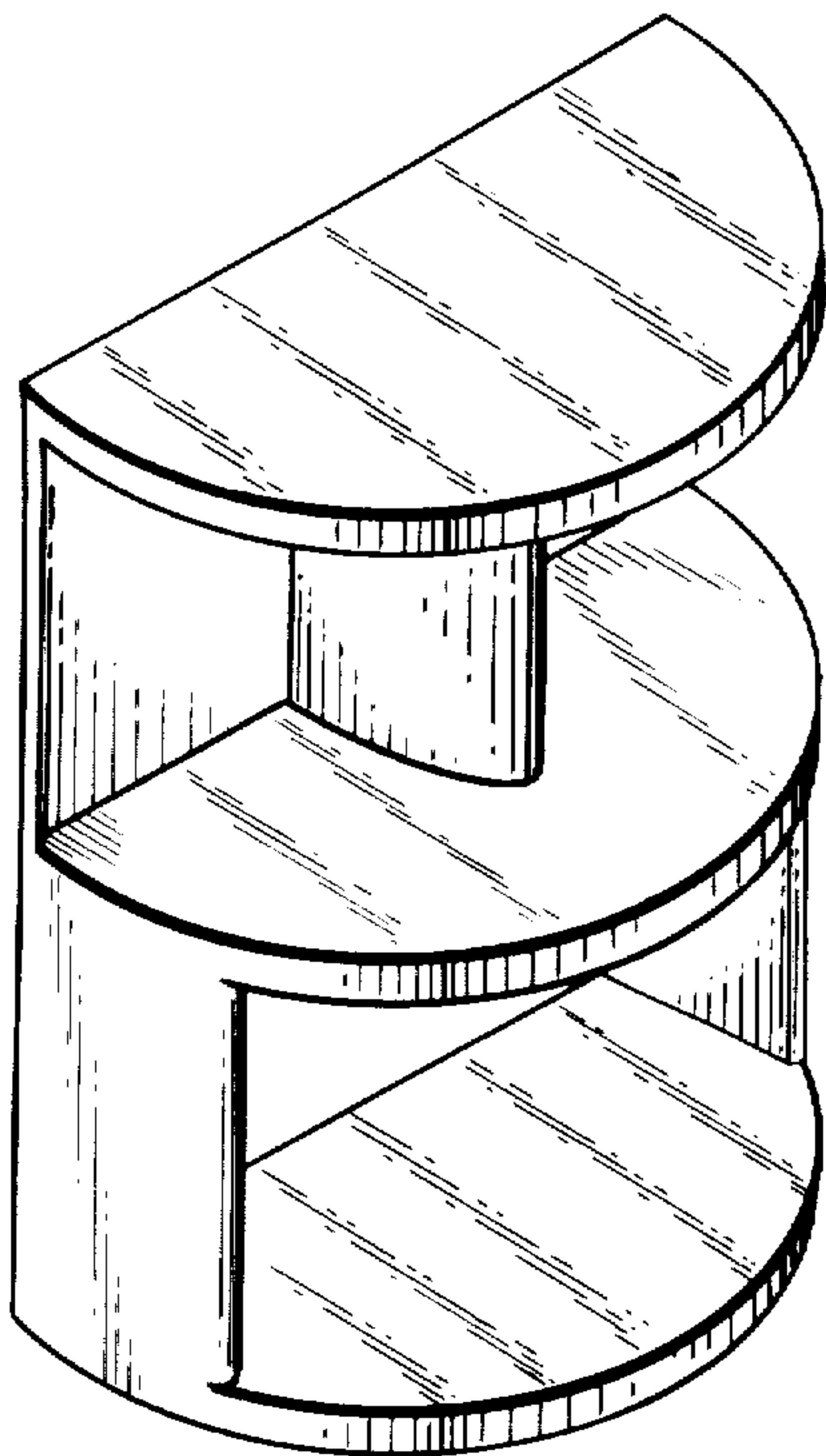

flat and unornamented.



