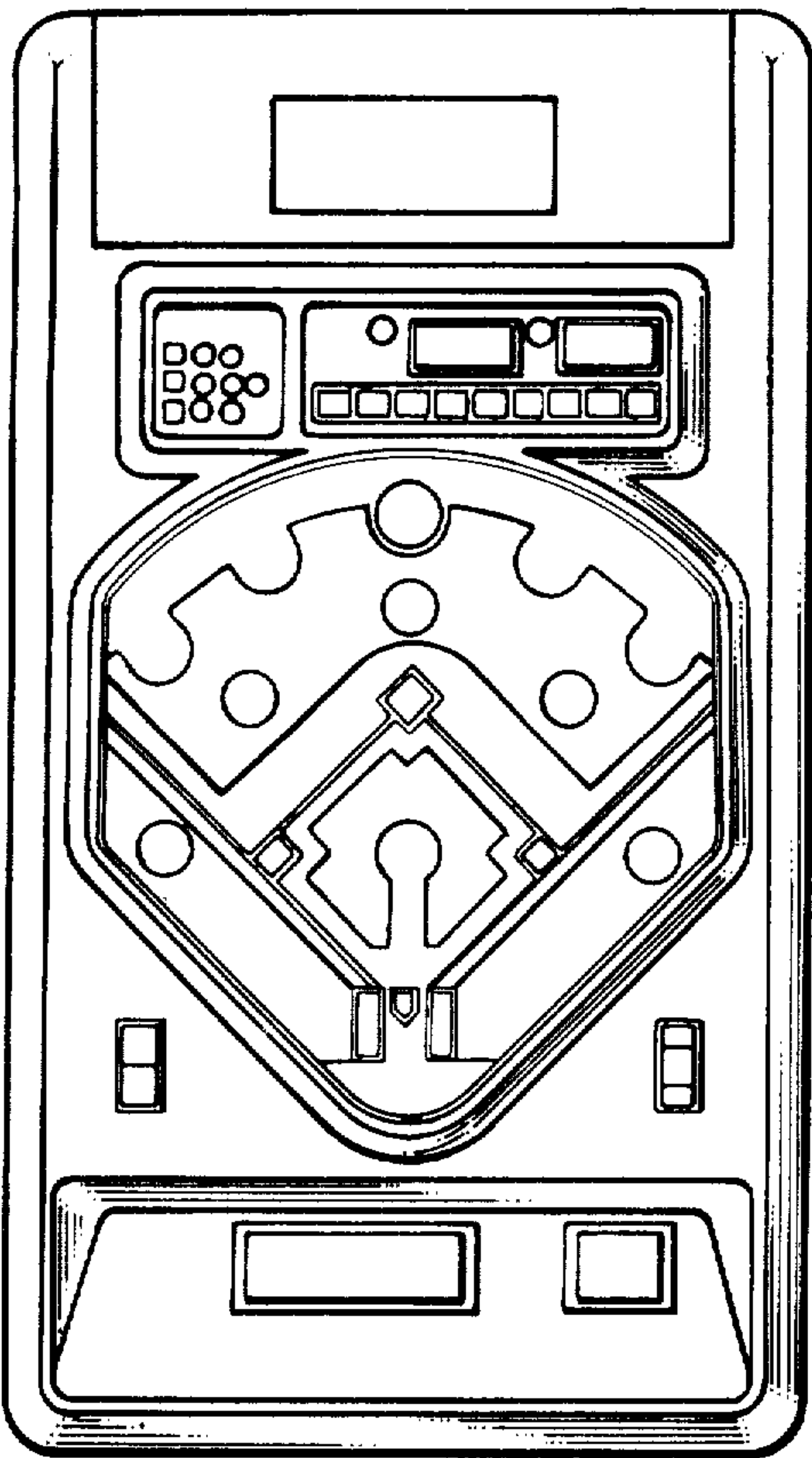

FIG. 6 is a rear edge view thereof.



