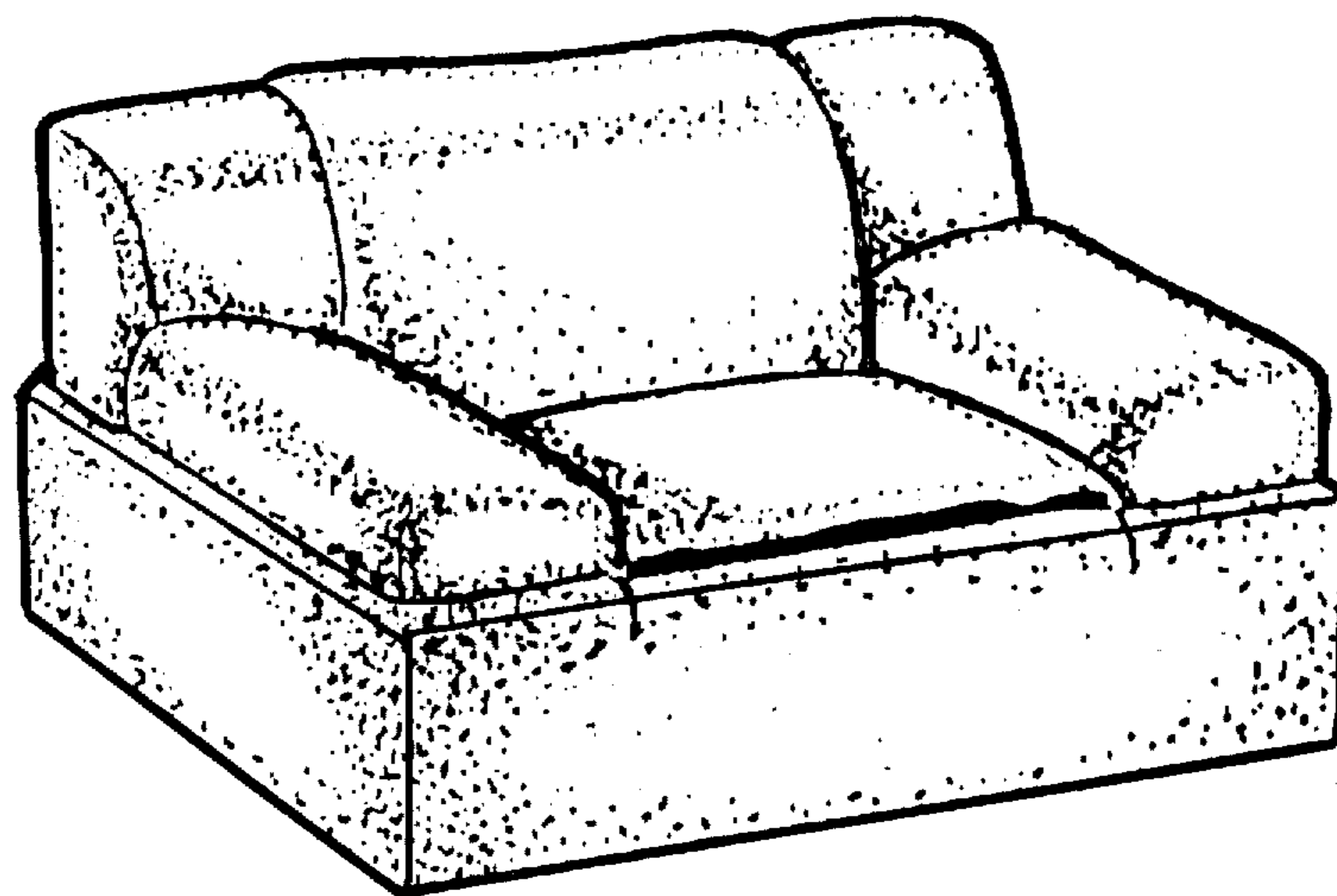
The ornamental design for an armchair, as shown.

FIG. 3 is a rear perspective view of the armchair shown in FIG. 1.



