DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a toy telephone showing
our new design;

FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof;

FIG. 3 is a front elevational view thereof;

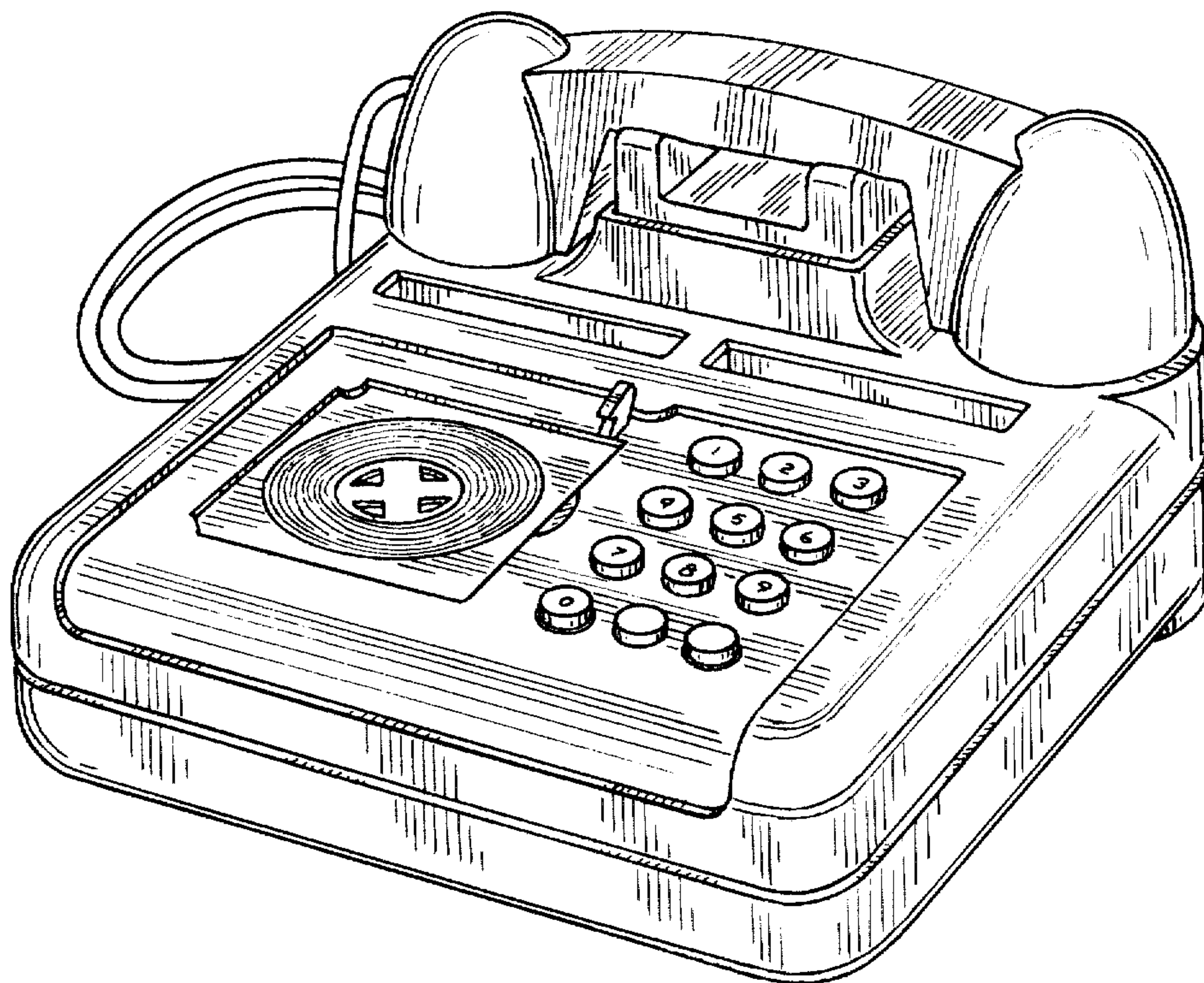
FIG. 4 is a bottom plan view thereof;

in FIGS. 3-7, for ease of illustration.