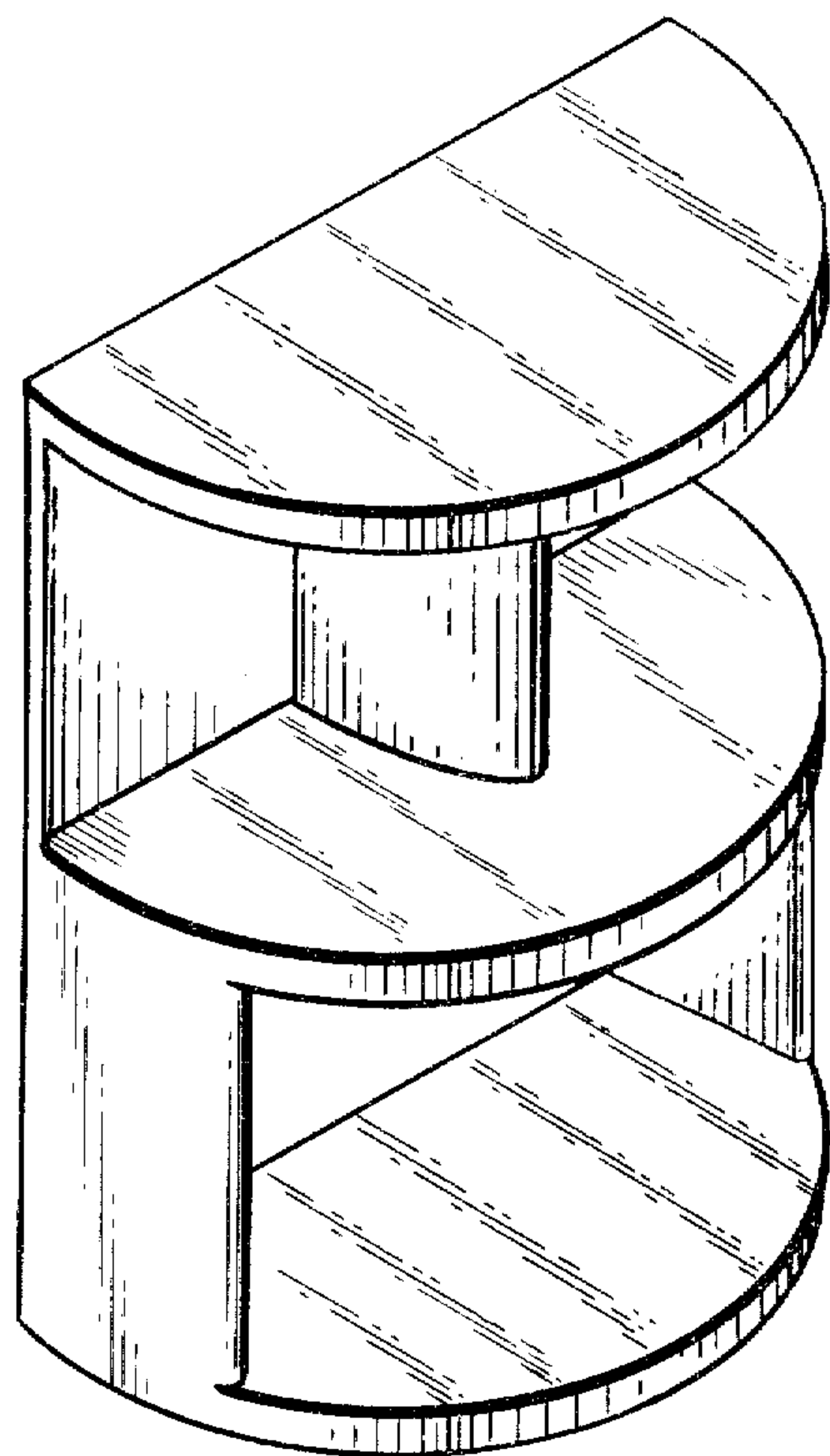