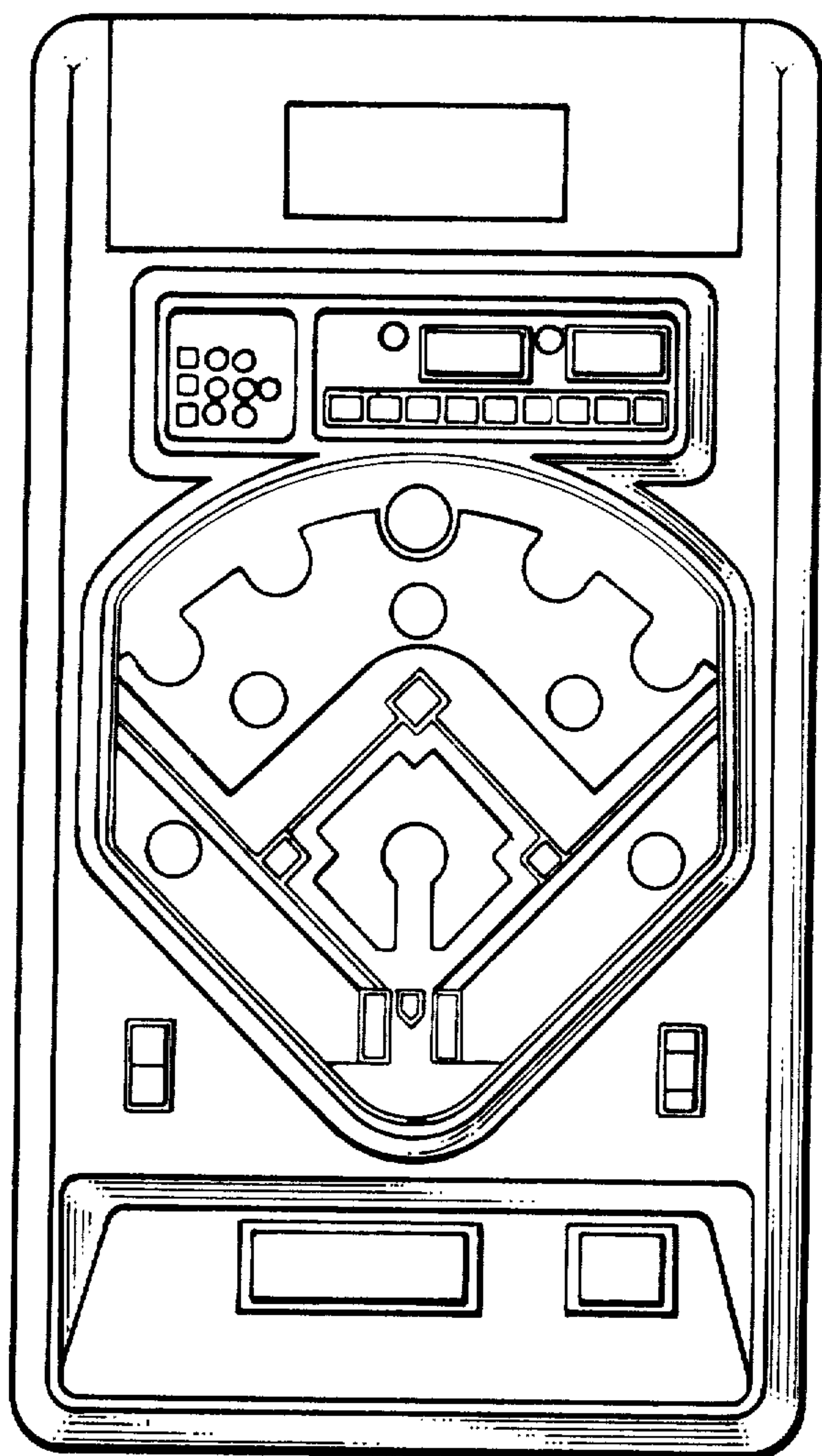

