DESCRIPTION

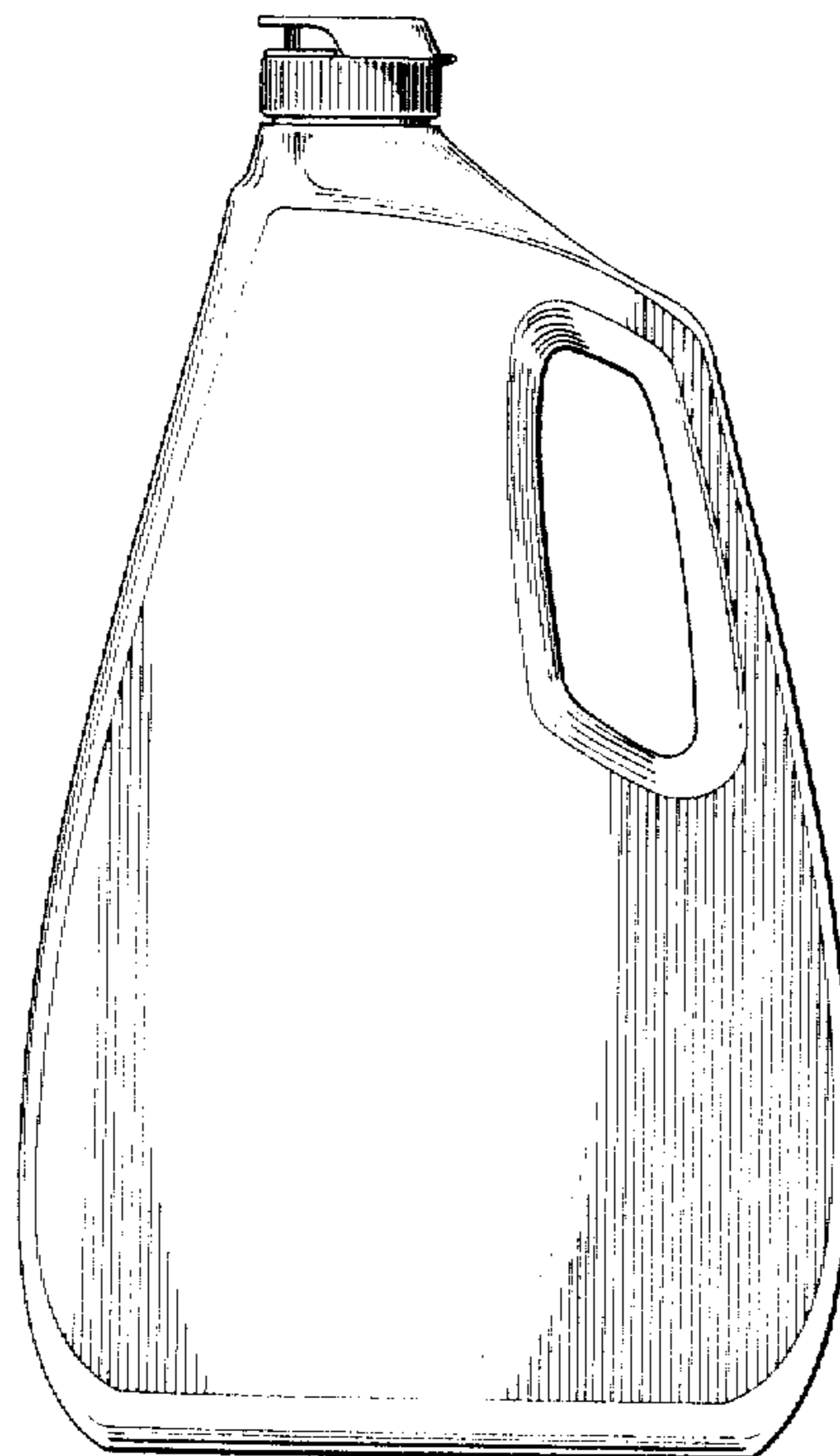
FIG. 1 is an elevational view of a combined bottle and closure embodying our new design.

FIG. 2 is a top plan view of the bottle and closure shown in FIG. 1.

FIG. 3 is an elevational view of the combined bottle and closure seen from the right of FIG. 1.

FIG. 4 is an elevational view of the combined bottle and closure as seen from the left of FIG. 1.

FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view thereof.



