DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top plan view of a video disk player showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a left side elevational view;

FIG. 5 is a rear elevational view;
FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view thereof;
FIG. 7 is a front, top and right side perspective view with the lid in raised condition.

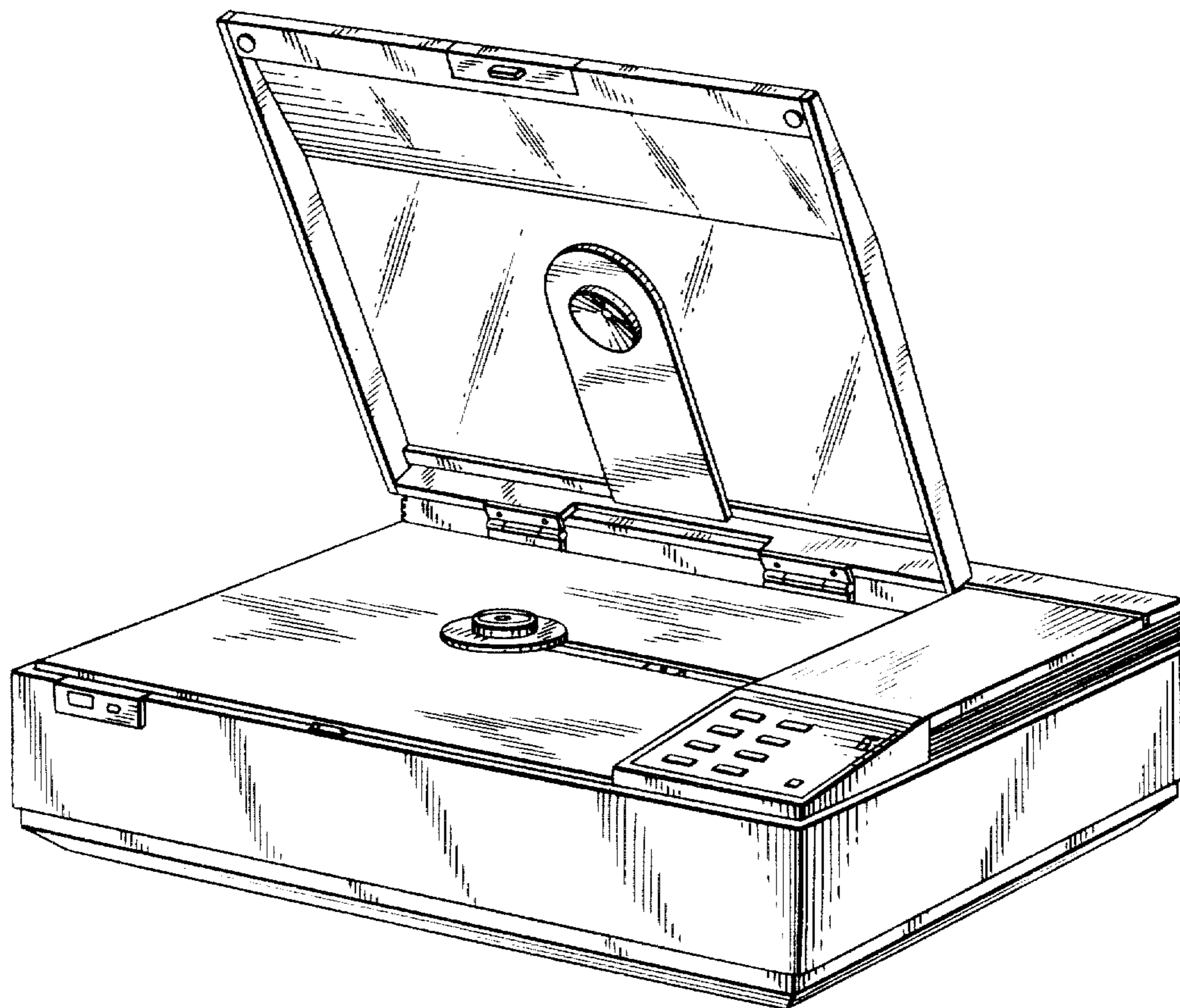