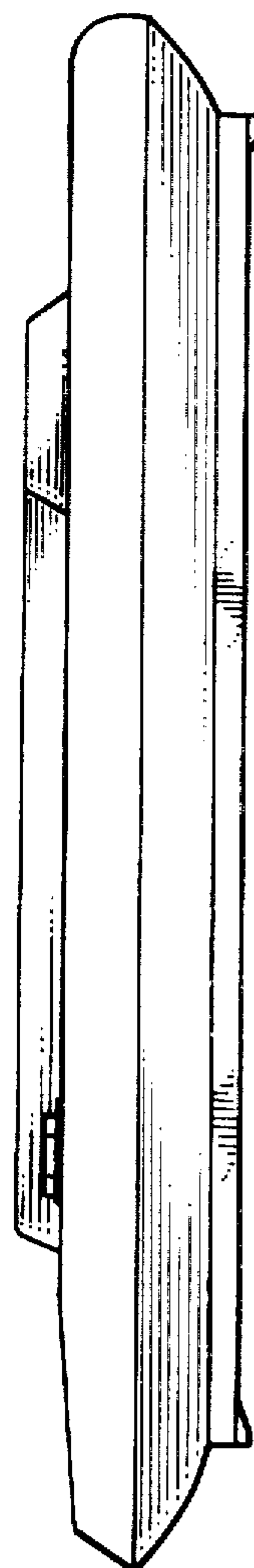

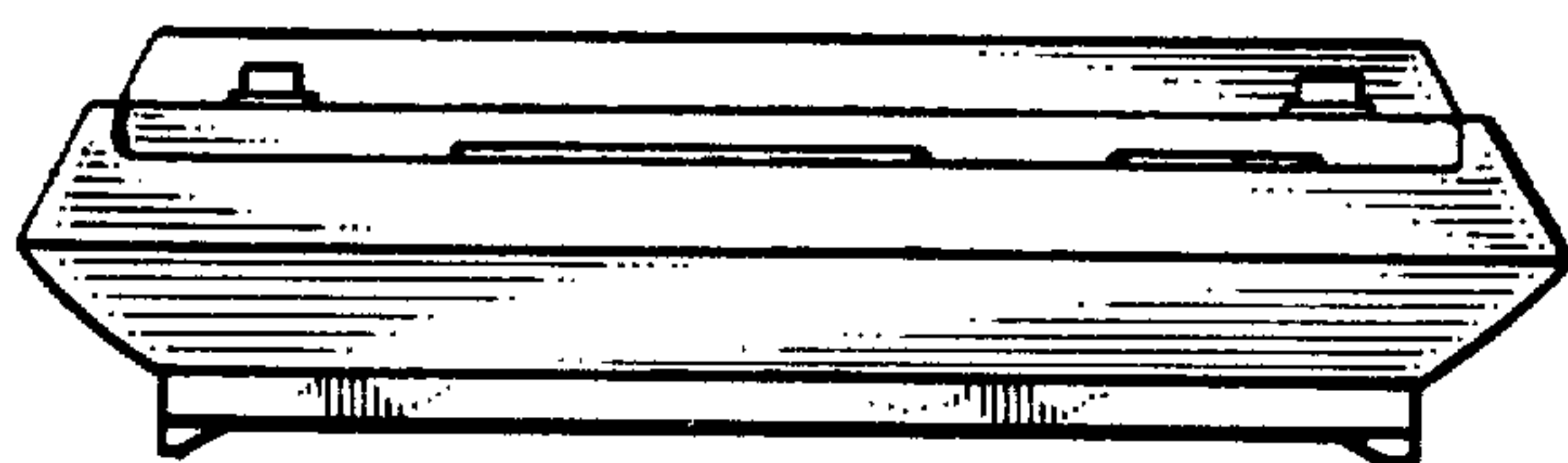