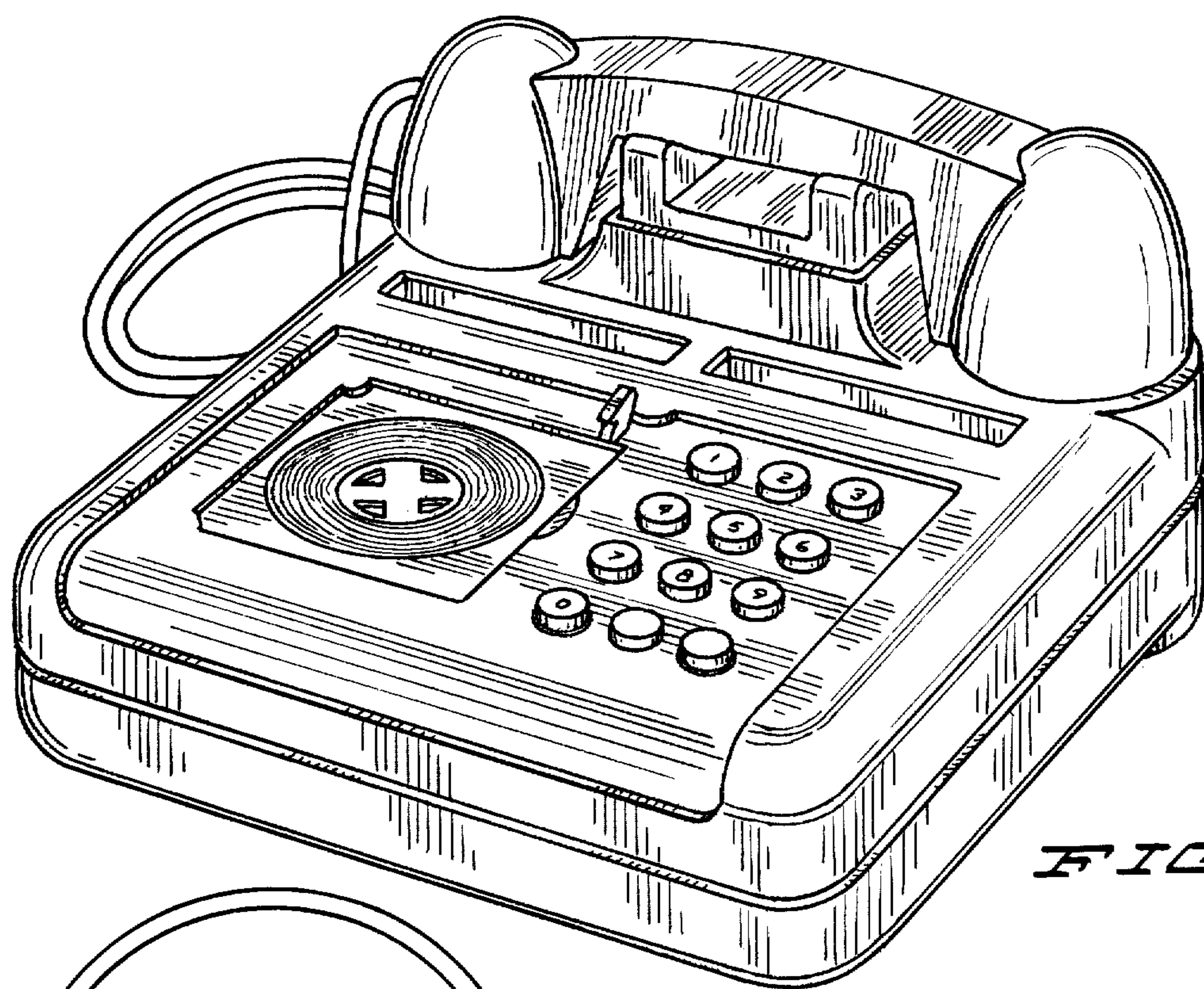

