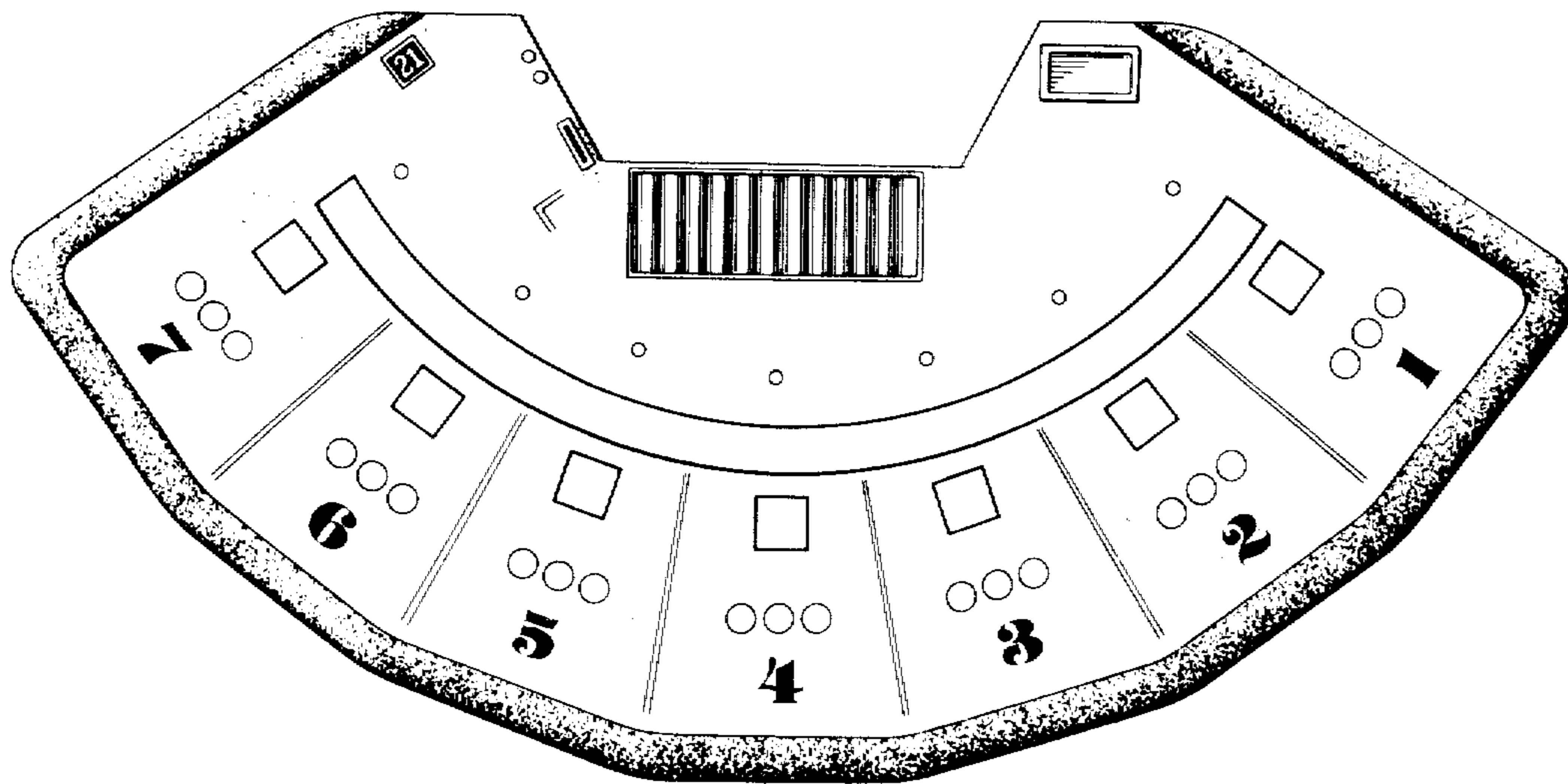

The ornamental design for a gaming table, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top plan view of a gaming table showing our new design;
FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a right side elevational view thereof;
FIG. 4 is a left side elevational view thereof; and
FIG. 5 is a rear elevational view thereof. The bottom end is plain and unadorned.



