FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a disposable cassette for use in a peristaltic pump employing my new design.

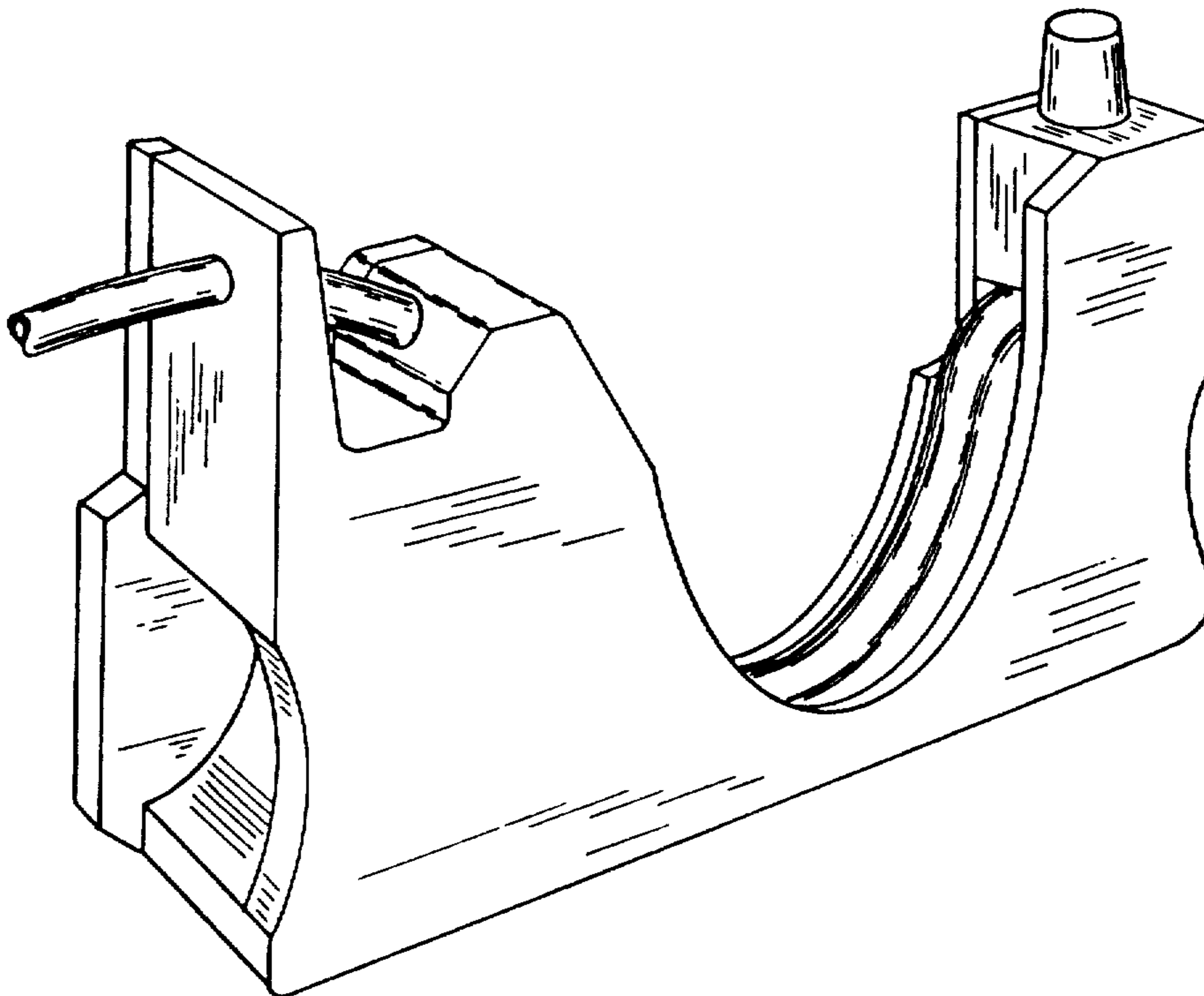
FIG. 2 is a front elevational view of the cassette shown in FIG. 1.