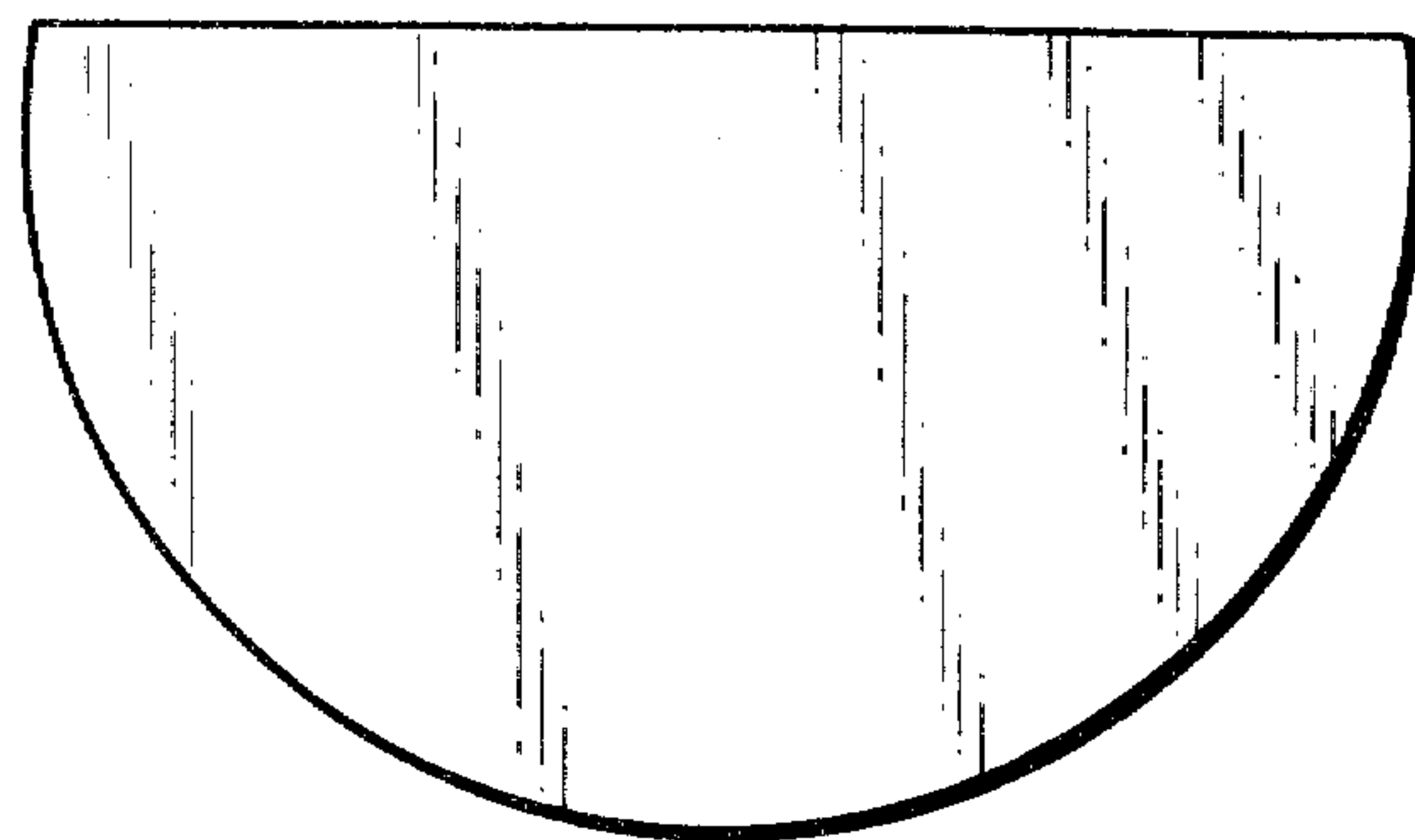

