[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a sole for a shoe, substantially as shown and described.

**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is a bottom plan view of a sole for a shoe showing my new design;

FIG. 2 is a side elevational view of one side thereof;

FIG. 3 is a front elevational view thereof;

FIG. 4 is a rear elevational view thereof;

FIG. 5 is a side elevational view of the other side thereof;

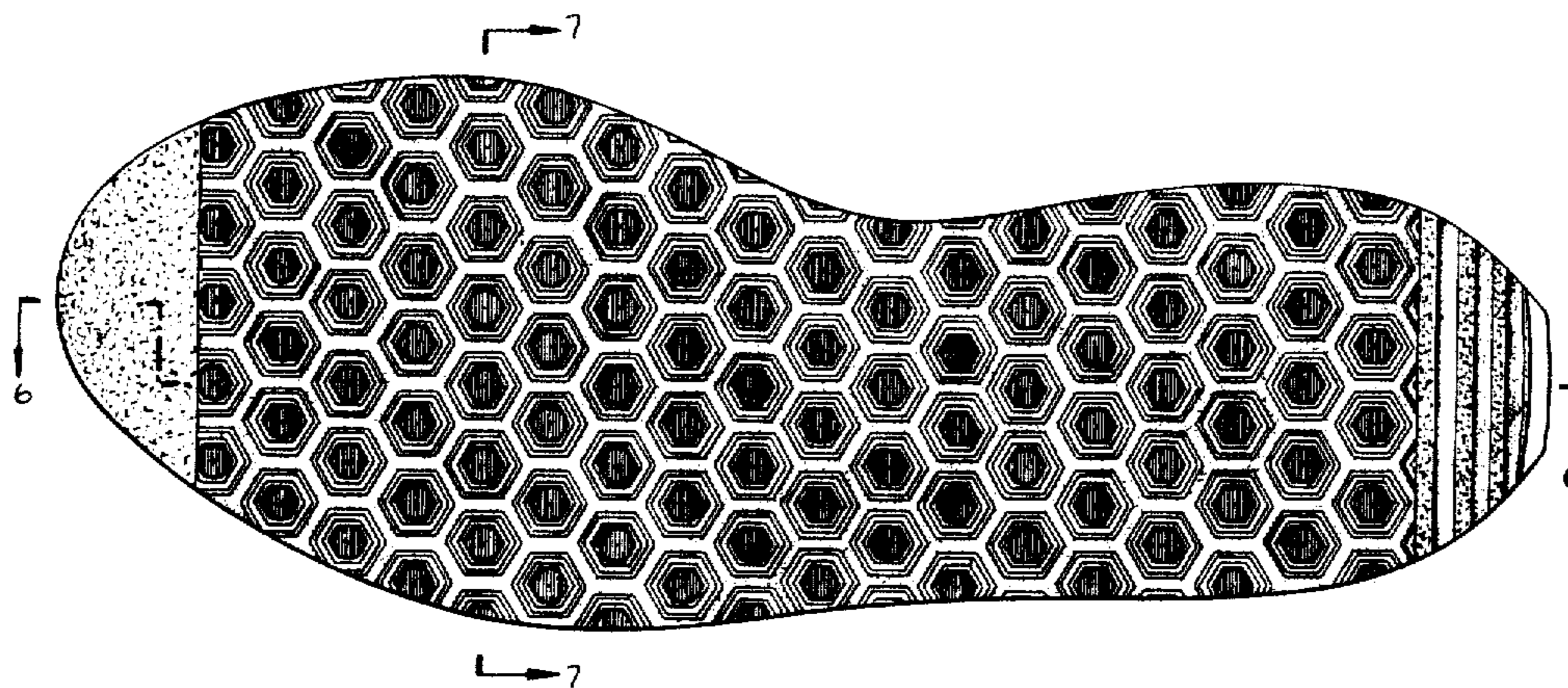
FIG. 6 is a cross-sectional view thereof as taken from line 6-6 of FIG. 1;

FIG. 7 is a cross-sectional view thereof as taken from line 7-7 of FIG. 1;

FIG. 10 is a fragmentary cross-sectional view thereof as taken from line 10-10 of FIG. 8.





