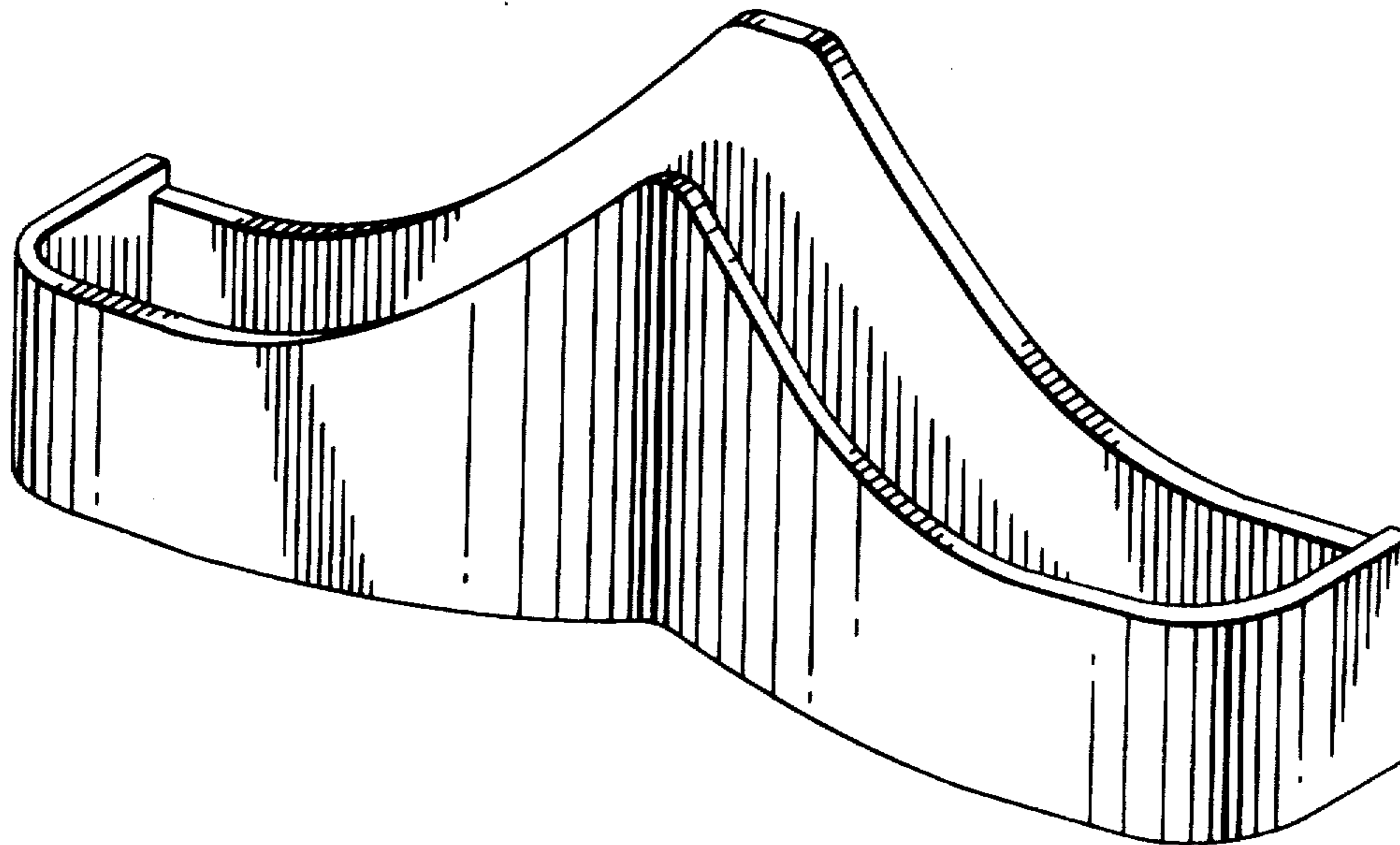
CLAIM

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is an enlarged perspective view of an eyeglass holder showing my new design, the rear being flat and unornamented;

FIG. 3 is an end elevational view thereof.



