The ornamental design for a combined light and ball game housing, substantially as shown and described.


DESCRIPTION


FIG. 1 is a left side elevational view of the combined light and ball game housing, the right side elevation being the same;


FIG. 2 is a frontal elevational view of the combined light and ball game housing;
