## [57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a payment deposit cabinet, substantially as shown and described.

## DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view as seen from the front and one side of a payment deposit cabinet showing my new design;

FIG. 2 is a view in front elevation thereof;




FIG. 3 FIG. 1 FIG. 2 FIG. 4

FIG. 3 is an elevational view of one side thereof;

FIG. 4 is a view in top plan thereof;

FIG. 5 is an elevational view from the other side thereof;

FIG. 6 is an elevational view from the rear thereof;

FIG. 7 is a view in bottom plan thereof;

FIG. 8 is a perspective view of the payment deposit cabinet showing a second embodiment of my new design as viewed from the front and one side thereof, the opposite side being a mirror image of the side shown, and the bottom, top and rear thereof being flat and unornamented.
