[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a chair, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a side elevation of a chair according to the invention, the opposite sides being mirror images of one another;

FIG. 2 is a top view of the chair of FIG. 1;

FIG. 3 is a rear elevational view of the chair of FIG. 1; and

FIG. 4 is a front elevational view of the chair of FIG. 1.

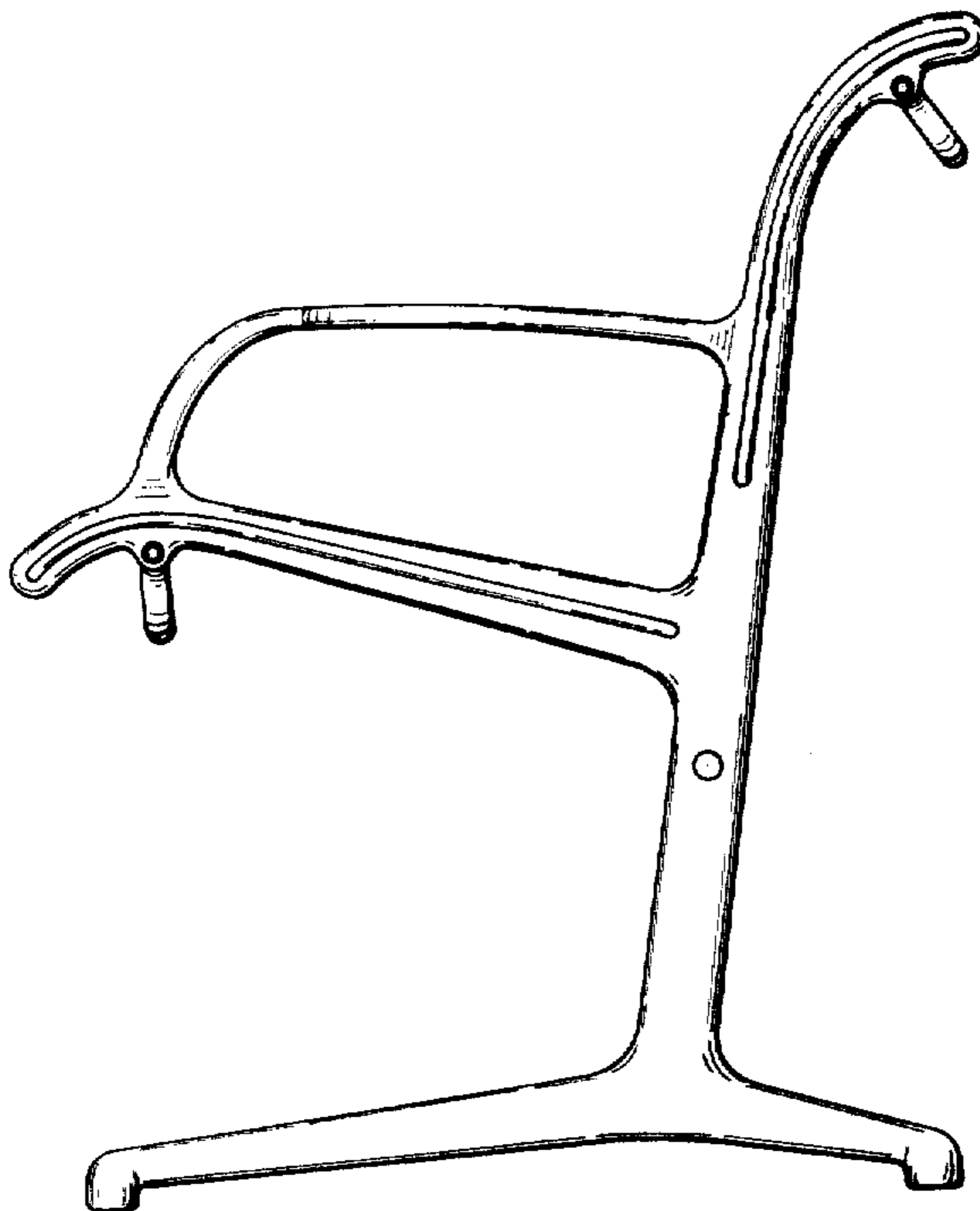

