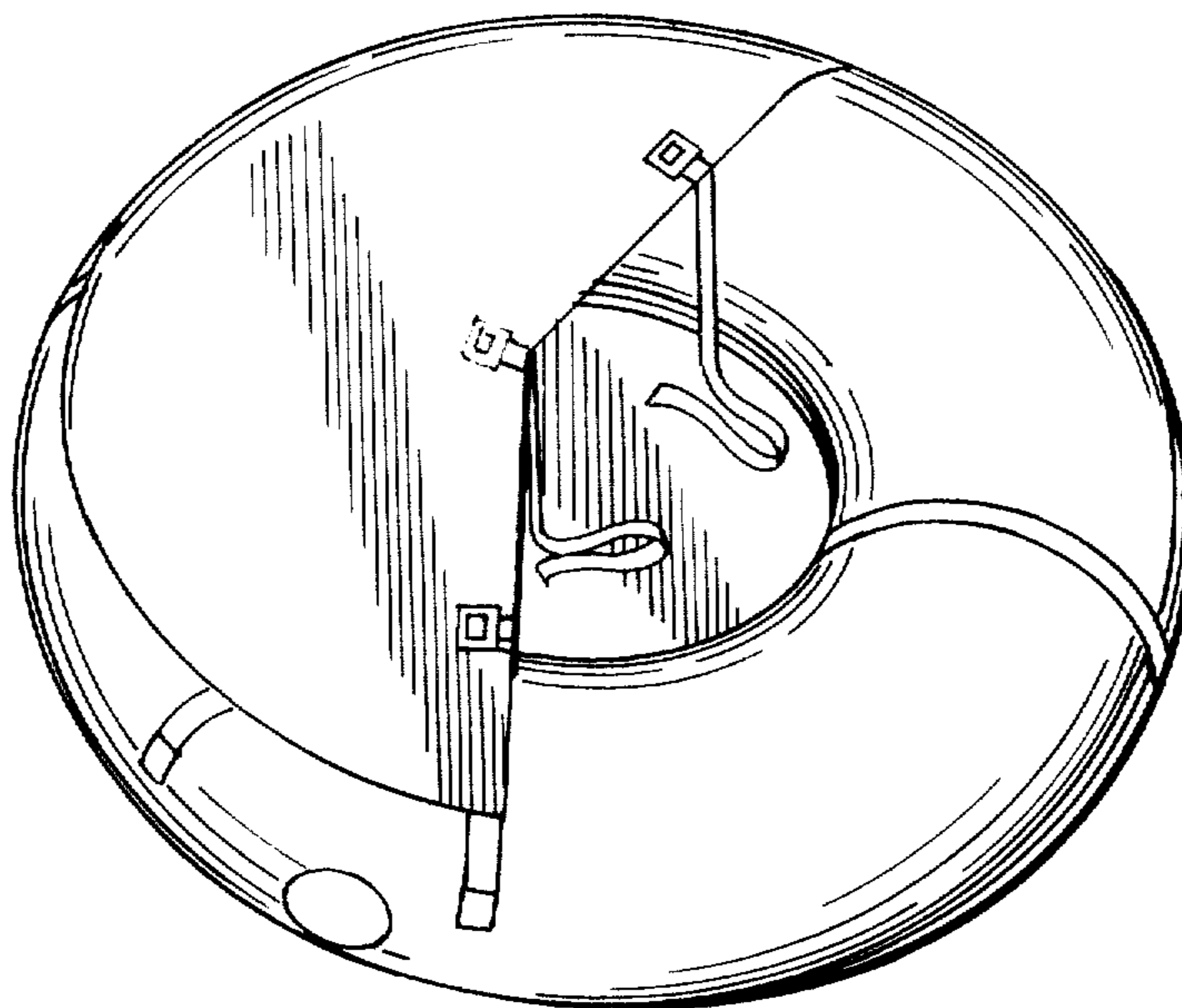

The ornamental design for a fishing float, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top perspective view of the fishing float showing my new design;  
FIG. 2 is a top perspective view as in FIG. 1 with a protective cover positioned over a portion thereof;  
FIG. 3 is a top plan view thereof;  
FIG. 4 is a bottom plan view thereof;  
FIG. 5 is a side view thereof with the opposite side being a mirror image;  
FIG. 6 is a front view in elevation; and,  
FIG. 7 is a rear view in elevation thereof.