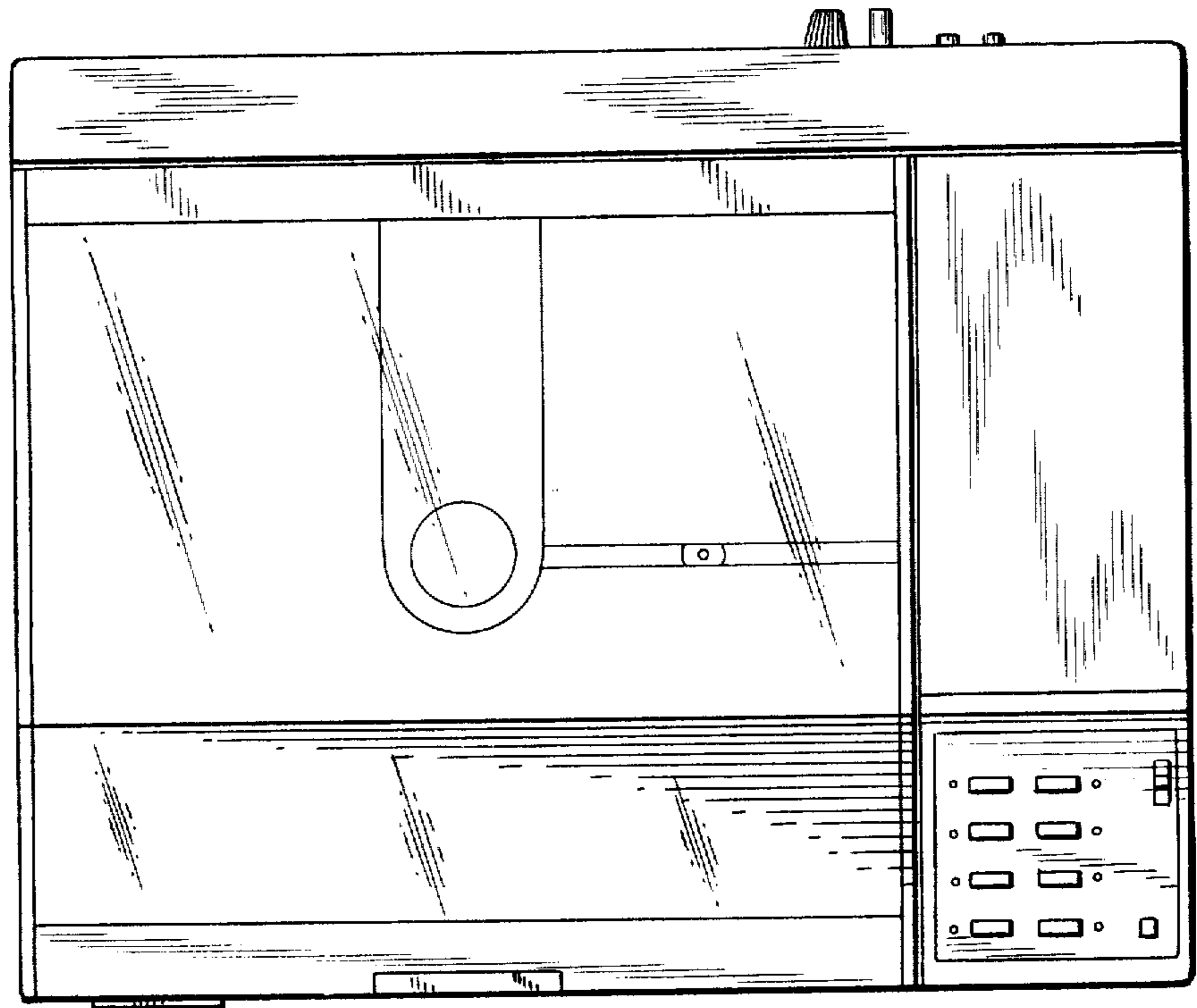

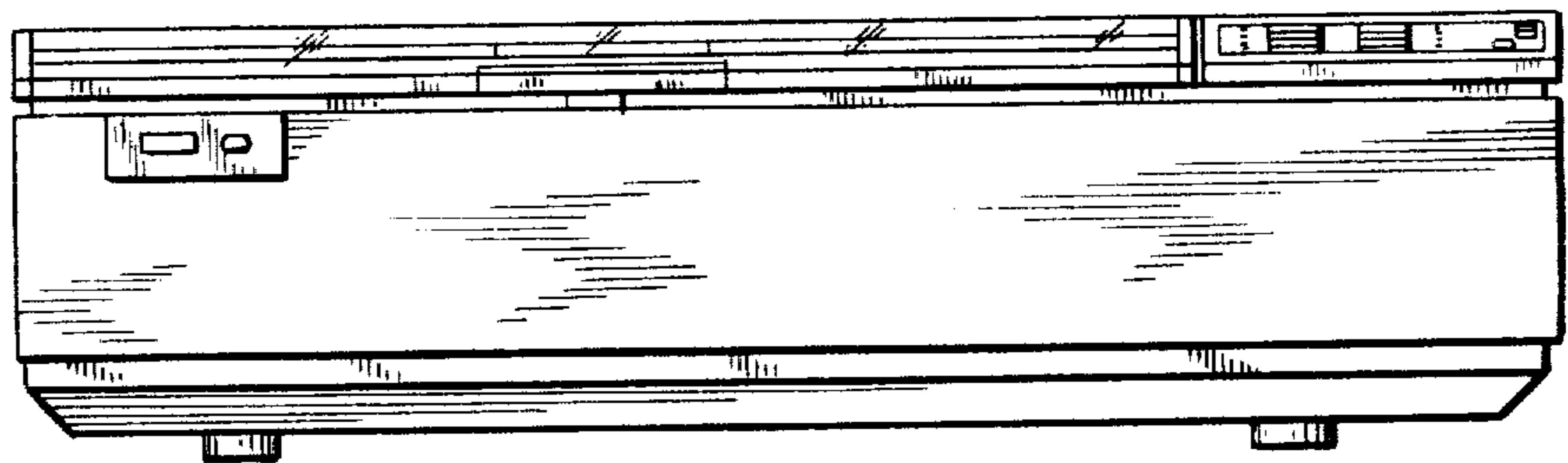

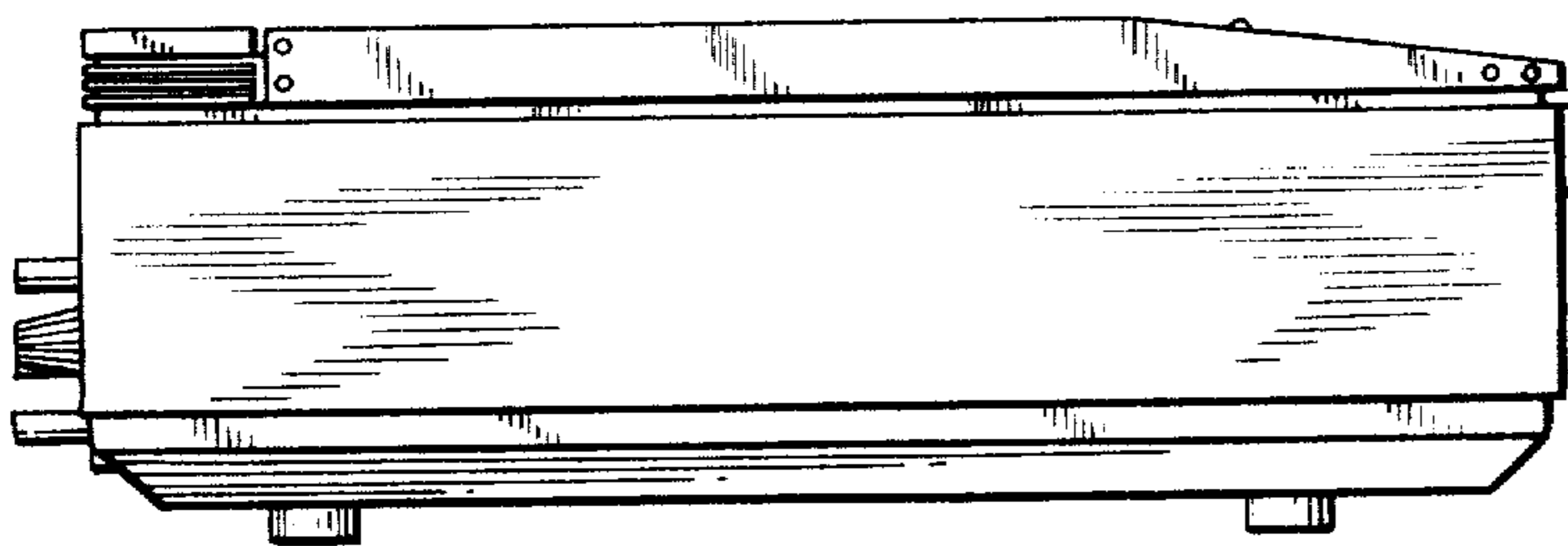

