FIG. 2 is a bottom plan view thereof;

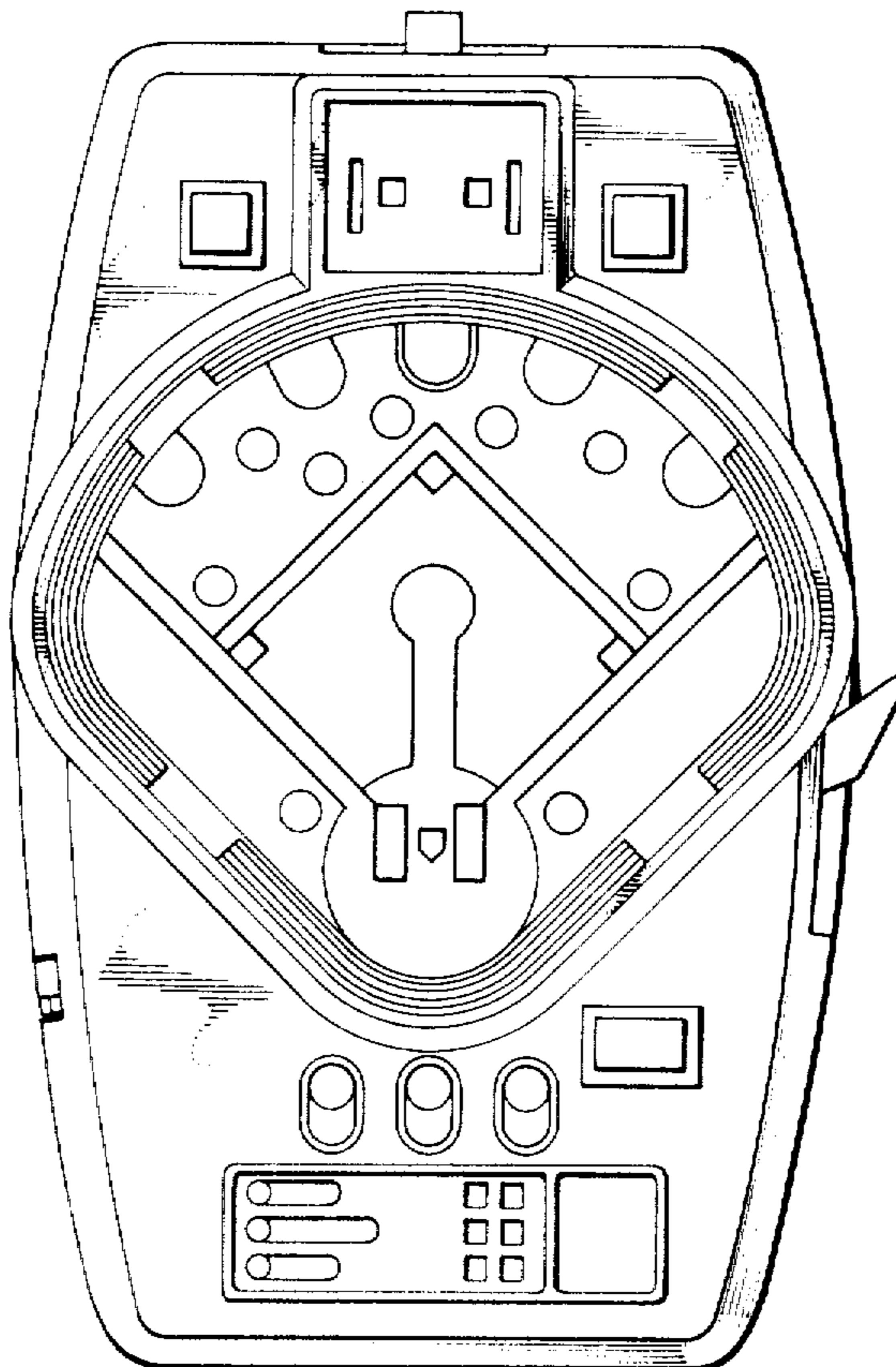
