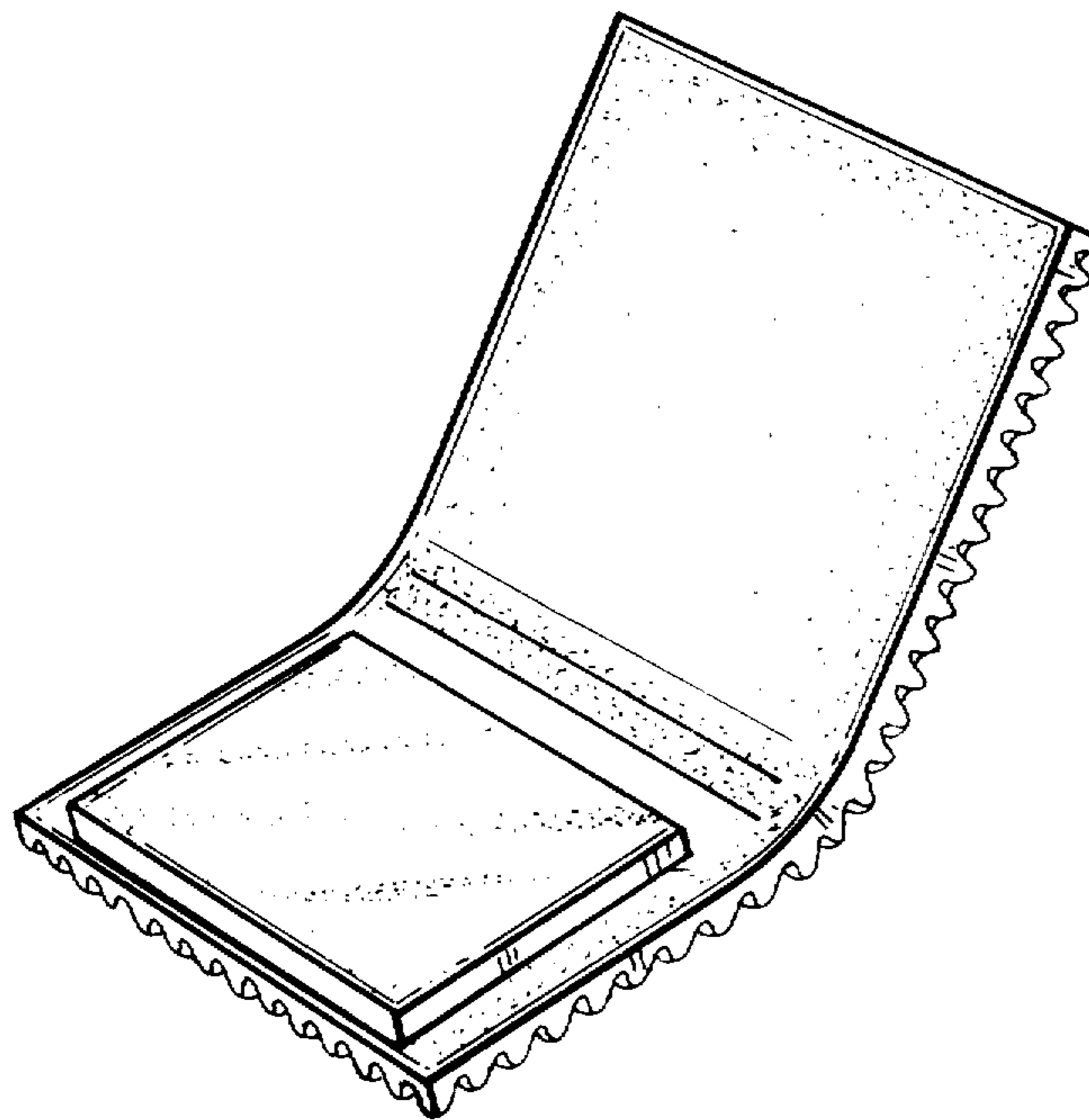

[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a bathtub mat, substantially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front and right side perspective view of a bathtub mat showing my new design; FIG. 2 is a left side elevational view; FIG. 3 is a front elevational view; FIG. 4 is a rear elevational view; FIG. 5 is a top plan view; FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view; and FIG. 7 is an enlarged fragmentary sectional view of the area of the mat indicated by arrows 8 in FIG. 6.



