FIG. 1 is a top plan view of an electronic hand-held baseball game housing or the like showing my new design;

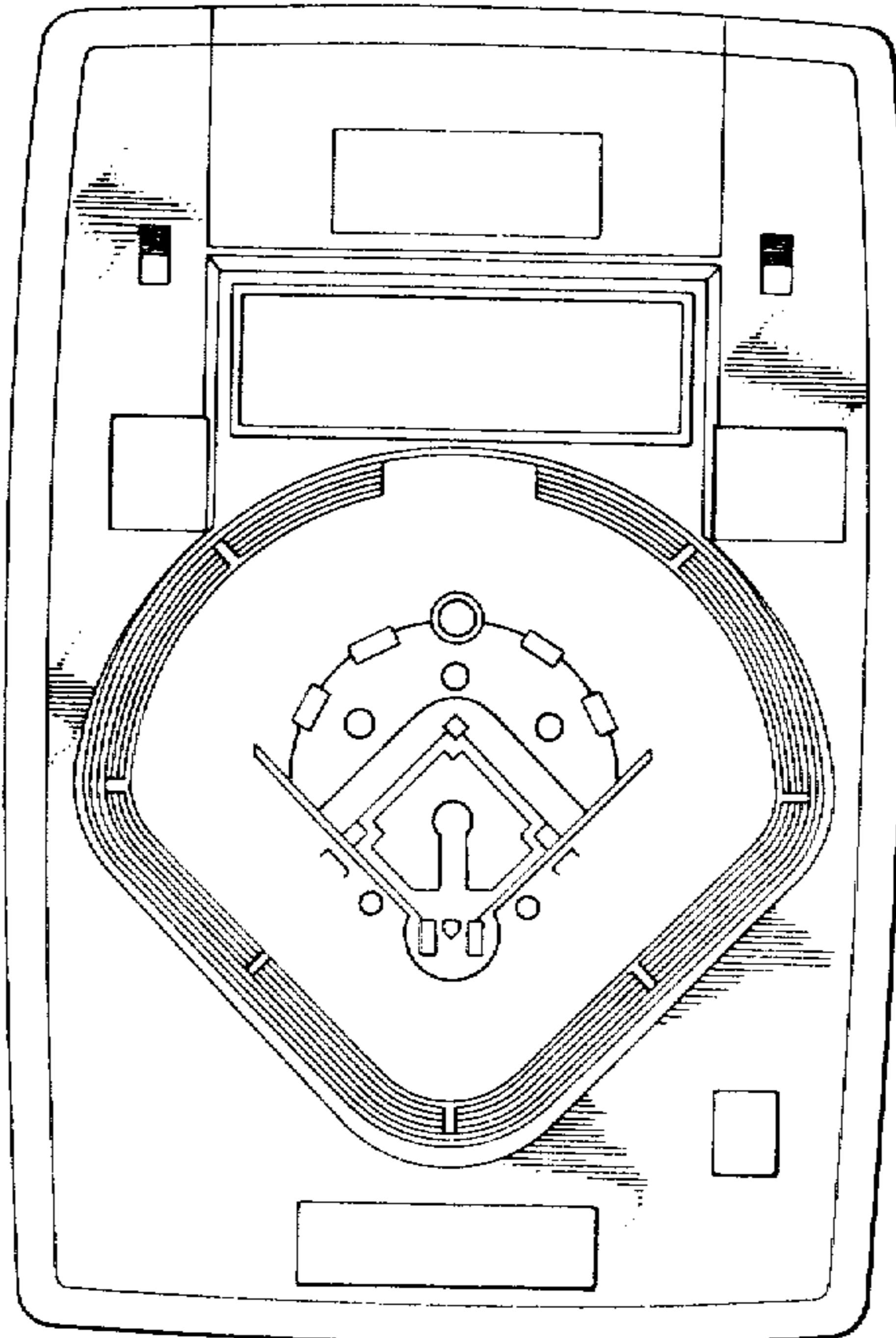
FIG. 2 is a bottom plan view thereof;

FIG. 6 is a rear edge view thereof.