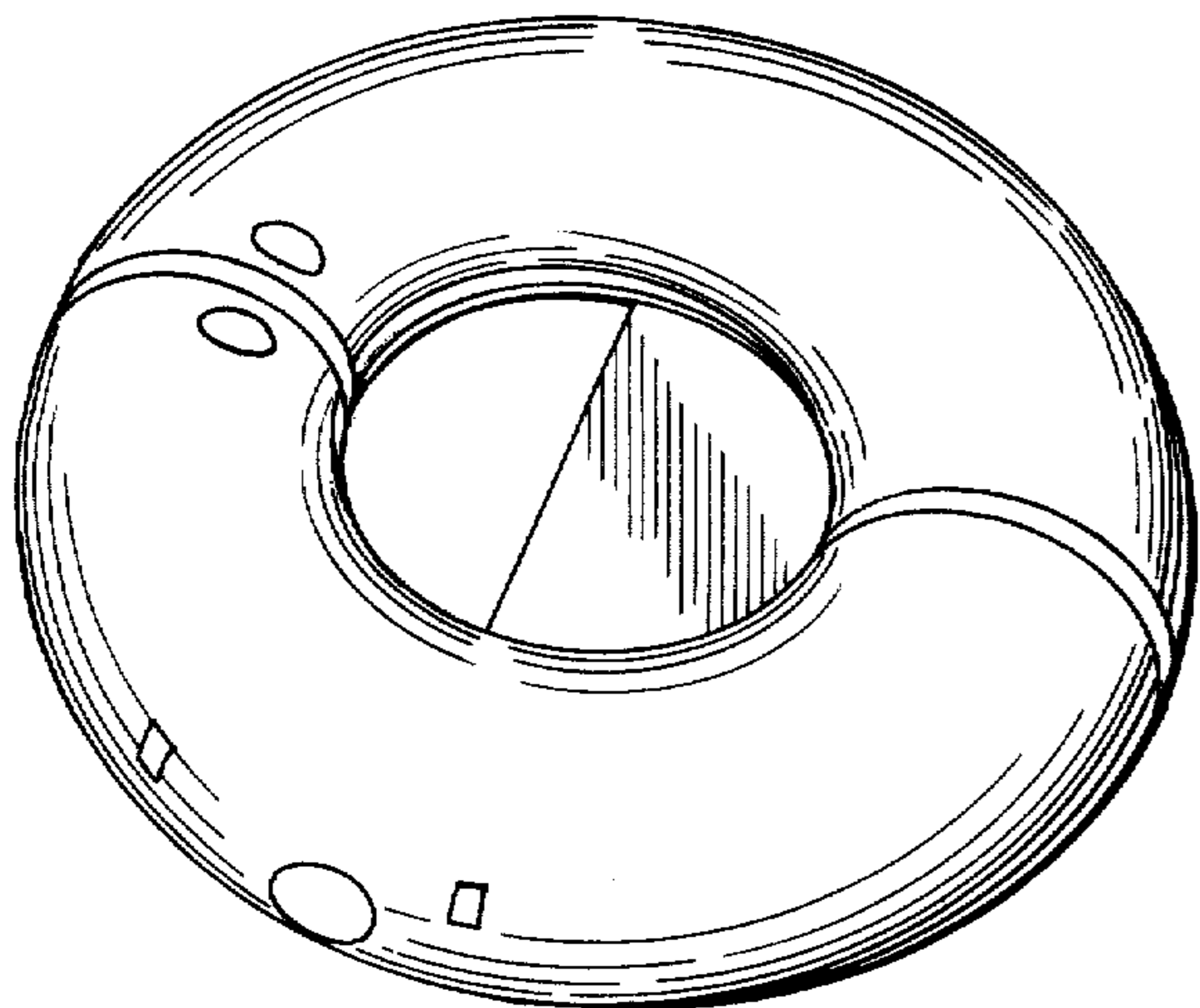