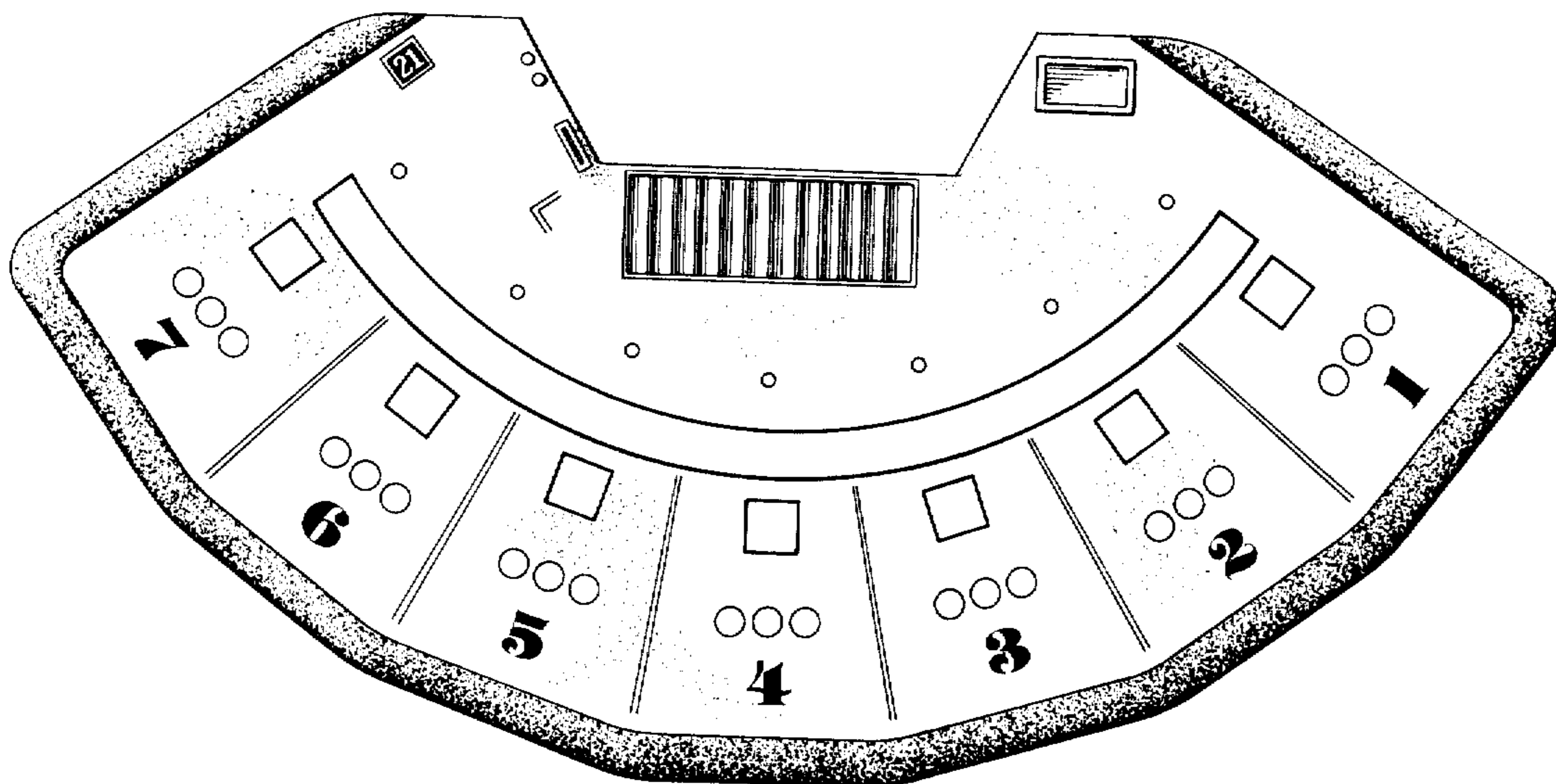
