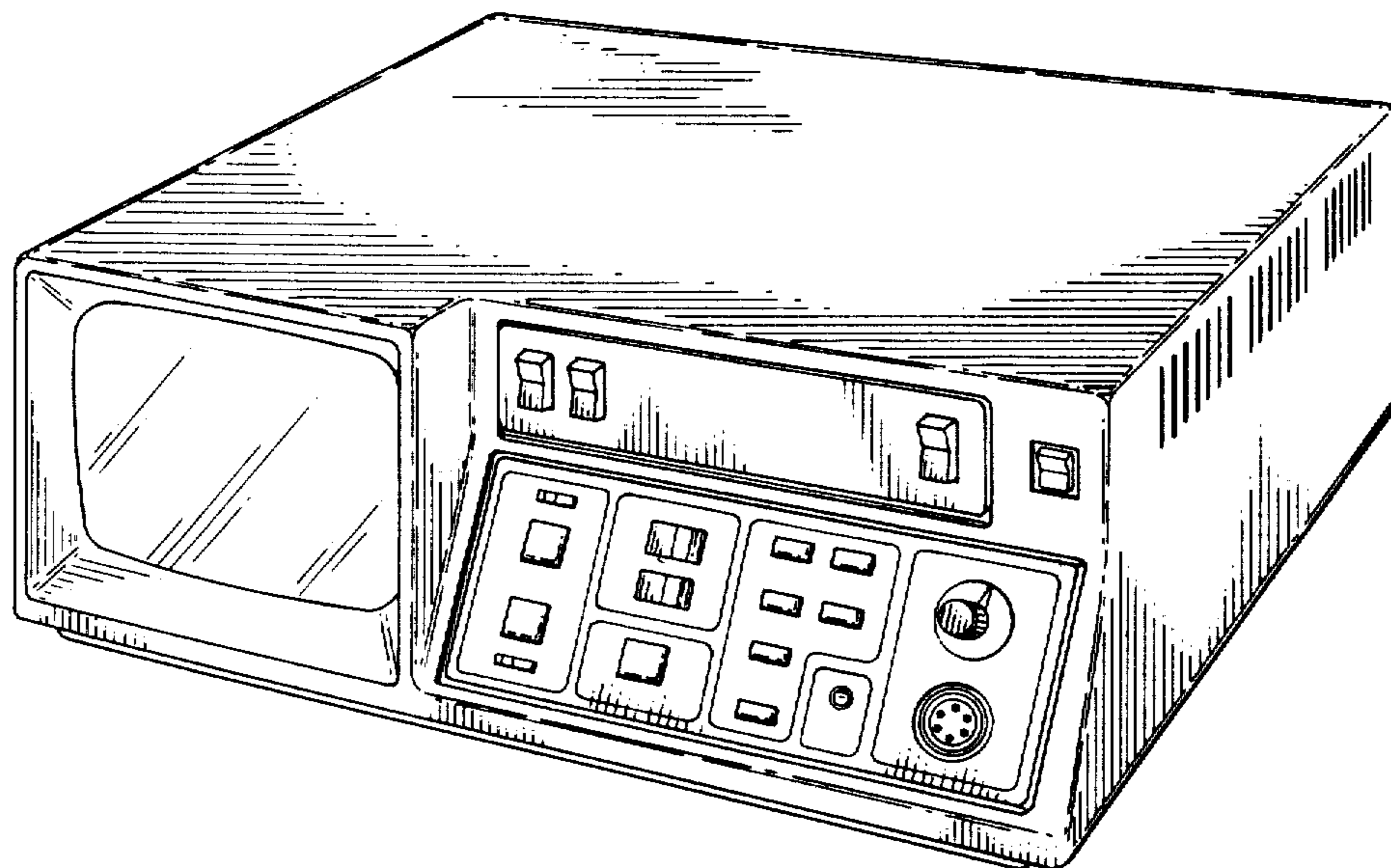

FIG. 1 is the left front perspective view of a patient monitor or the like embodying our new design; and FIG. 2 is the right rear perspective view thereof.