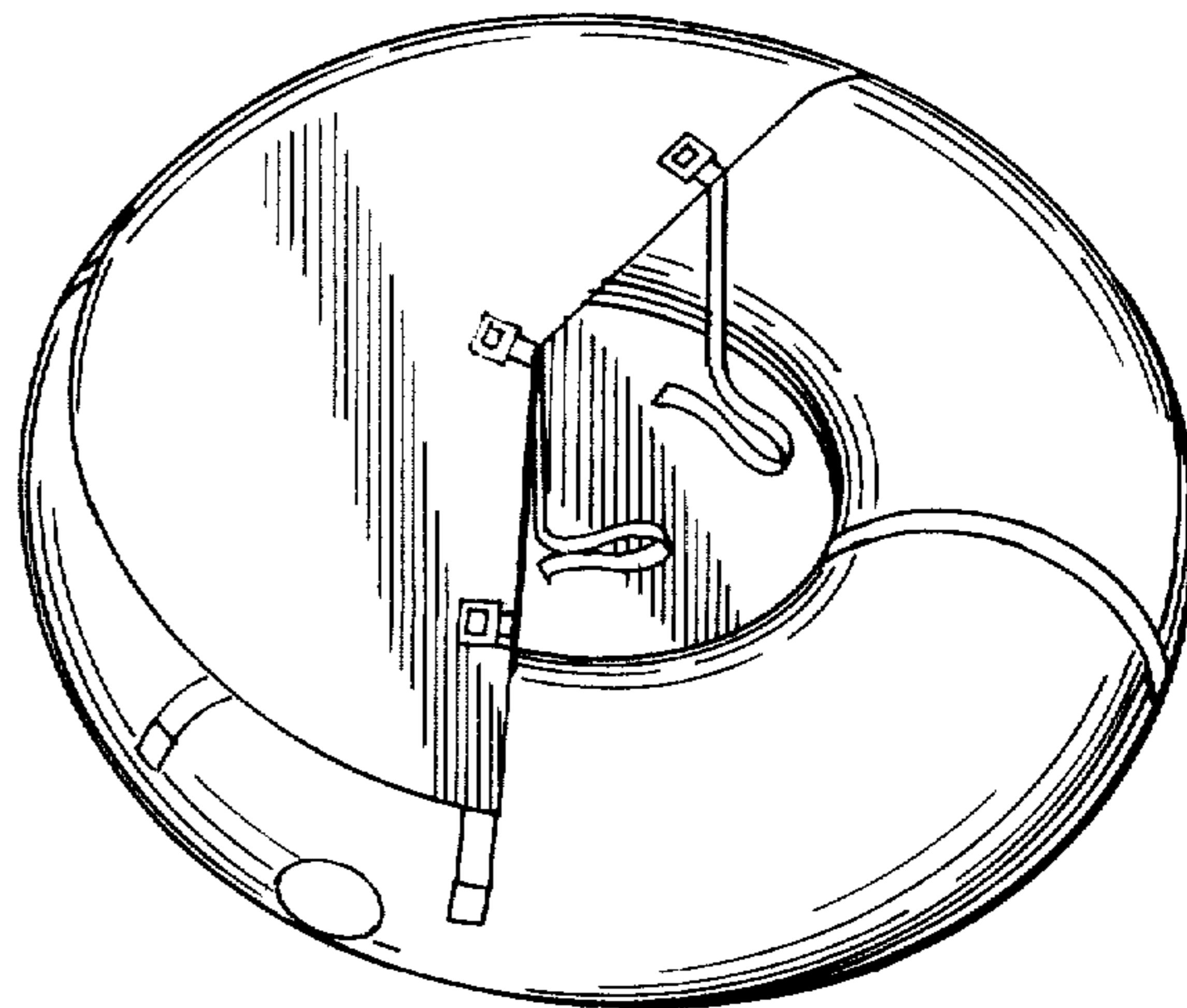