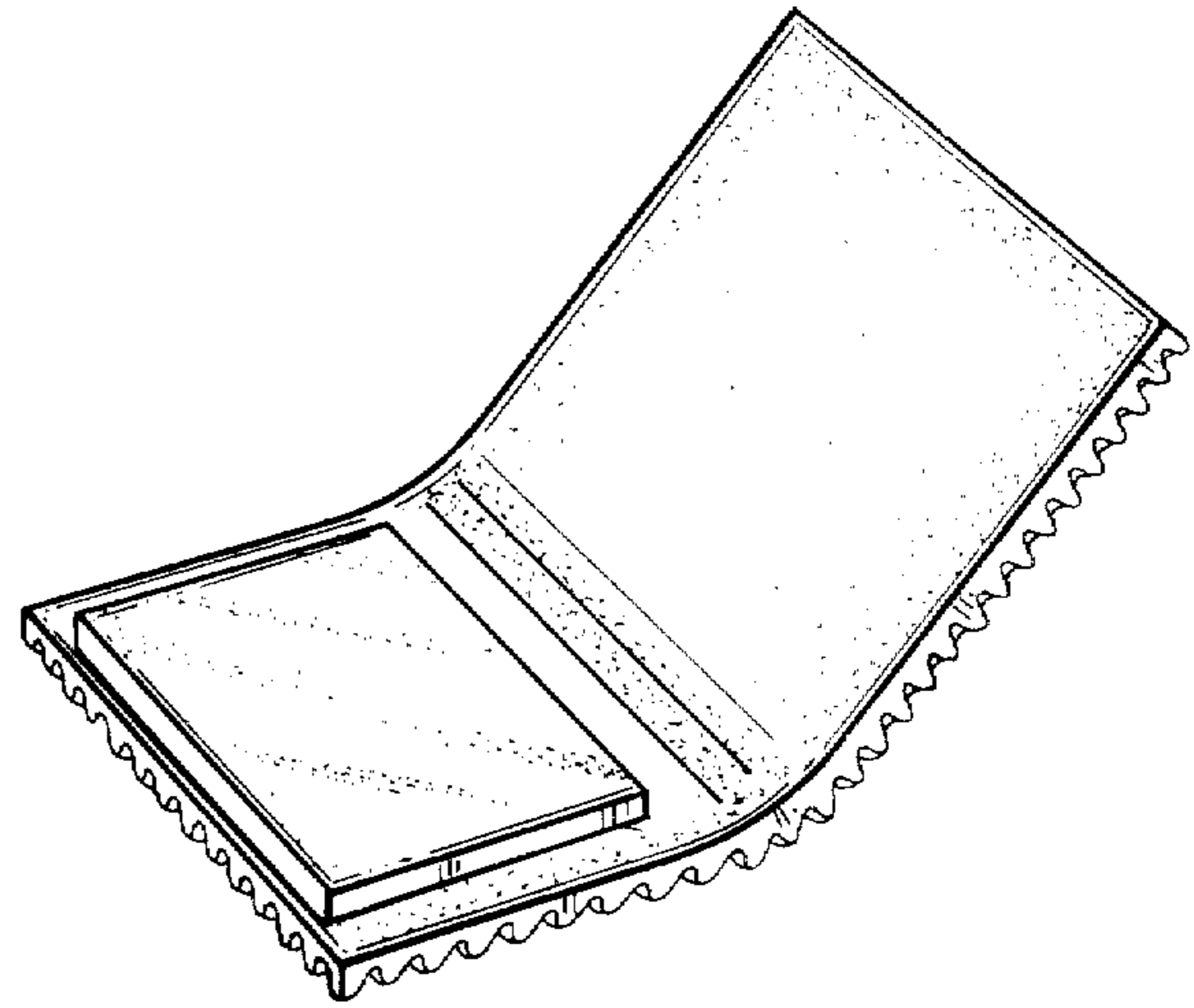

