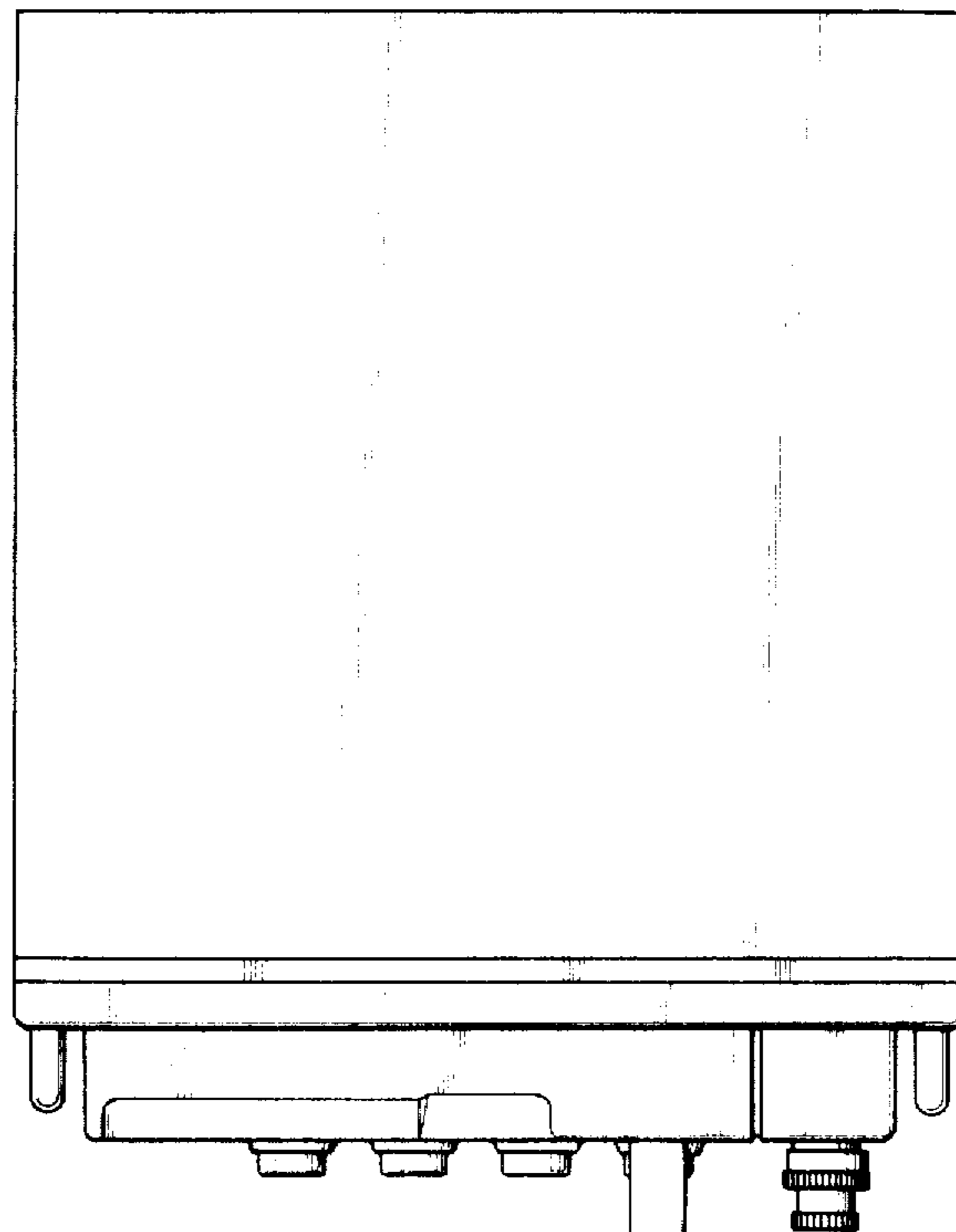
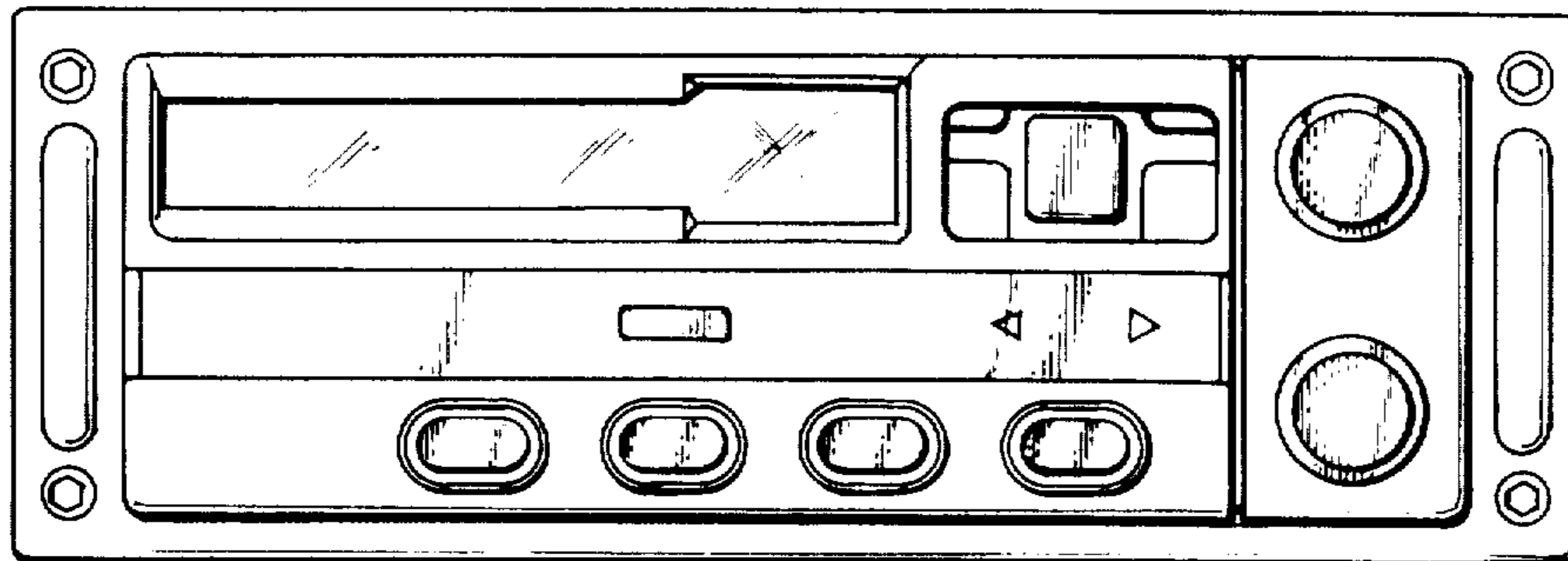