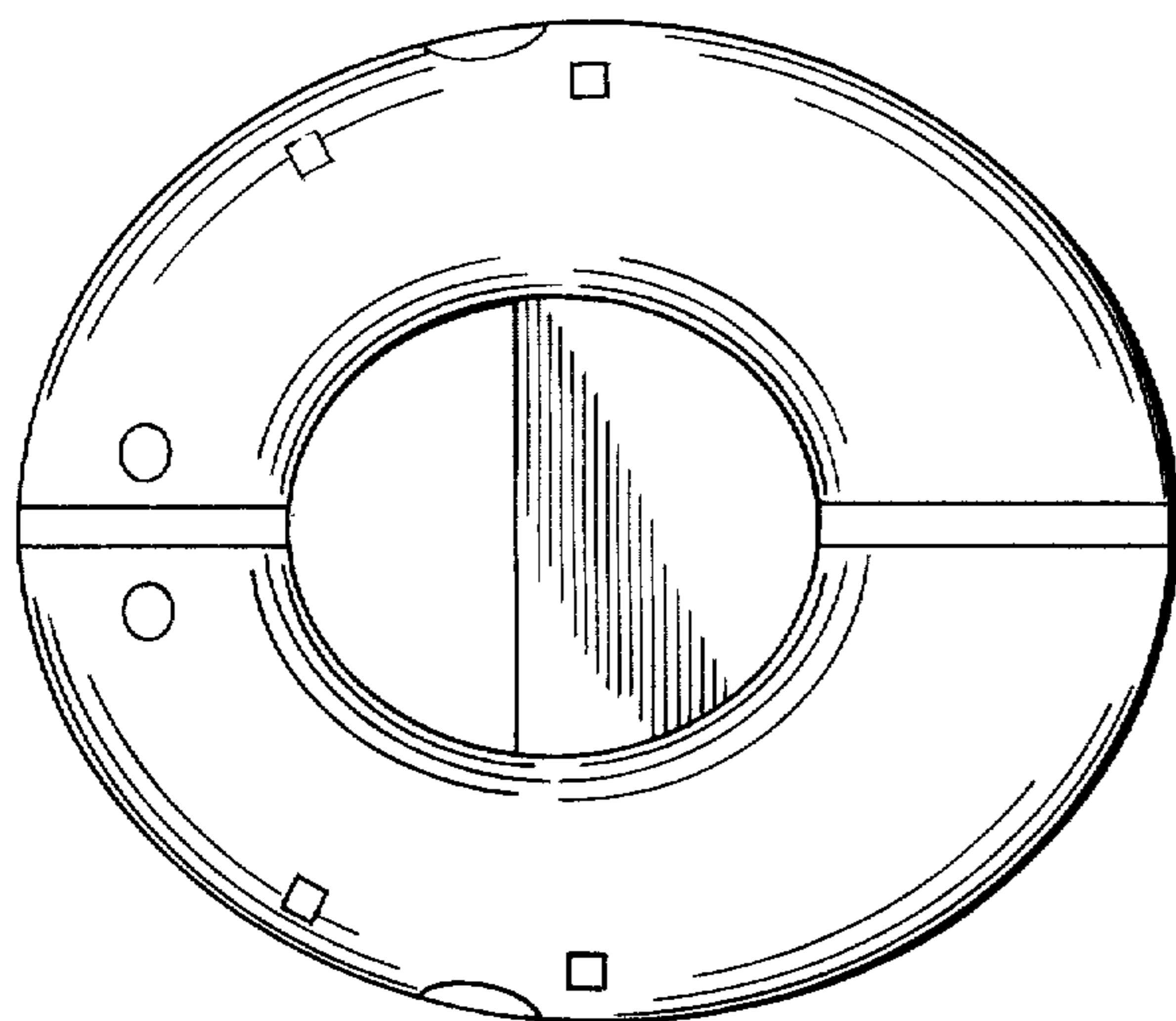

