DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a simulative clock showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a right side elevational view thereof;

FIG. 7 is a front elevational view of another embodiment of my new design of FIGS. 1-6, all other views being substantially similar thereto.

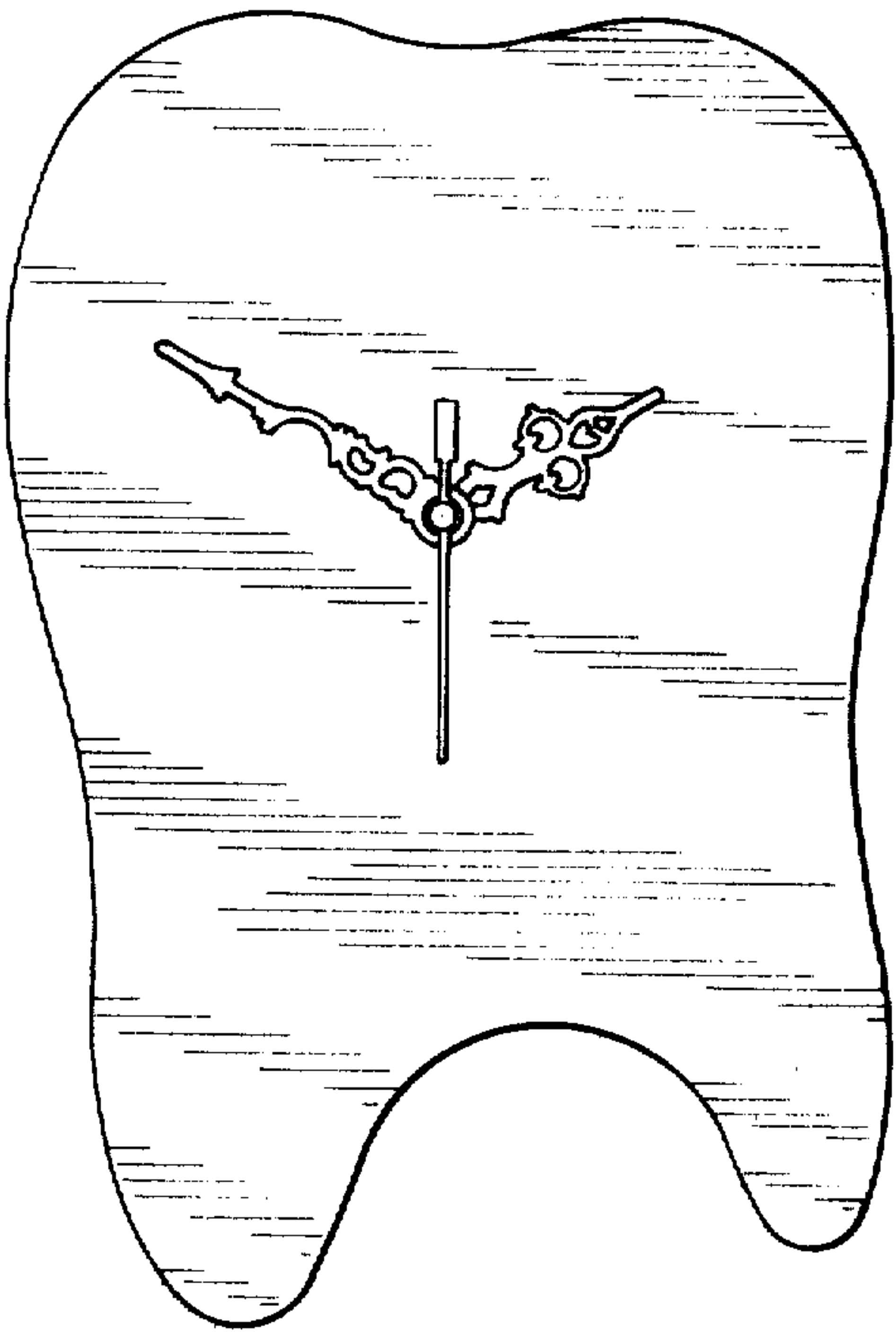

