[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a combined jar and lid, substantially as shown.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top perspective view of a combined jar and lid showing our new design;
FIG. 2 is an elevational view;
FIG. 3 is a bottom perspective view showing the side opposite that seen in FIG. 1; and
FIG. 4 is a top plan view of the combined jar and lid of FIG. 1.

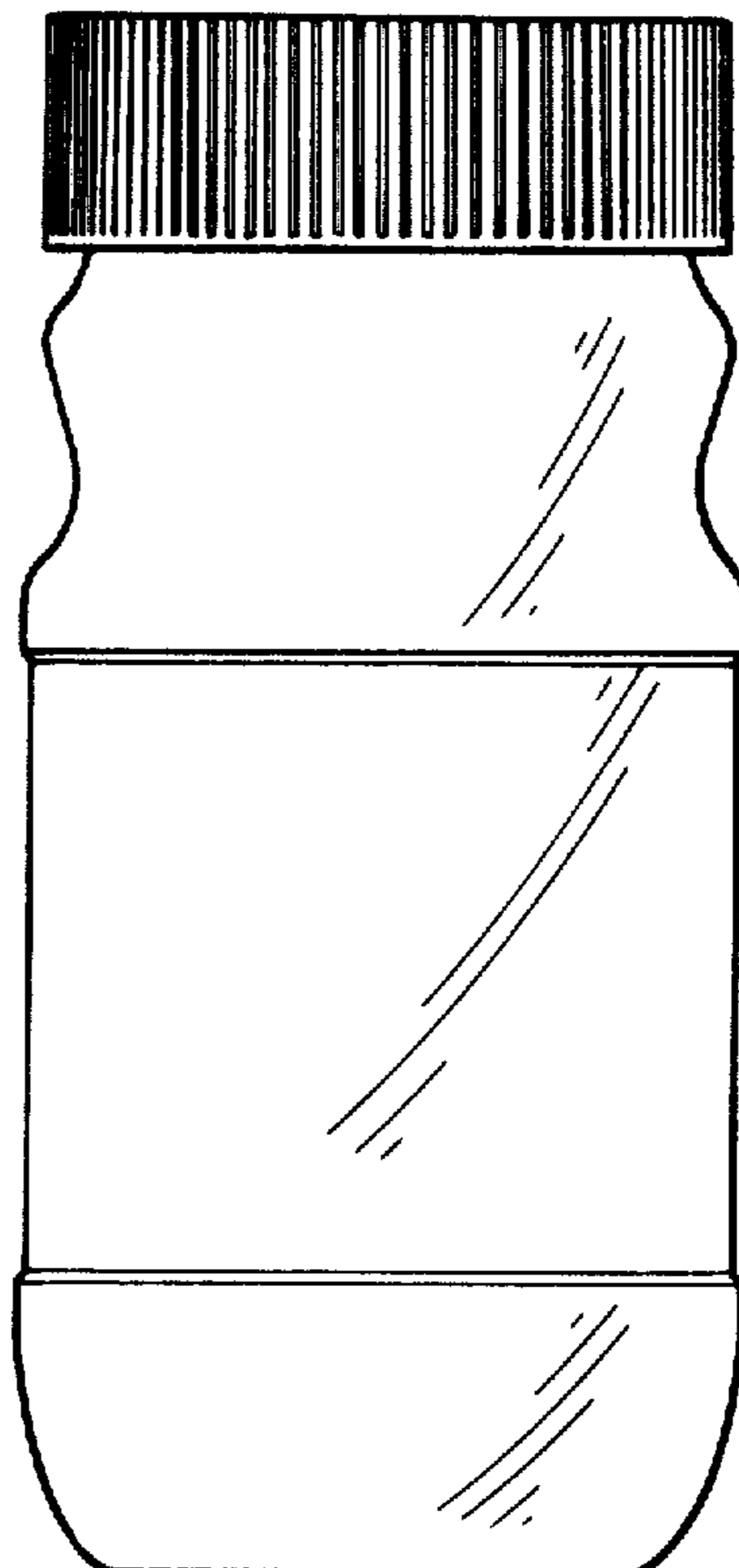

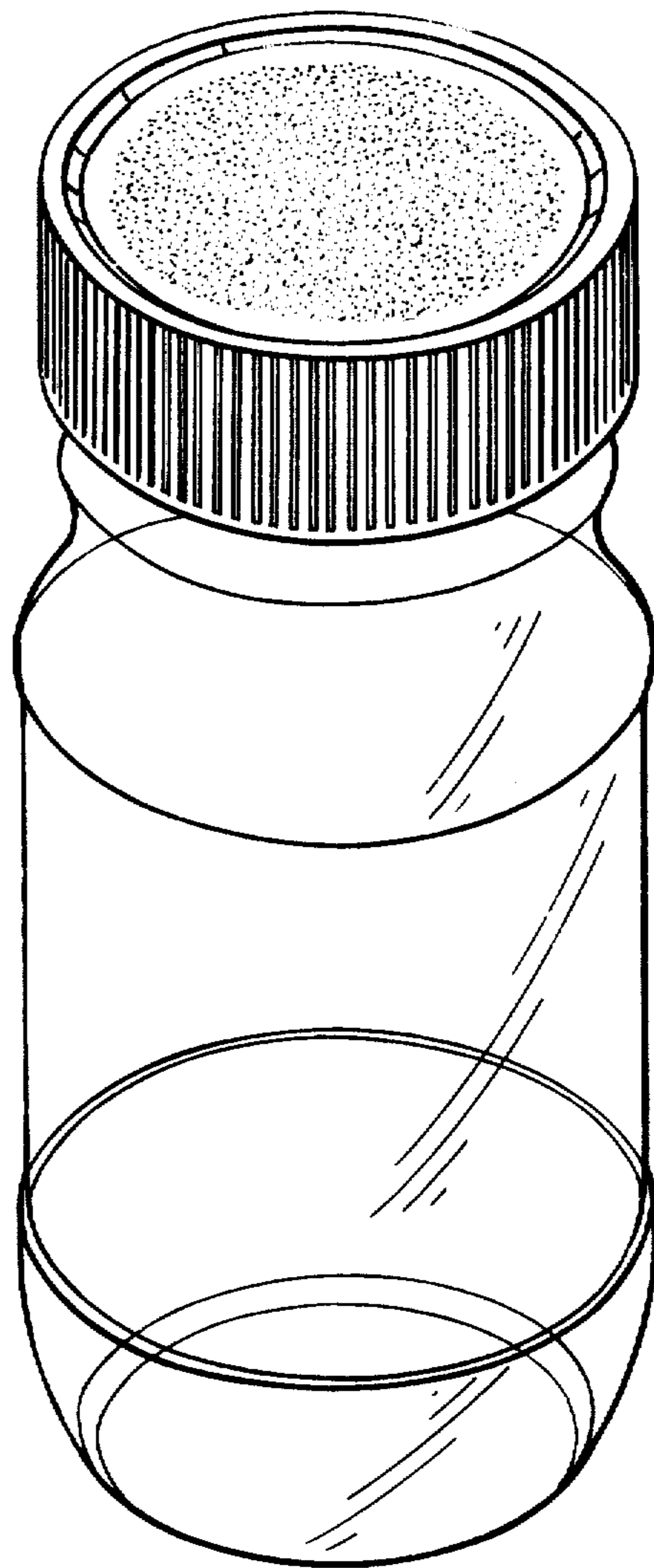

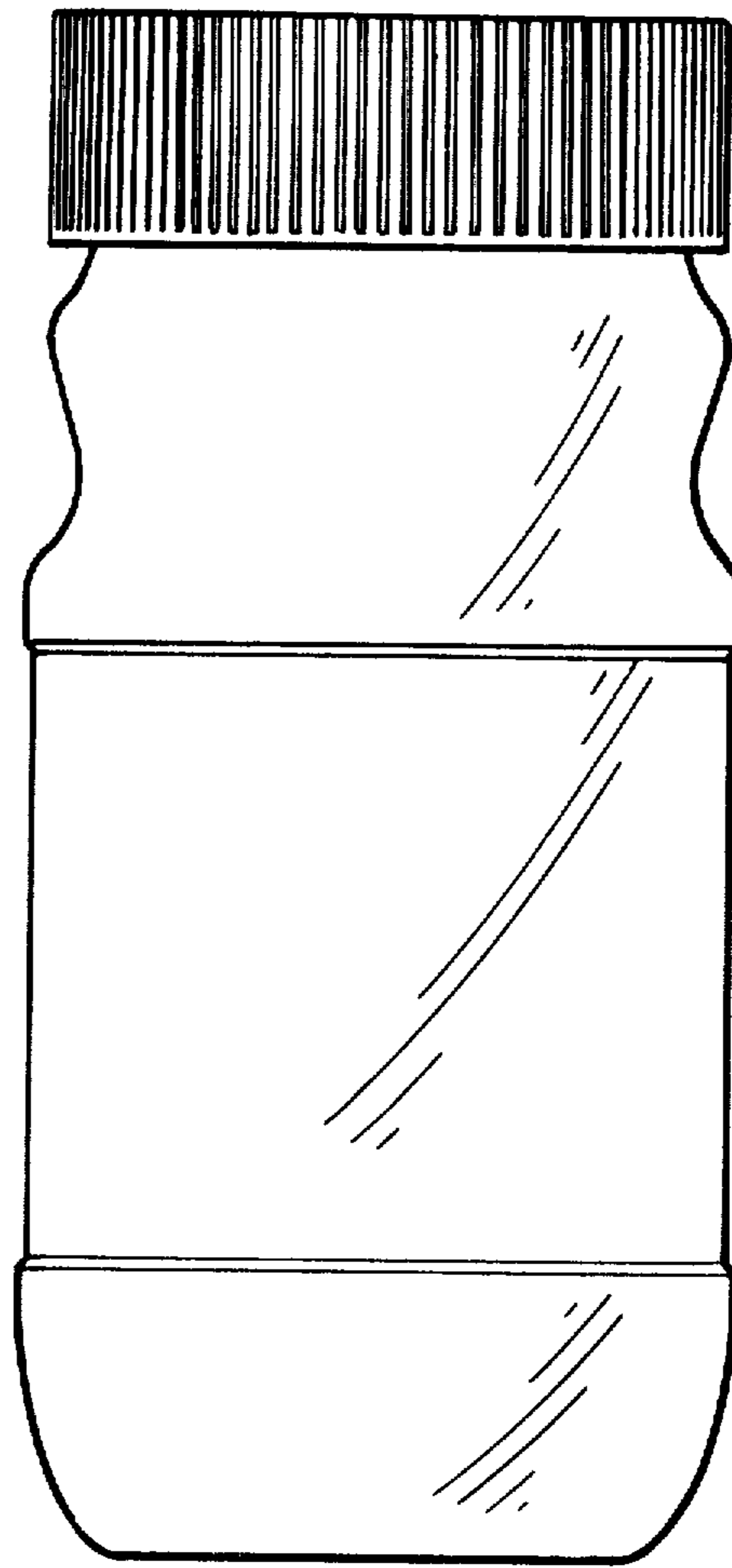

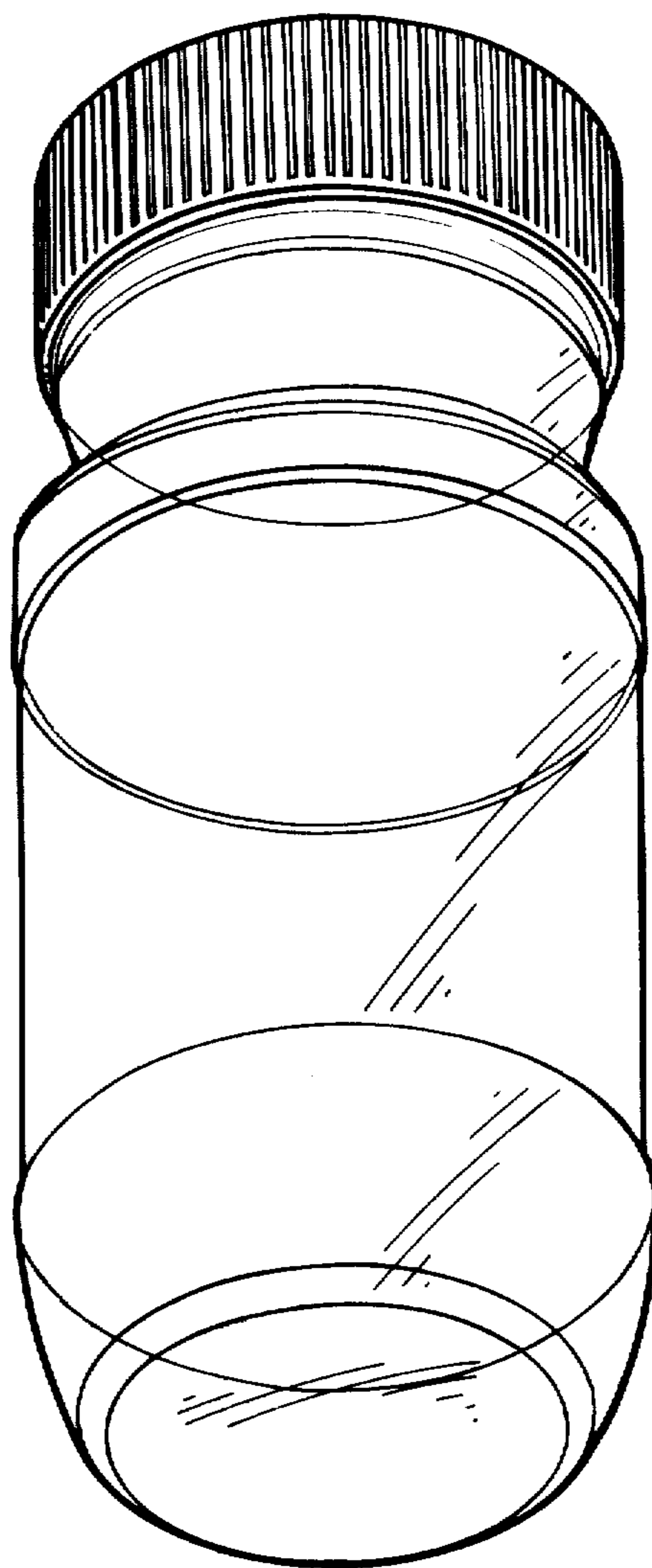
