DESCRIPTION

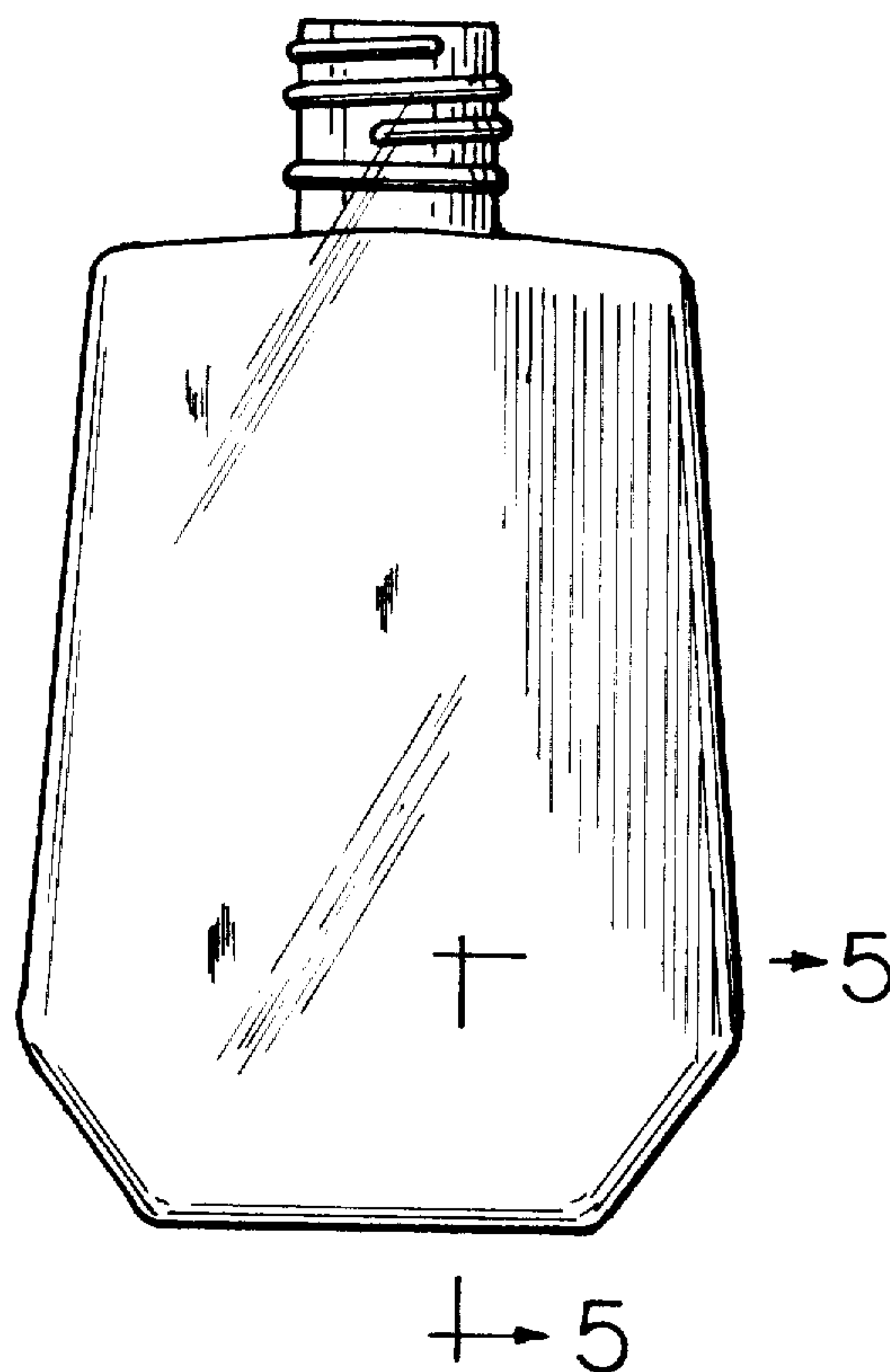
FIG. 1 is a top plan view of a bottle showing my new design;

FIG. 2 is a front view in elevation thereof, the obverse view being identical to the front view;

FIG. 3 is a bottom plan view thereof;

FIG. 4 is an end view in elevation thereof, both end views being identical; and

FIG. 5 is a partial cross-sectional view taken along the lines 5—5 of FIG. 1.