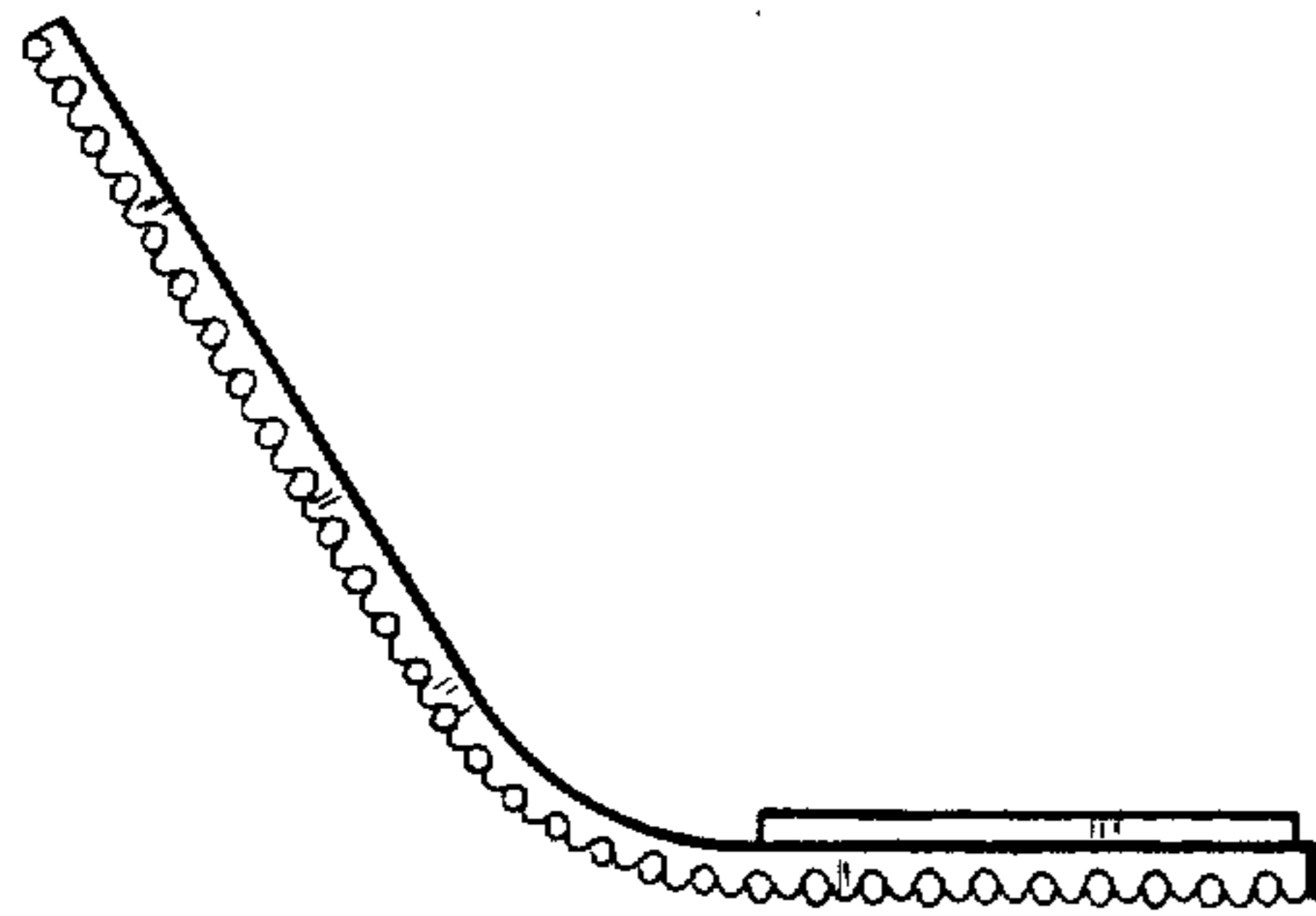