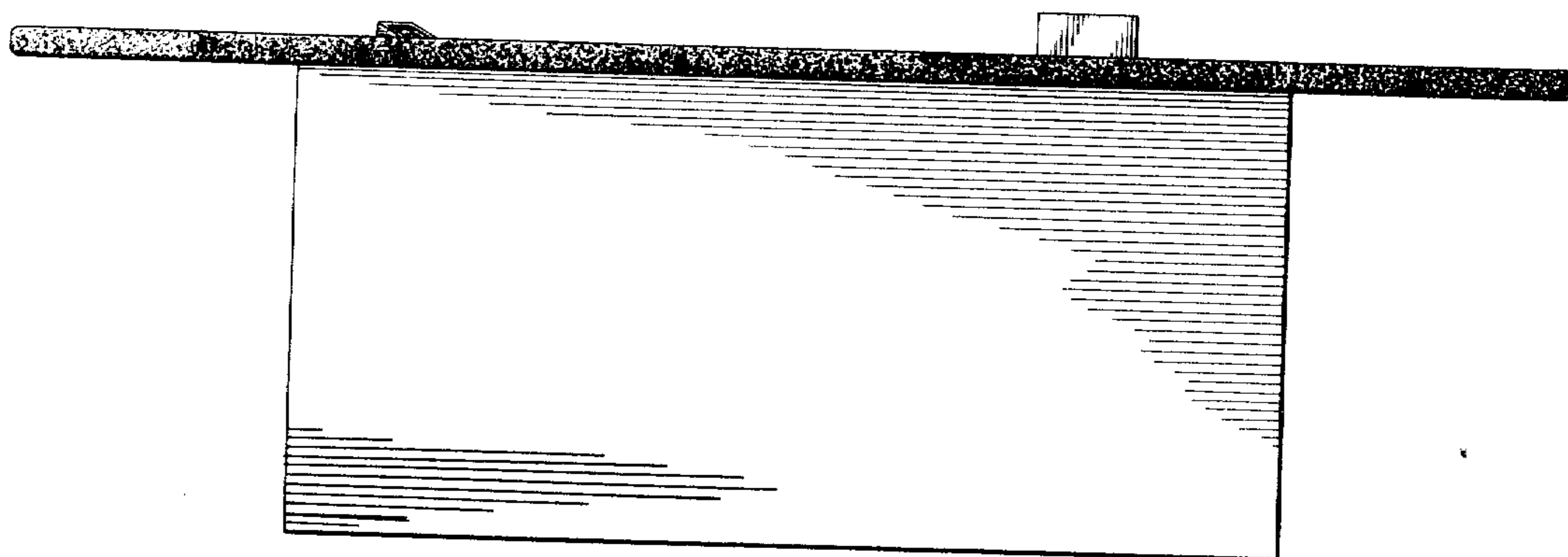

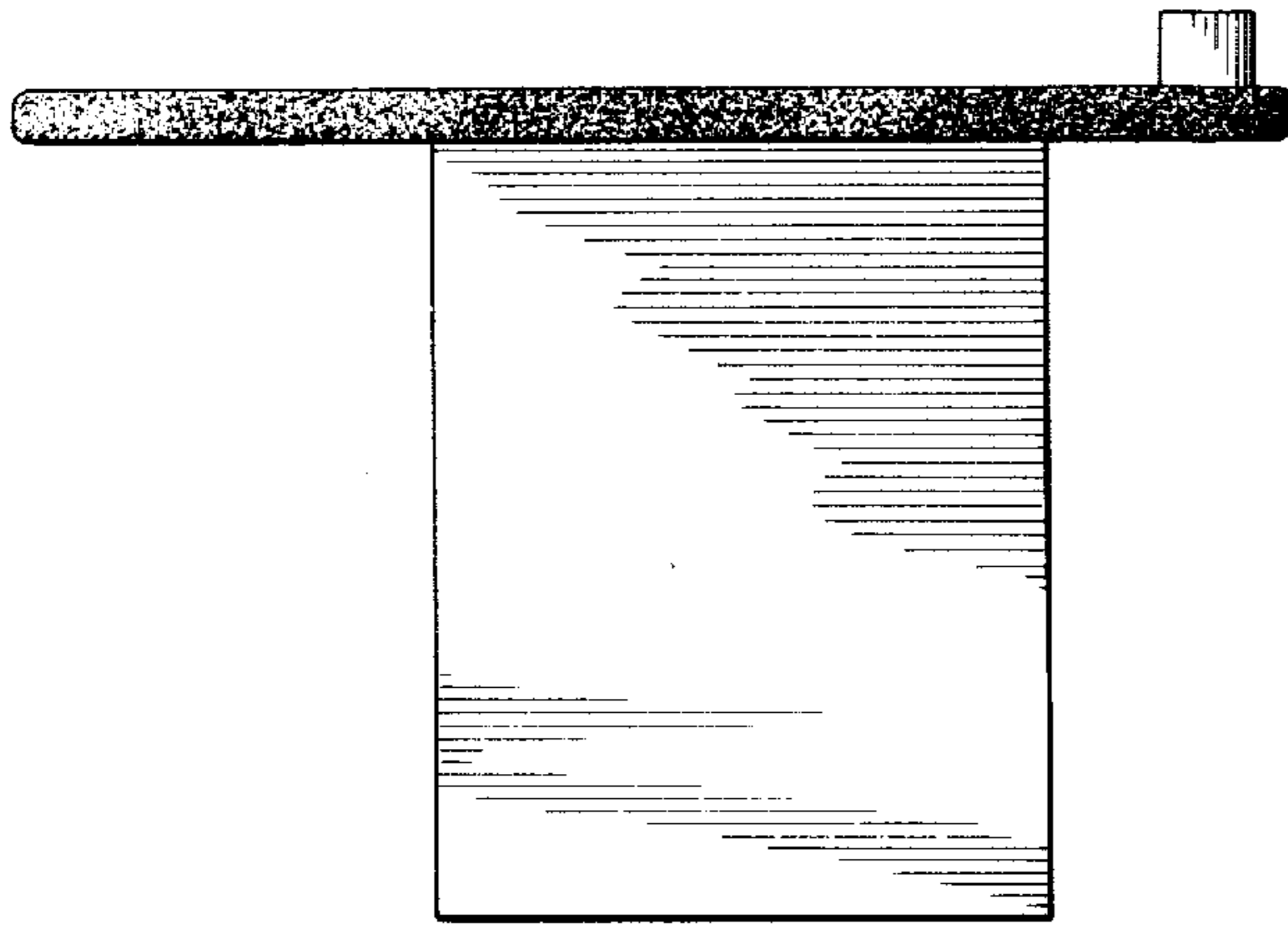