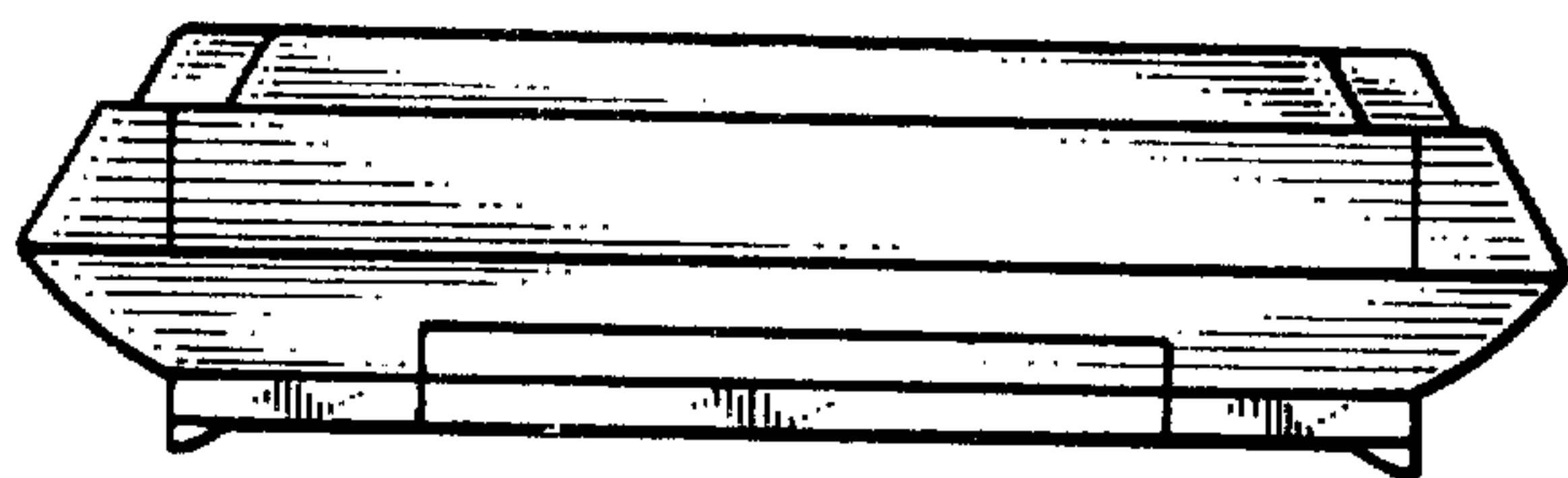