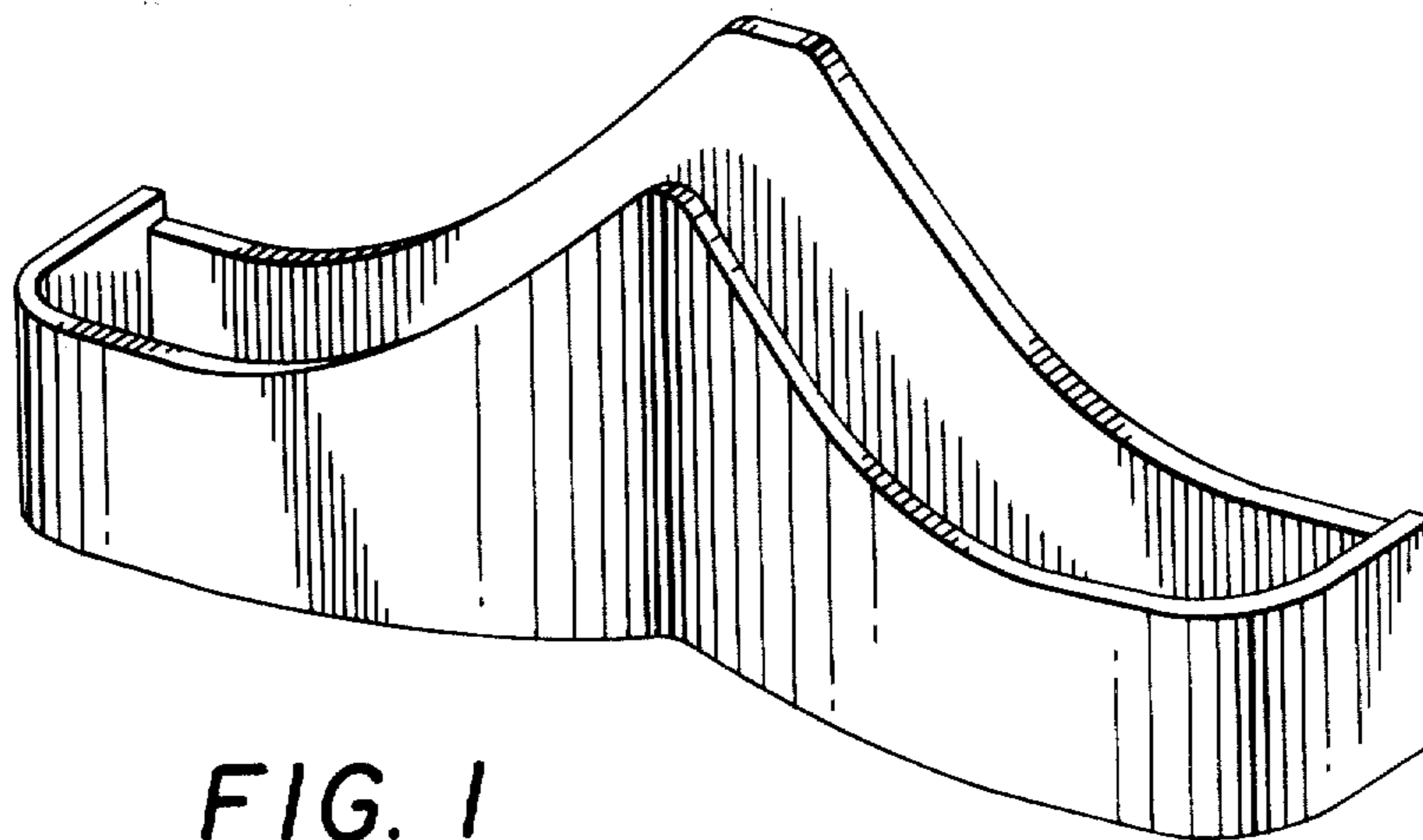