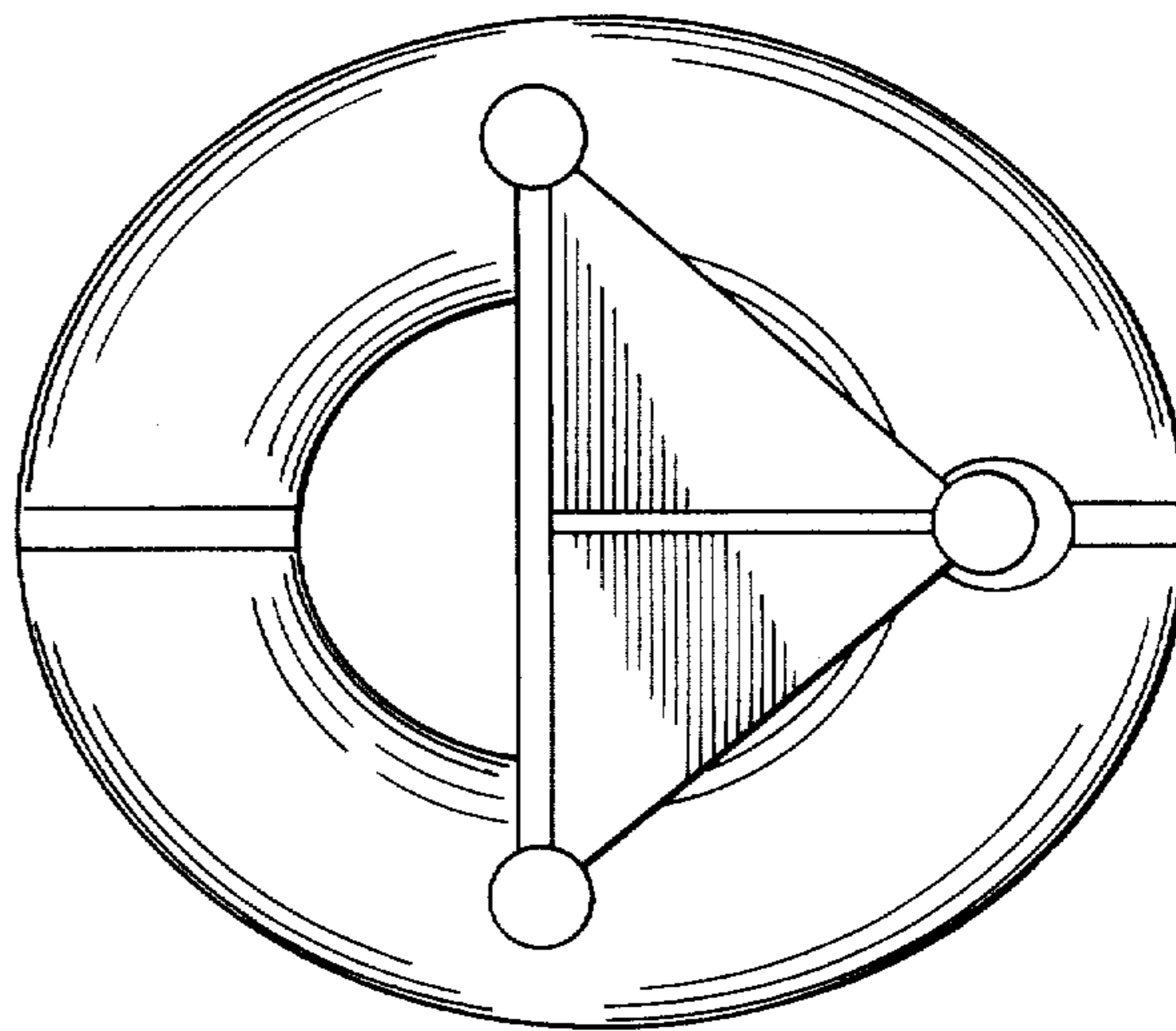

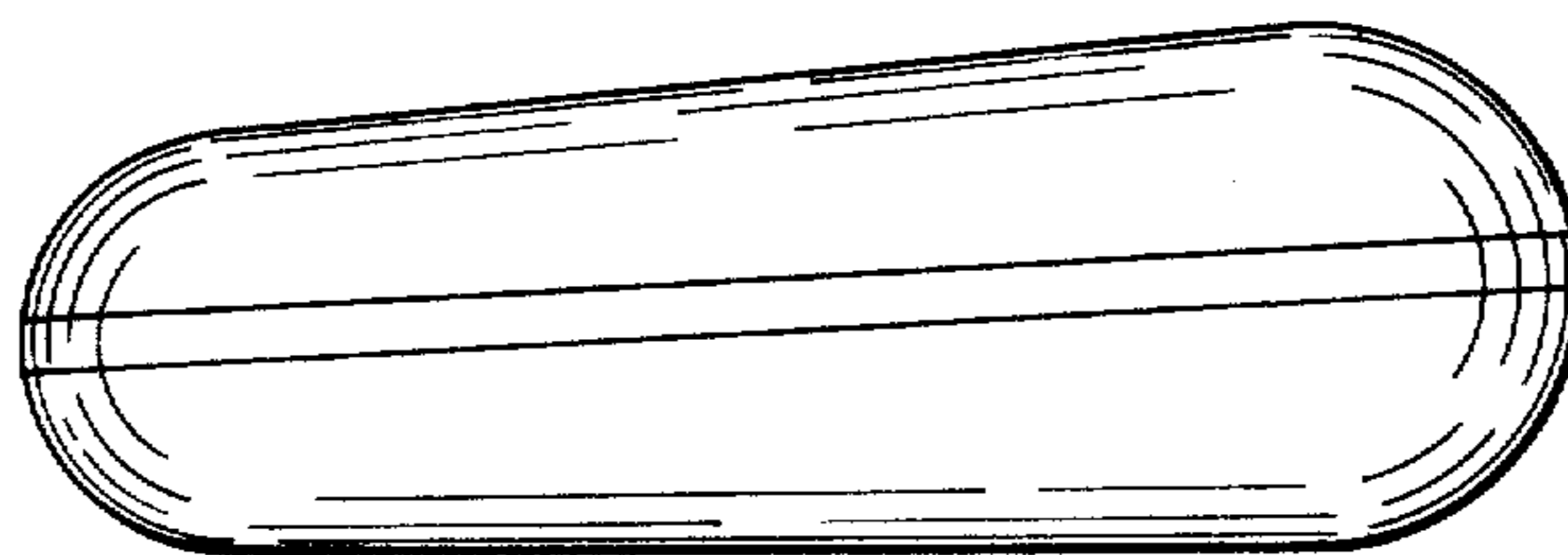