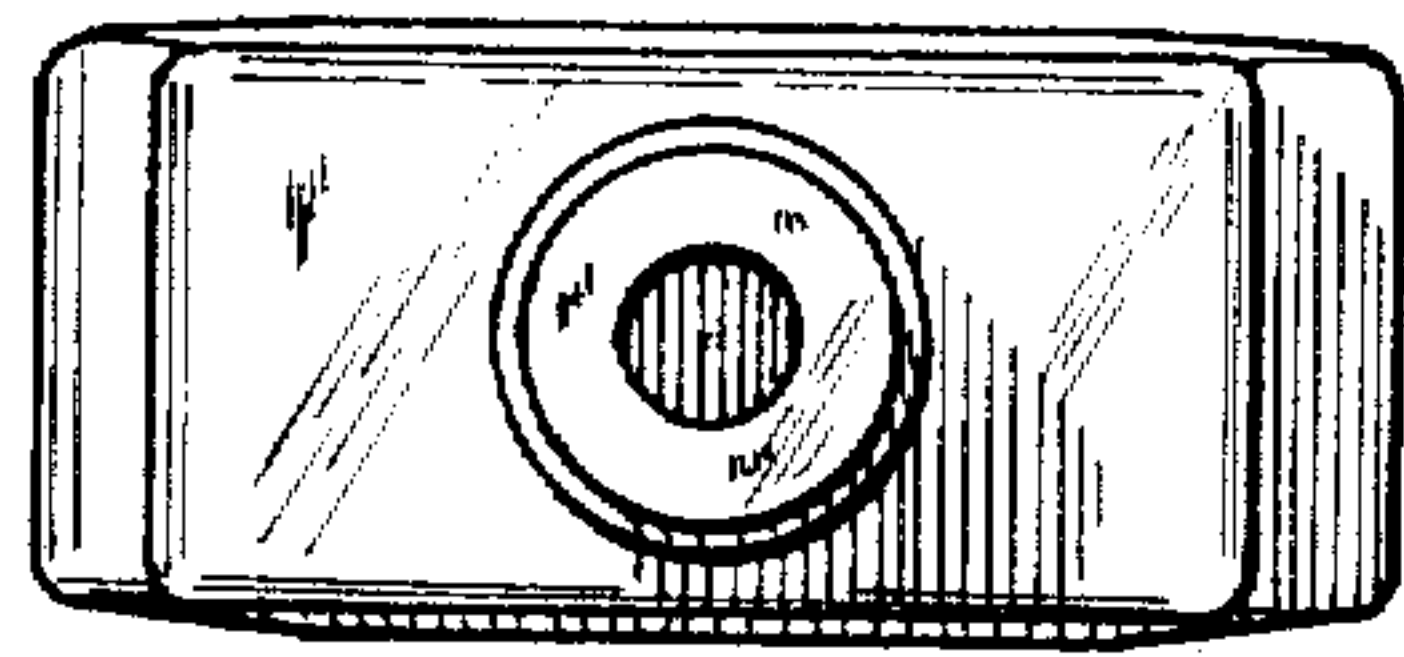

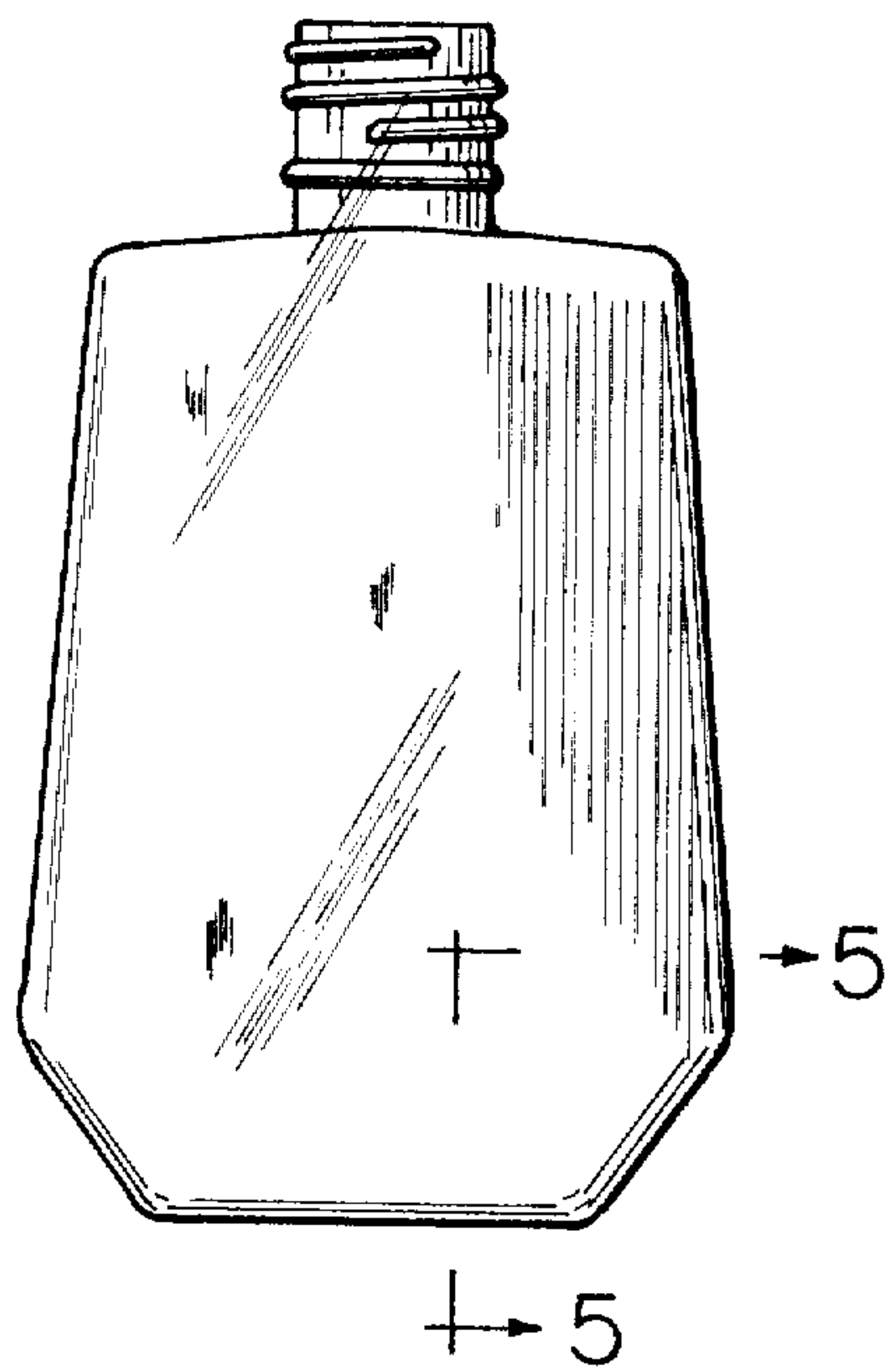