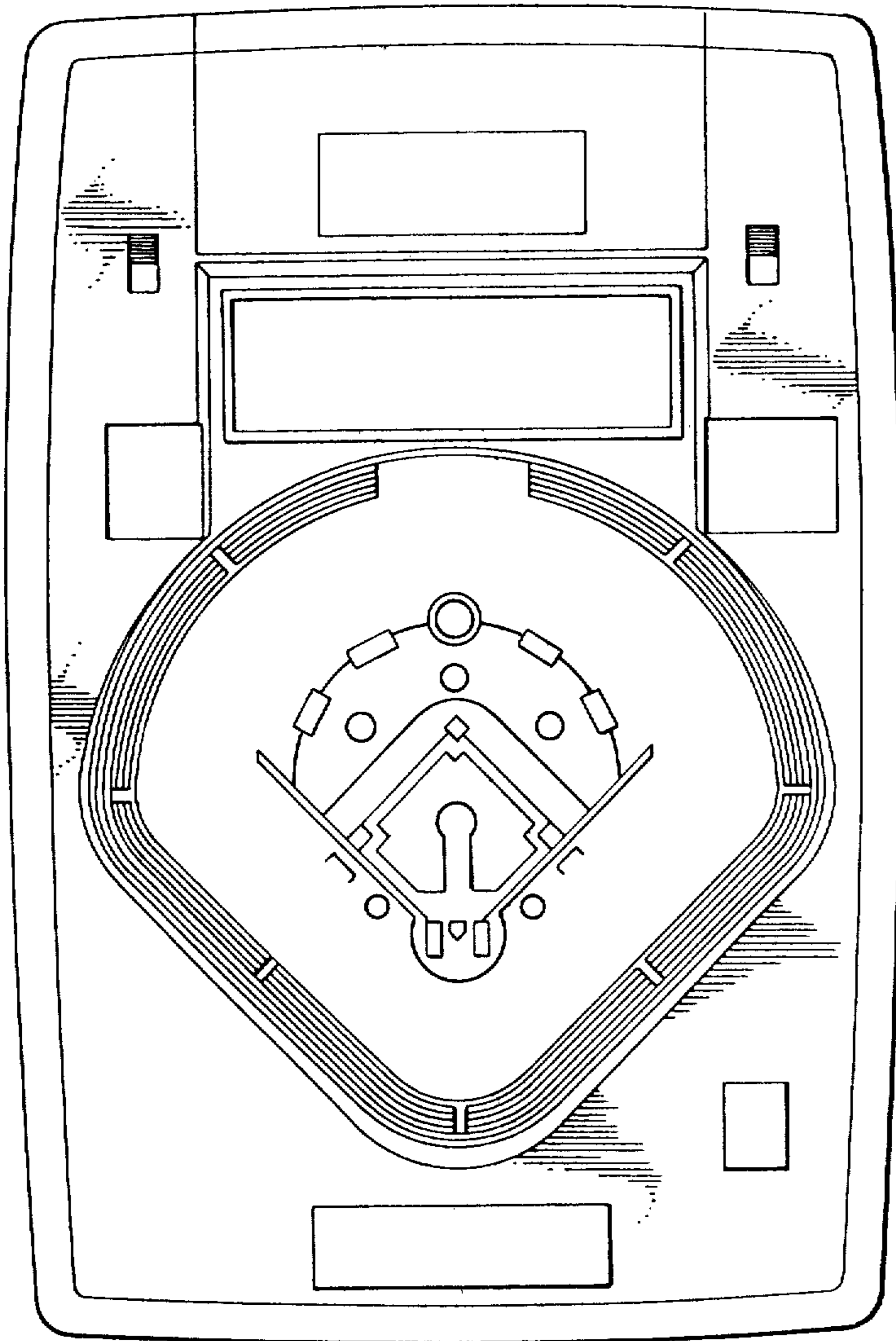

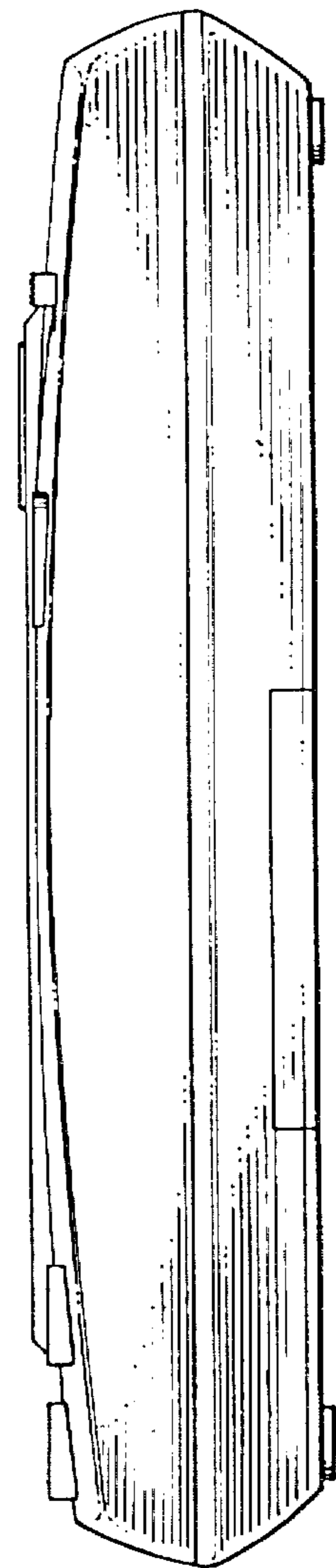