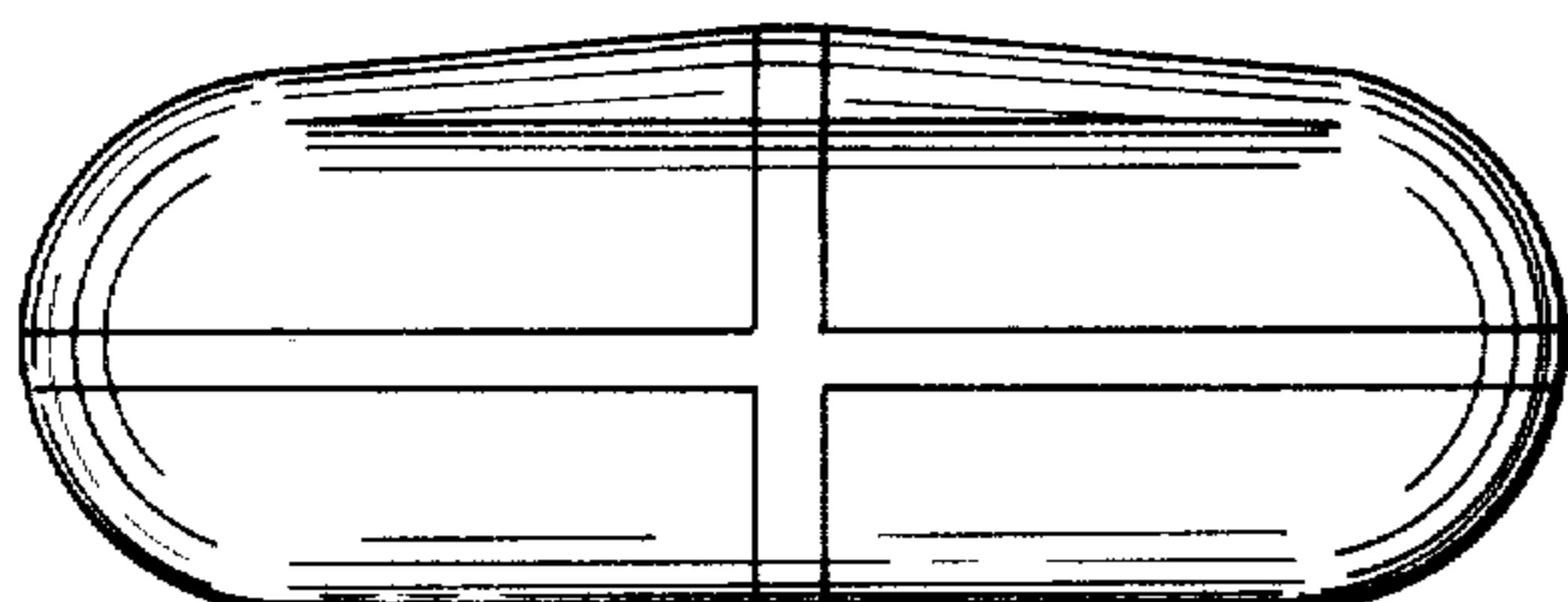