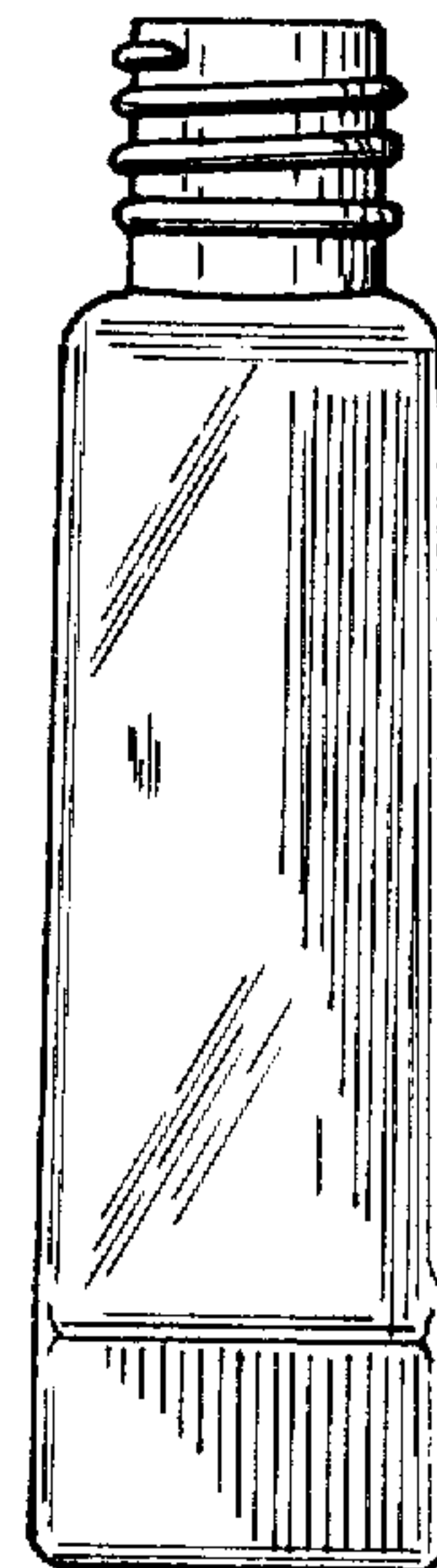