FIG. 3 is a left side elevational view thereof;

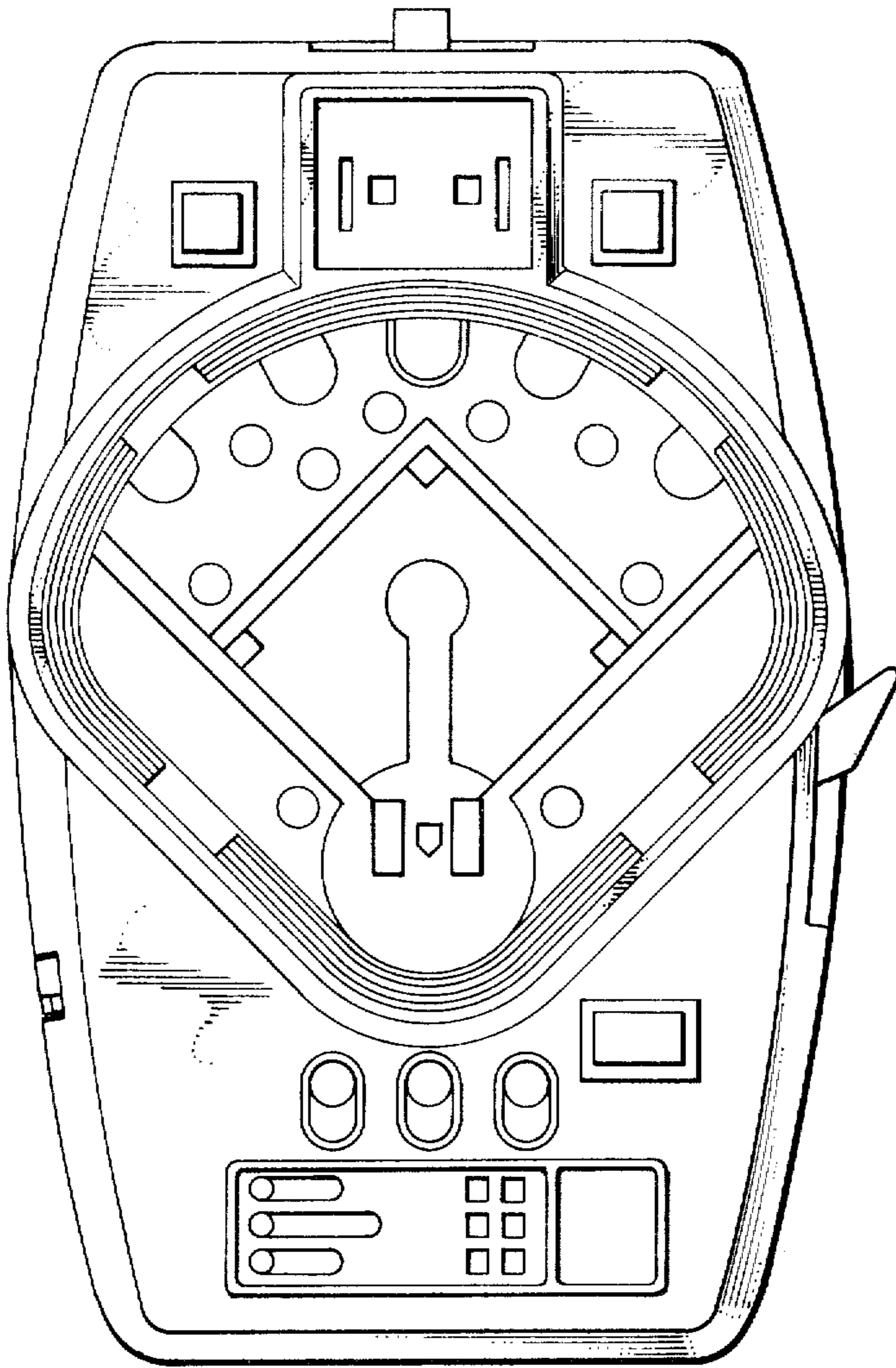

