[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a tennis racket, substantially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevation view of a tennis racket showing my new design;
 FIG. 2 is a right side view thereof,
 FIG. 3 is a left side view thereof,
 FIG. 4 is a top view thereof,
 FIG. 5 is a bottom view thereof,
 FIG. 6 is a sectional view taken along the line 6—6 in FIG. 1 thereof,
 FIG. 7 is a sectional view taken along the line 7—7 in FIG. 1 thereof, and
 FIG. 8 is front elevation view of another embodiment of the design which is the same as the embodiment in FIGS. 1-7 but has surface ornamentation on the front face as shown therein.