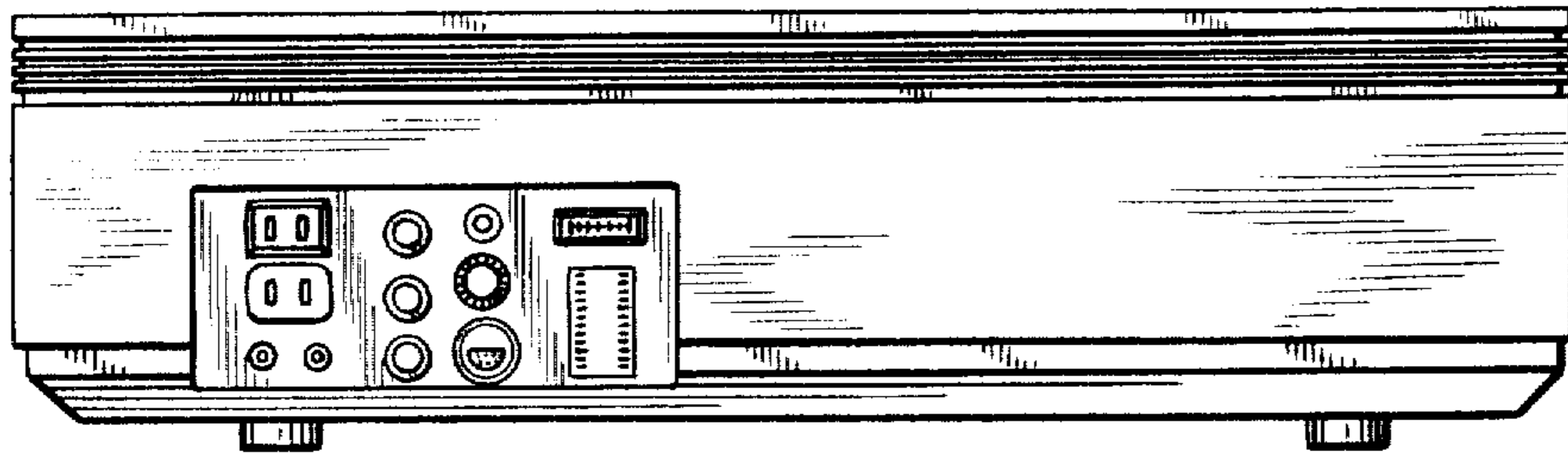
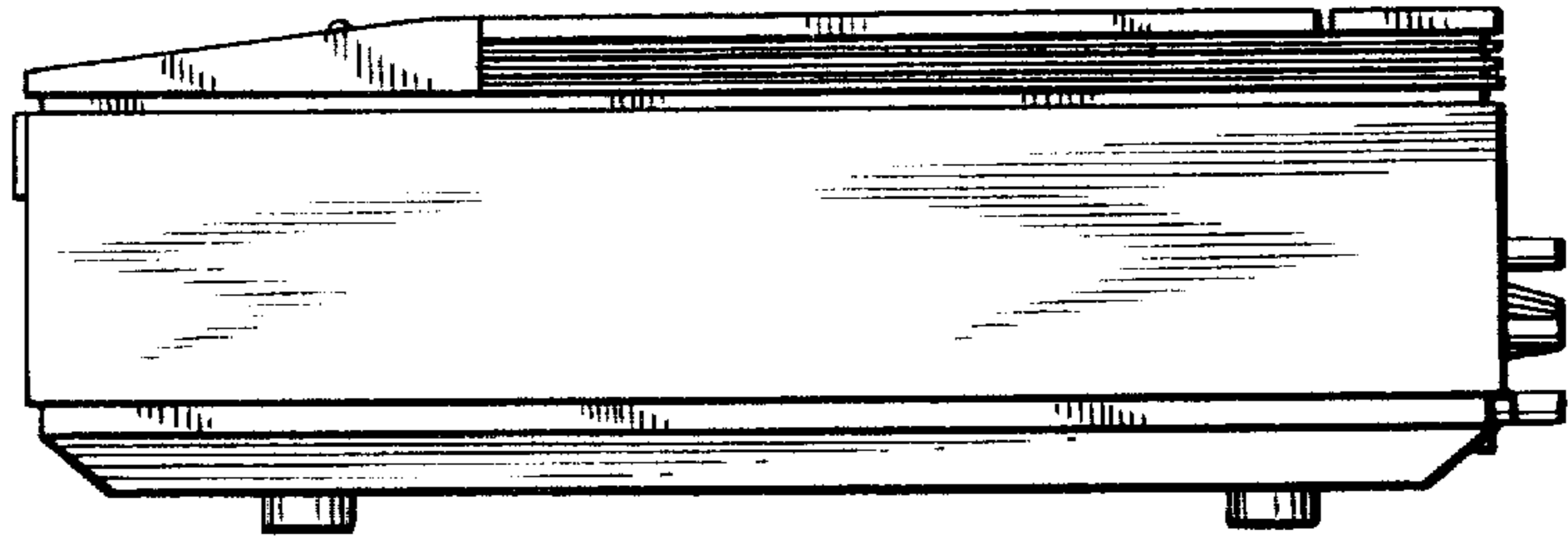

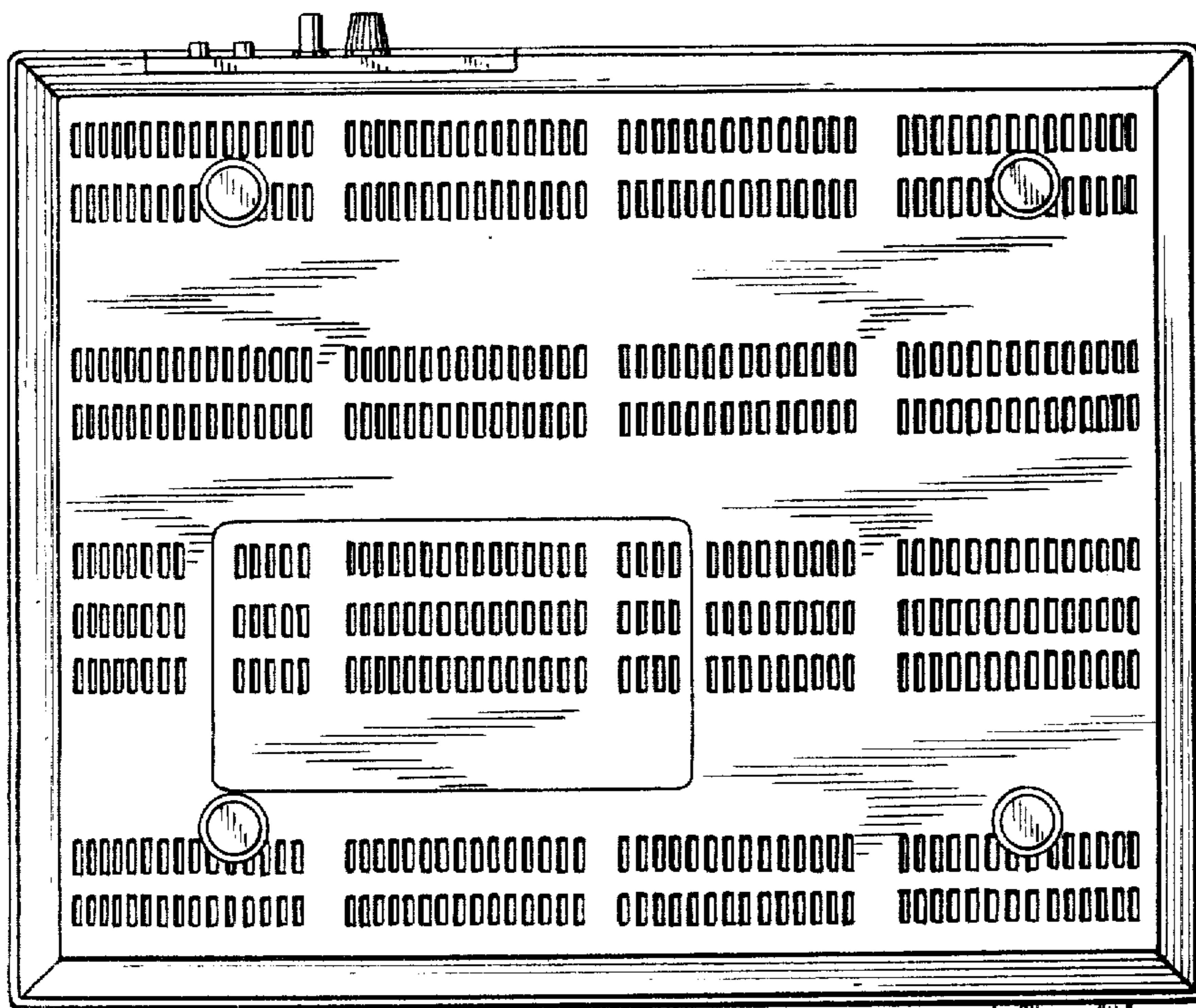