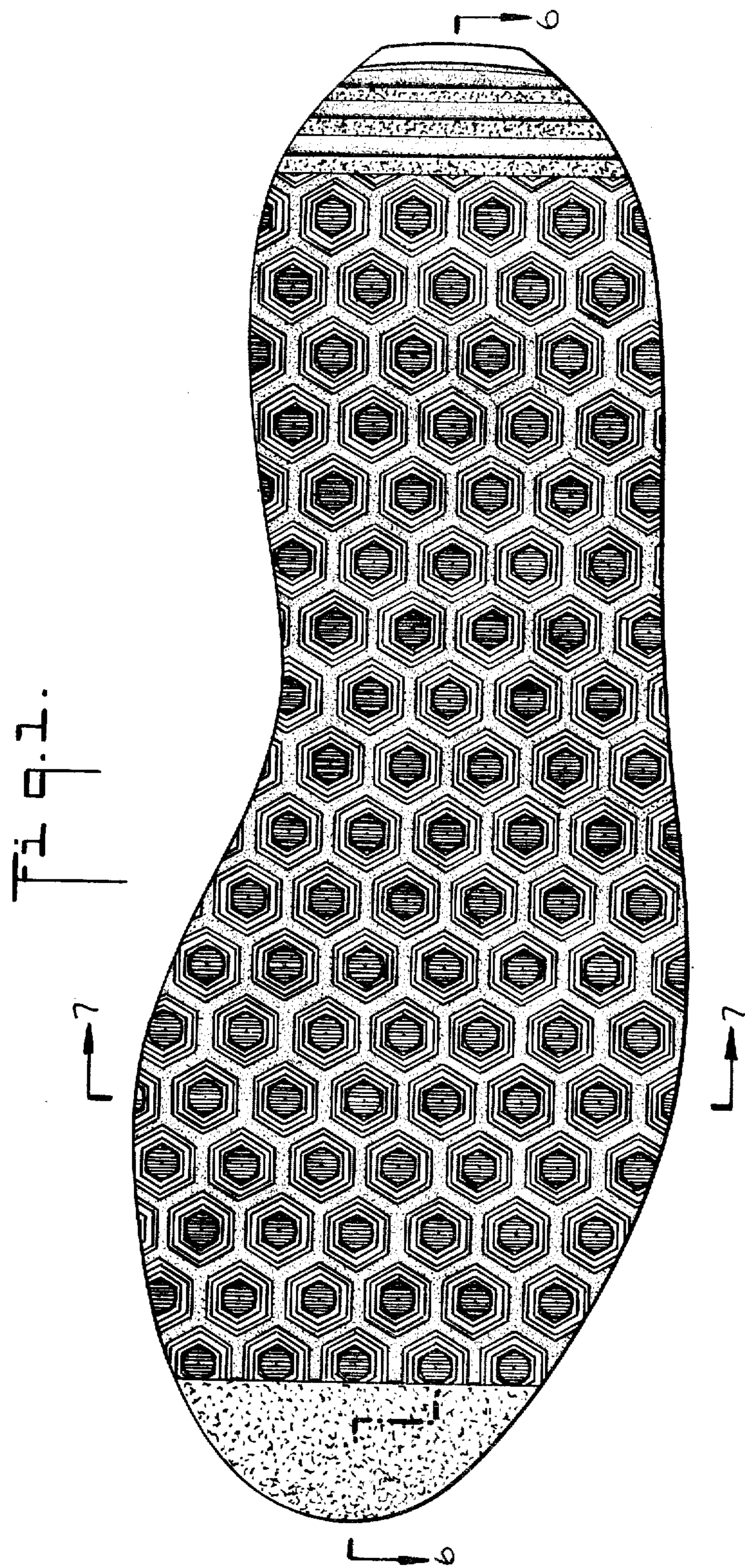

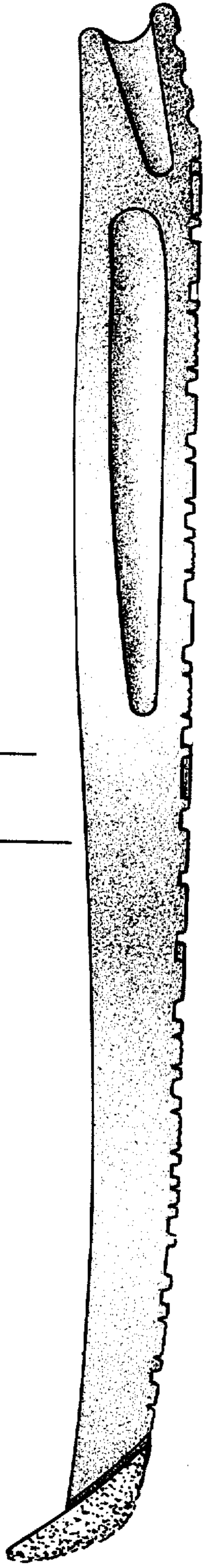