FIG. 6 is a right side elevational view of the cassette shown in FIG. 1.



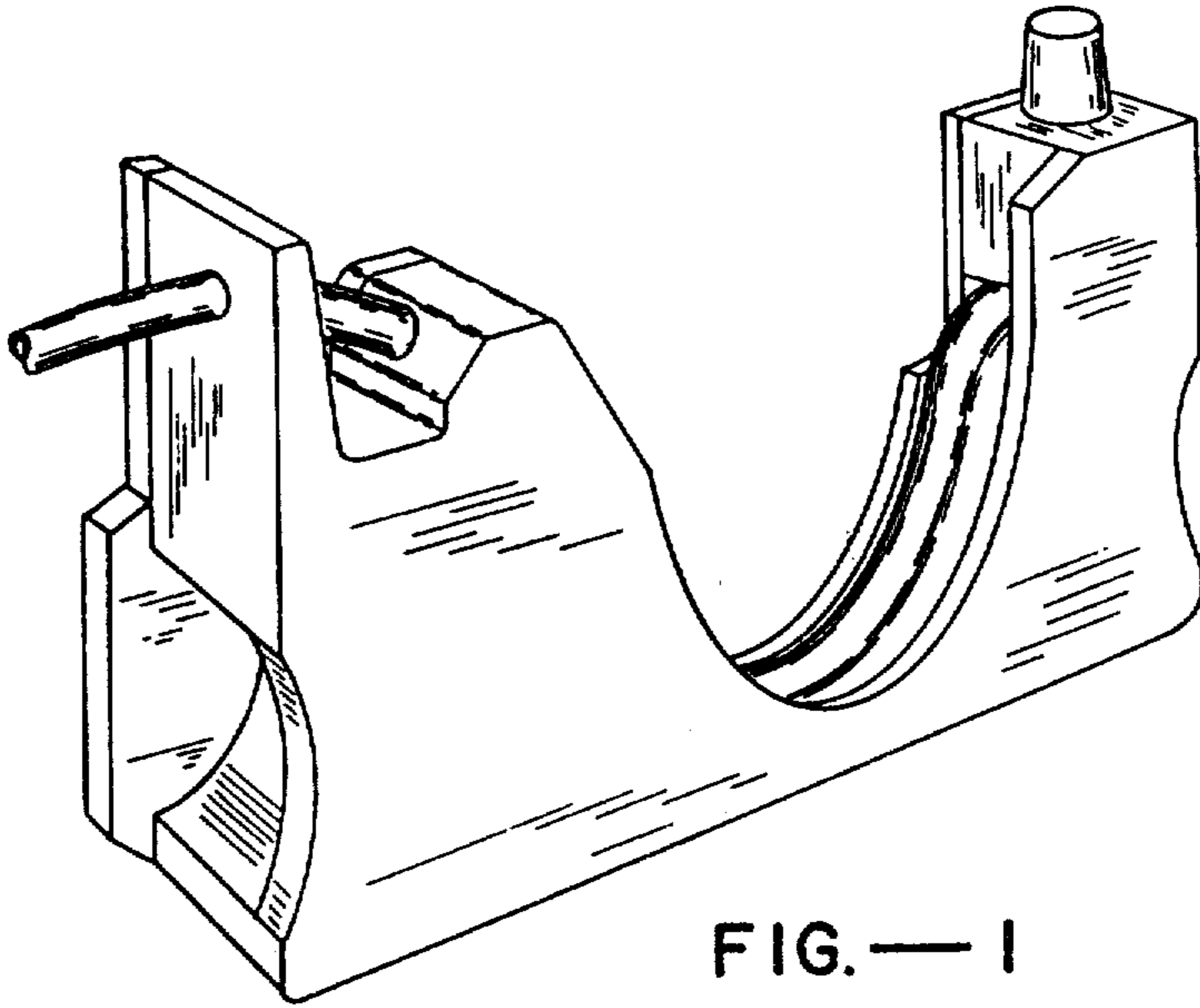

