

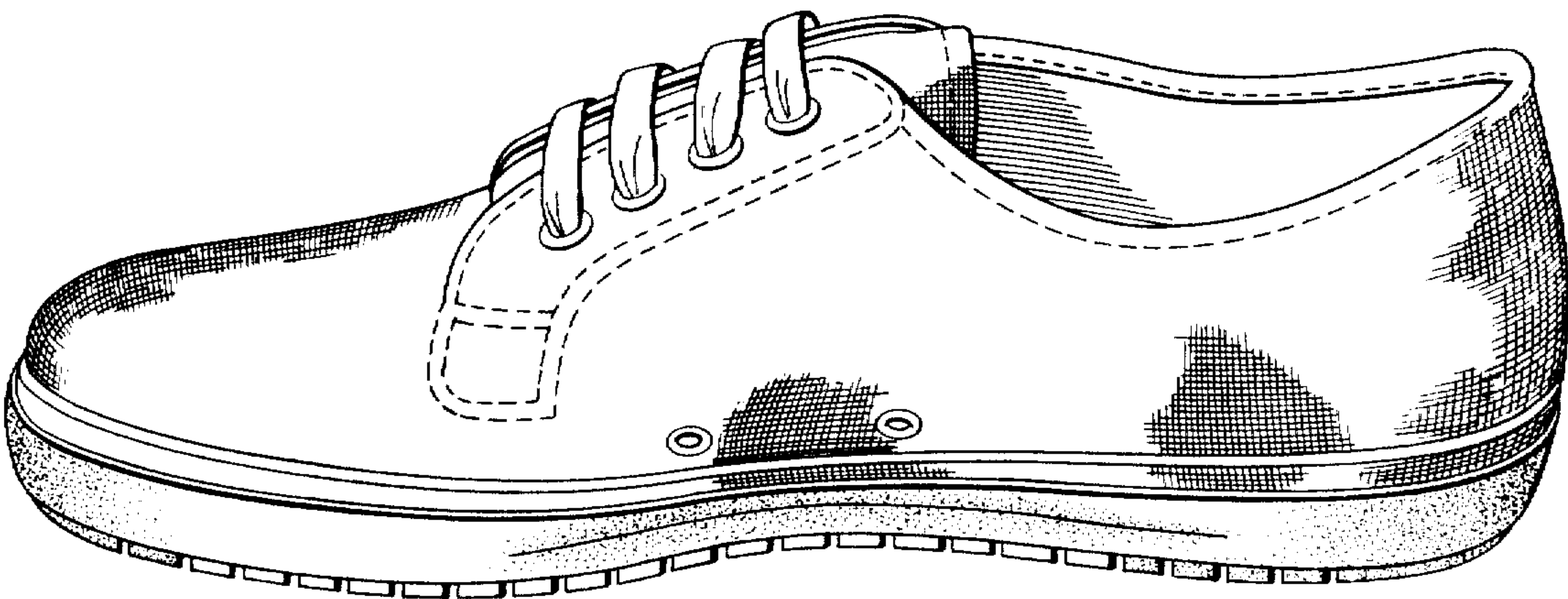

DESCRIPTION
FIG. 1 is a bottom plan view of a shoe showing my new
design, it being understood that the pattern is continu-
ous over the entire surface thereof;
FIG. 2 is a top and side perspective view thereof, the
opposite side, not shown, being substantially a mirror
image thereof.