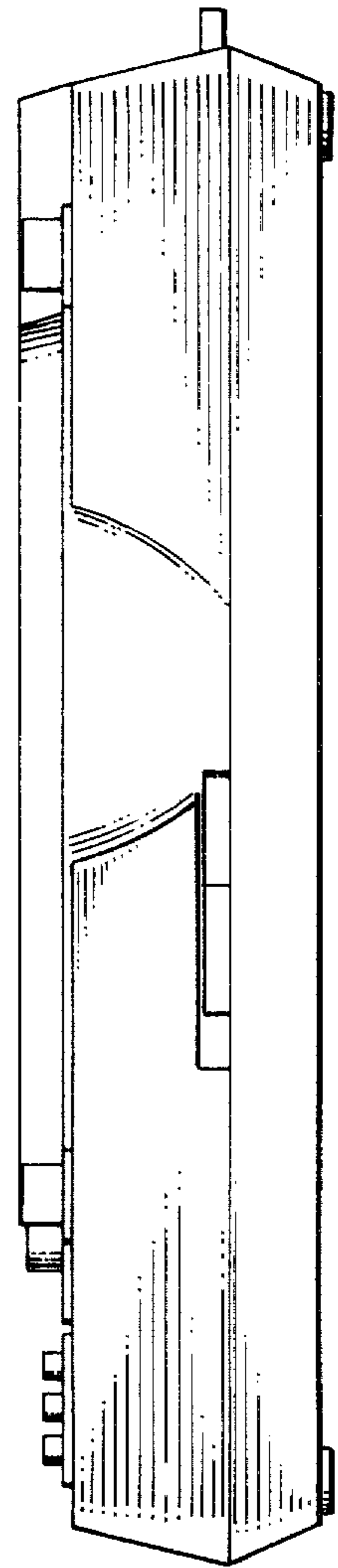

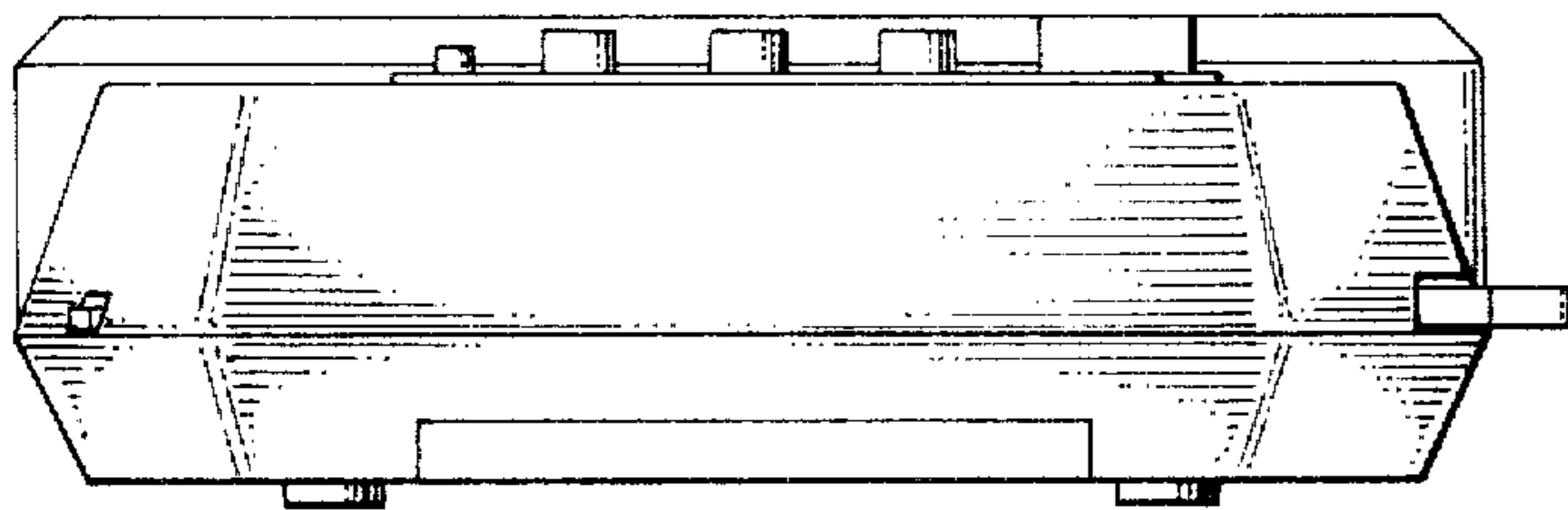

