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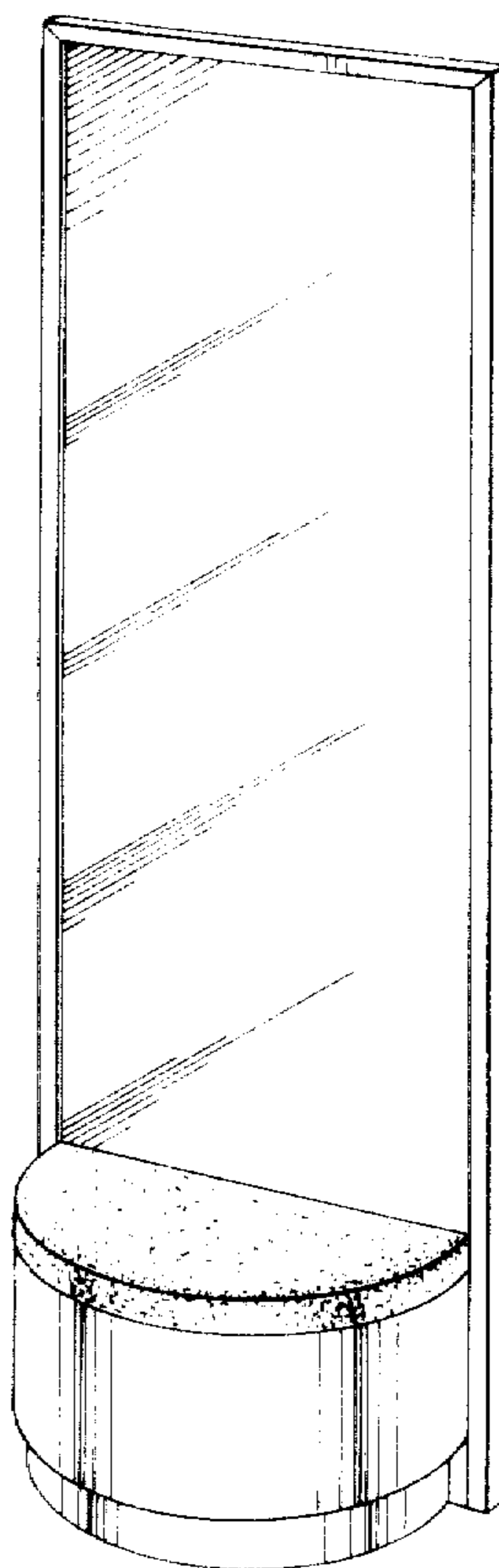

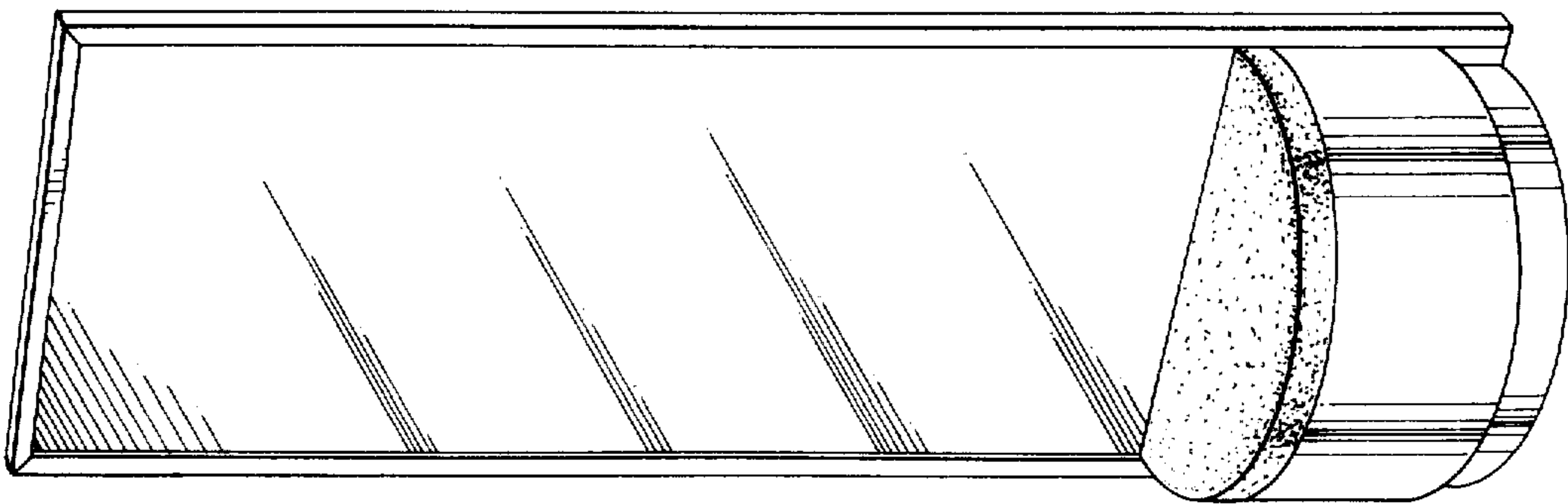
The ornamental design for a combined seat and mirror, as shown and described.