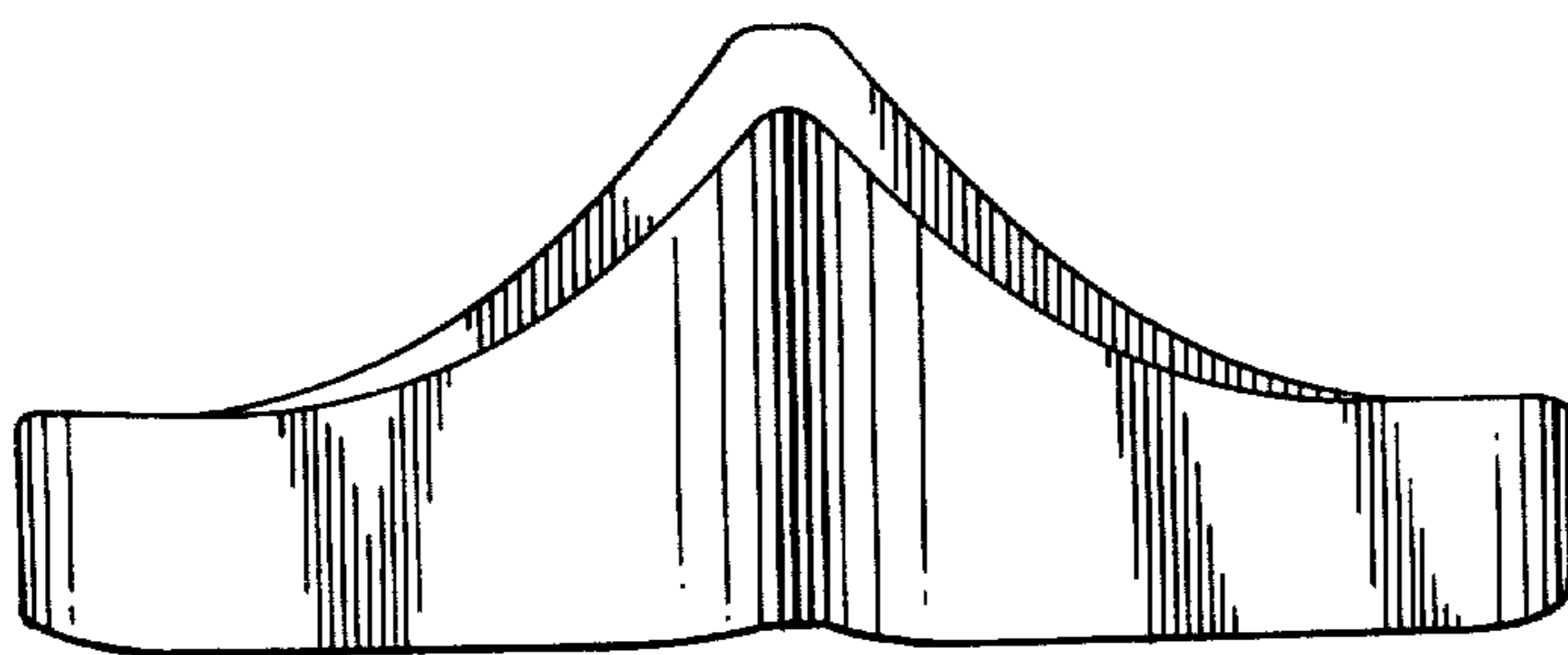

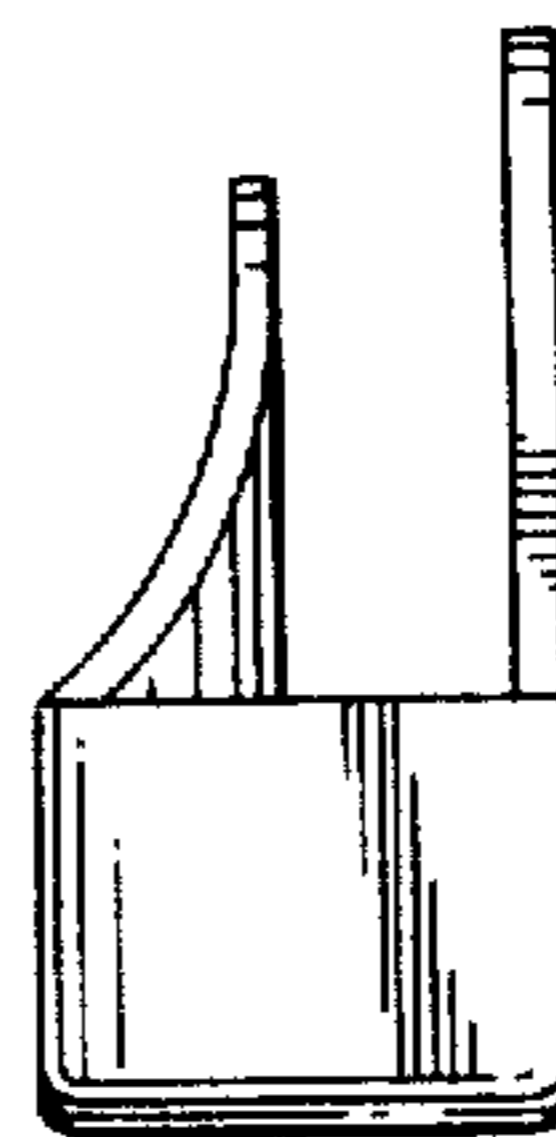