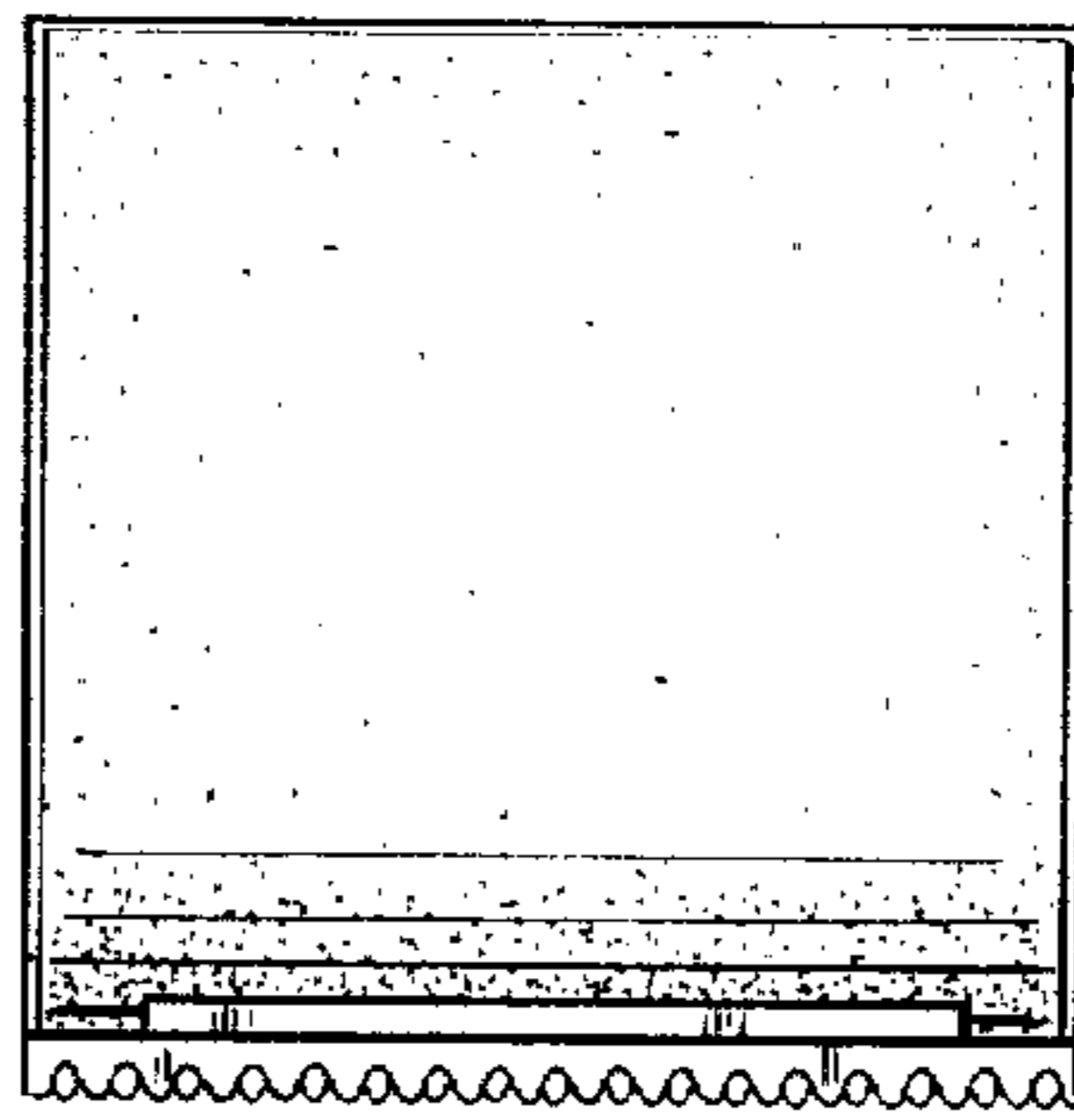