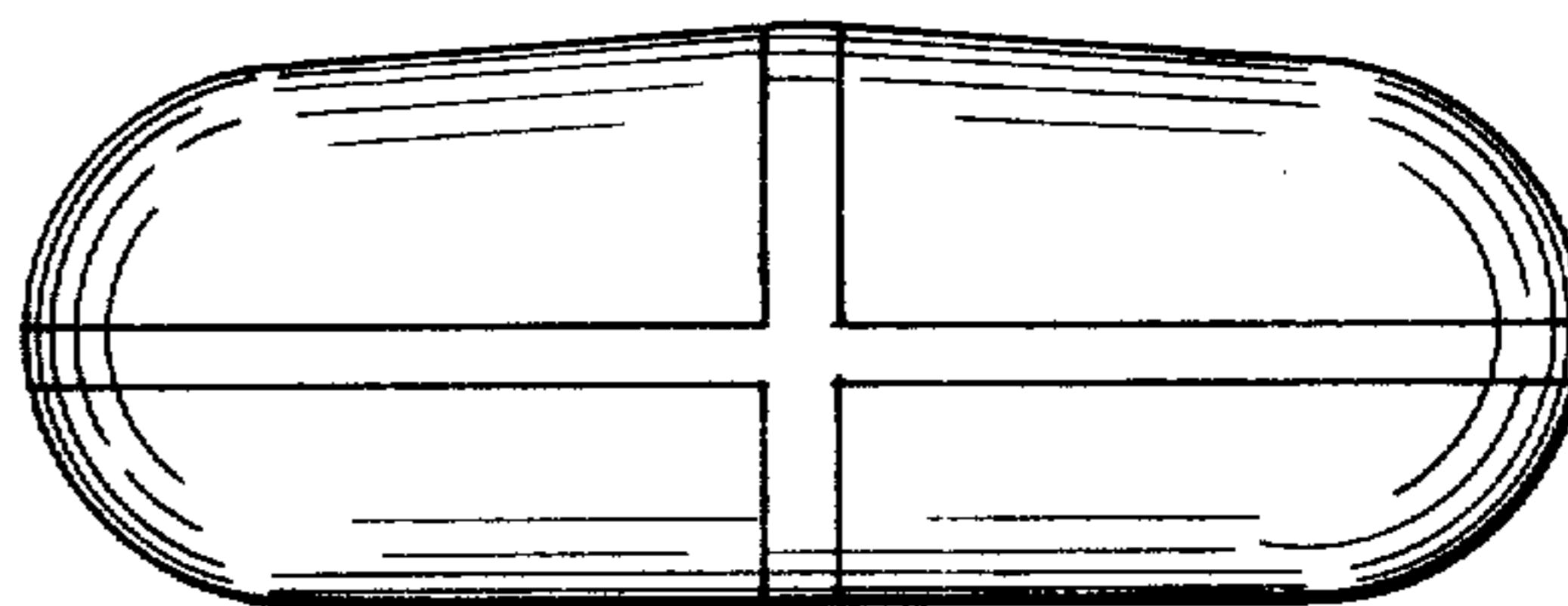