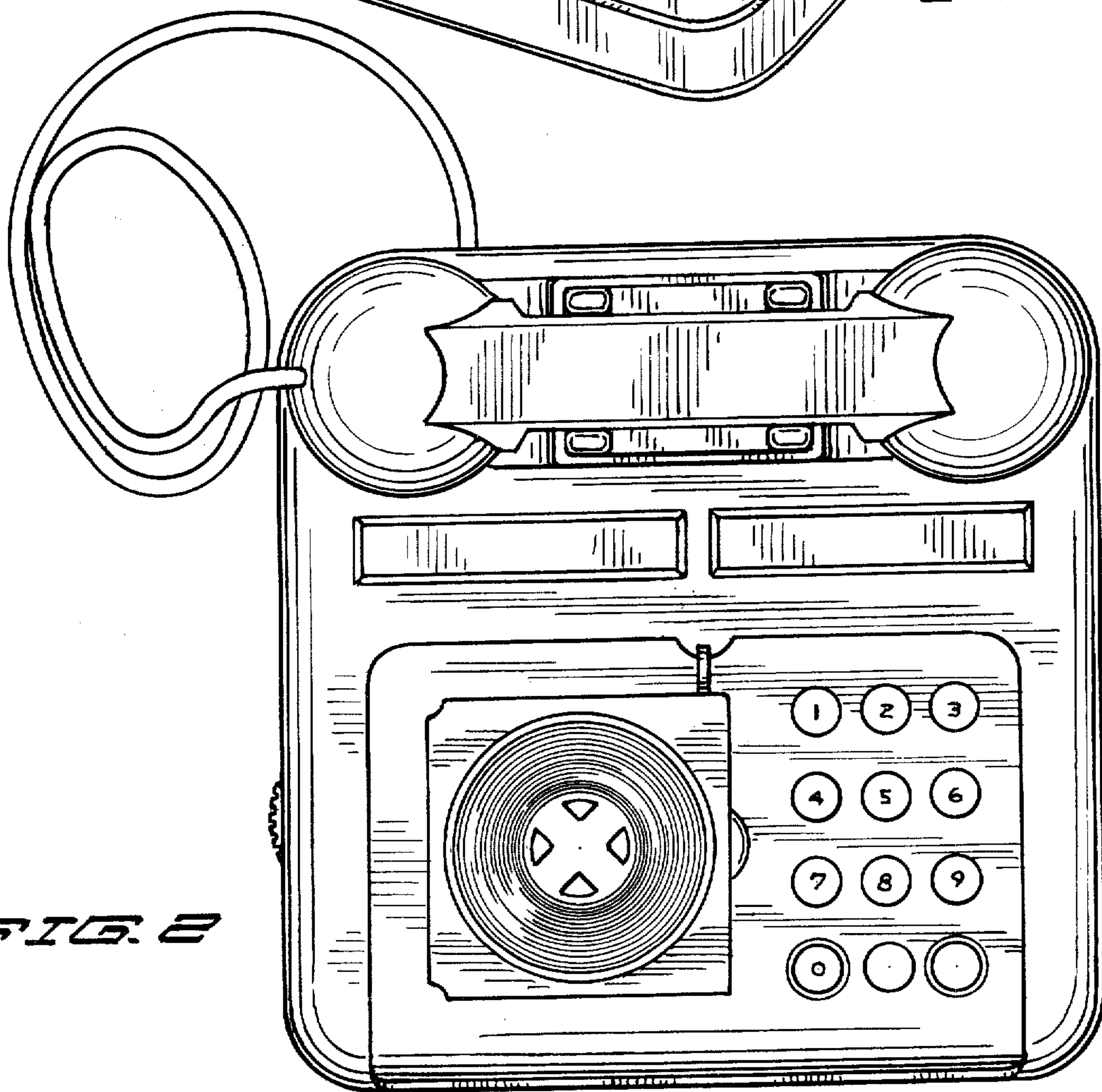