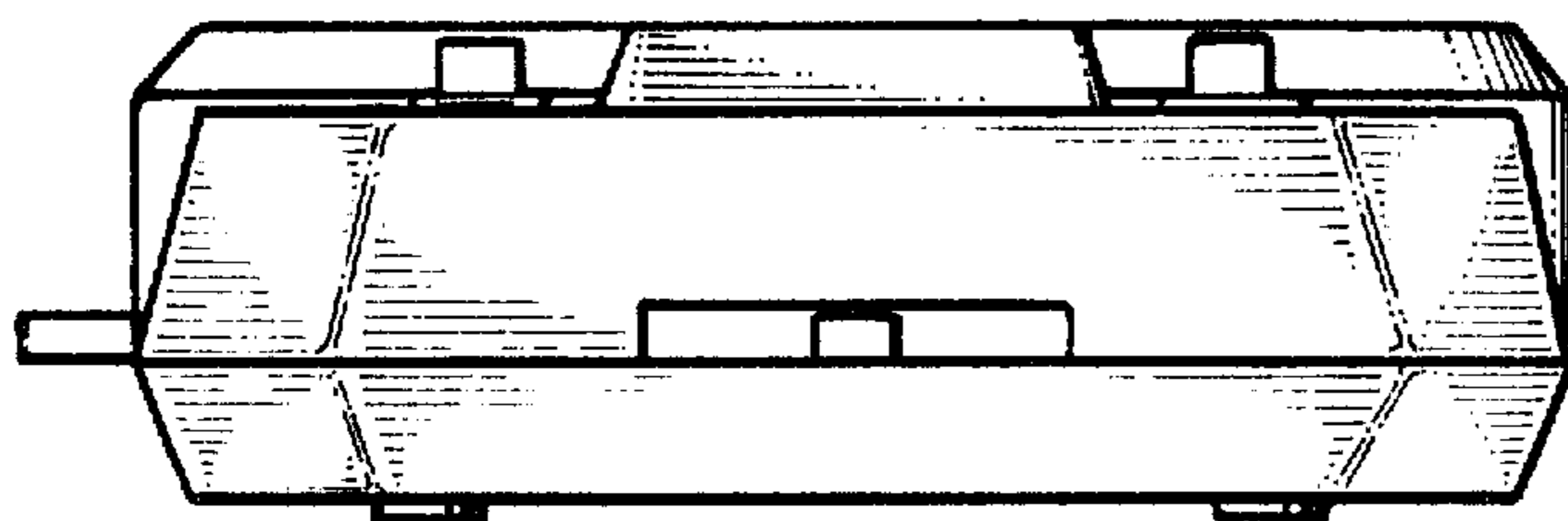

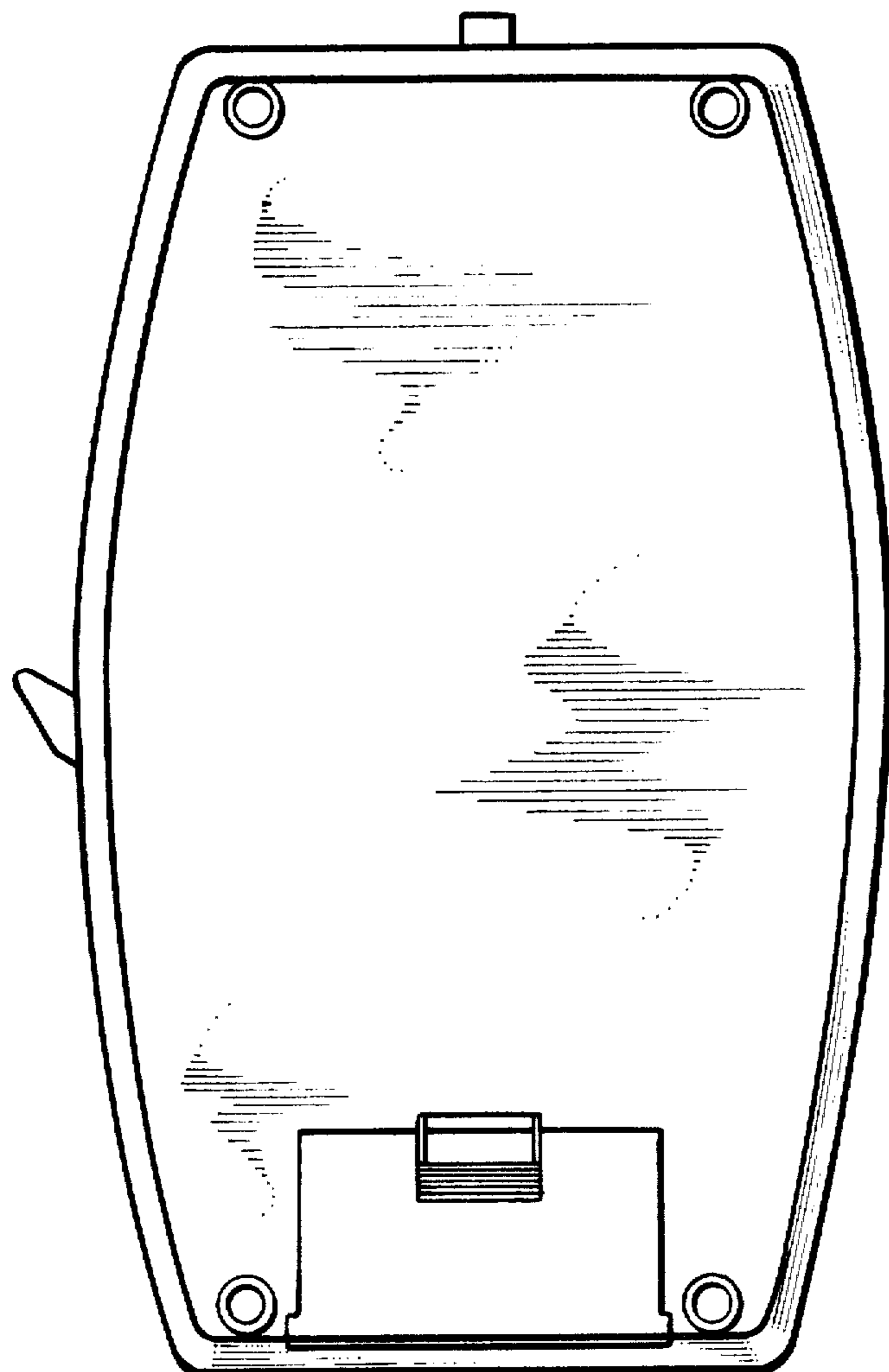