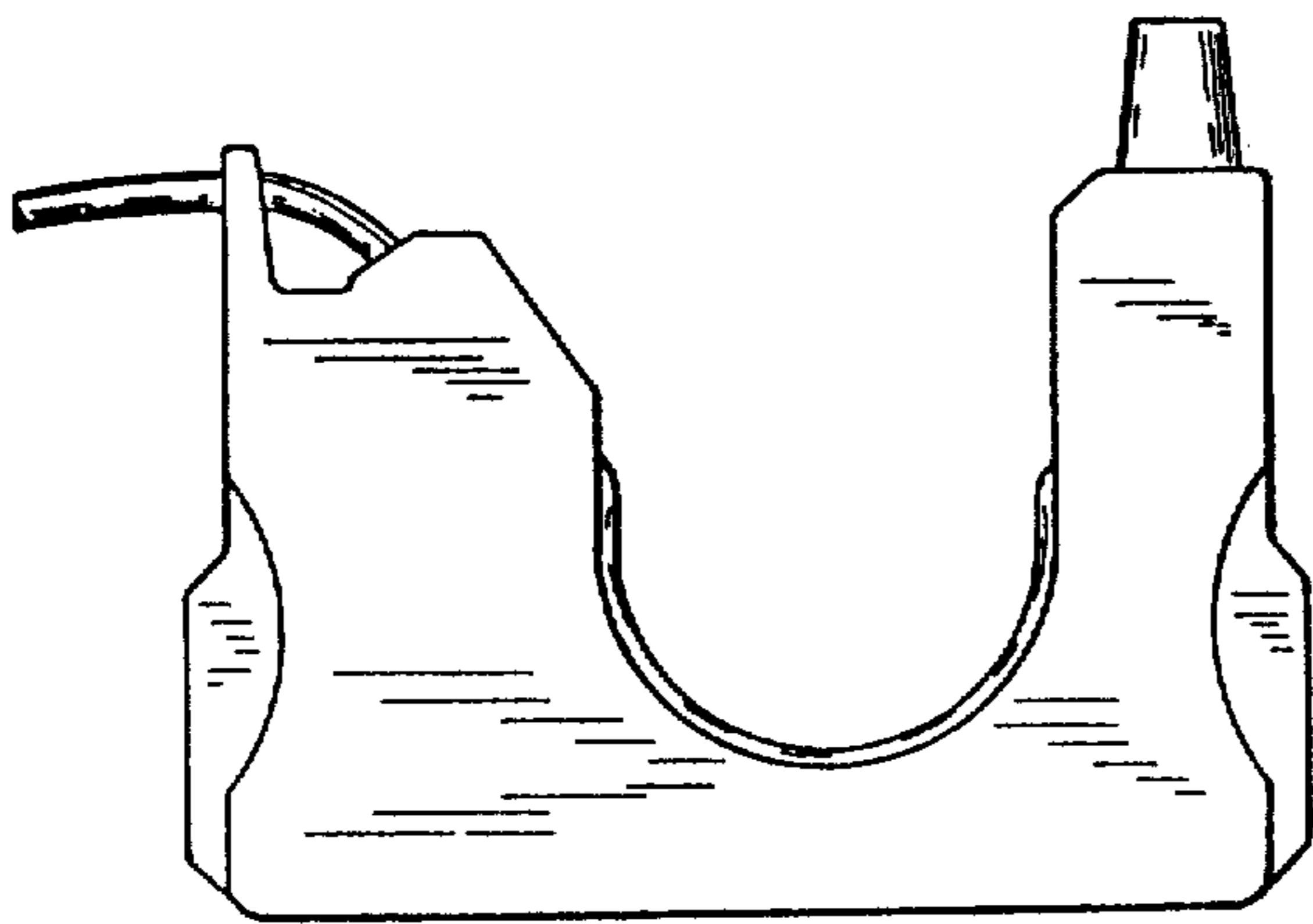

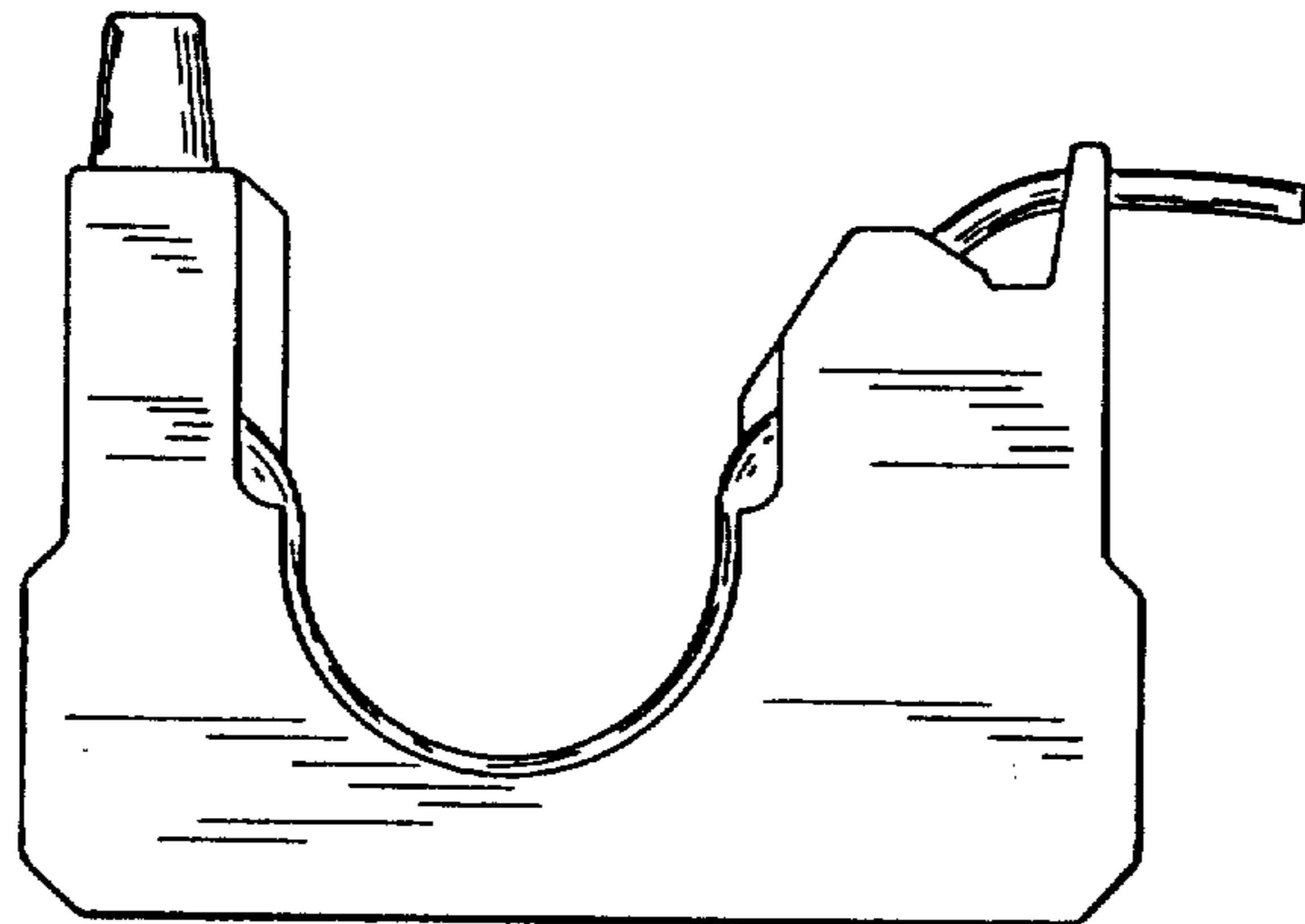