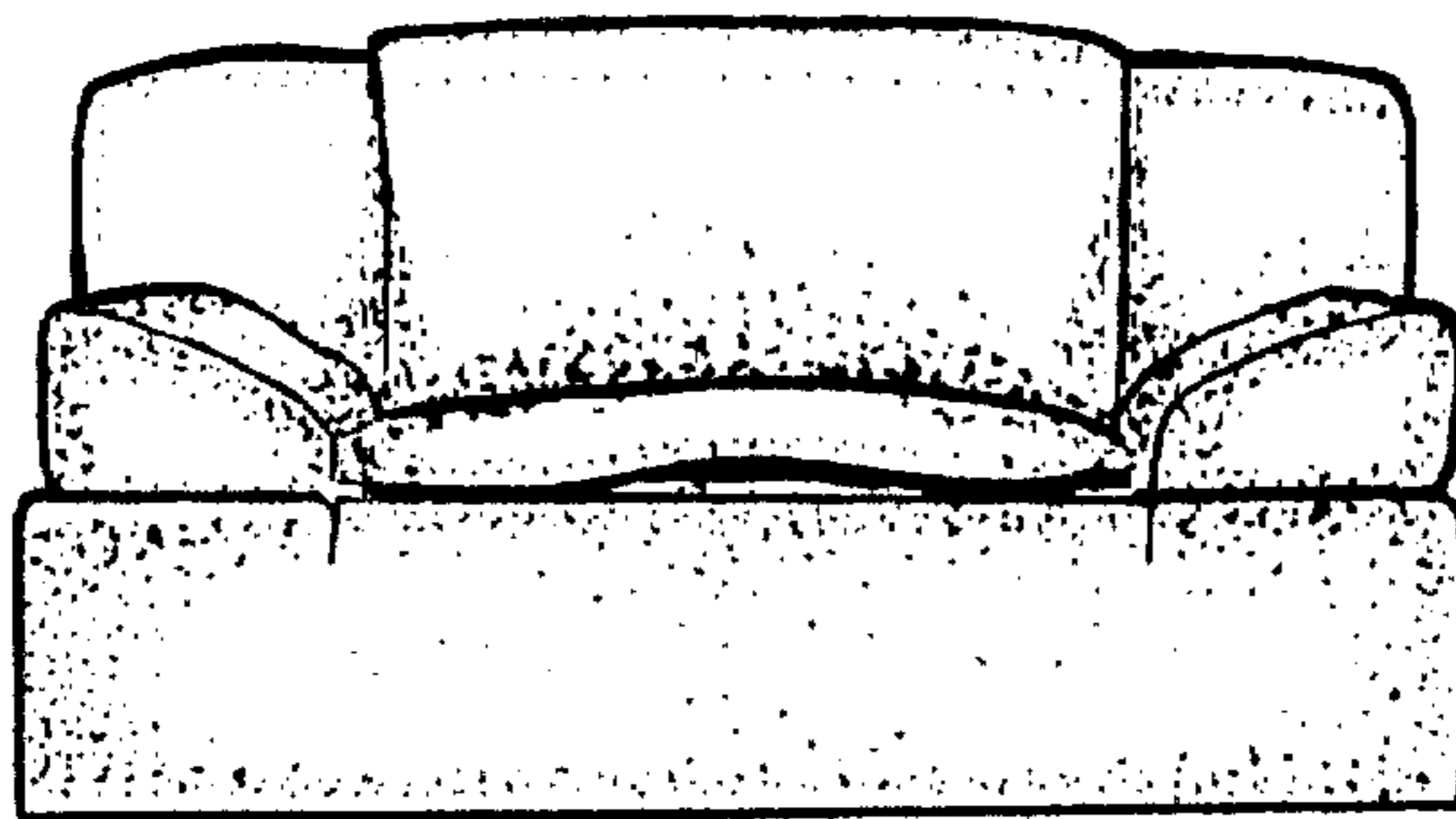

