- FIG. 5 is a cross-section taken on the line 5—5 of FIG. 3.

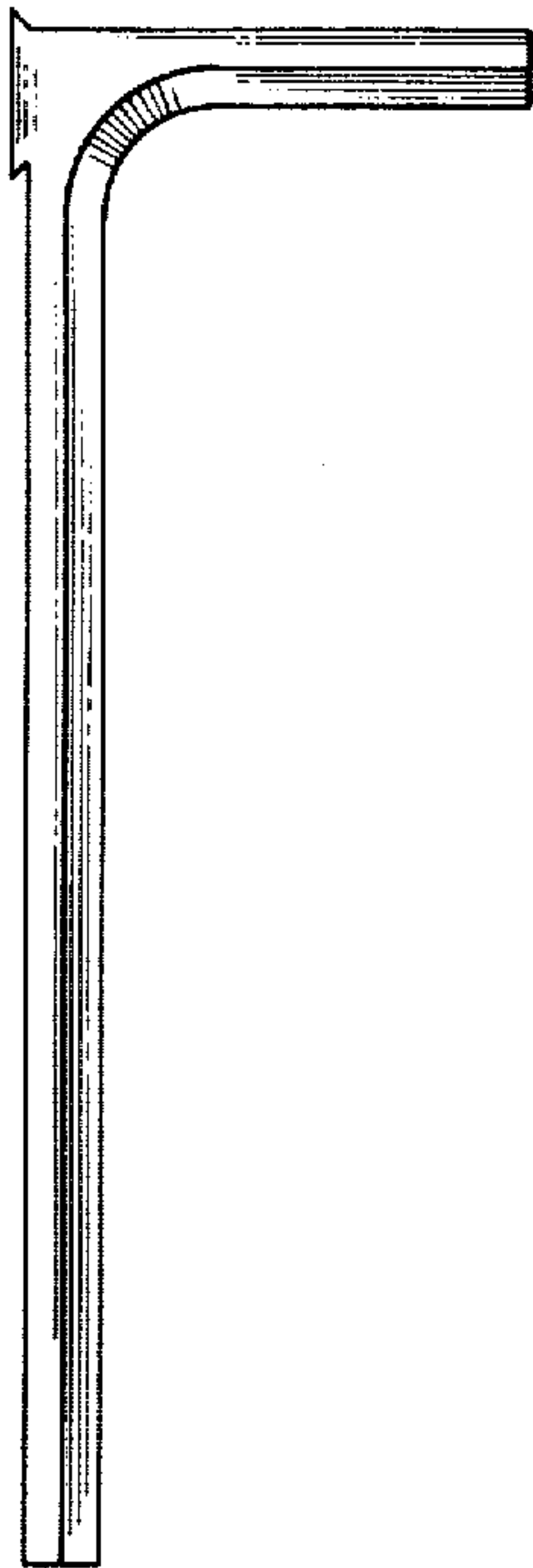