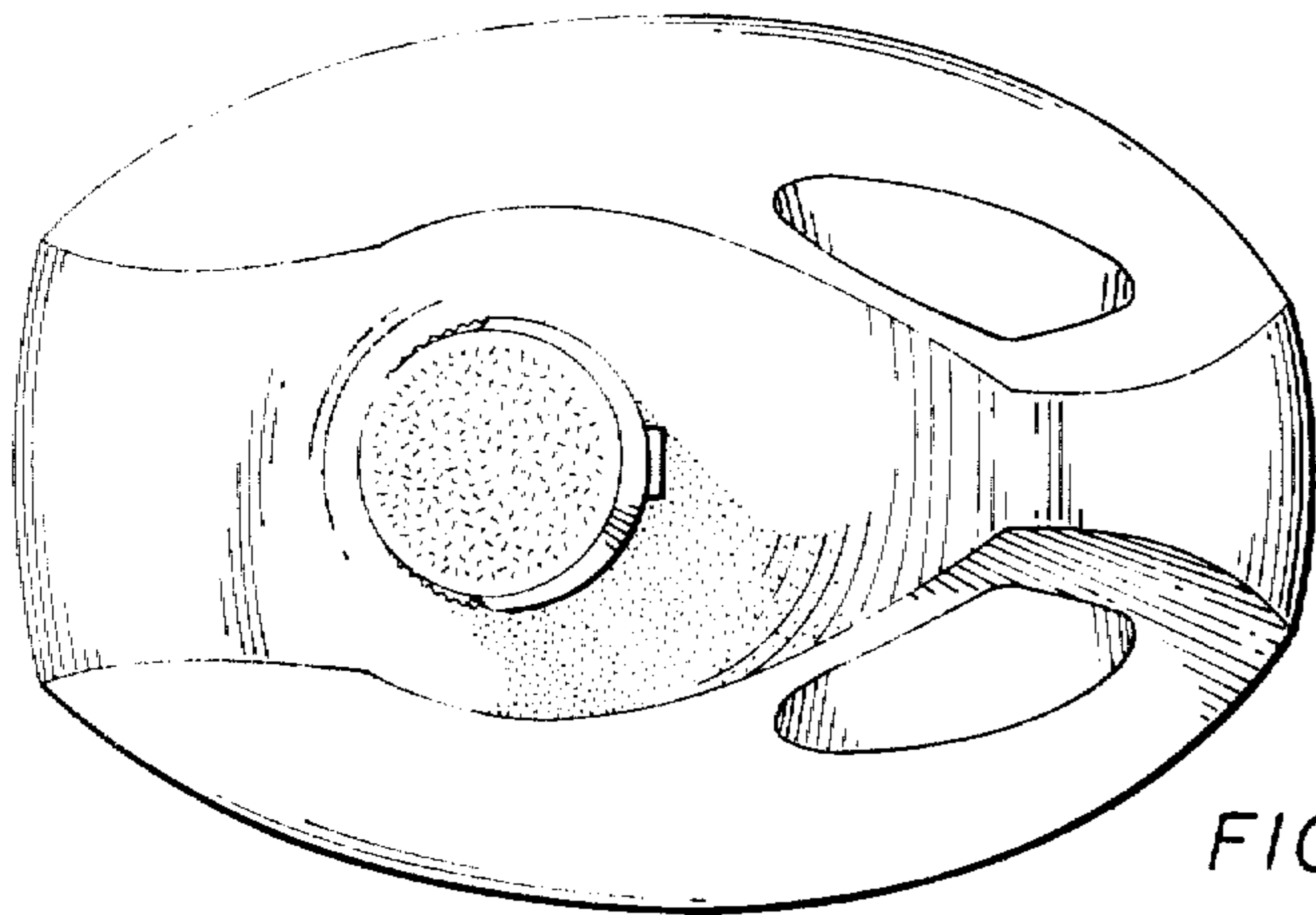