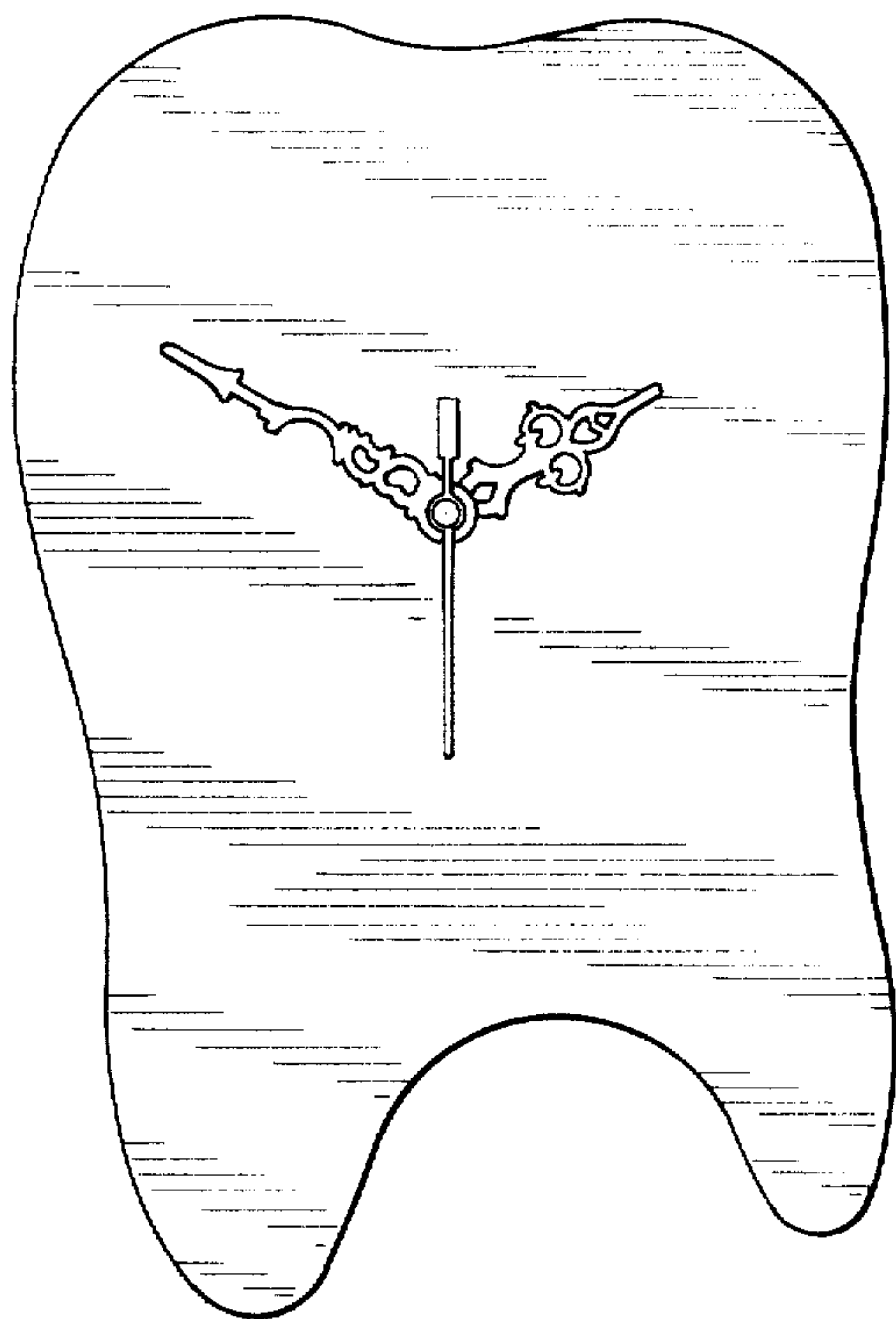

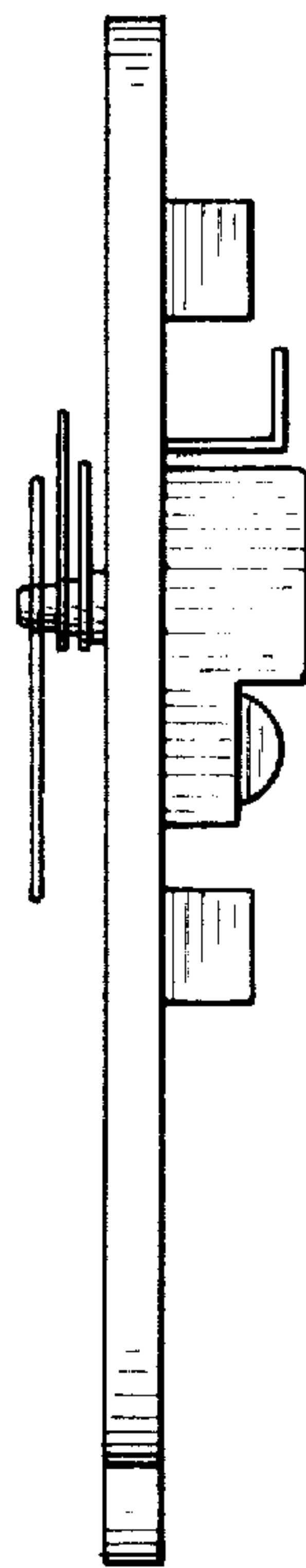

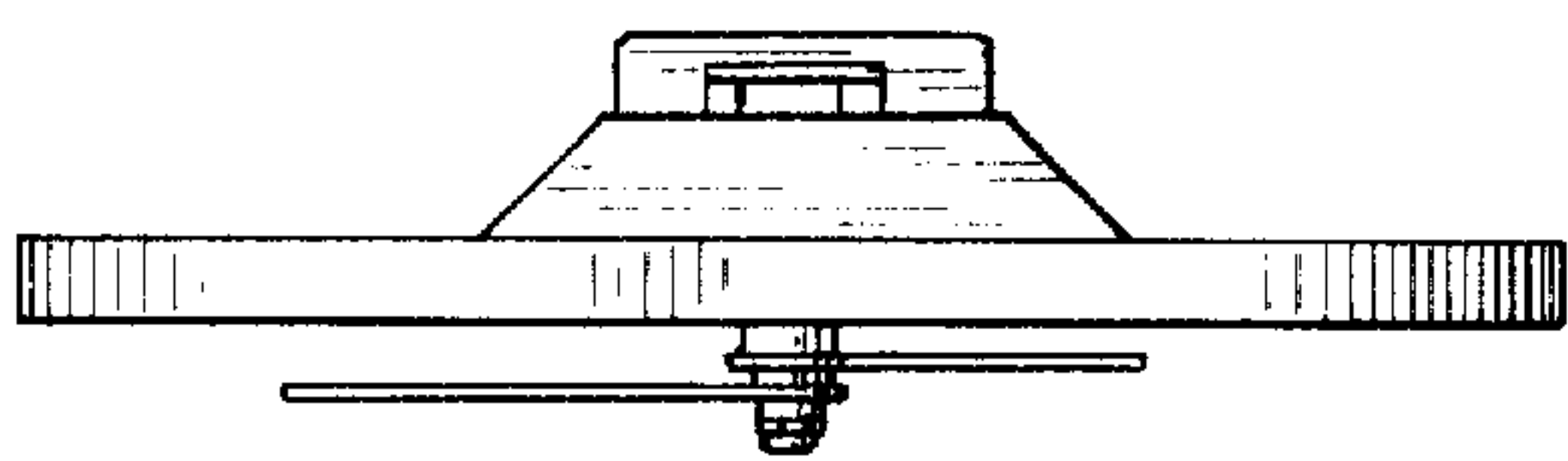