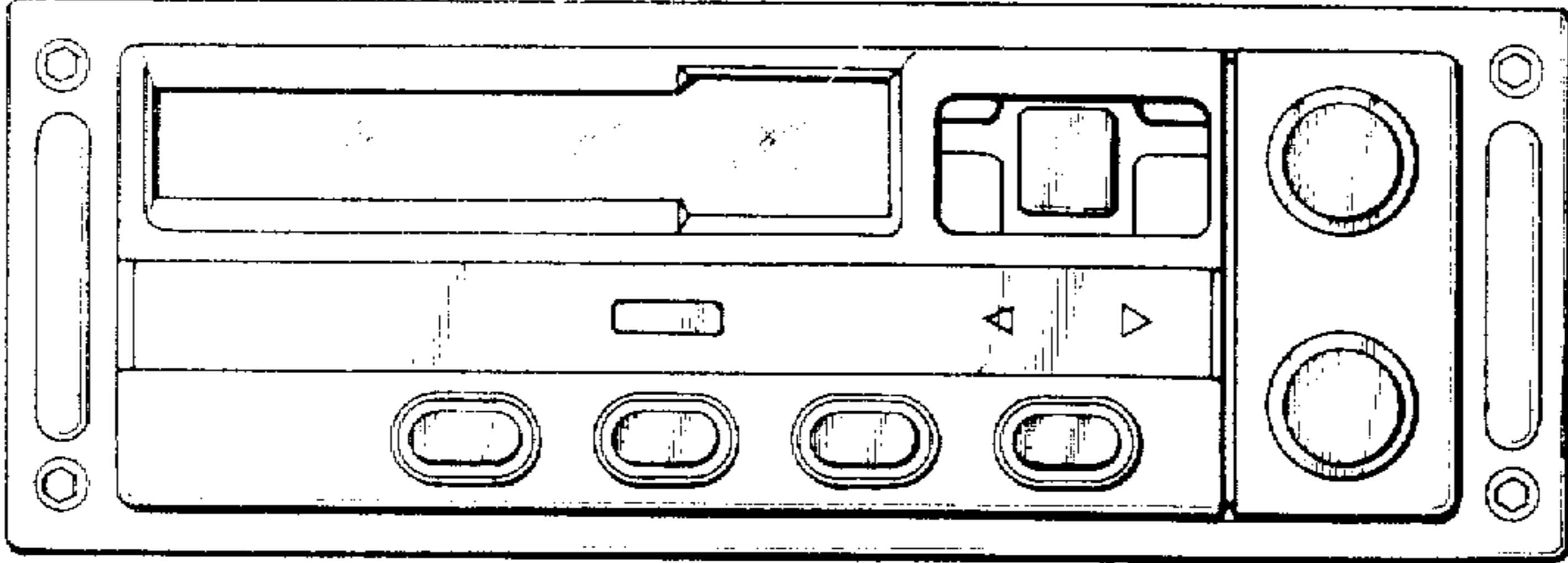
The ornamental design for an