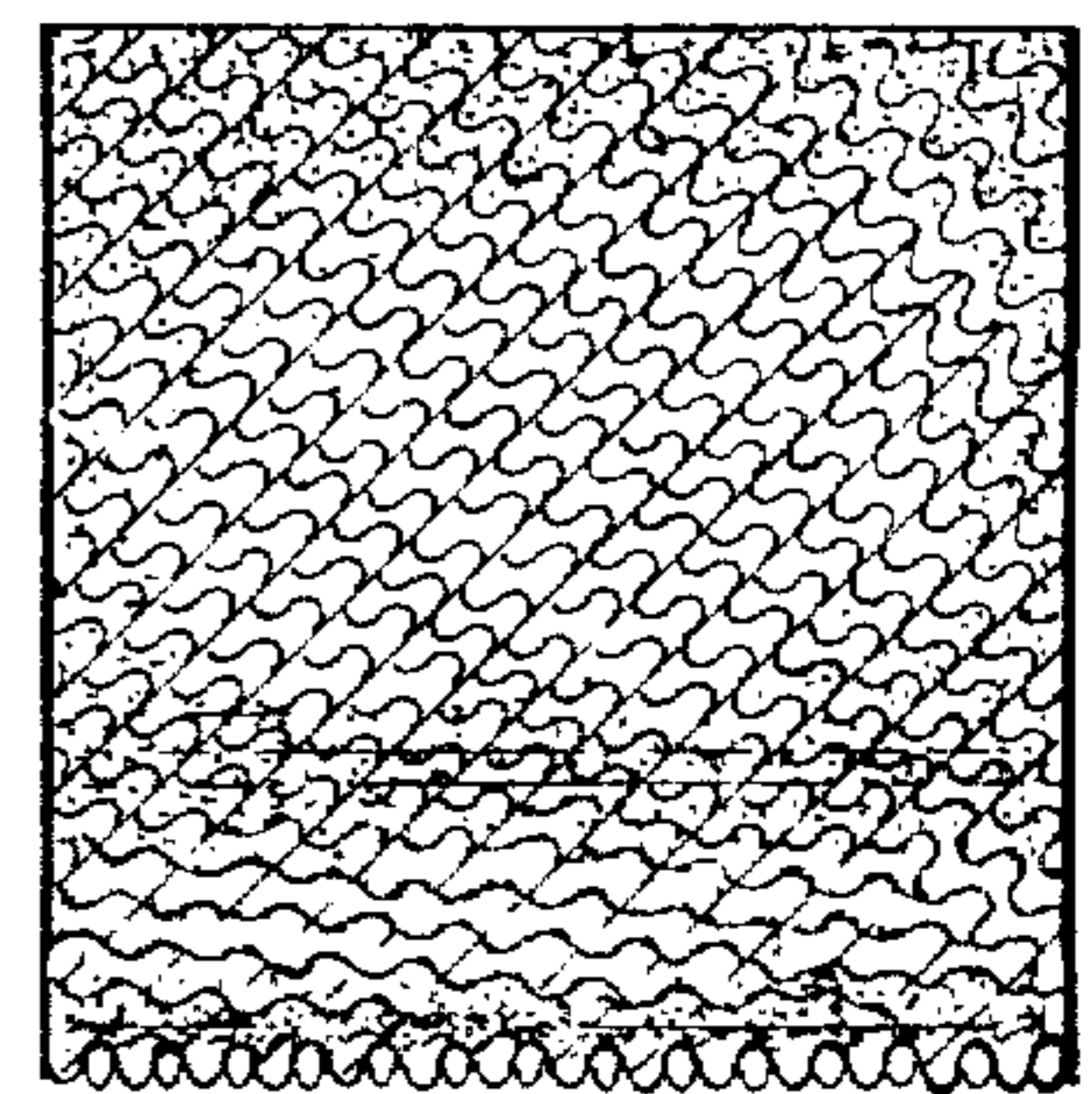

