**CLAIM**

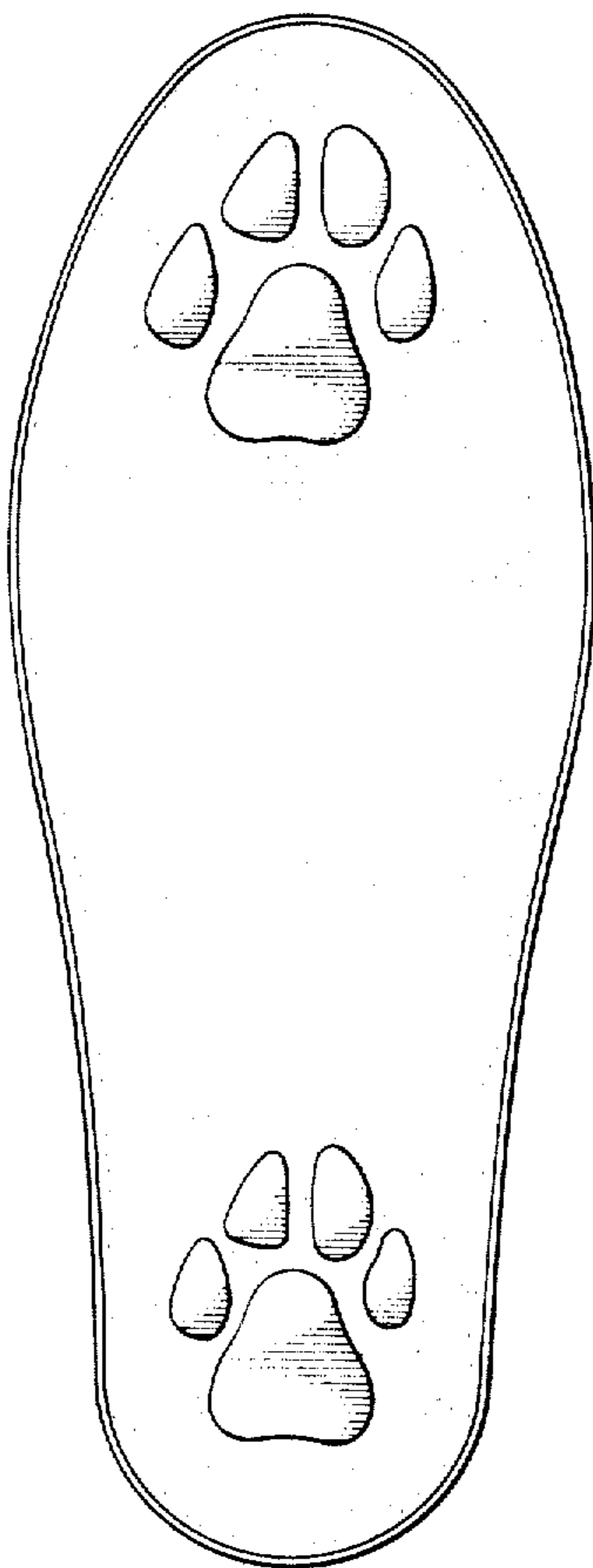
The ornamental design for a shoe sole, substantially as shown.

**DESCRIPTION**

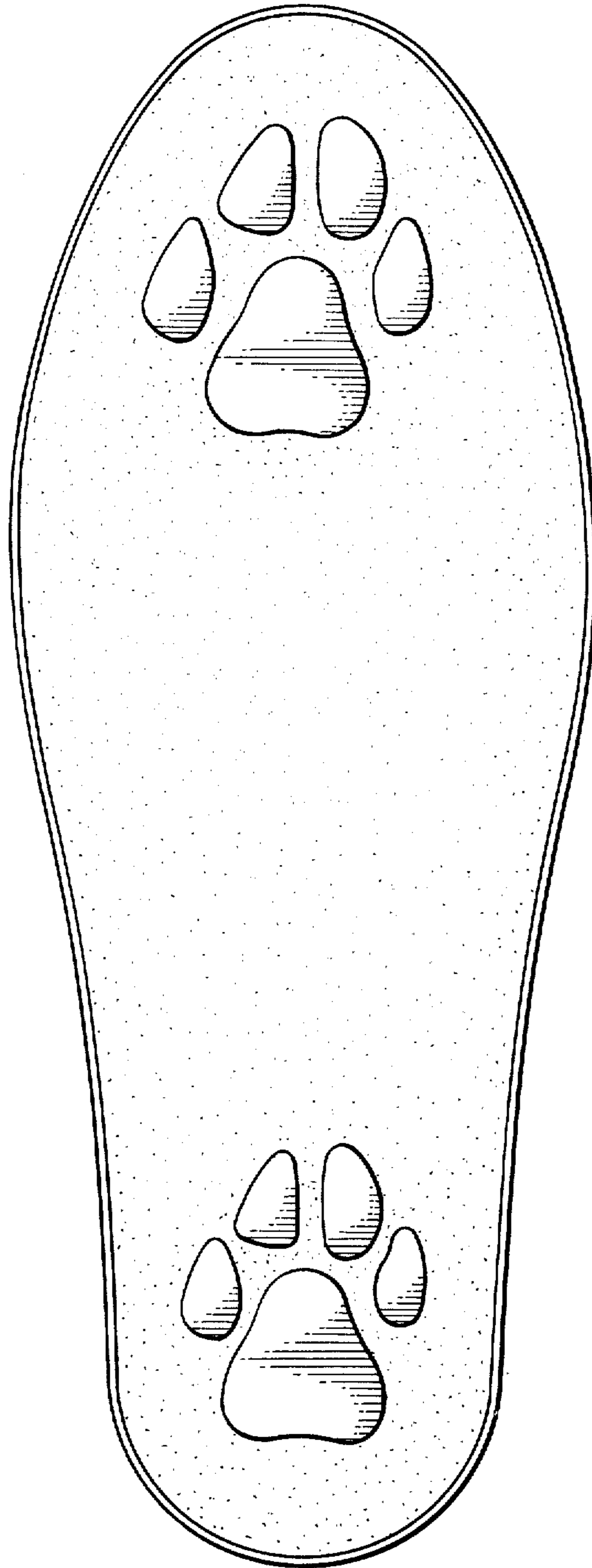
FIG. 1 is a bottom plan view of a shoe sole showing my new design; and
