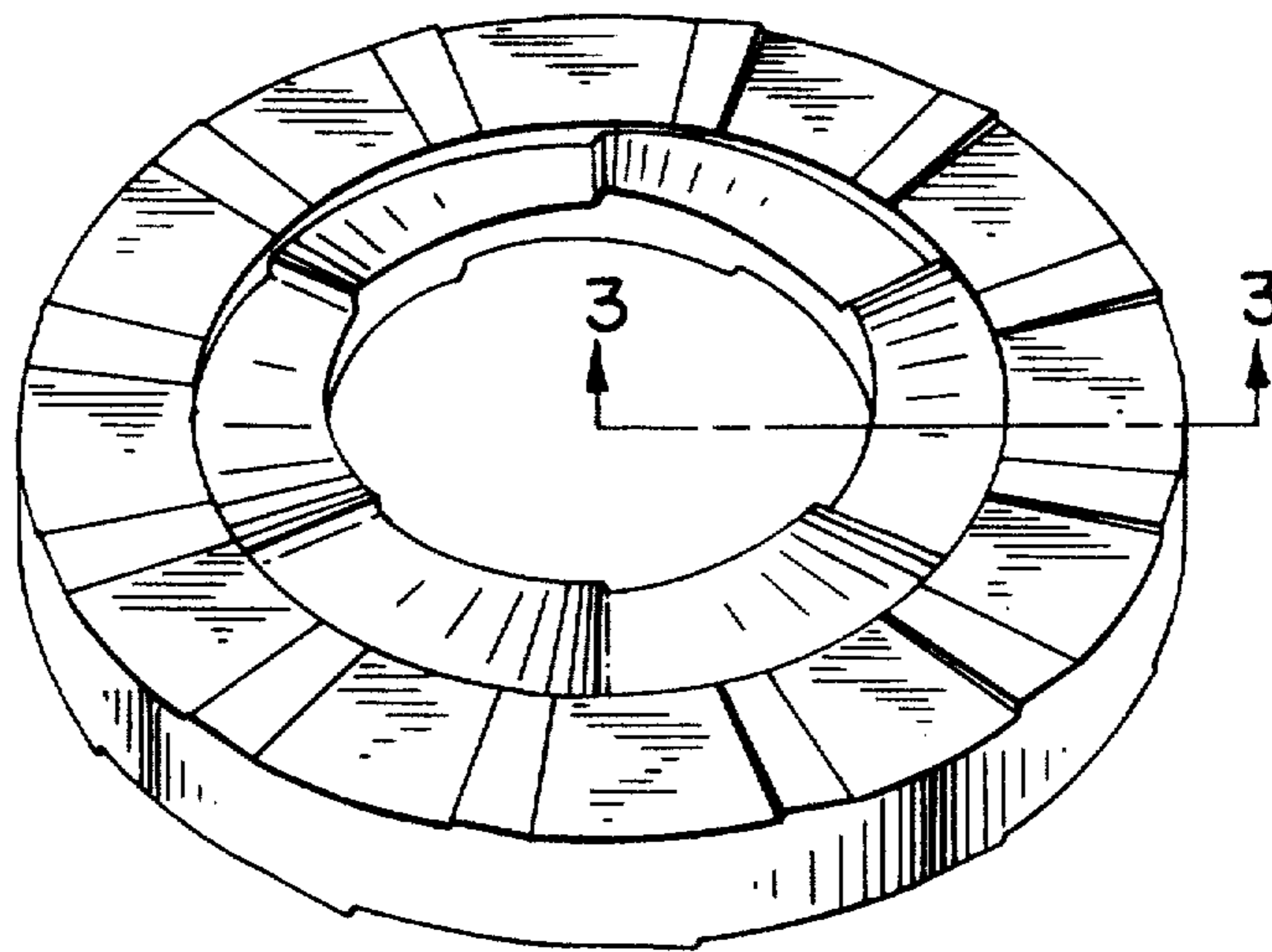

FIG. 3 is an enlarged fragmentary sectional view taken in the direction of the arrows on line 3-3 of FIG. 1.



