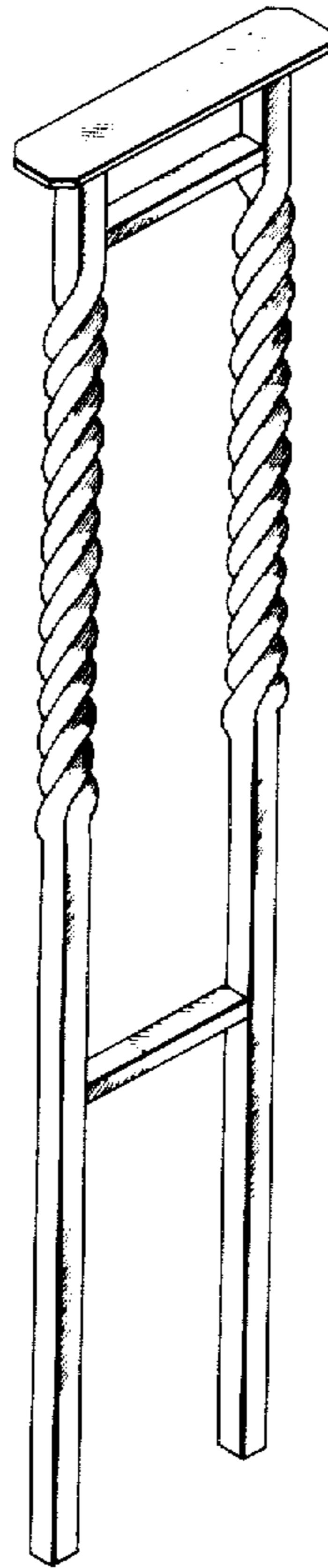

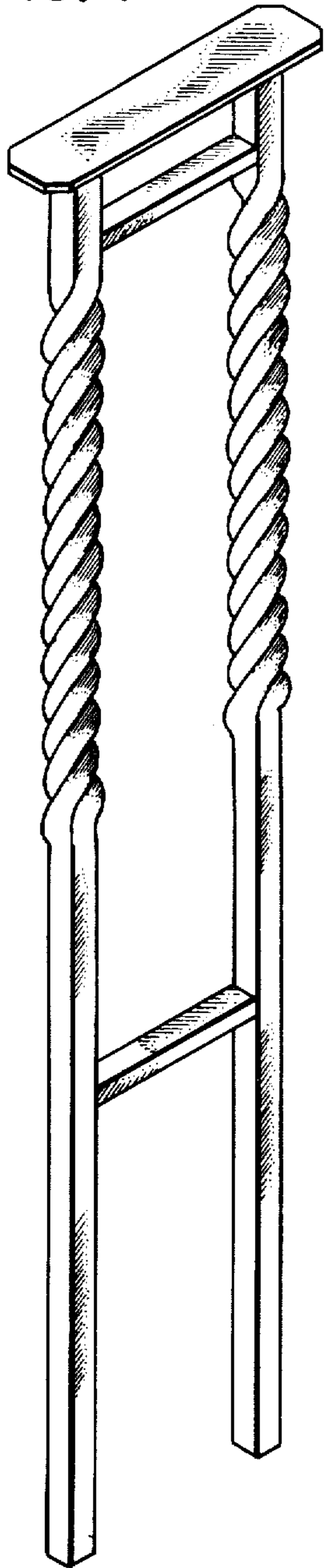
The ornamental design for a support stand for a mailbox or similar article, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

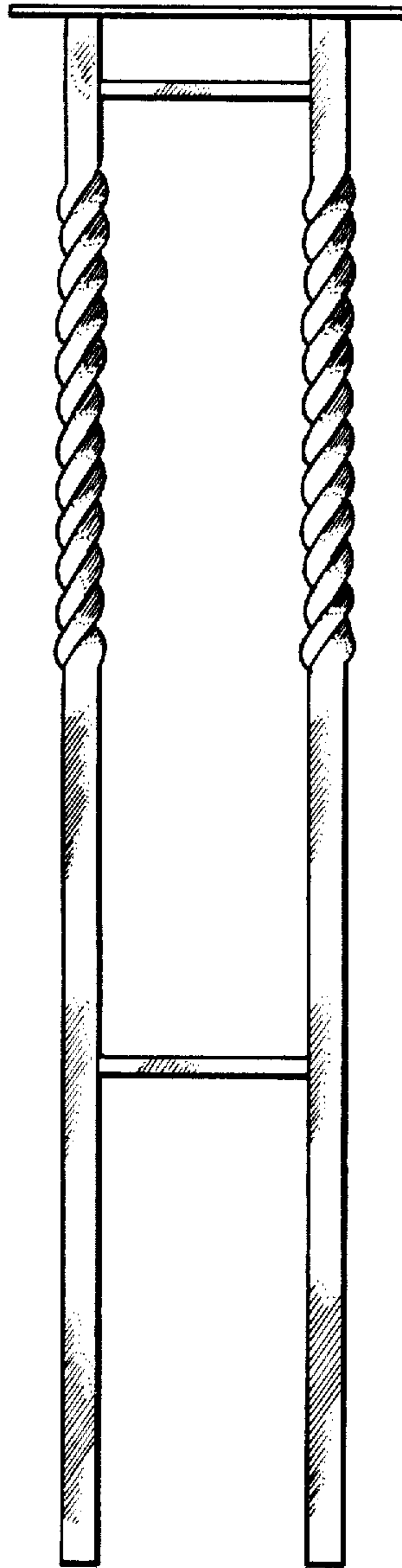
FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a support stand for a mailbox or similar article showing my new design;

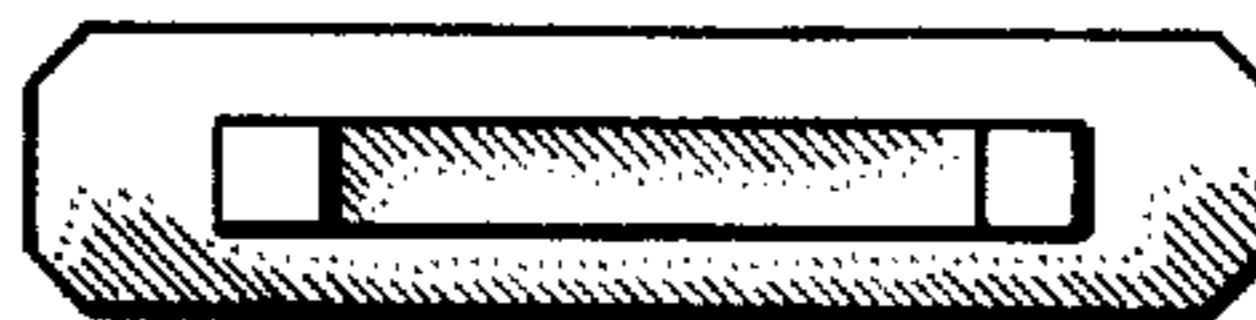