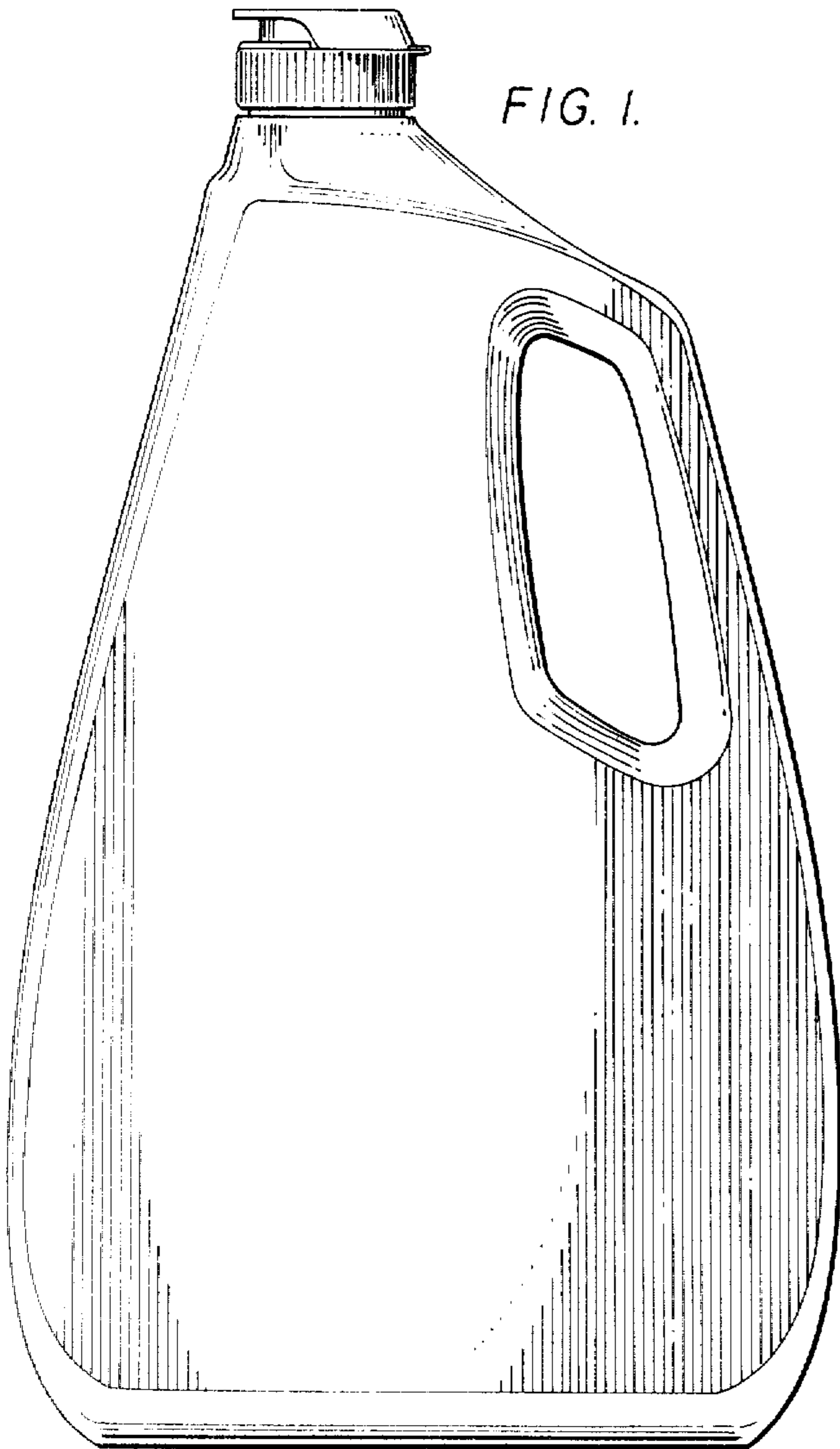

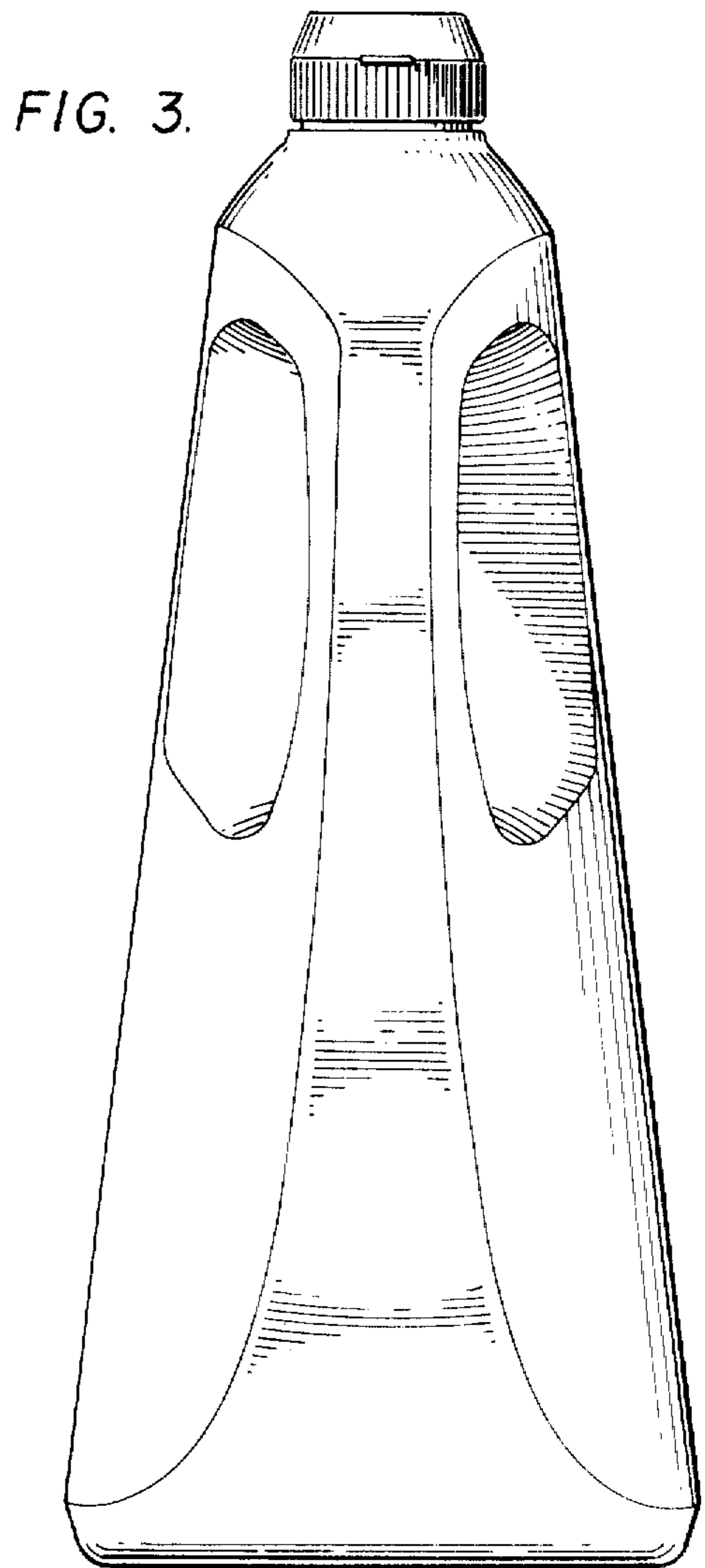