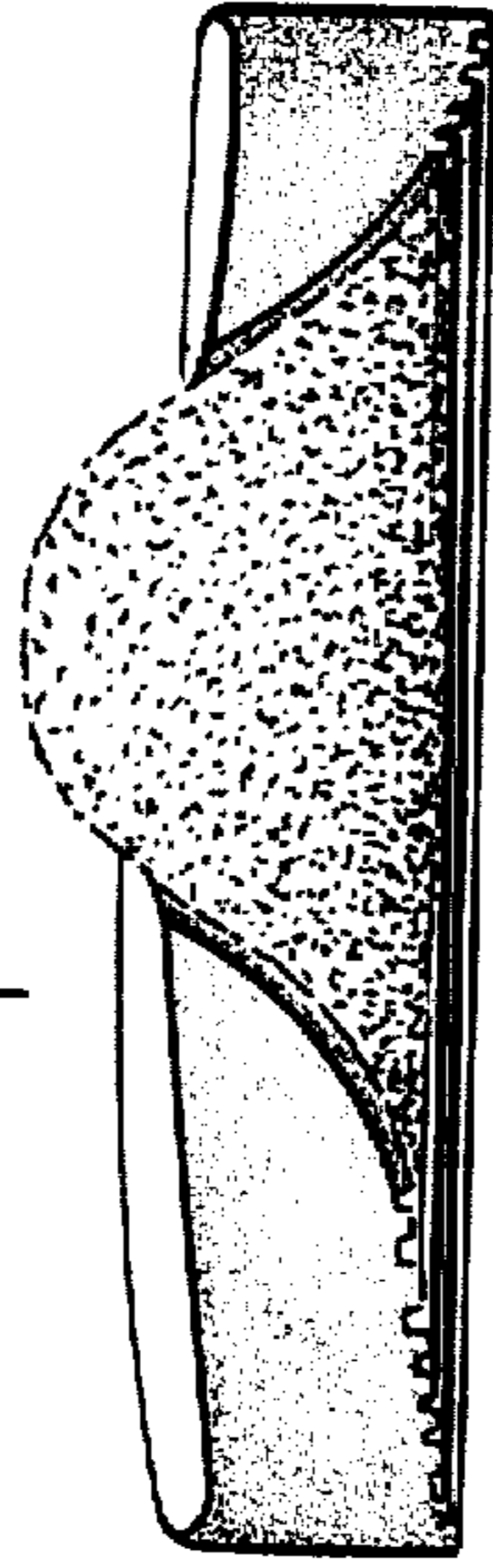

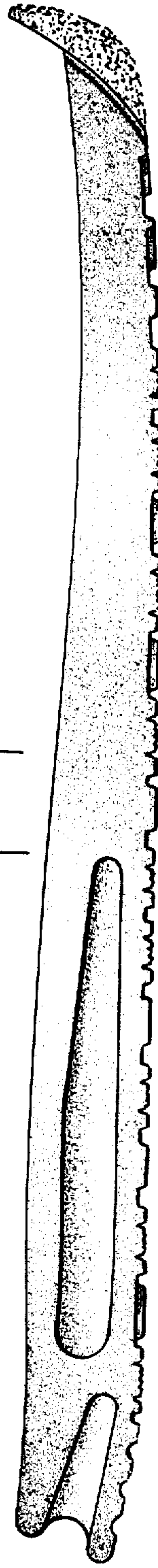

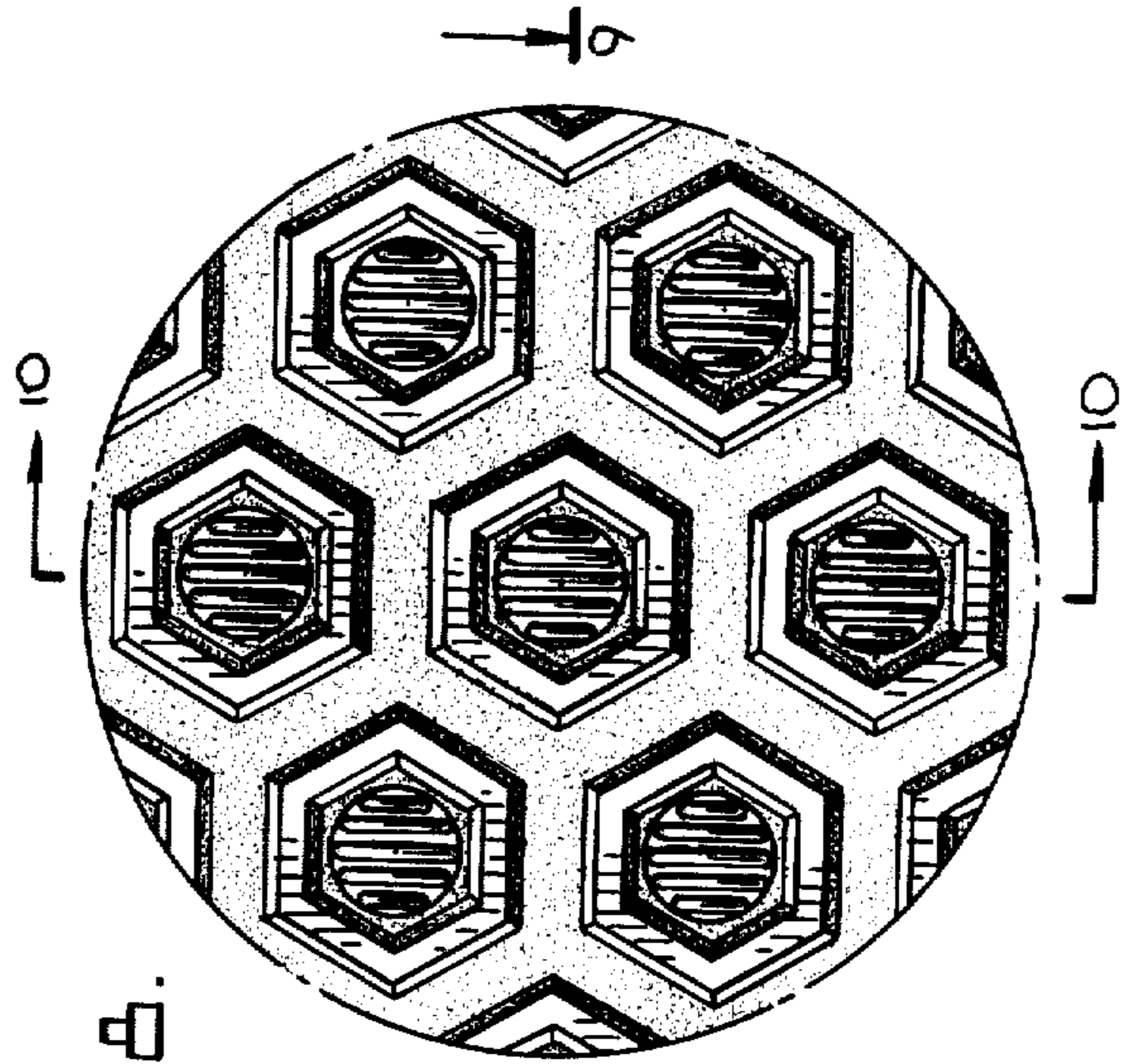