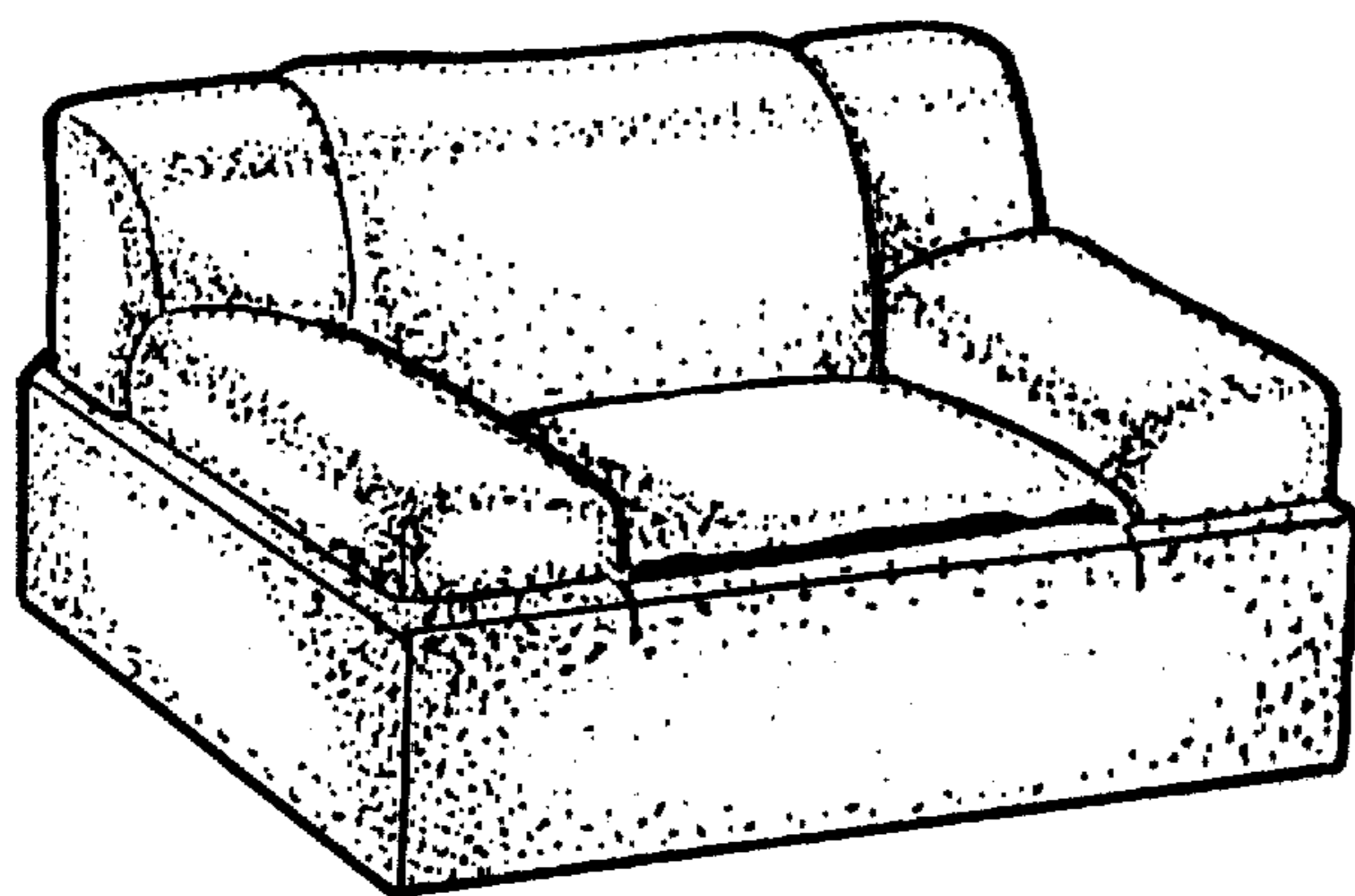