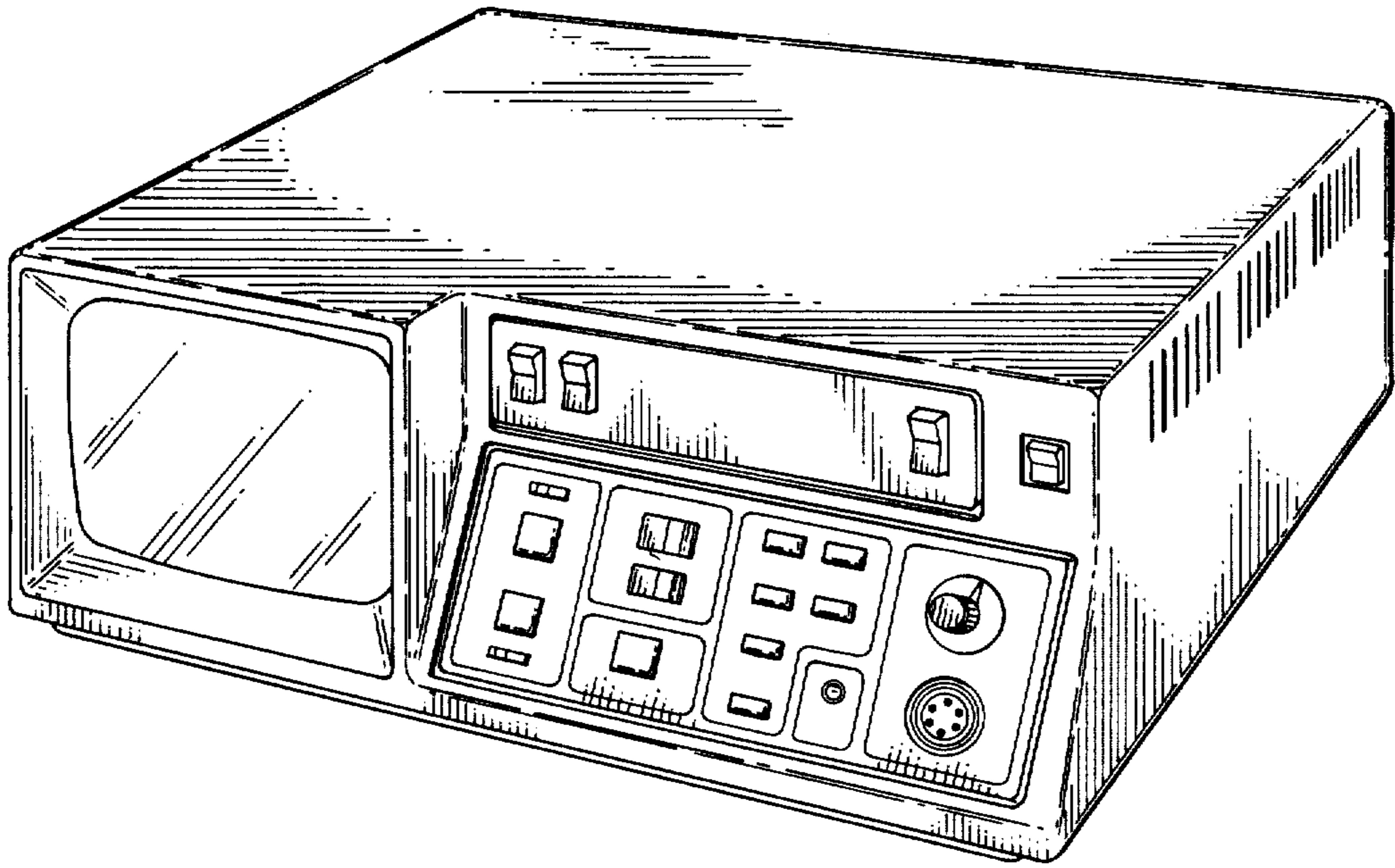