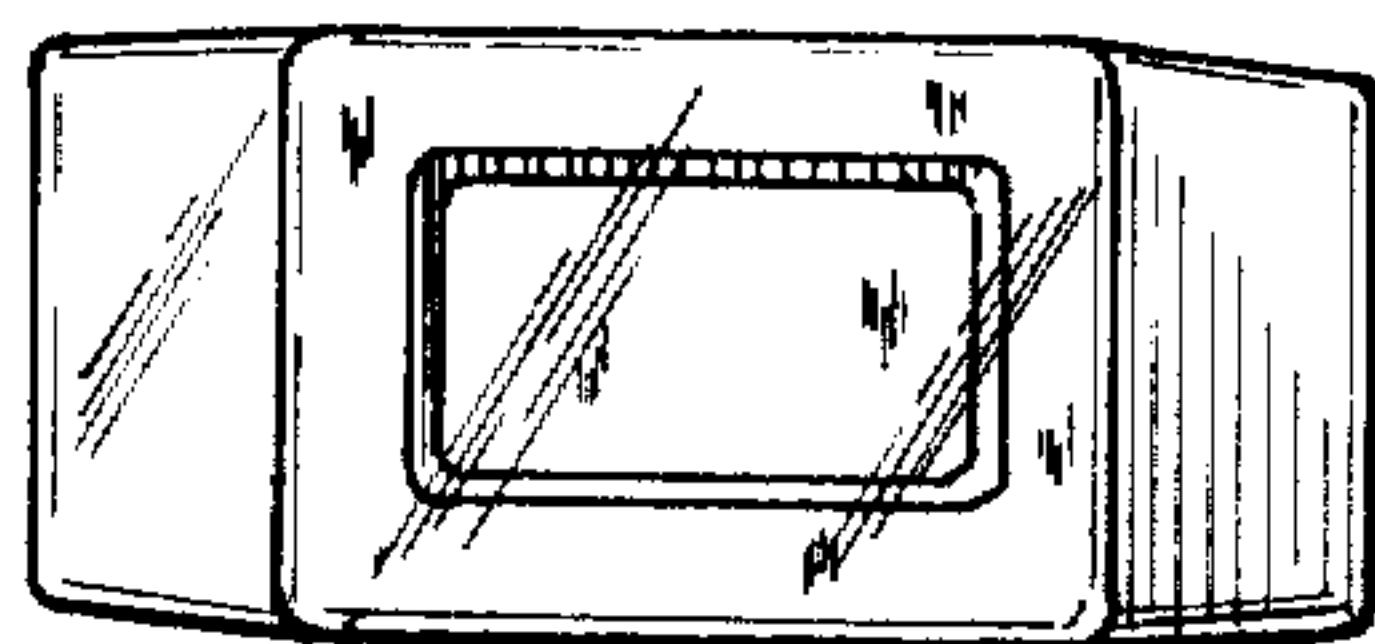

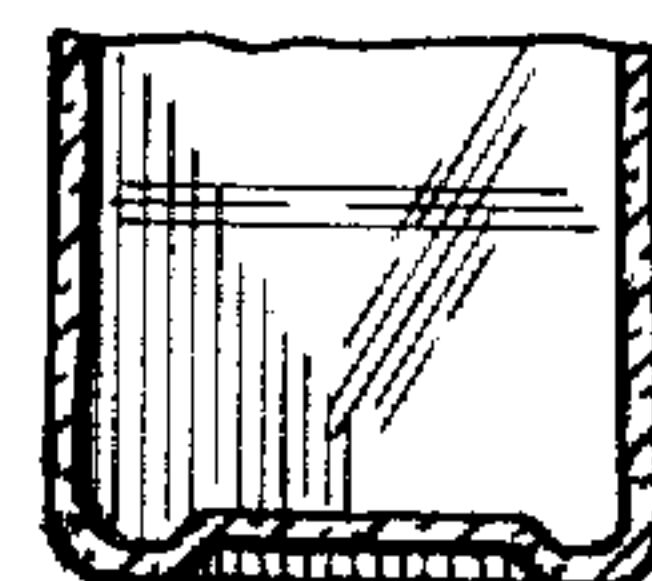