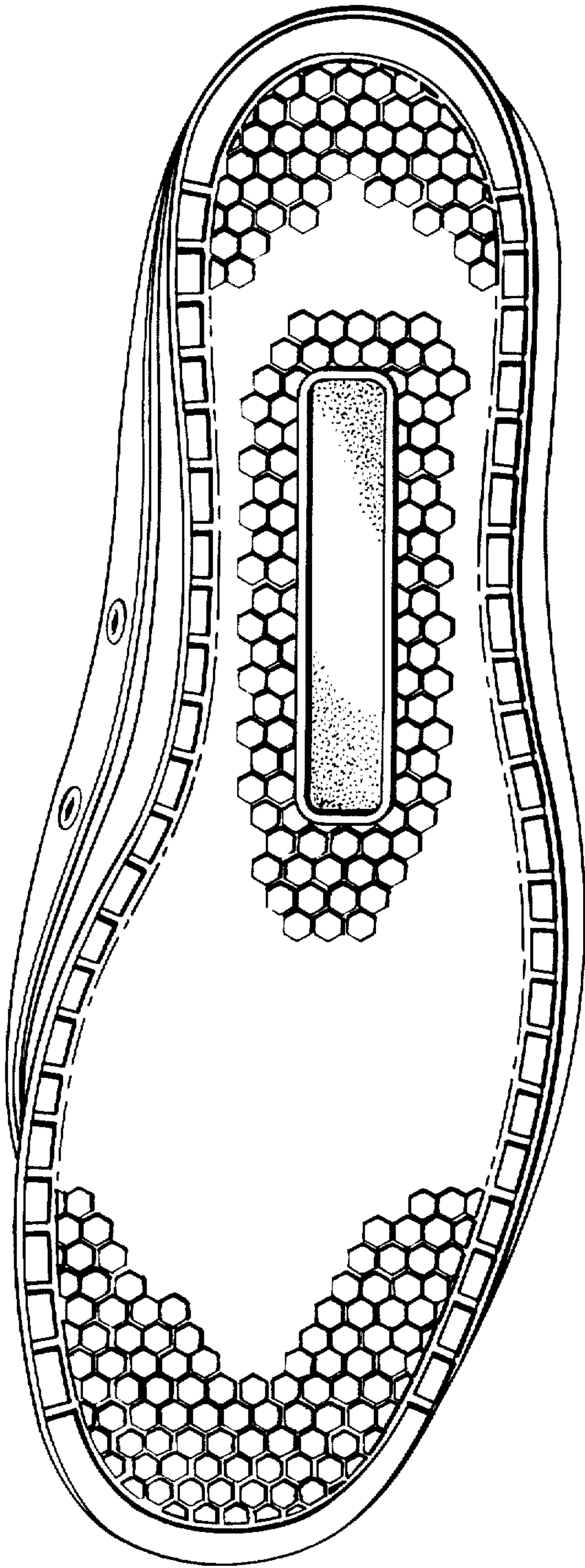

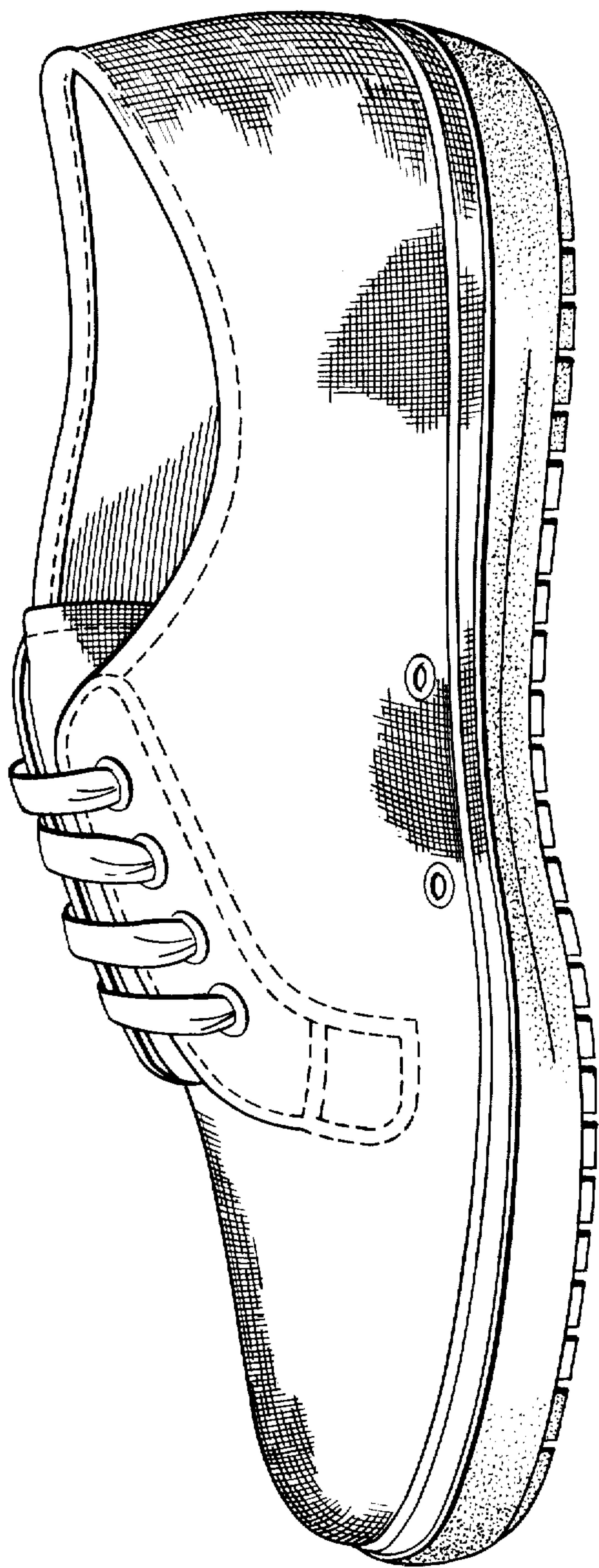
