[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a combined lamp and planter, substantially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a combined lamp and planter illustrating our new design; FIG. 2 is a side elevational view thereof; FIG. 3 is an end elevational view thereof; and FIG. 4 is a plan view thereof.