automobile cassette player, substantially as shown.

DESCRIPTION

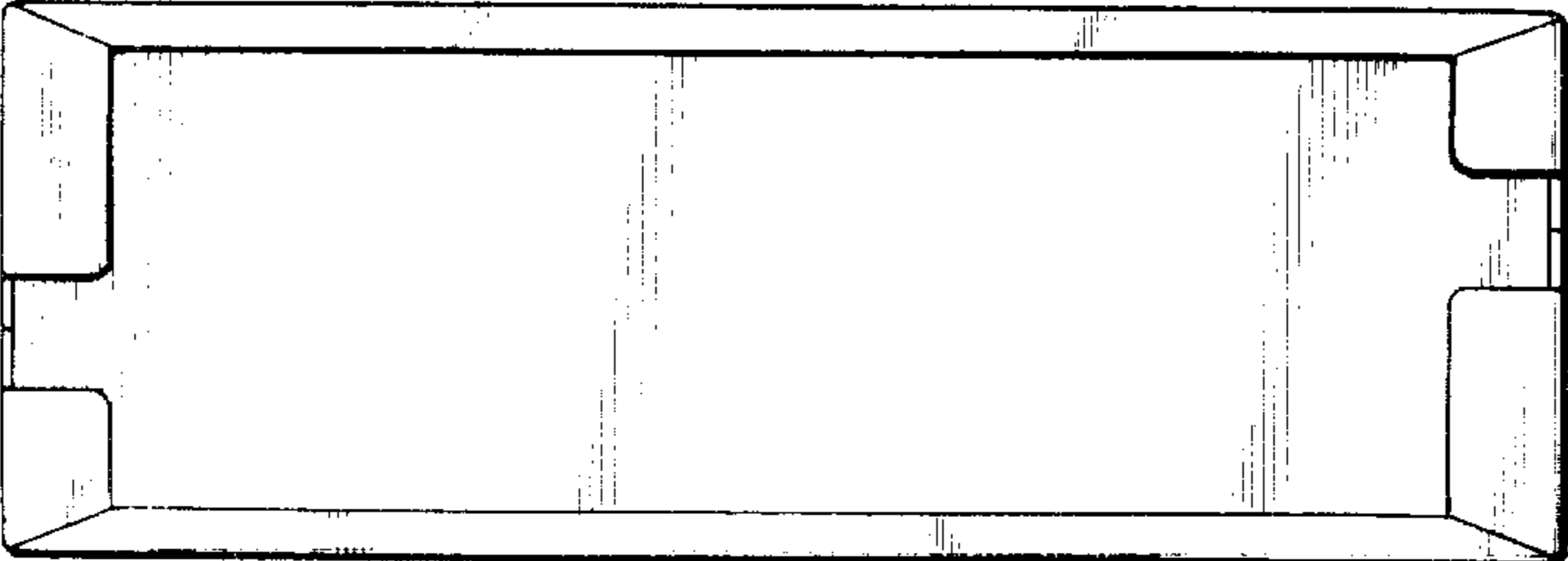

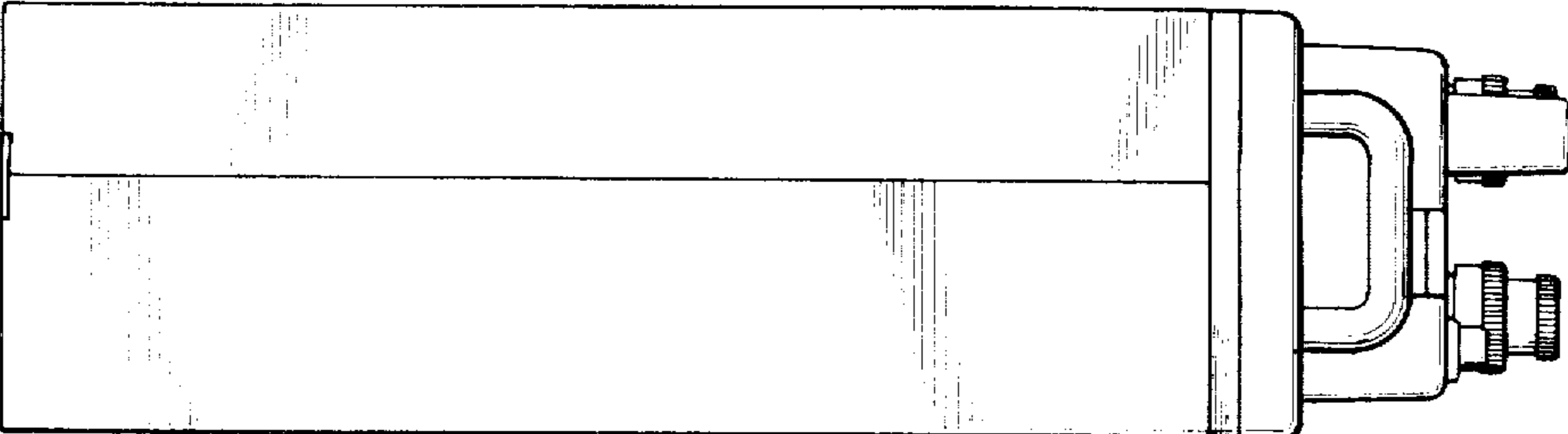