**DESCRIPTION**

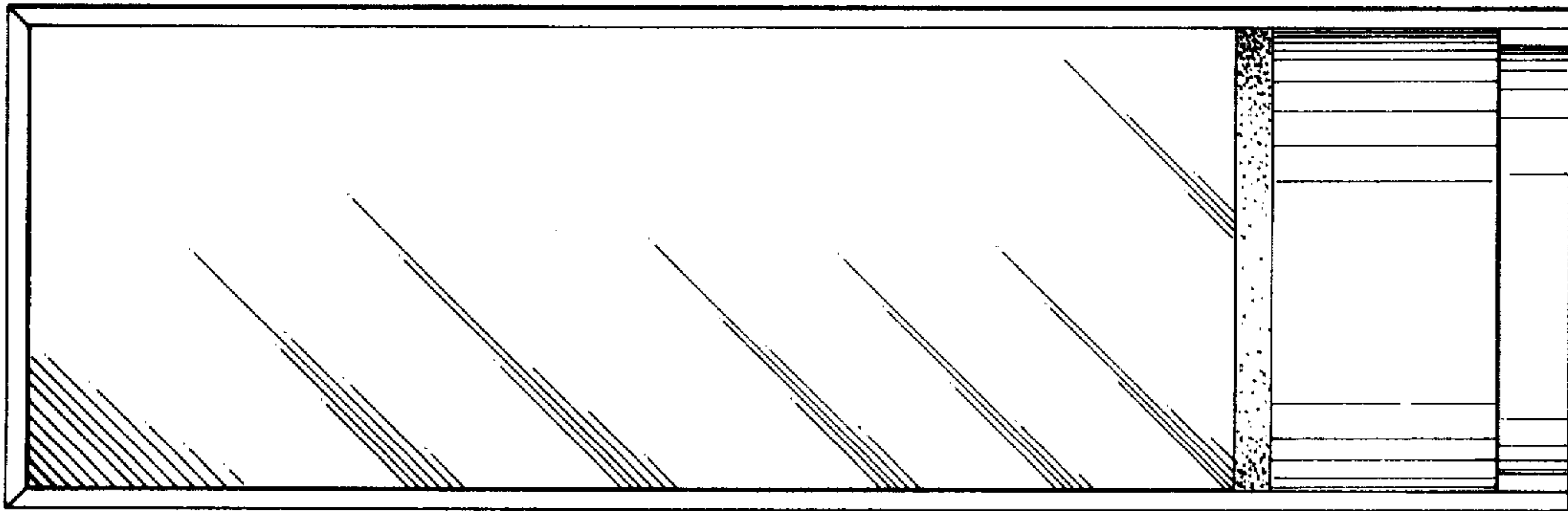
FIG. 1 is a perspective view of the combined seat and mirror according to the present invention; FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof; FIG. 3 is an elevational view of one side of the combined seat and mirror, the other side being substantially identical thereto; and FIG. 4 is a top plan view thereof. The rear surface of the combined seat and mirror is conventionally flat and unadorned.



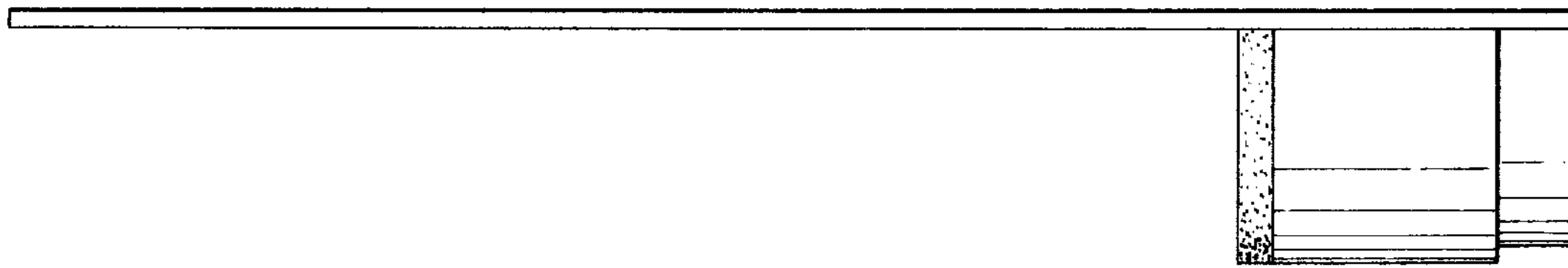
