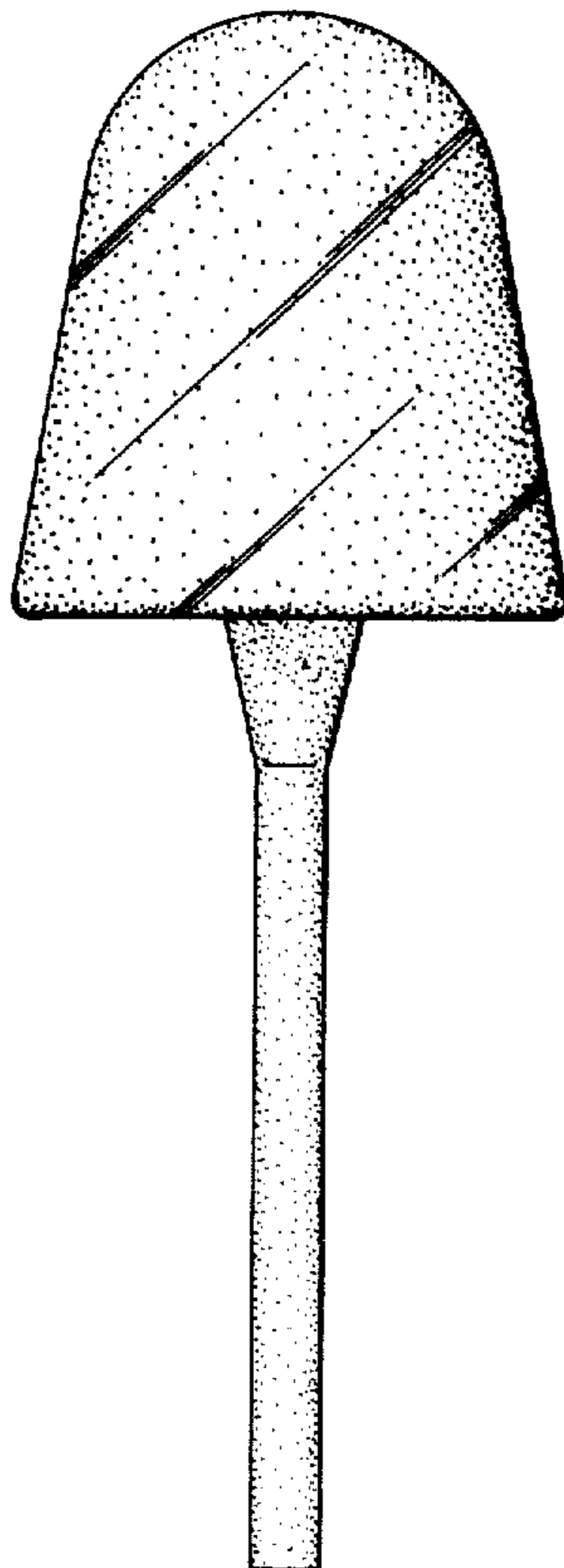

FIG. 3 is a bottom plan view of