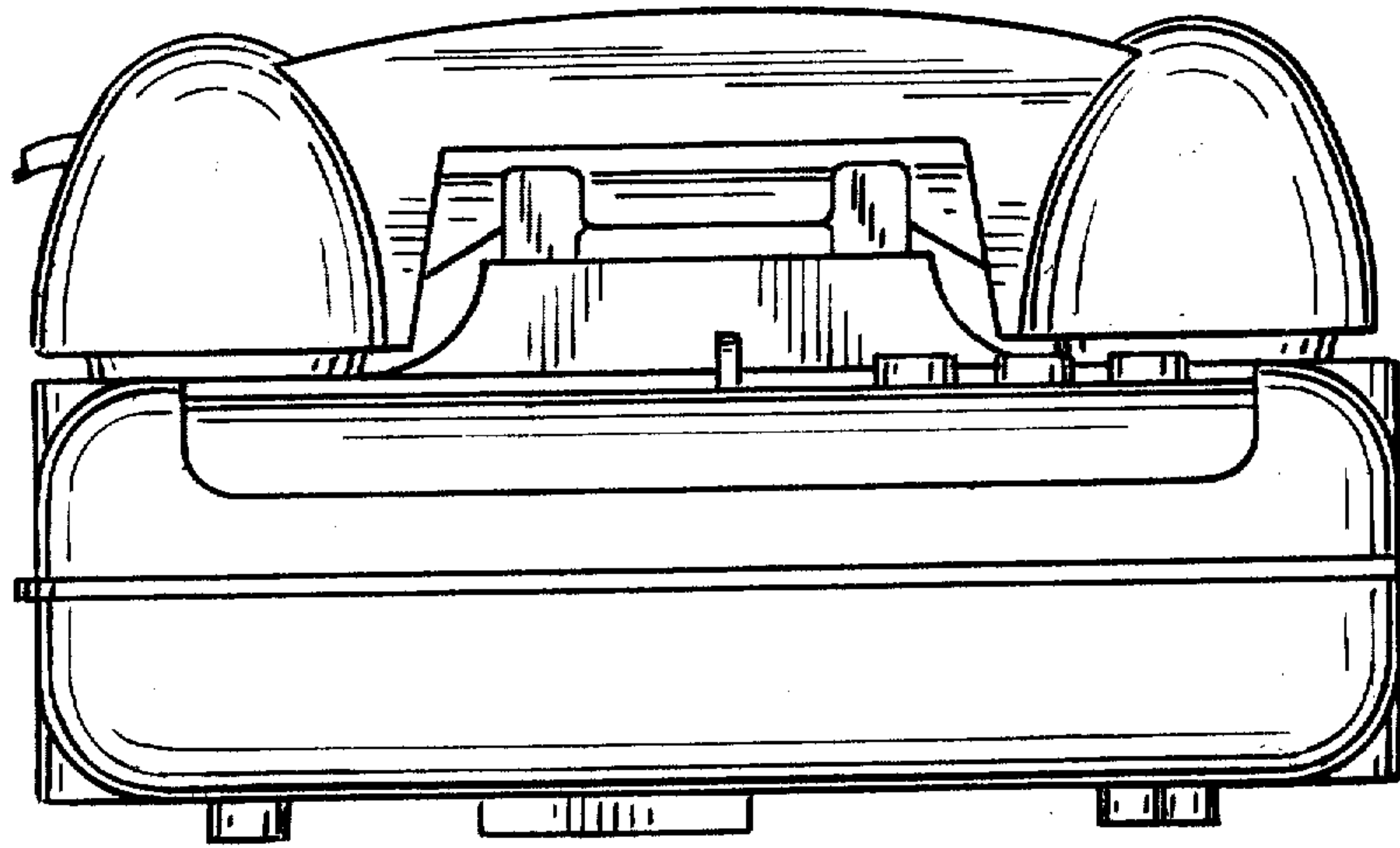