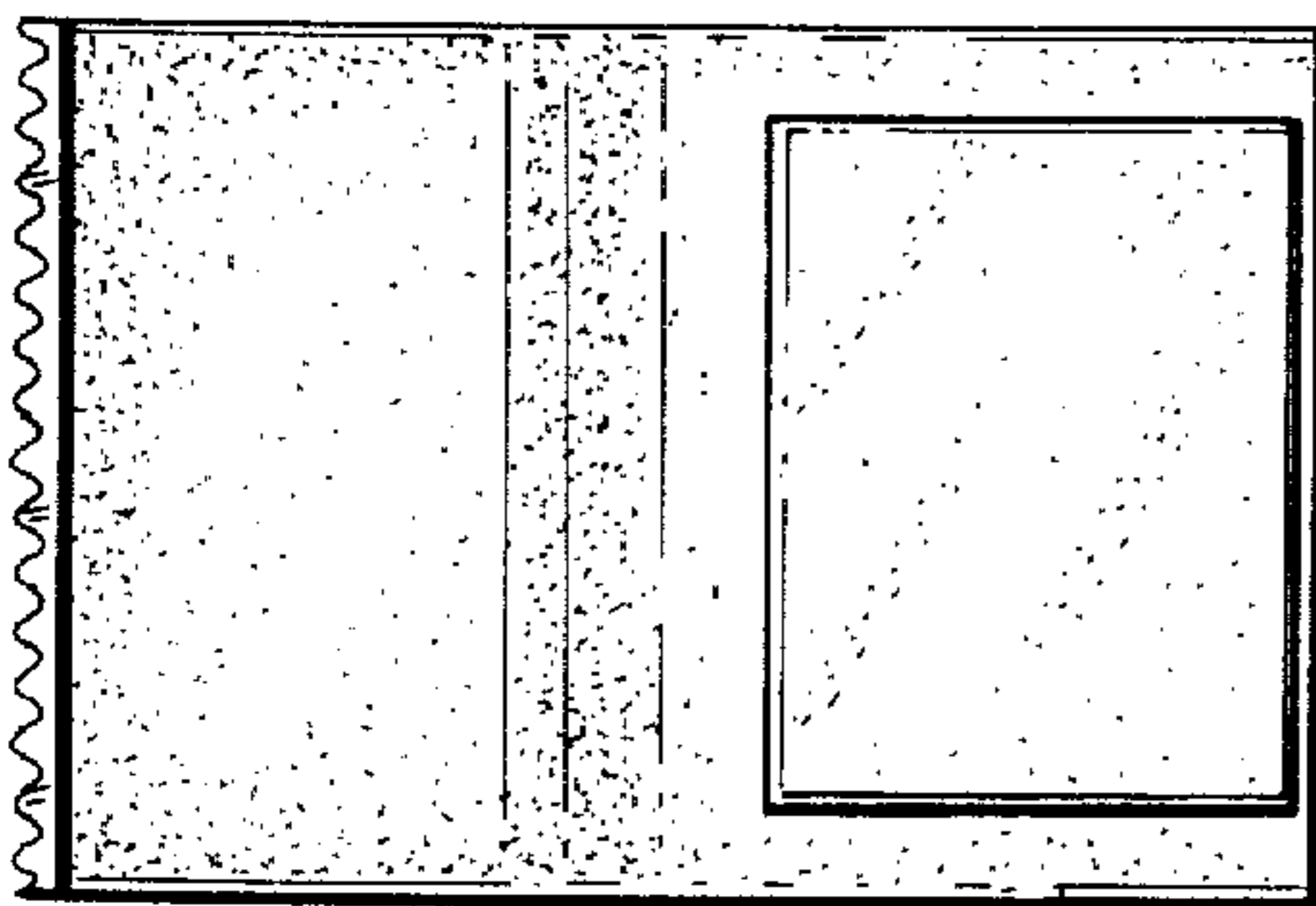