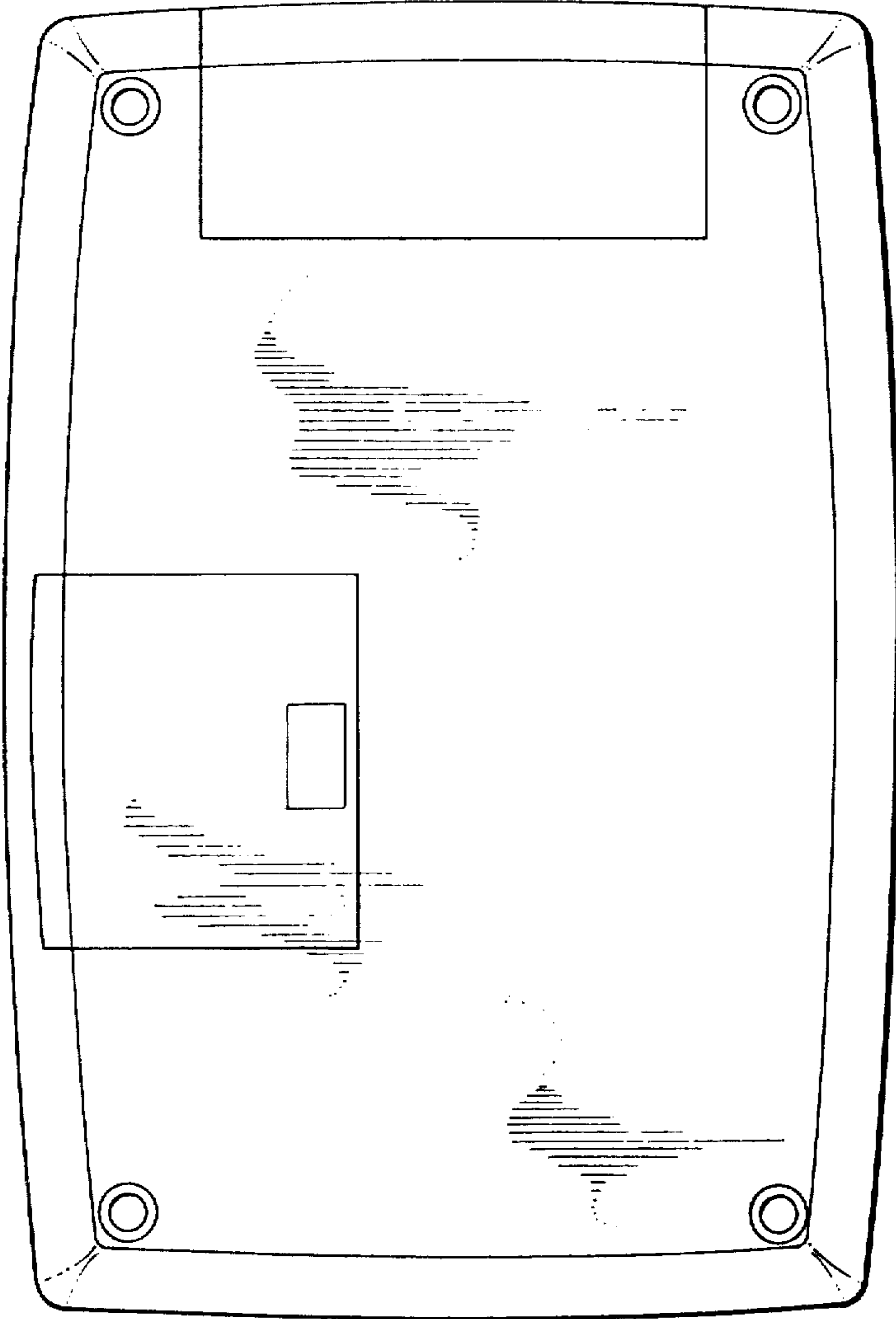