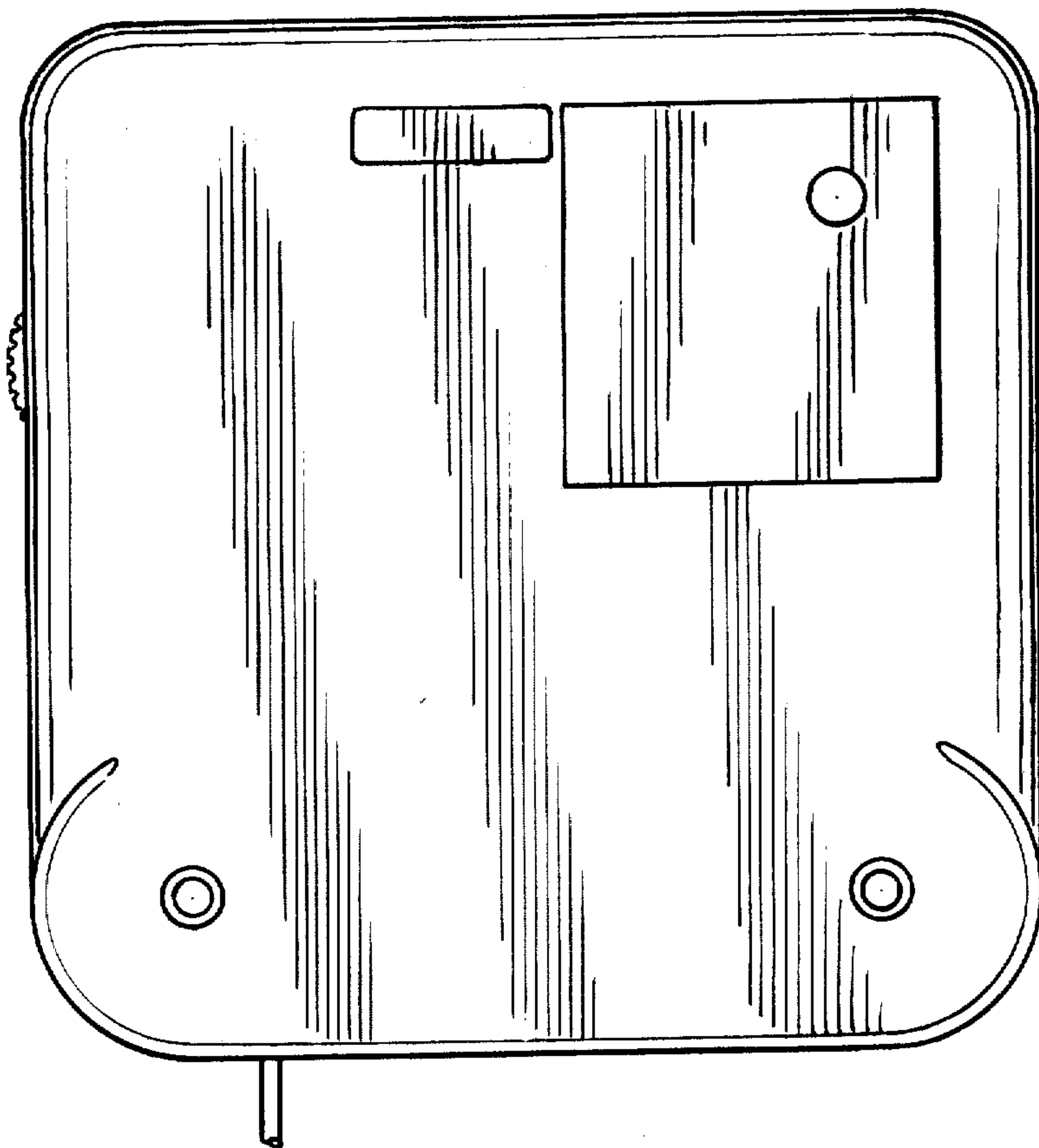