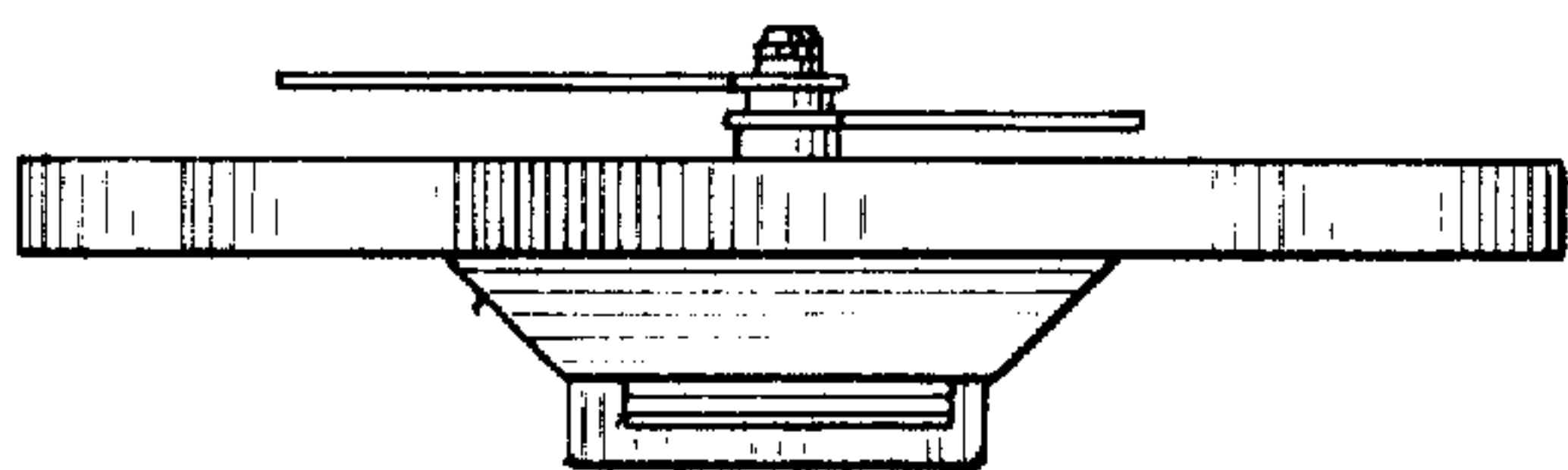

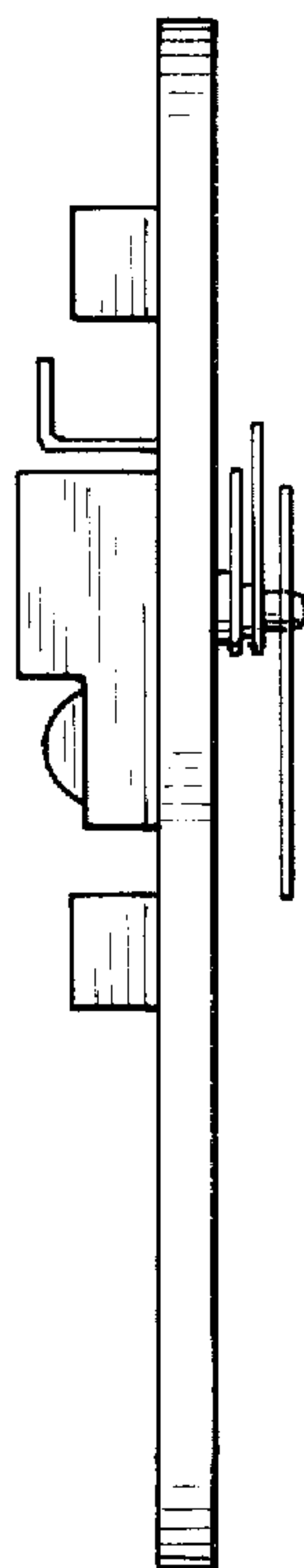

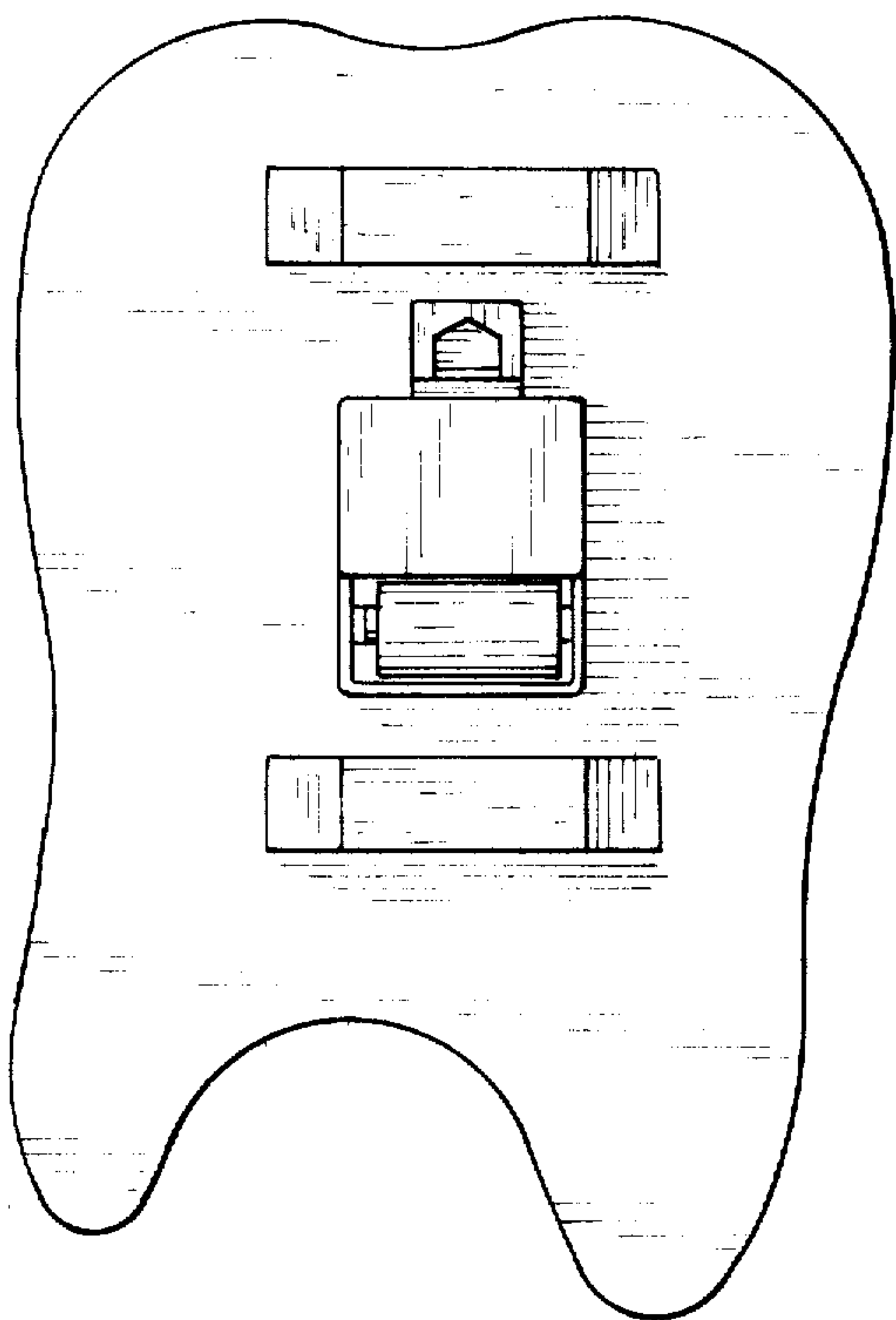