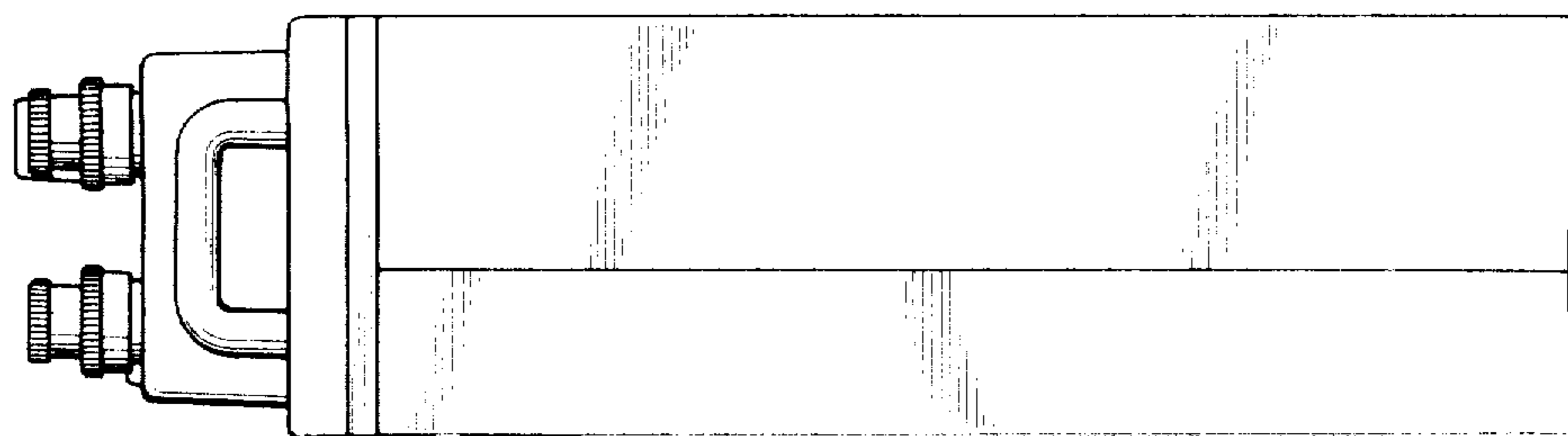

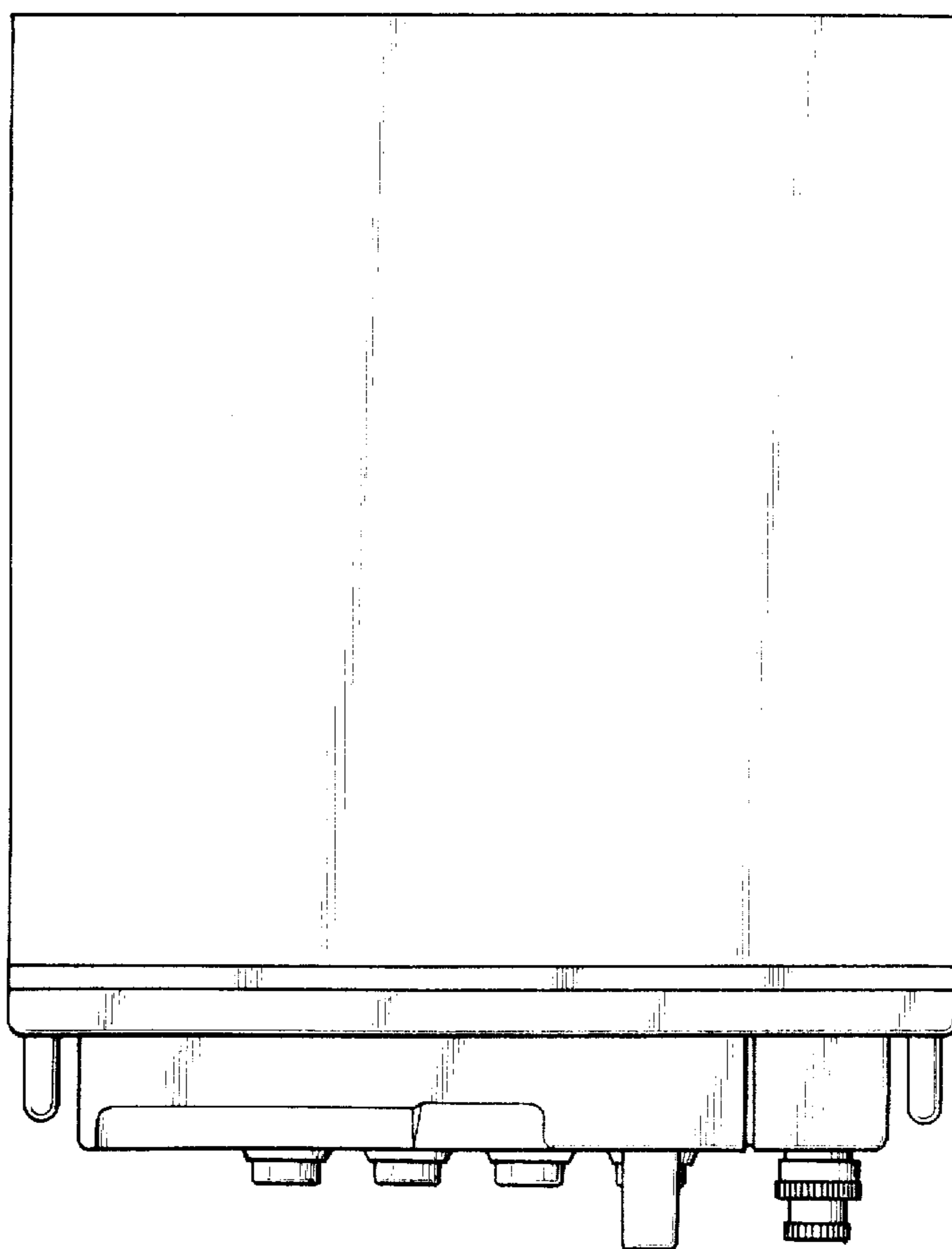