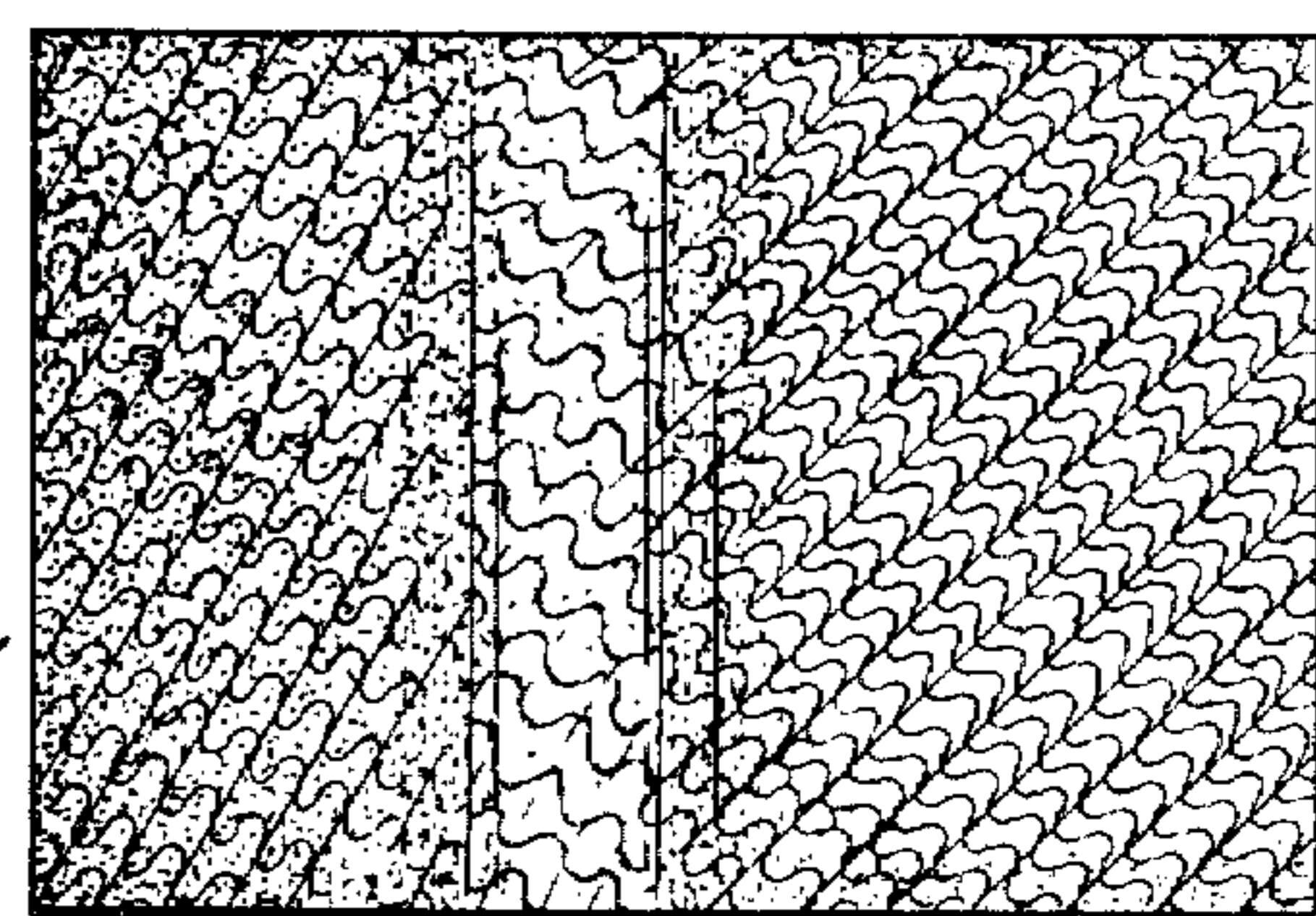