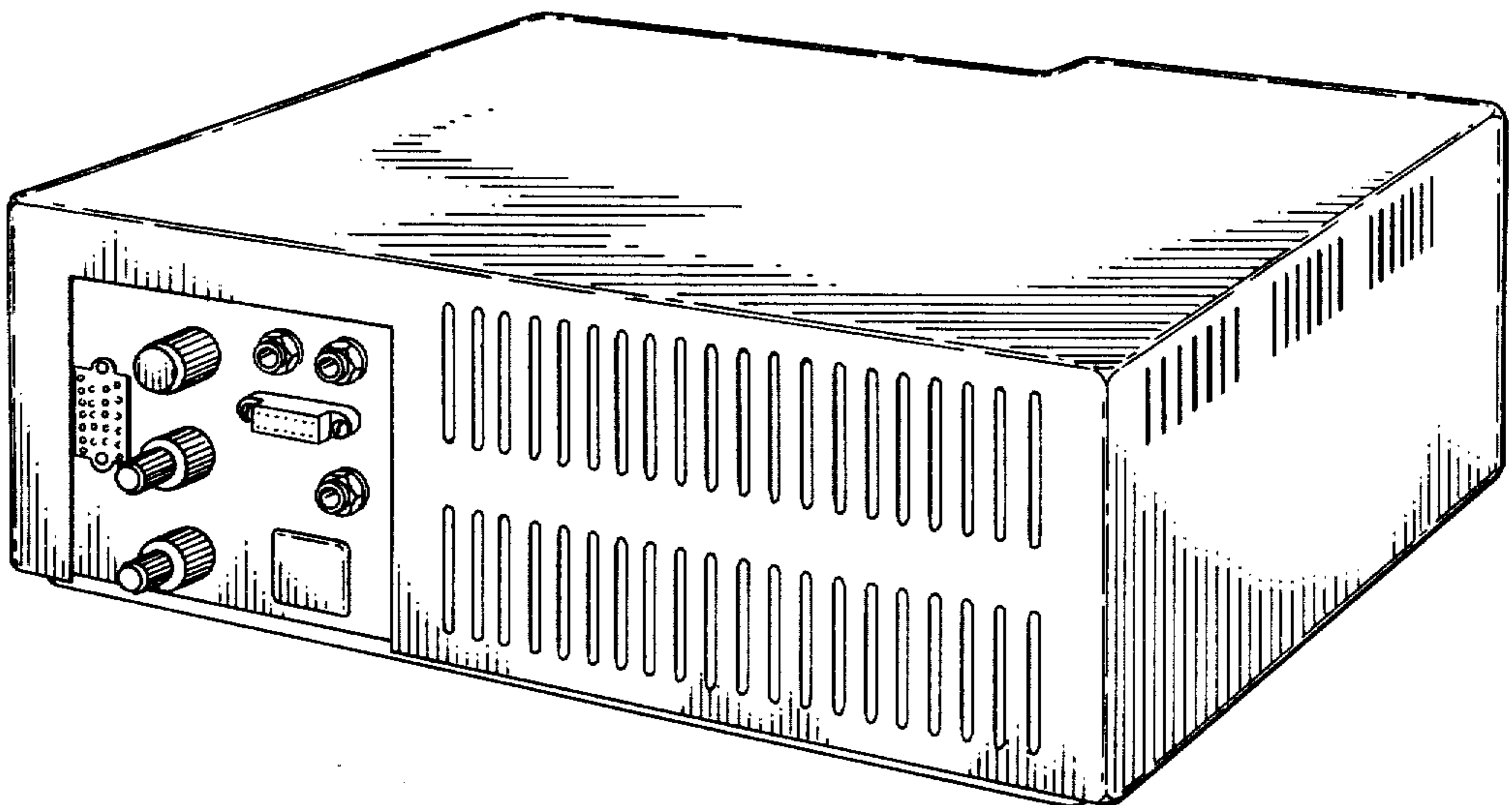