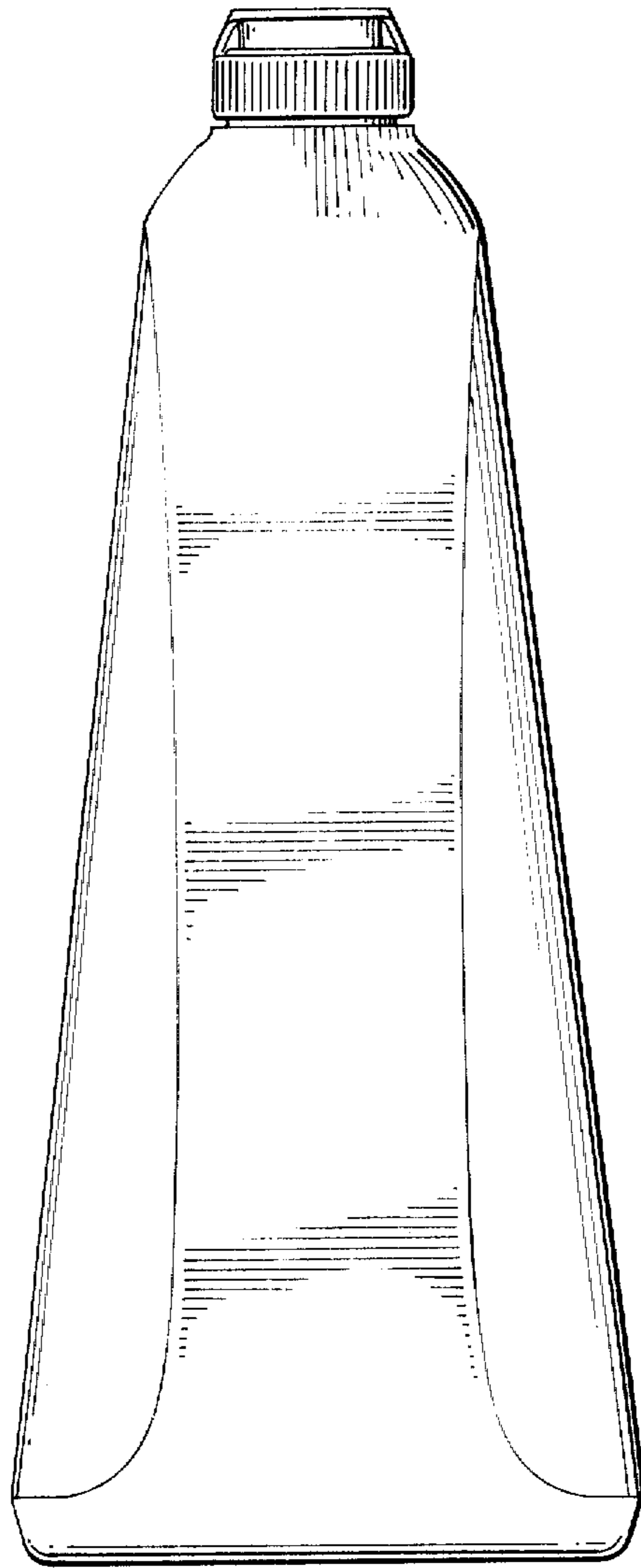