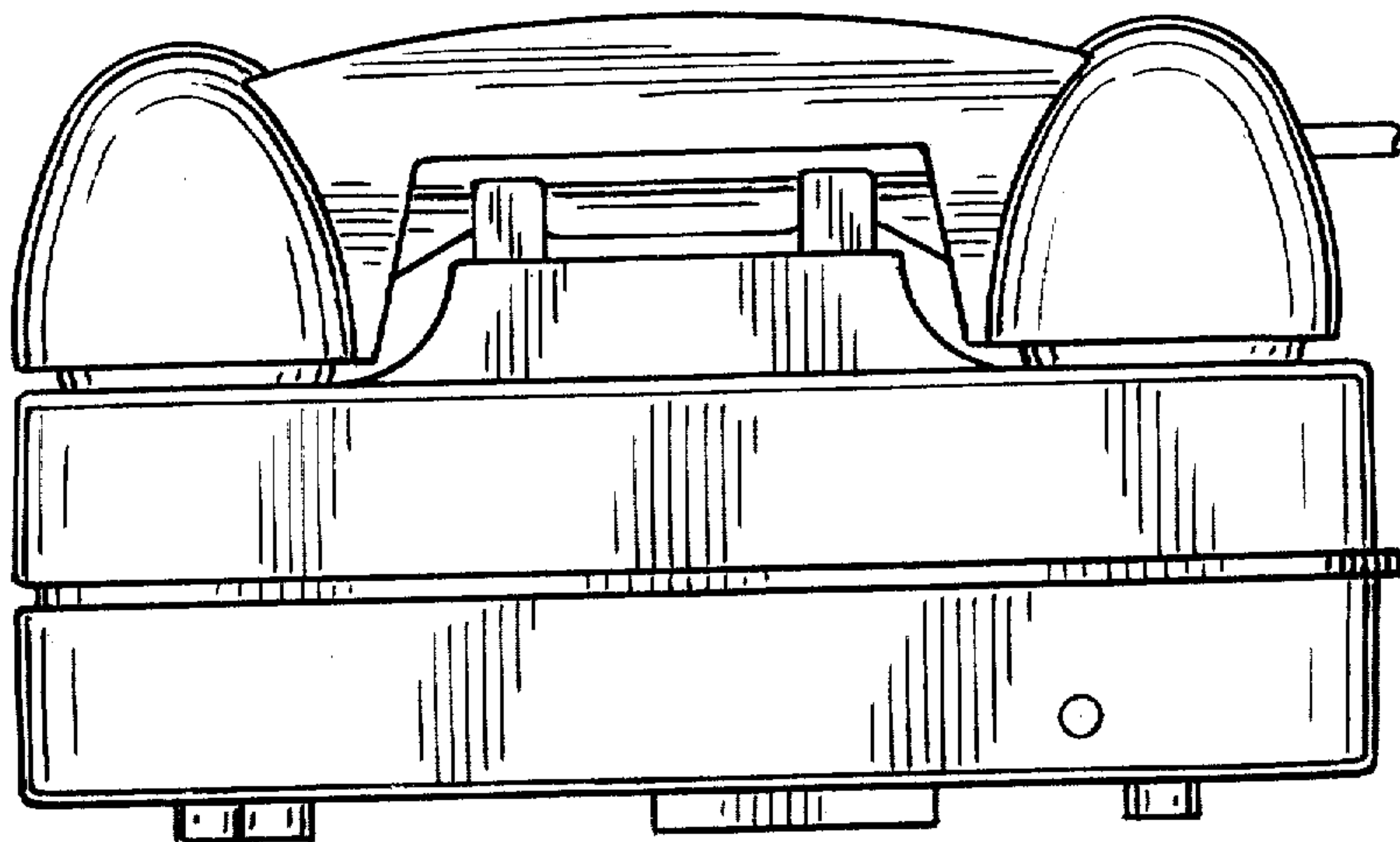