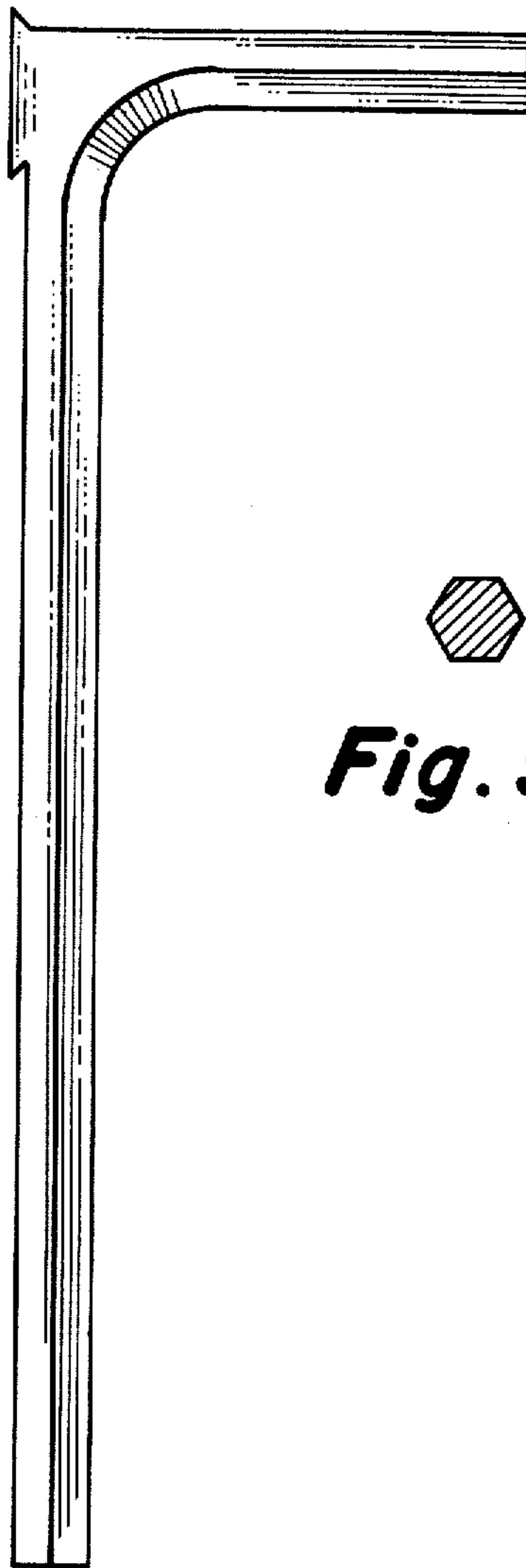

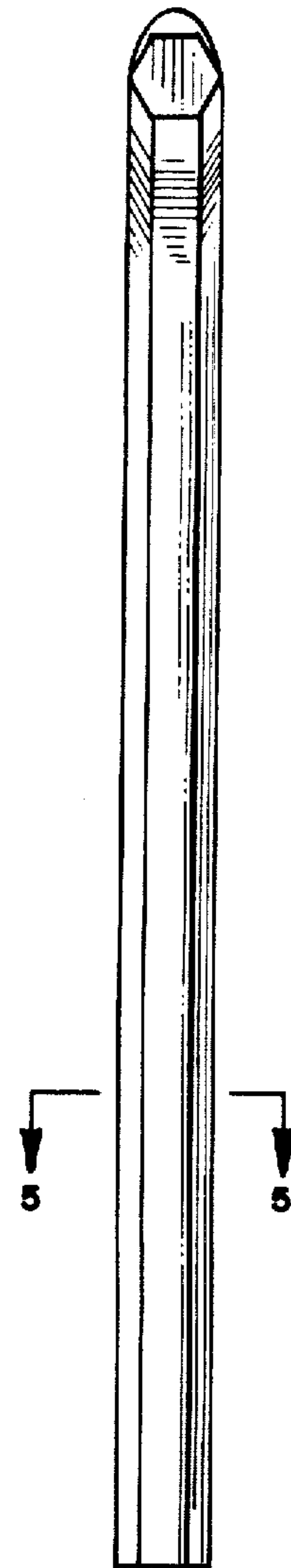

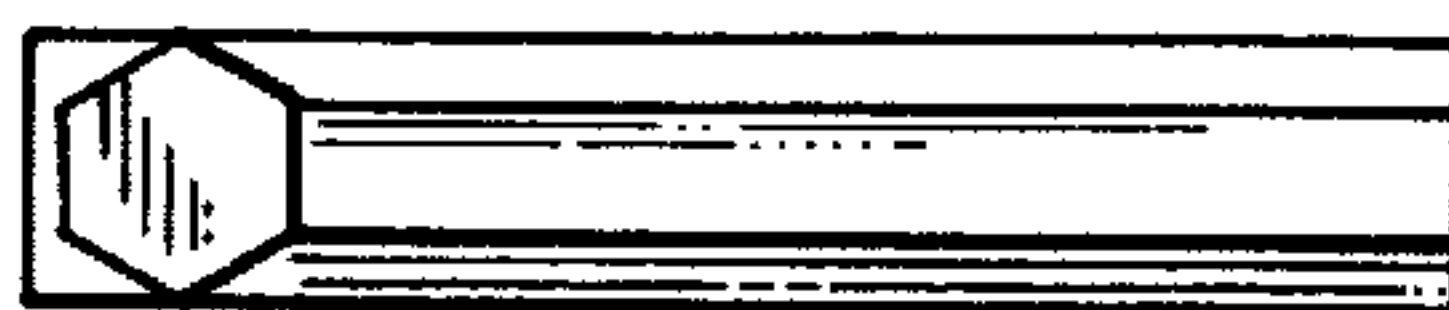