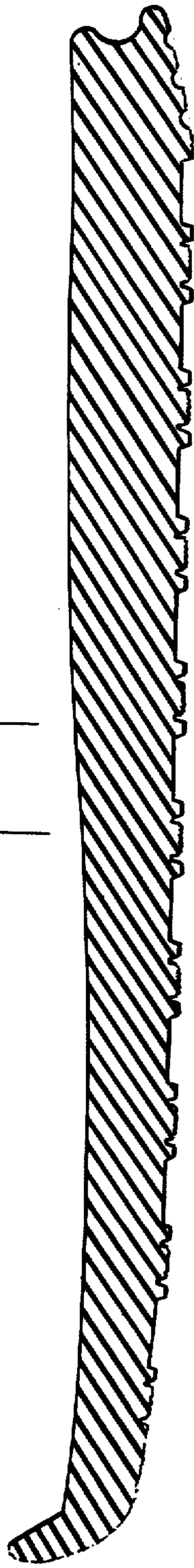

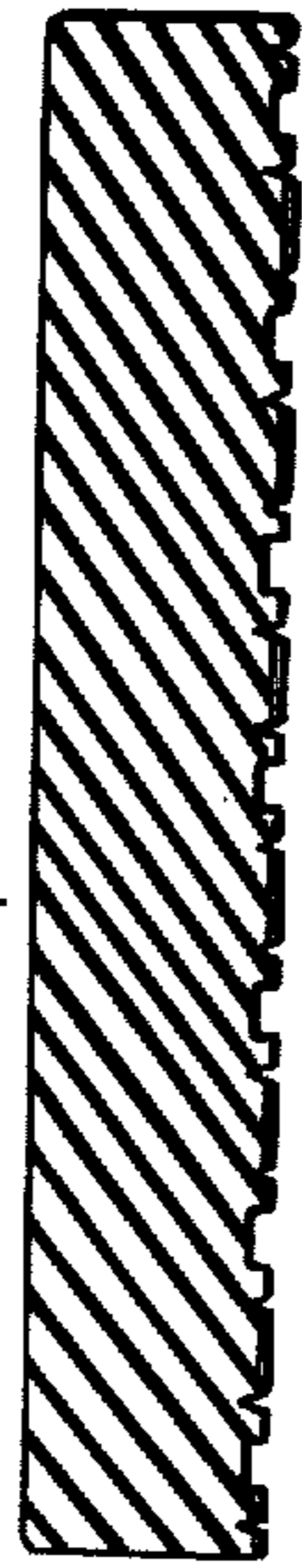