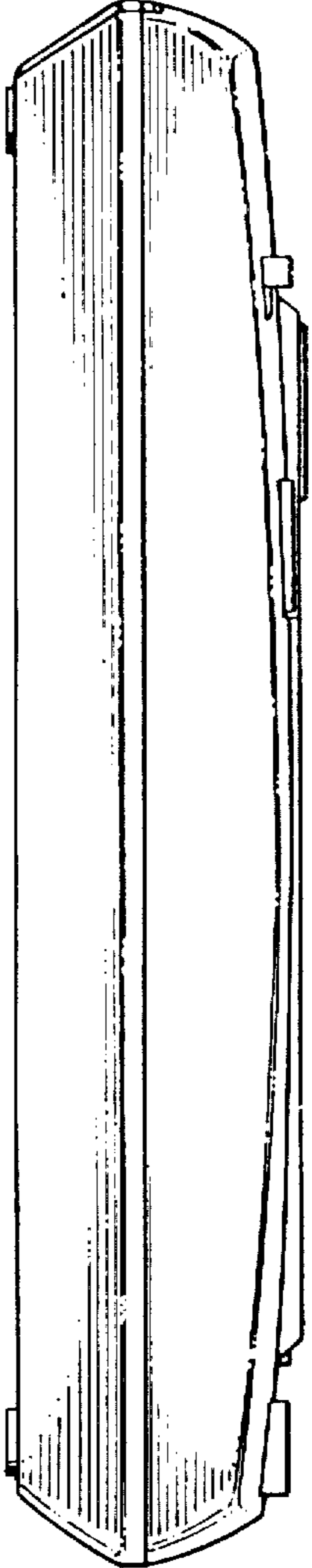

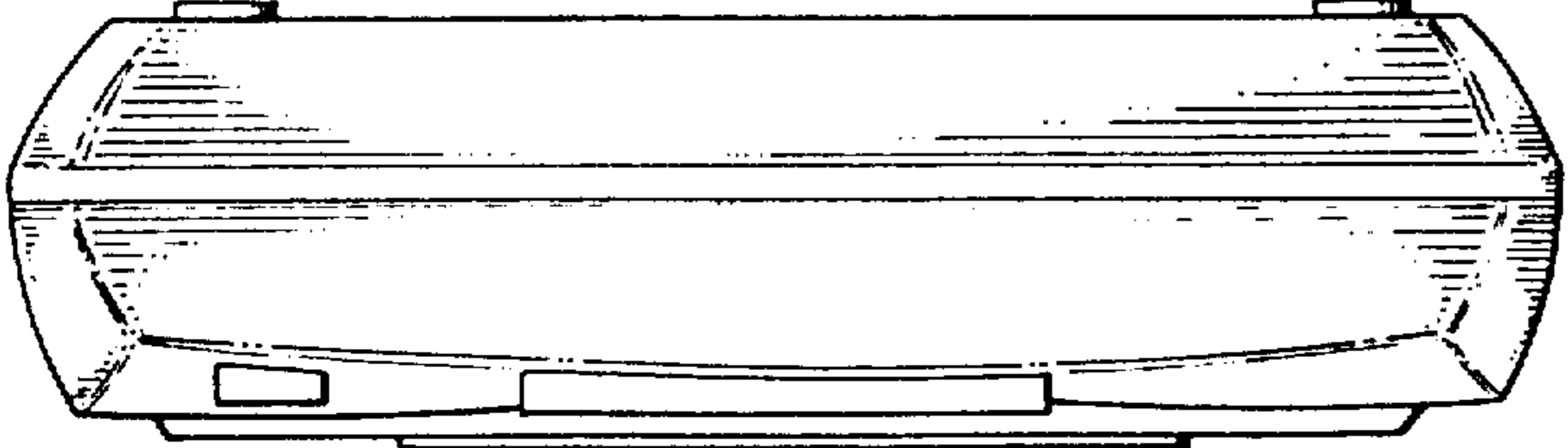
