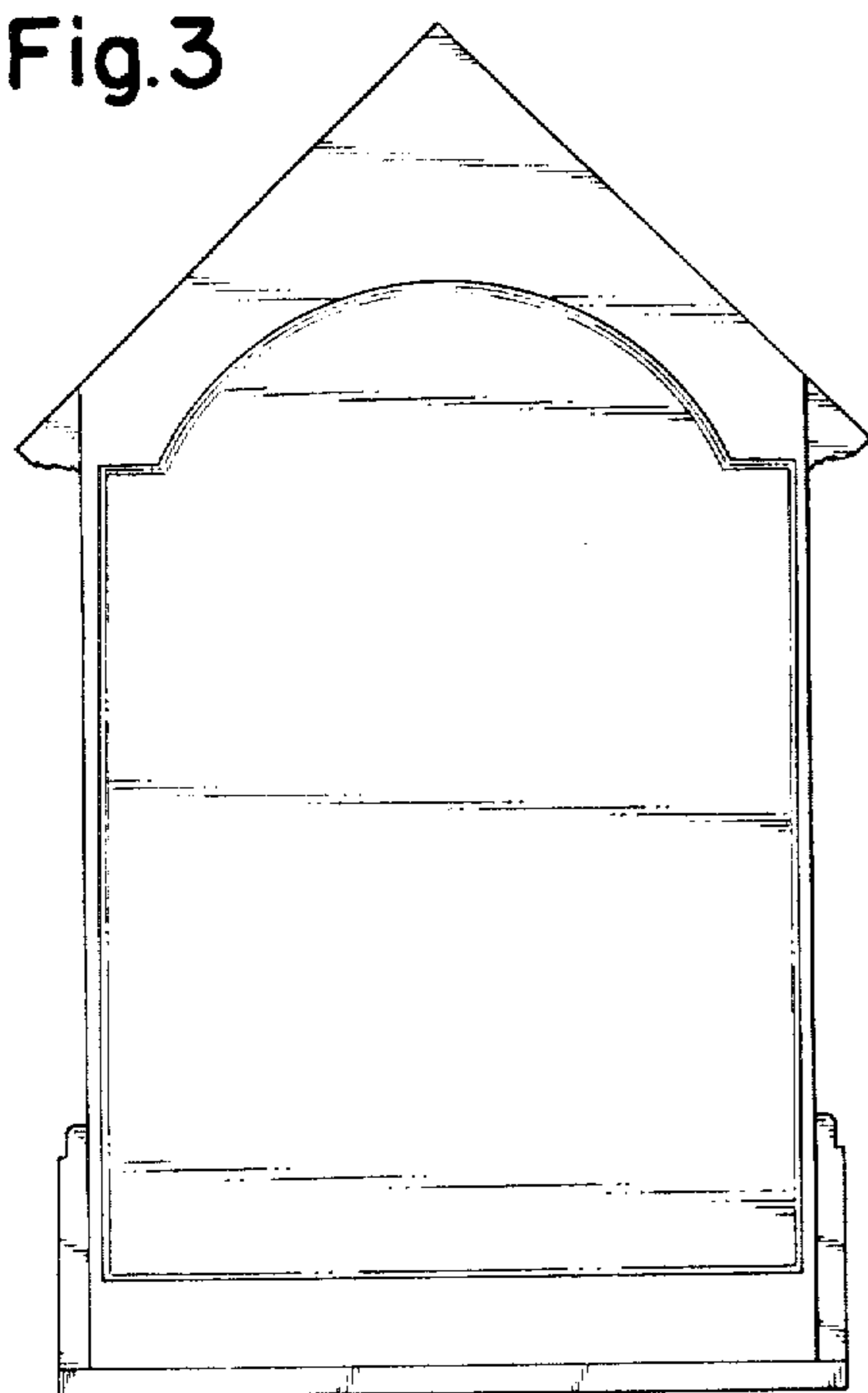