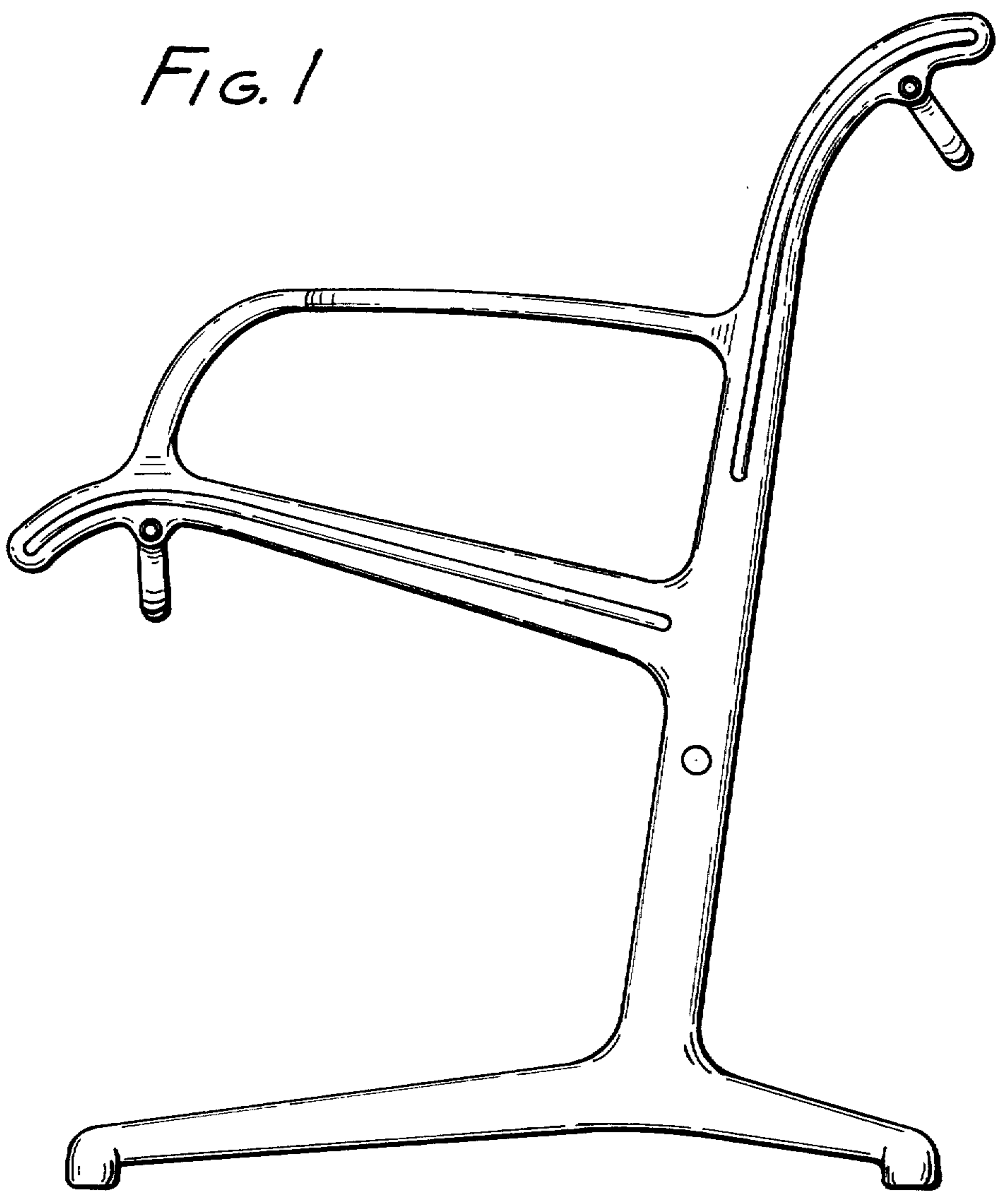

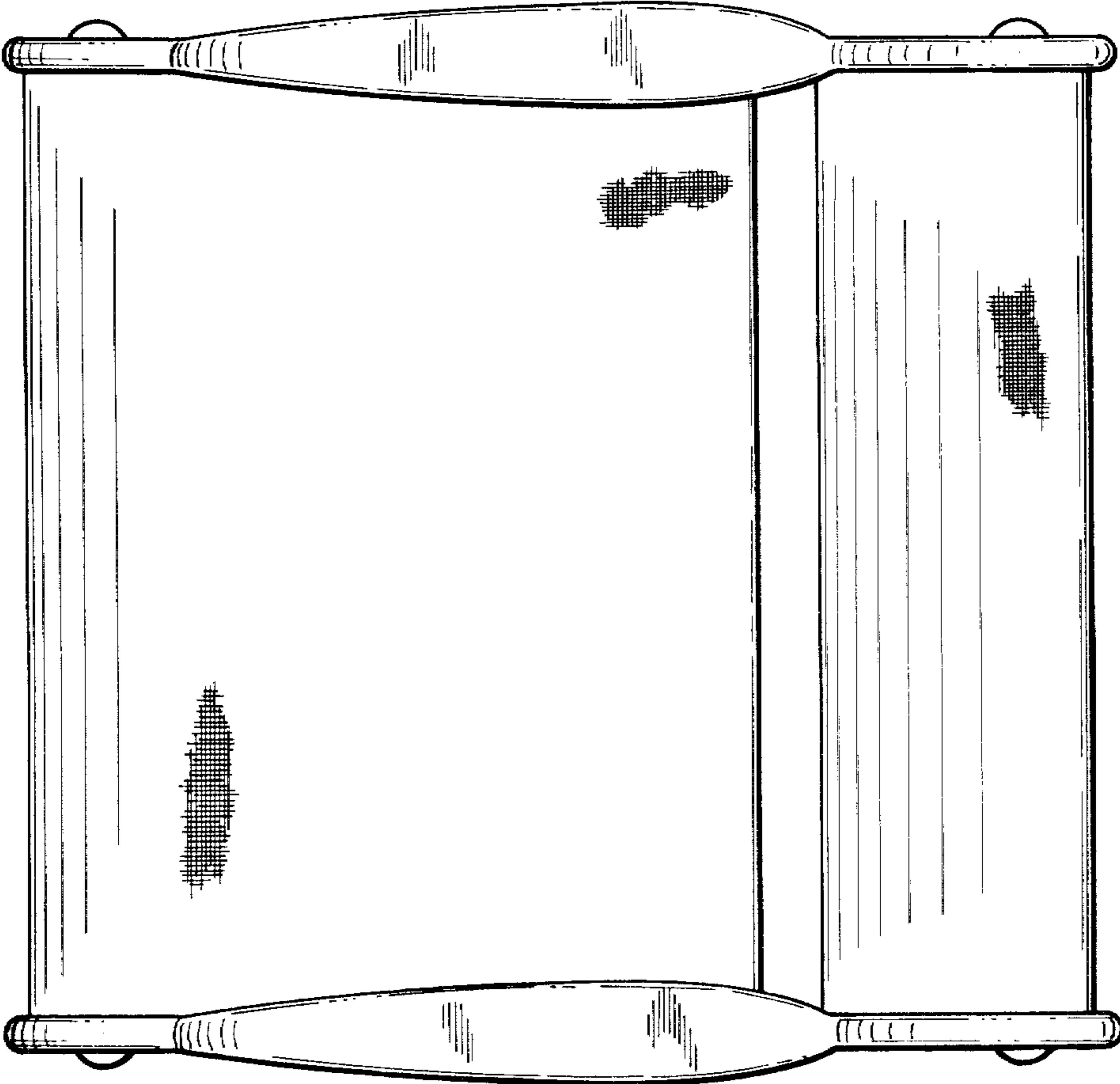

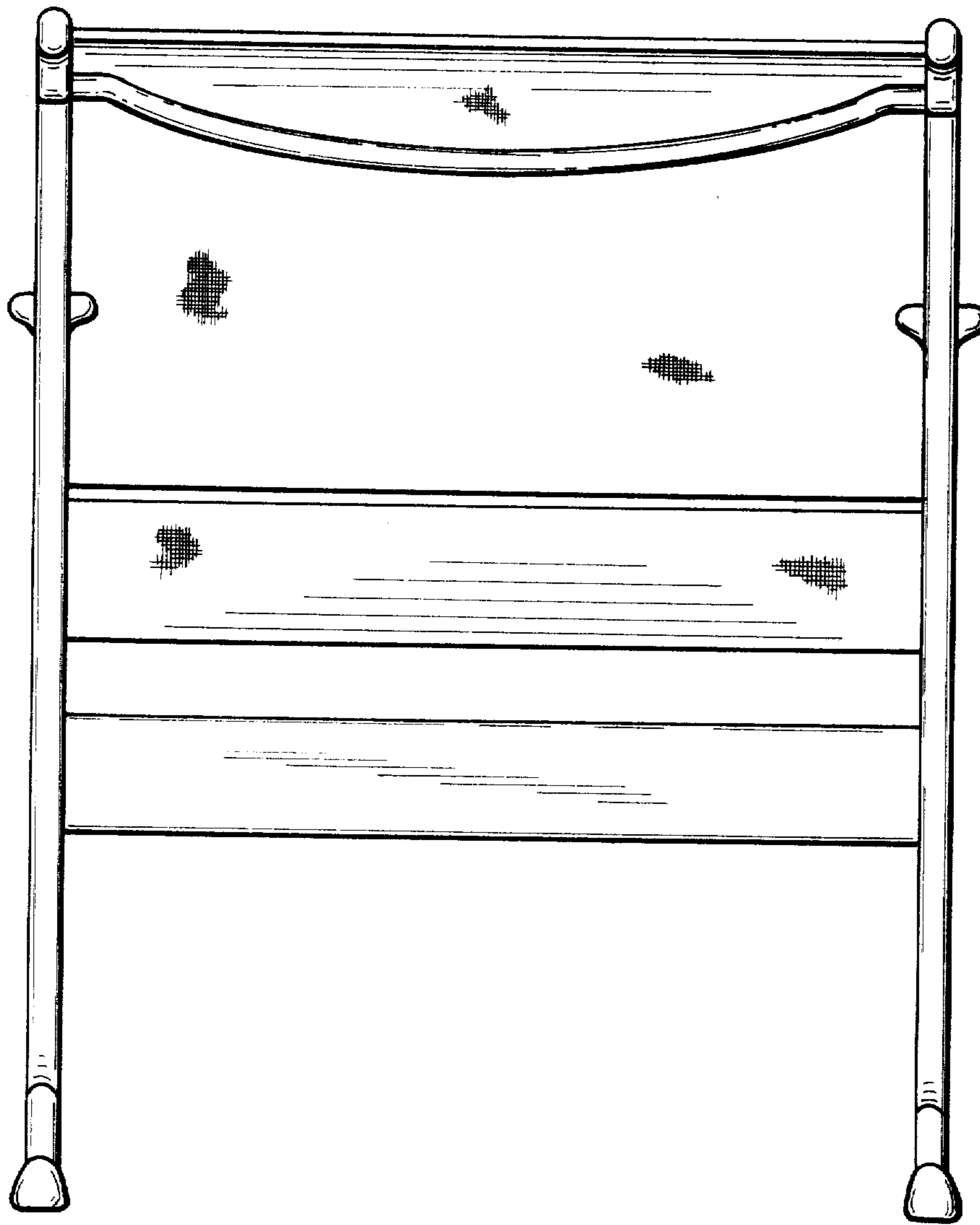