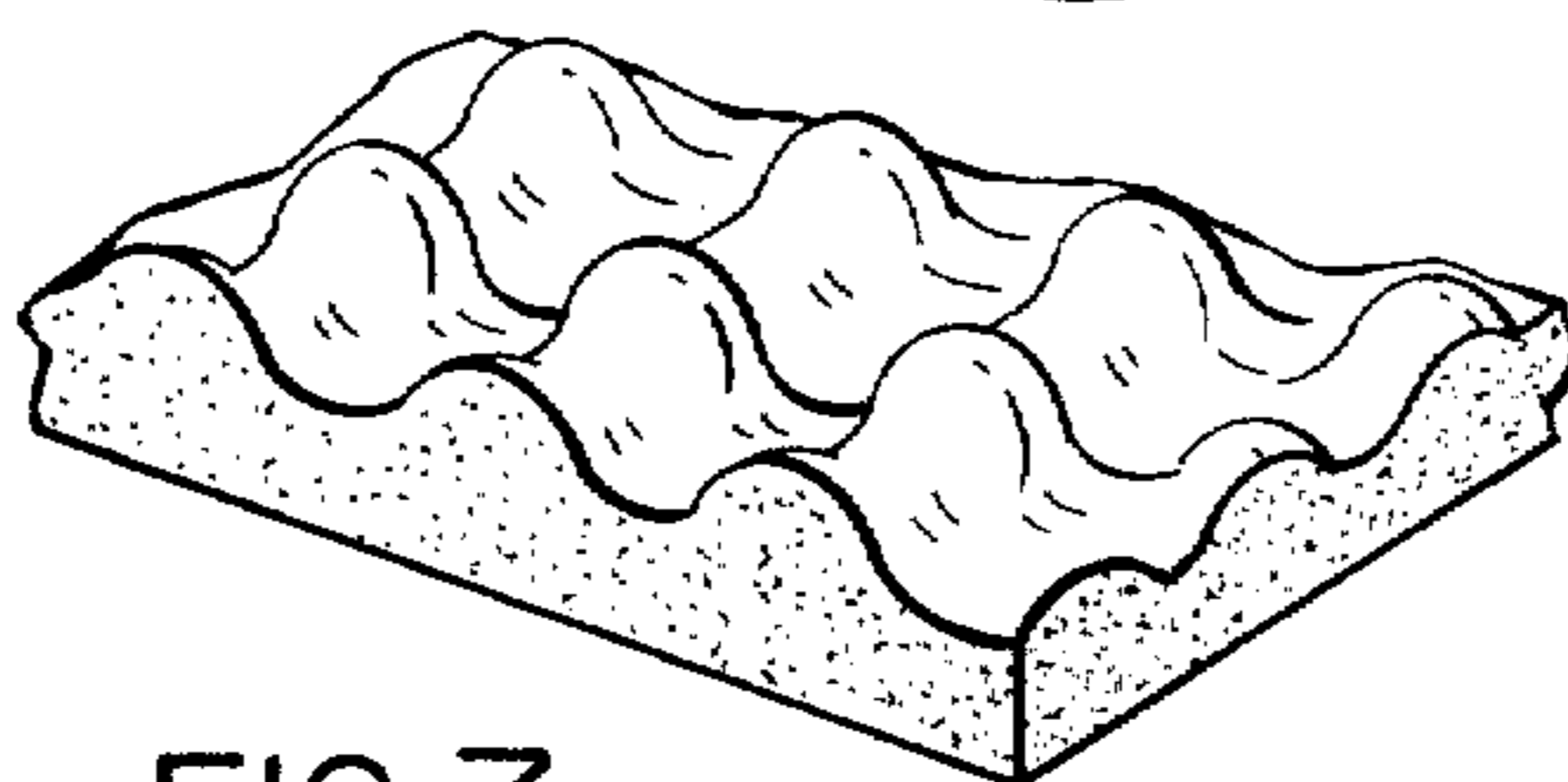