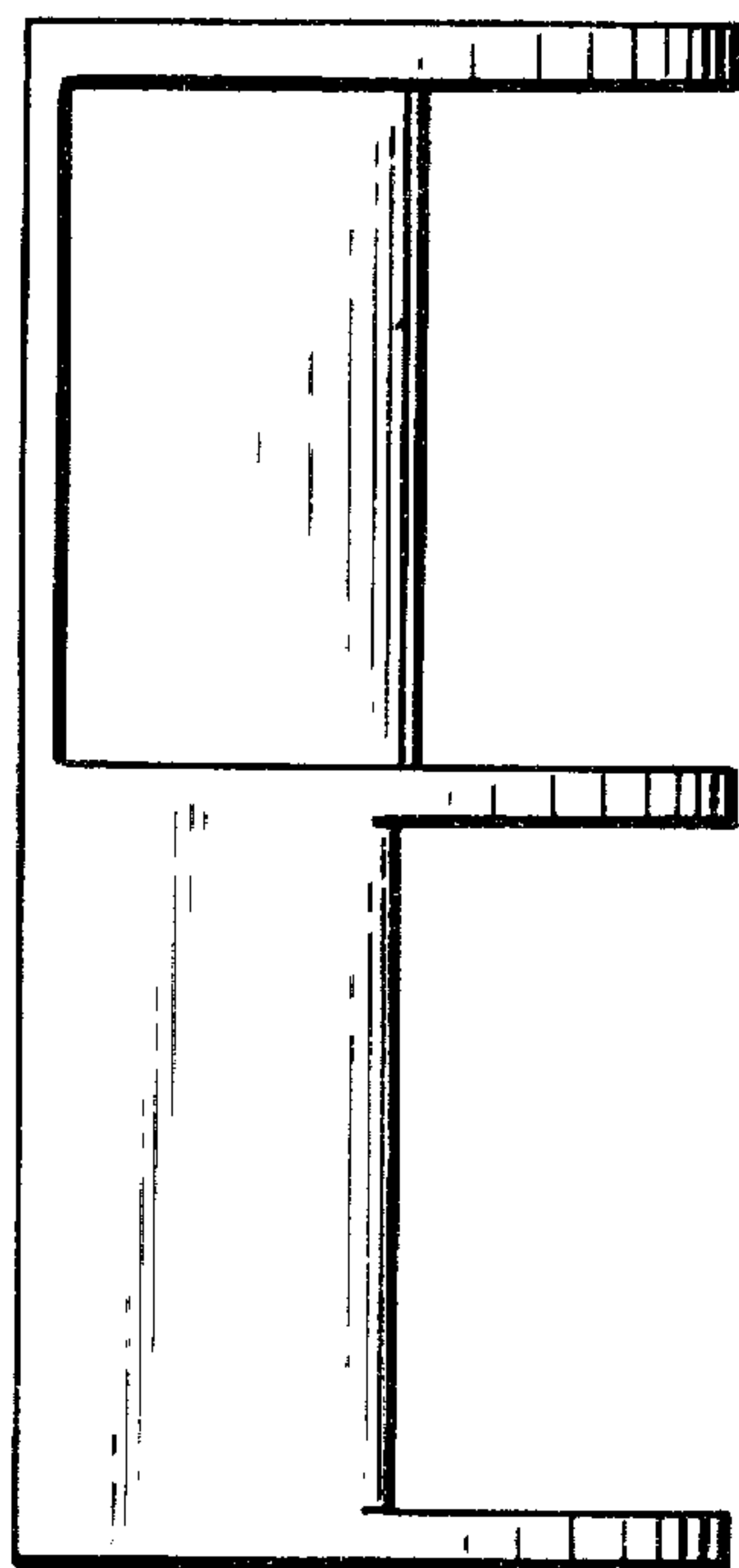

