[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a toy spaceship, substantially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top plan view of a toy spaceship showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a side elevational view thereof, the opposite side being a mirror image;

FIG. 5 is a rear elevational view thereof.

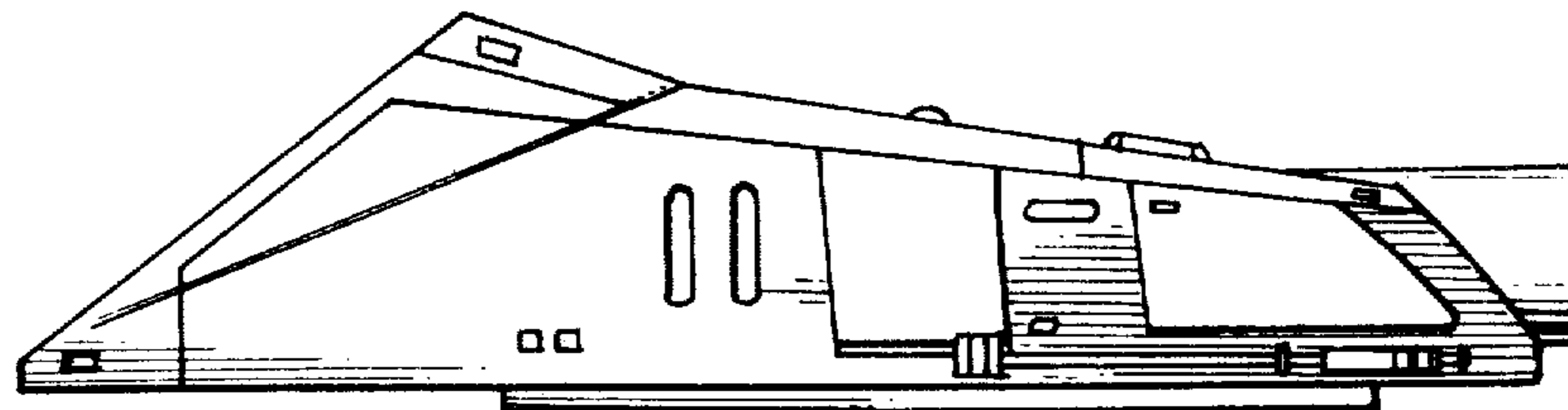

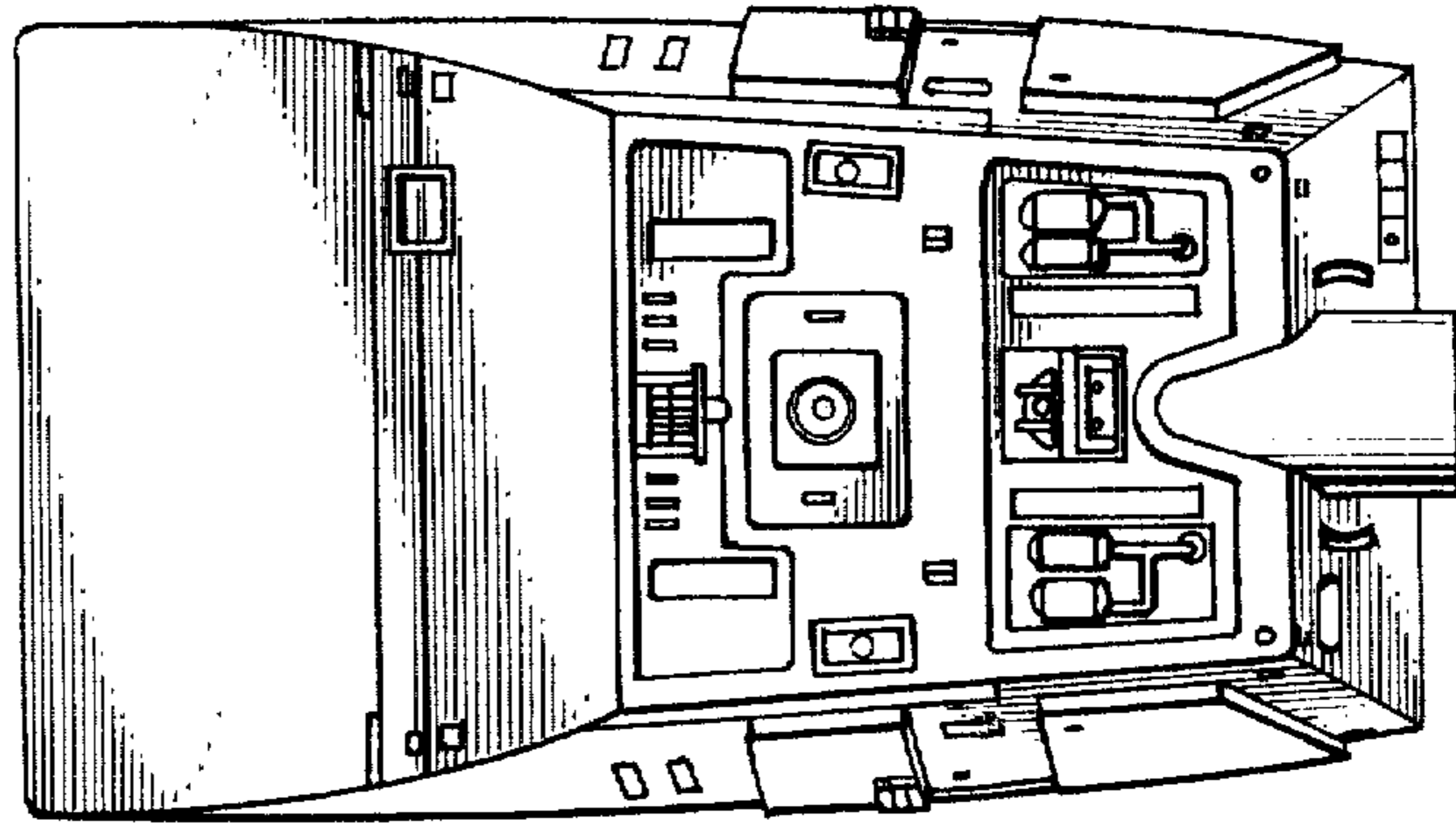

