The ornamental design for a cleated shoe sole, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a side elevational view of a cleated shoe sole showing my new design;
 FIG. 2 is a bottom plan view thereof;
 FIG. 3 is a bottom plan view of another embodiment of my new design of FIGS. 1 and 2;
 FIG. 4 is an enlarged sectional perspective view of an individual cleat.

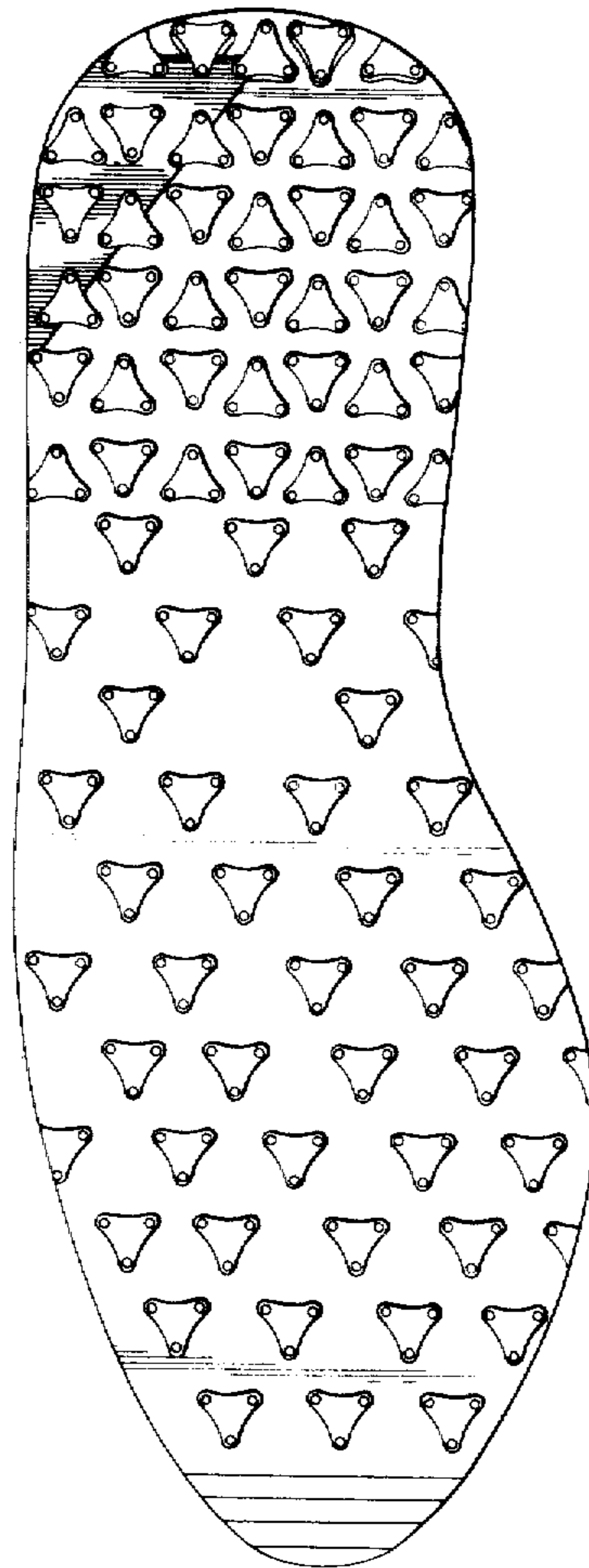

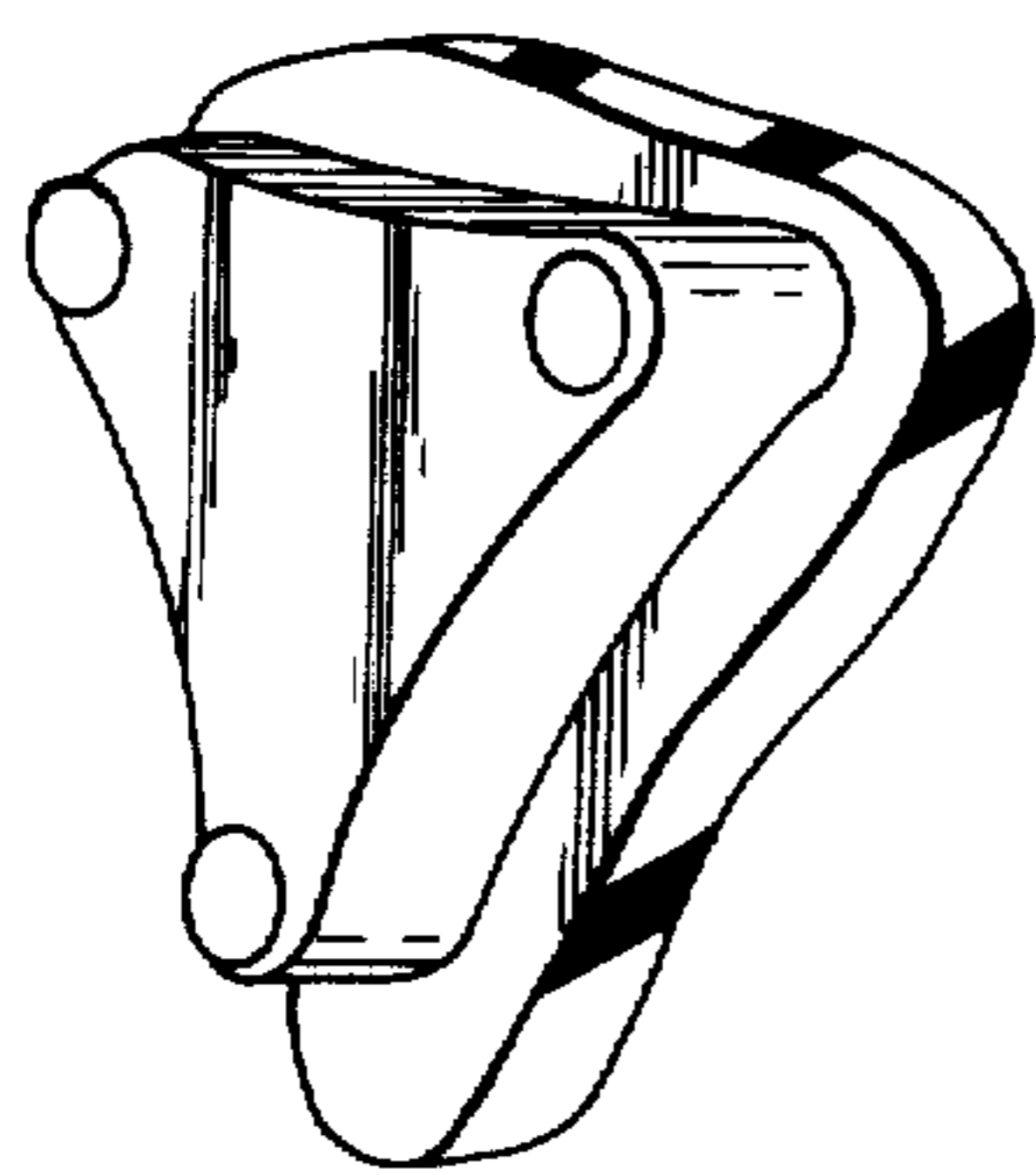

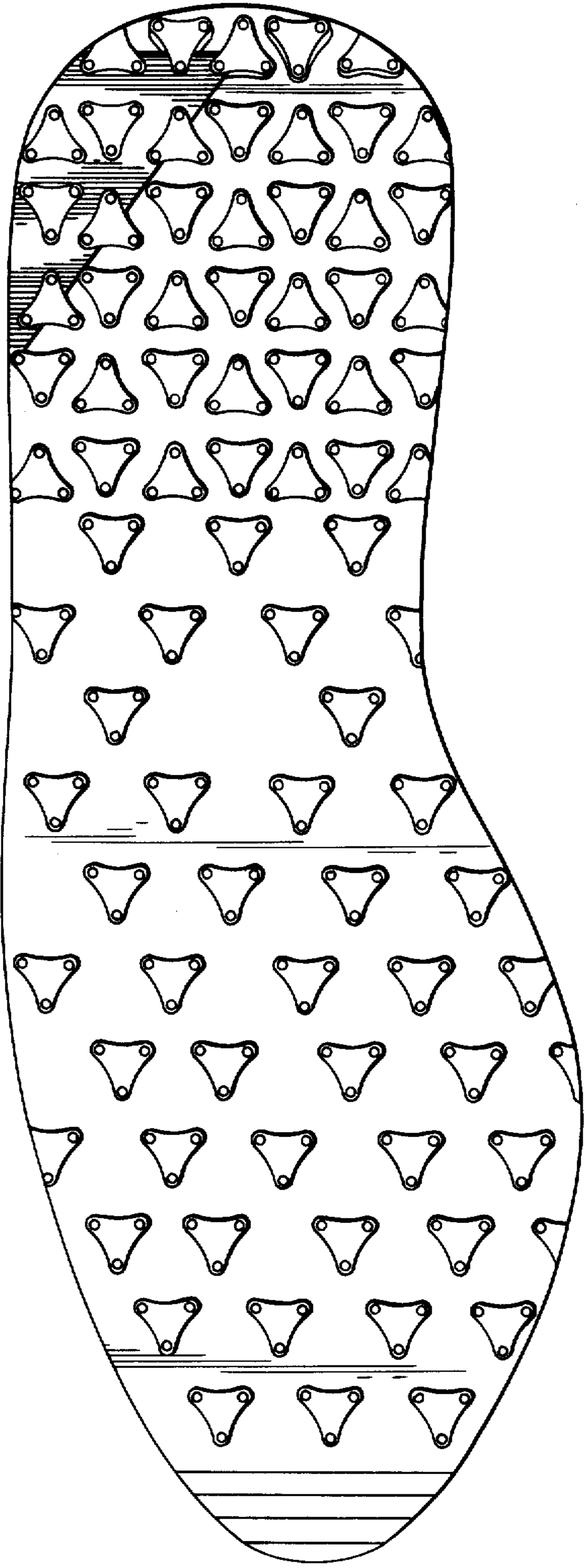

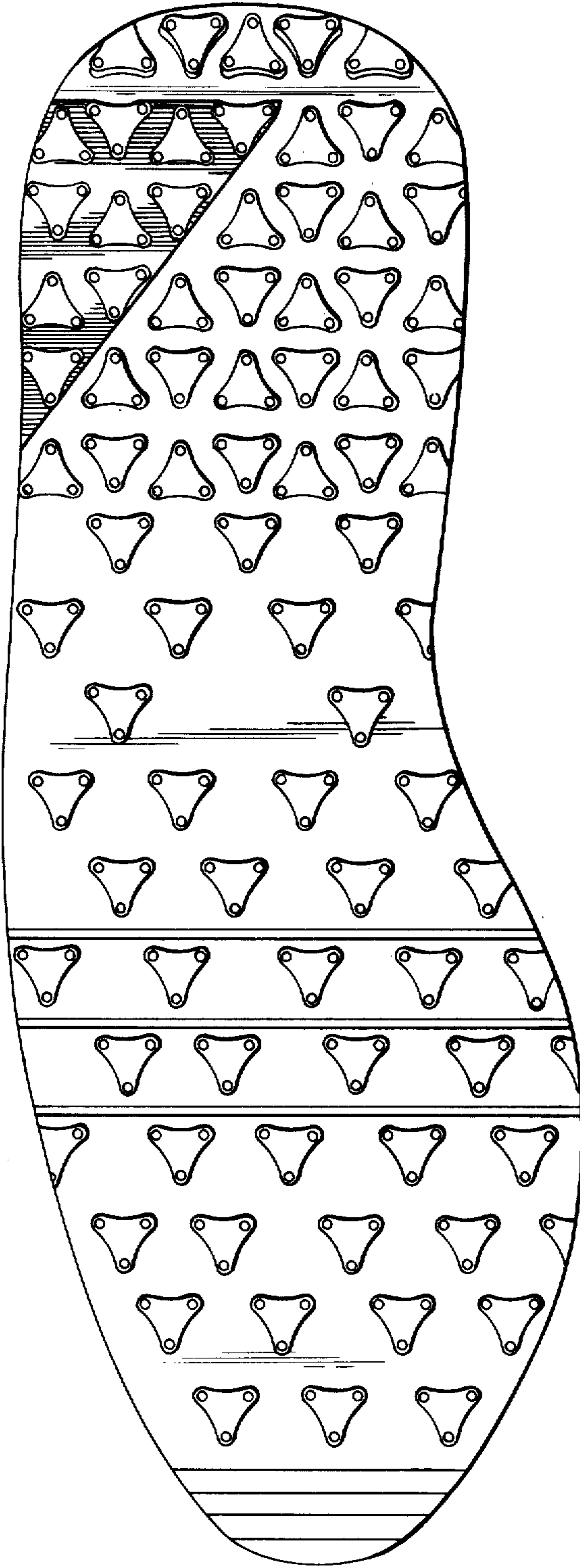