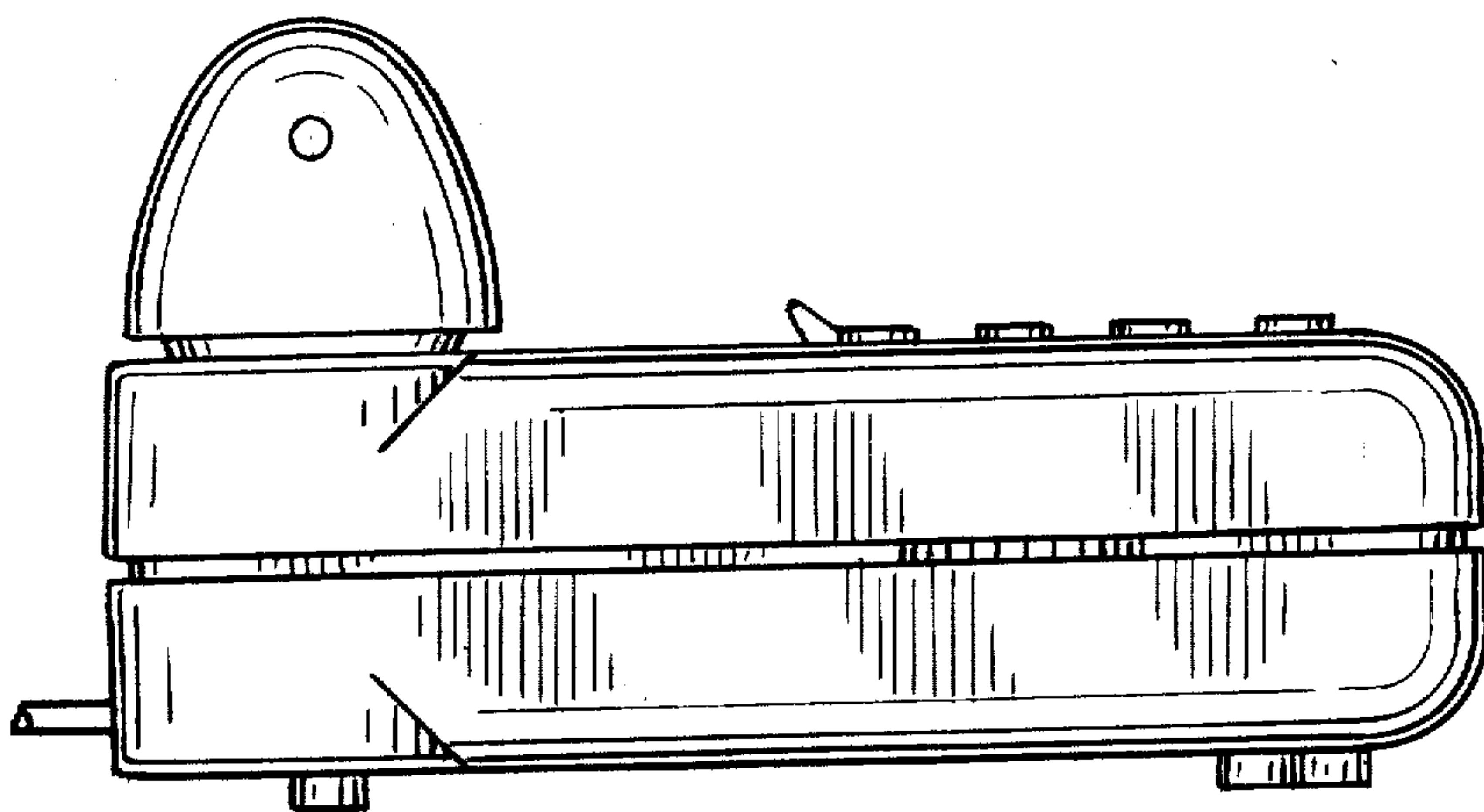