the lamp of FIG. 1.



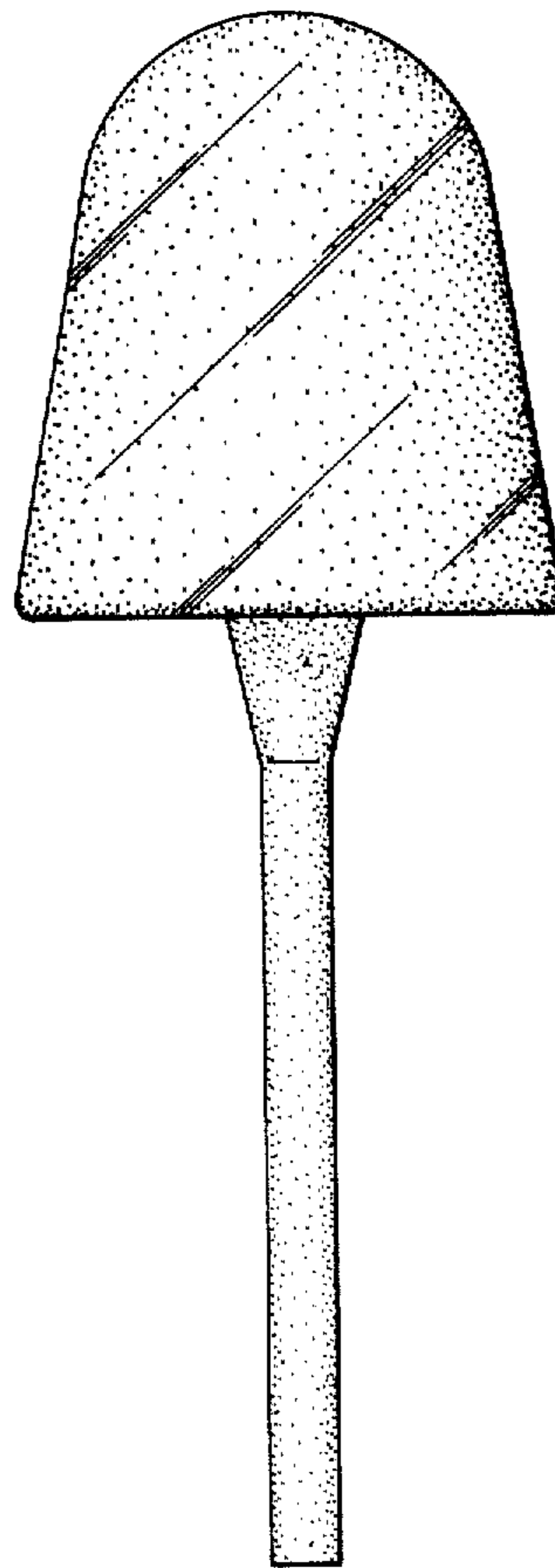