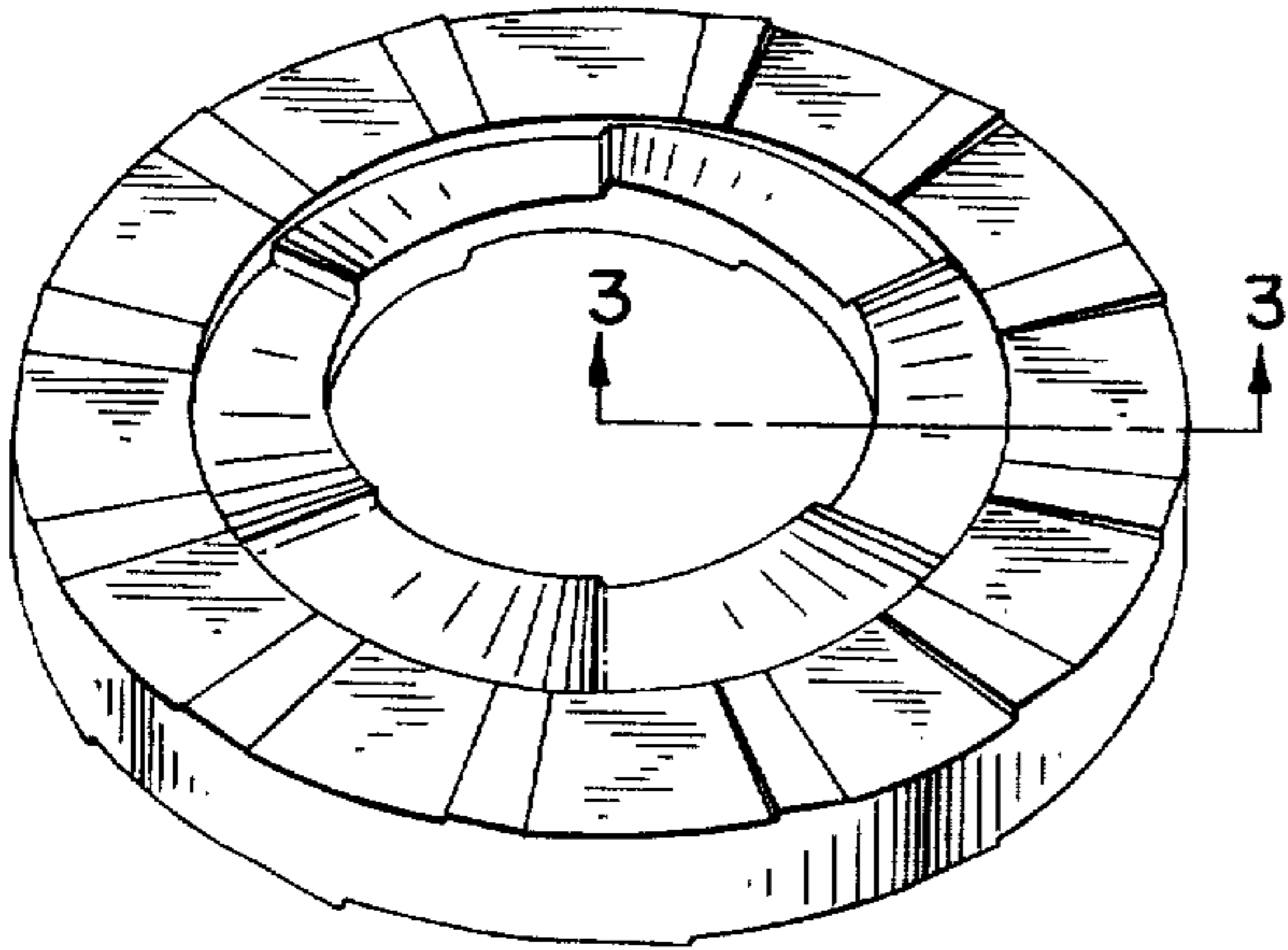