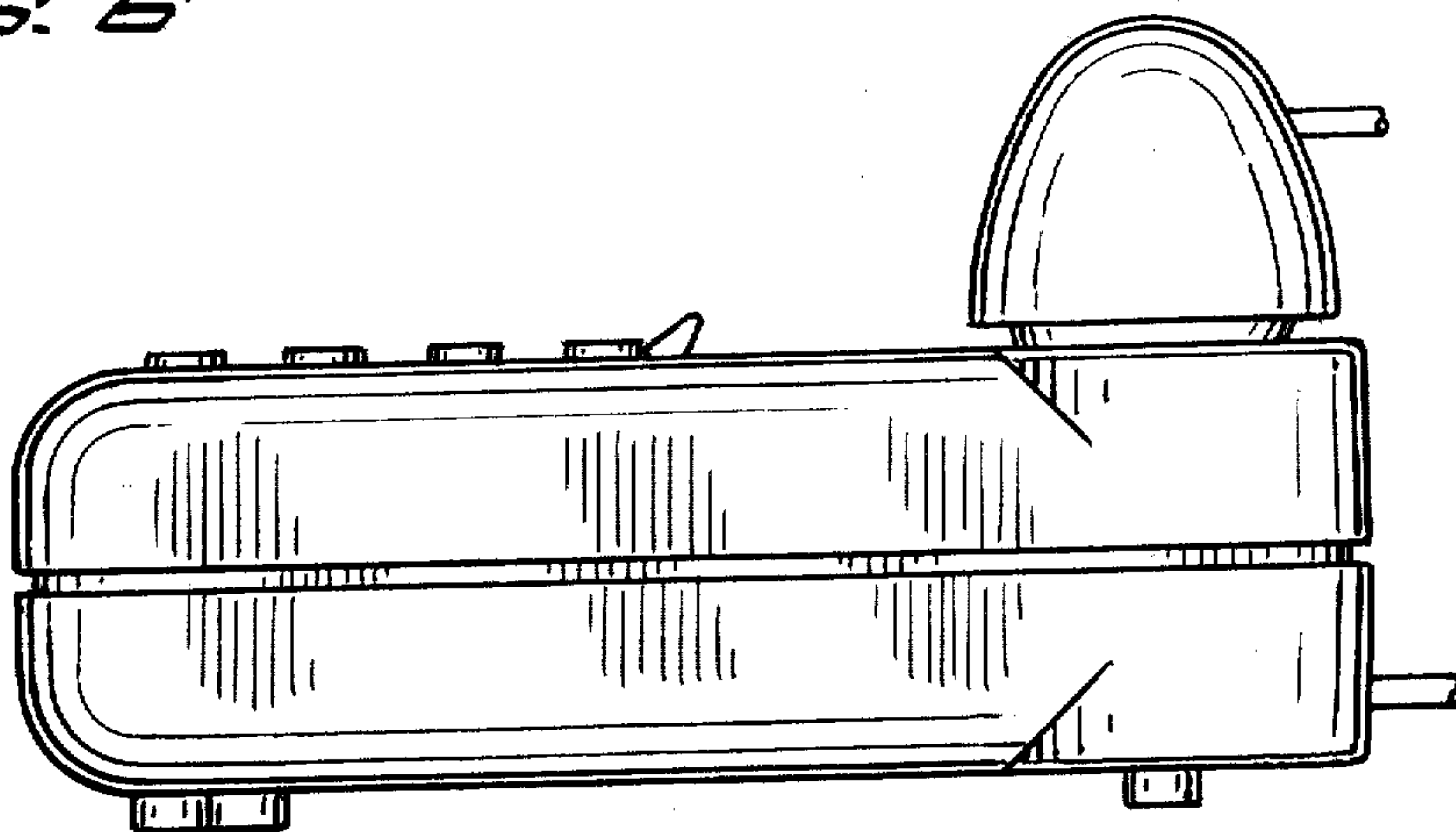