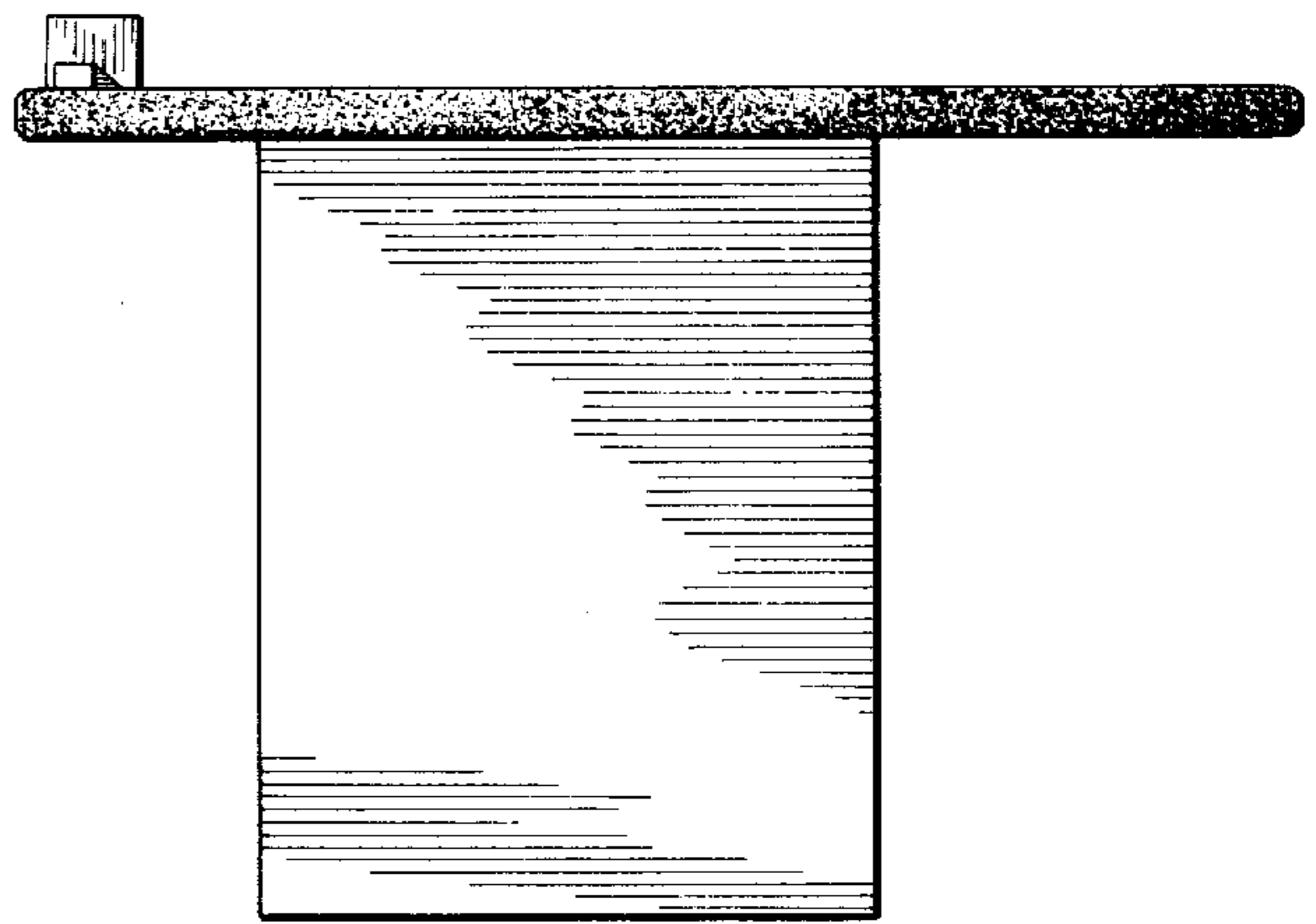