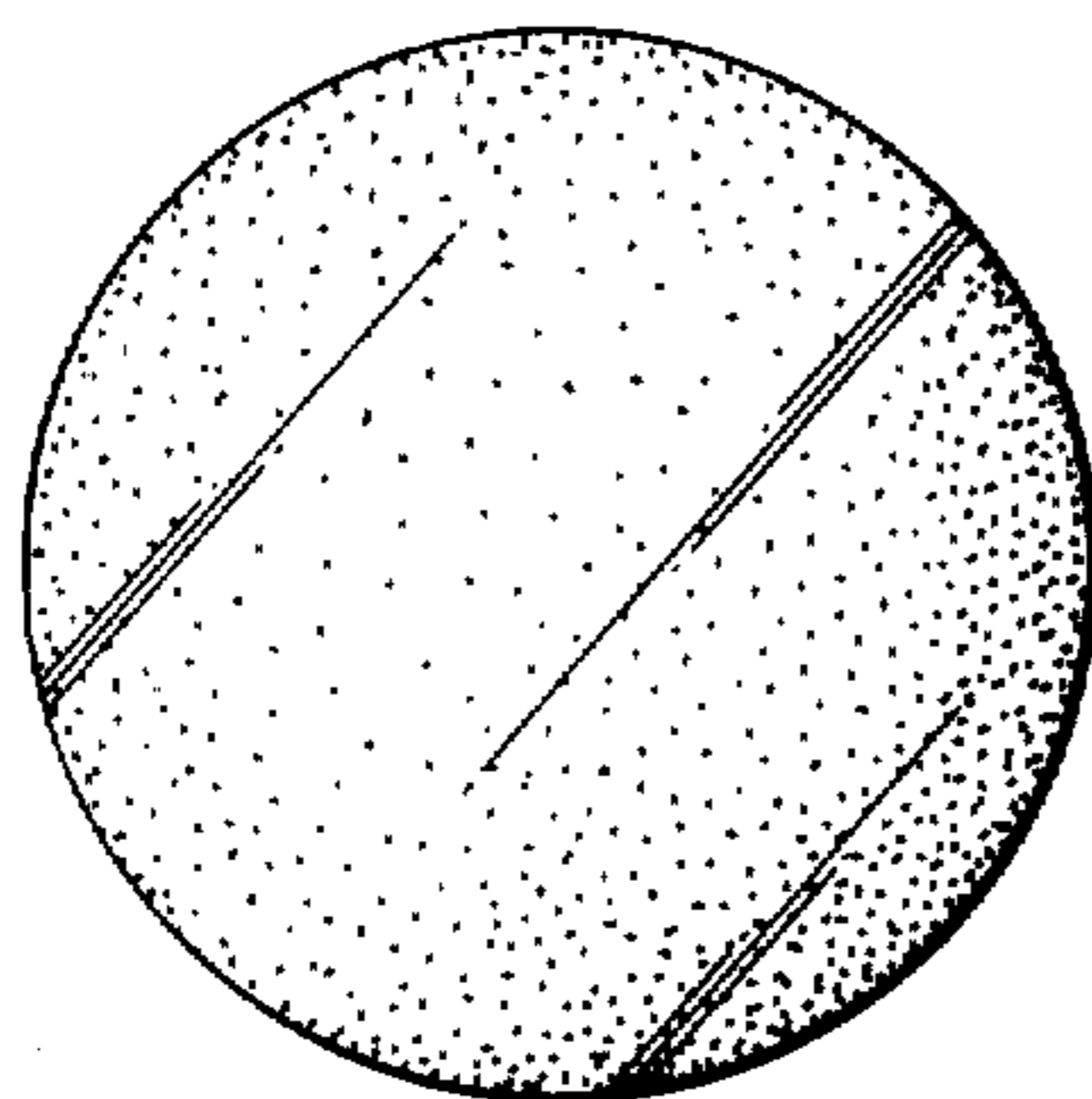

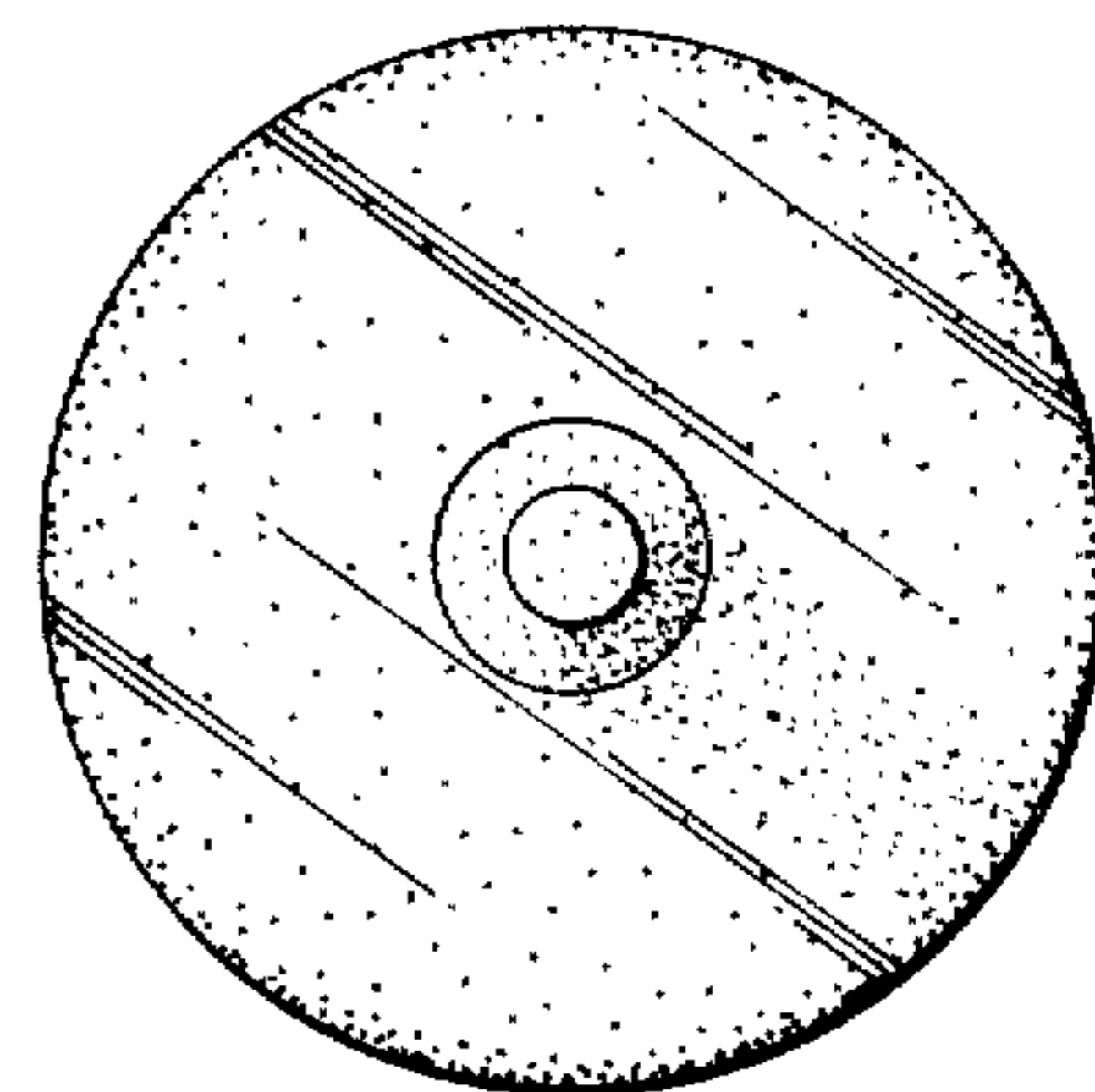