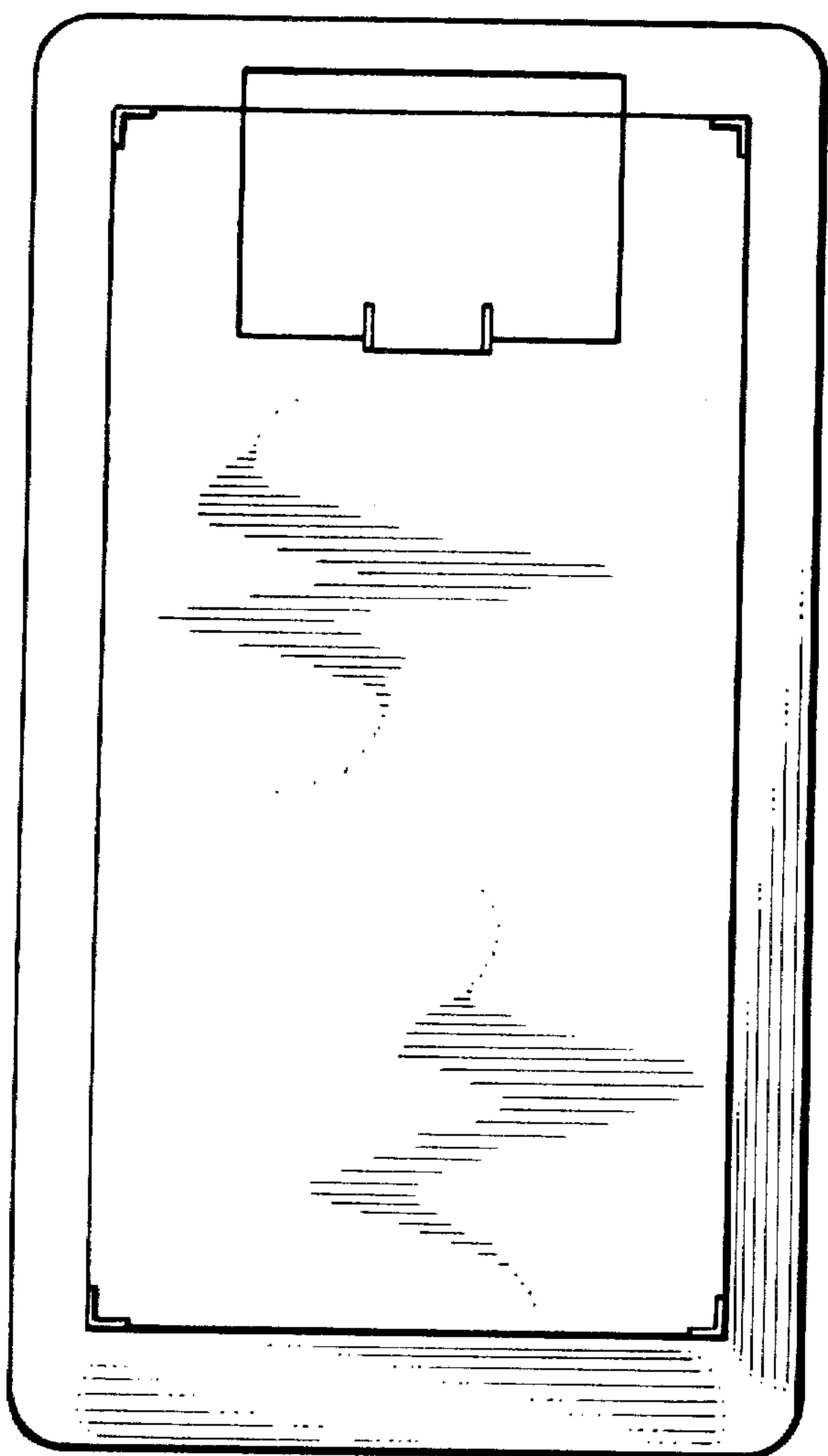

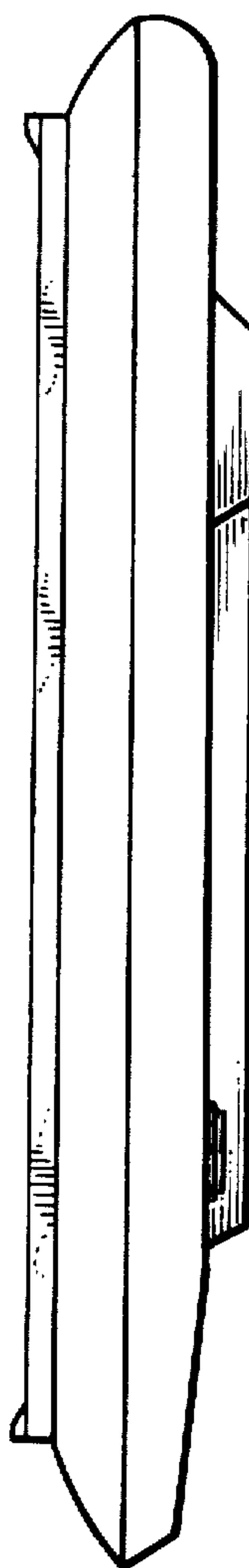