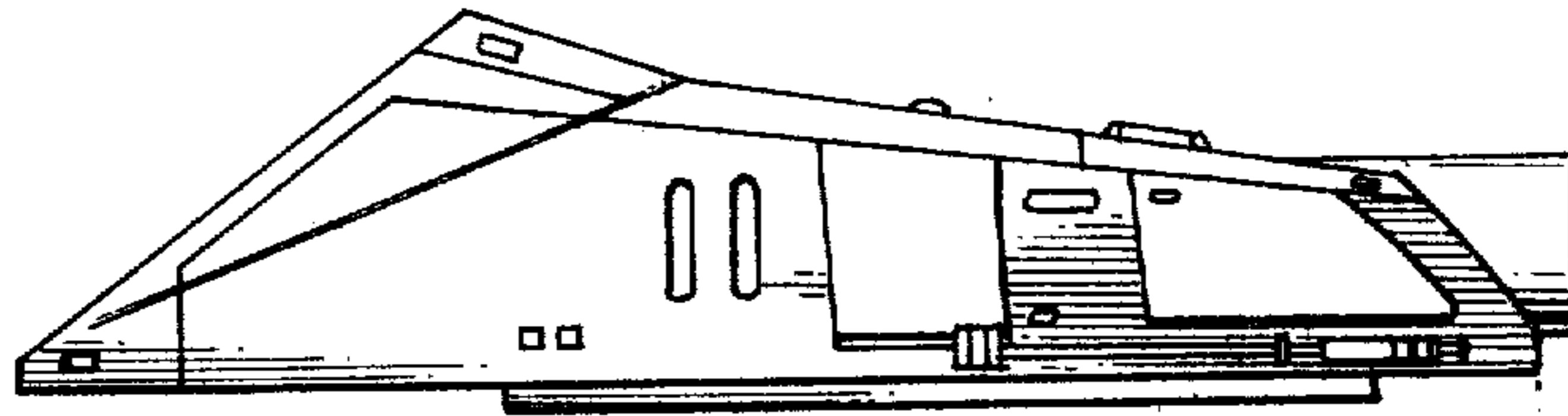

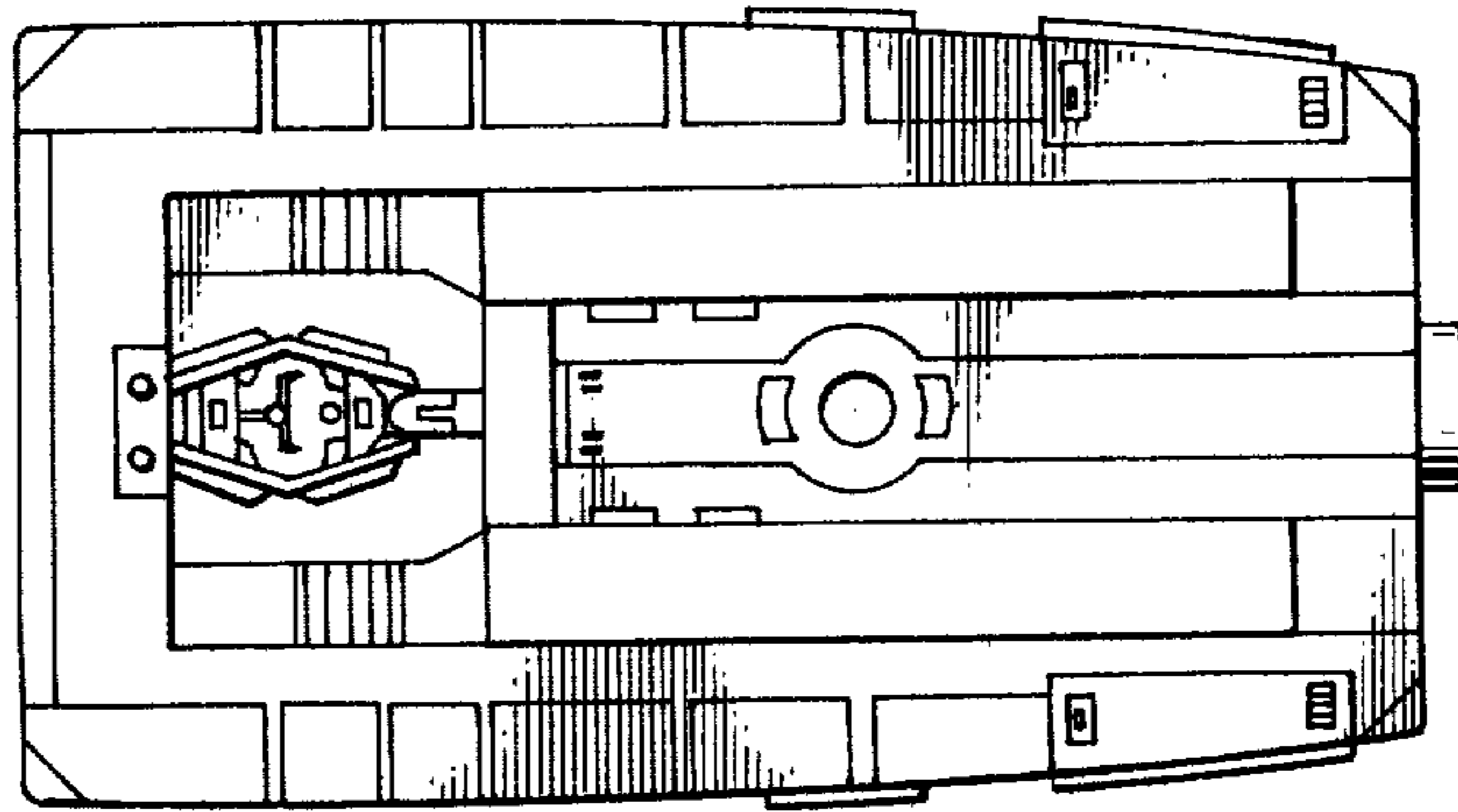

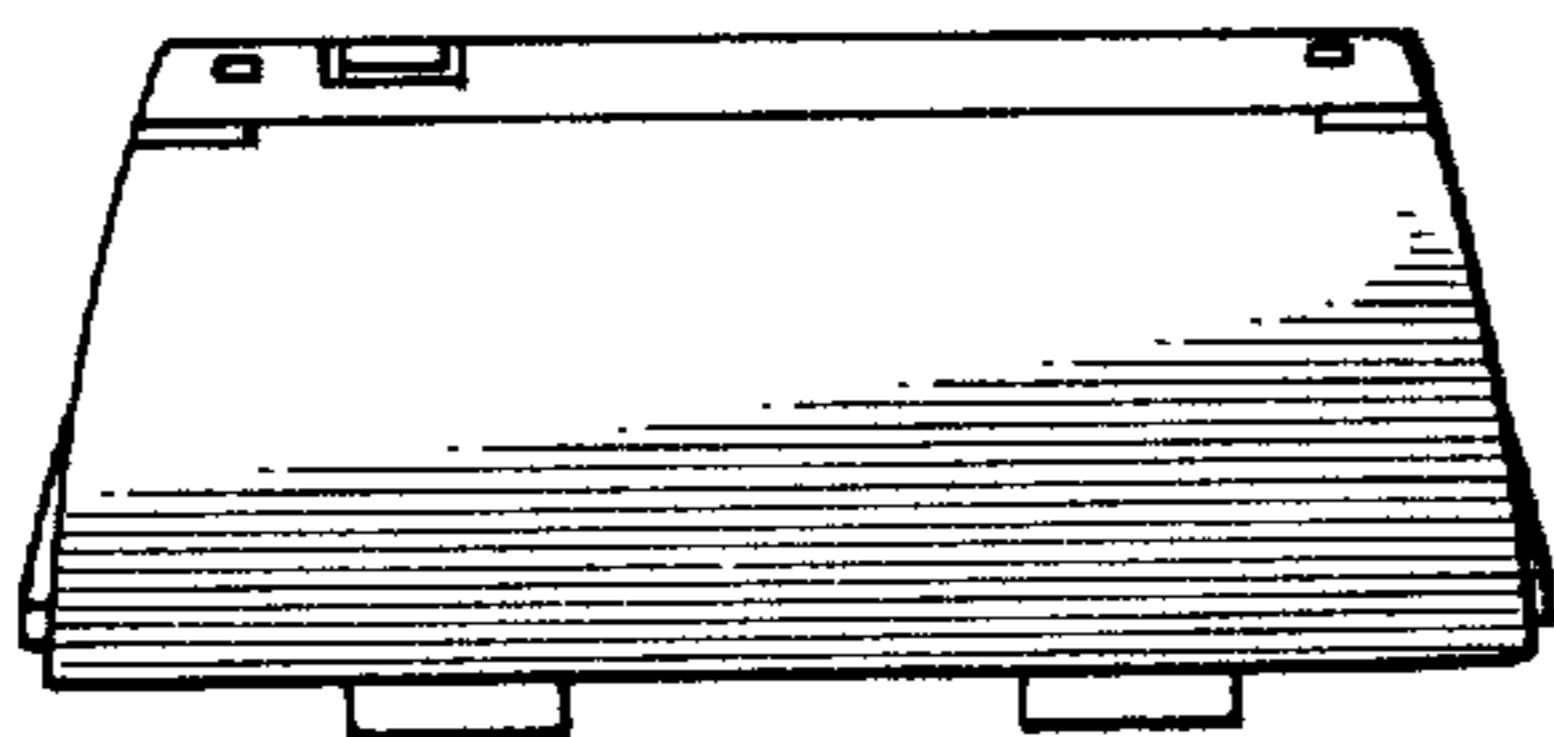