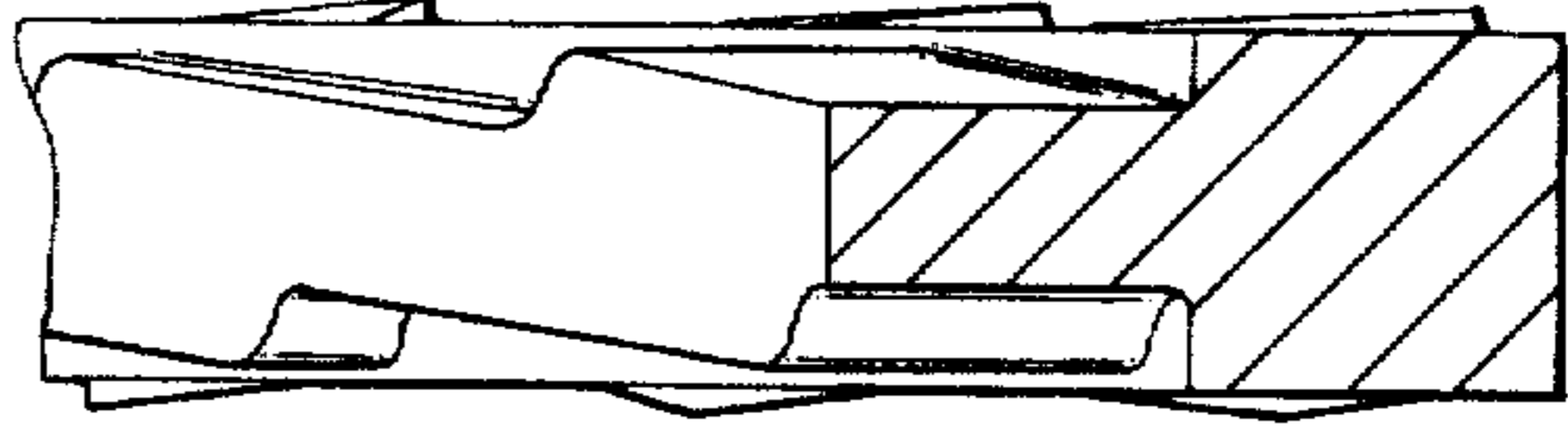

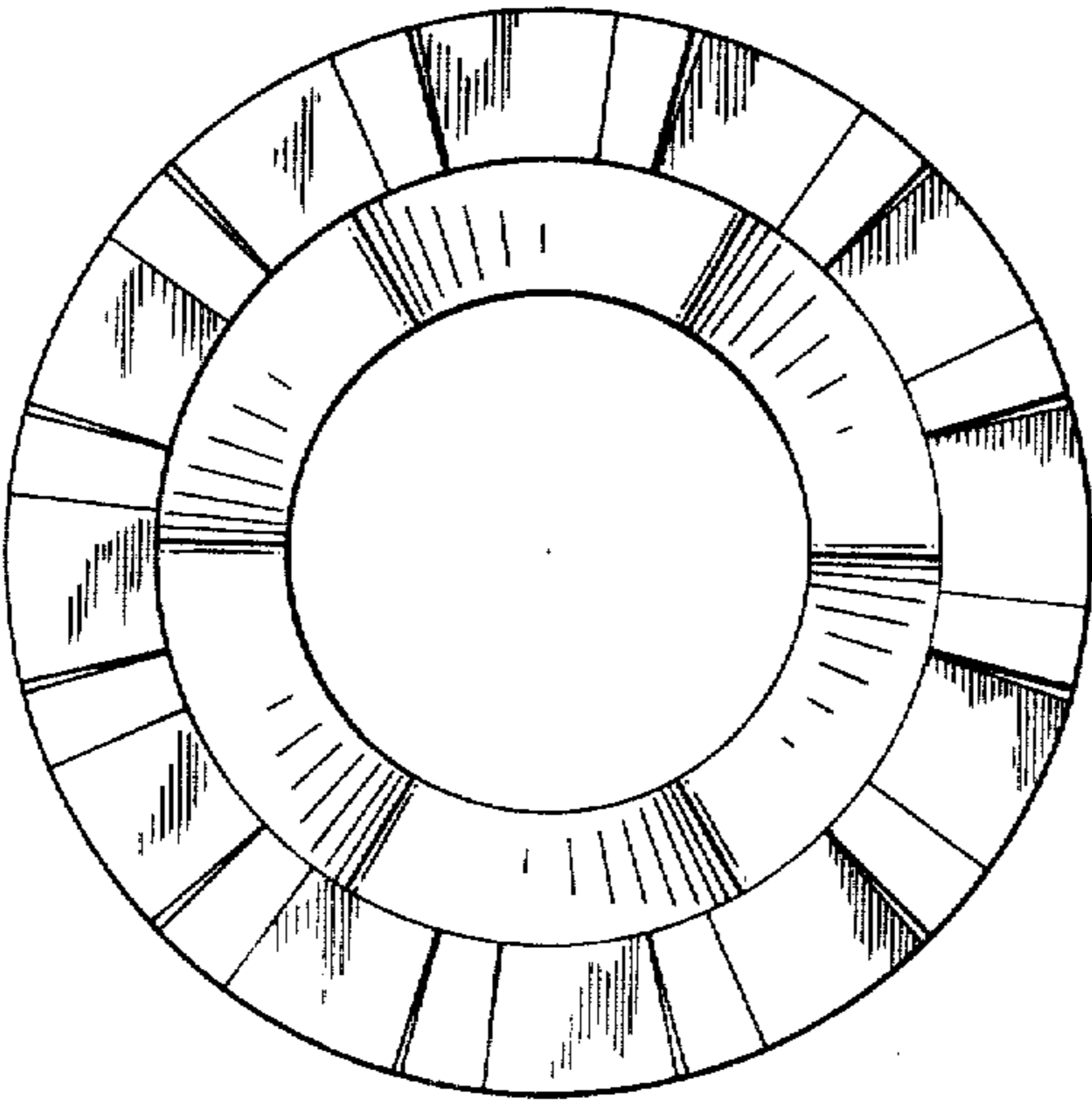