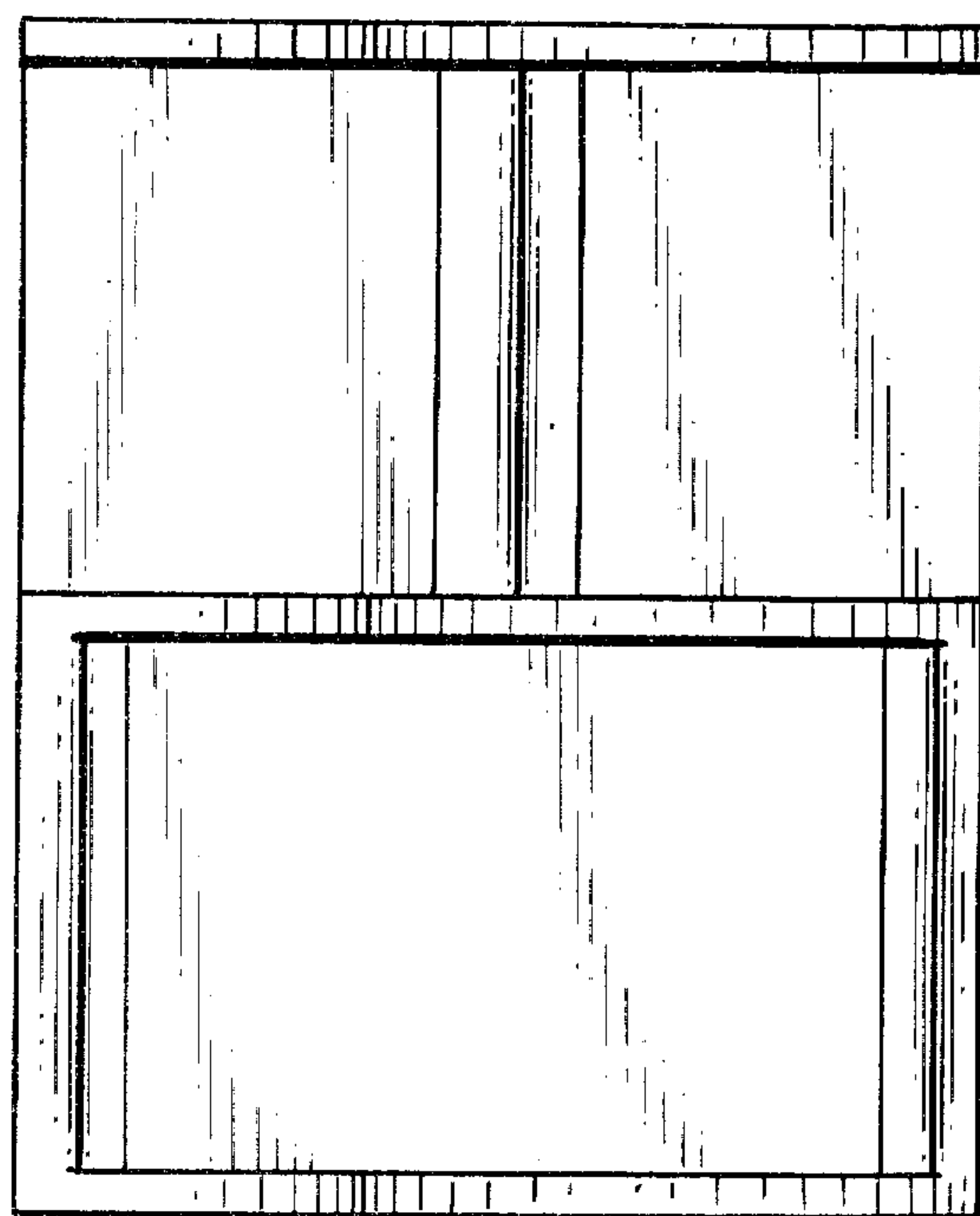
