[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a combined hockey and golf game board, substantially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a side perspective view of my combined hockey and golf game board in open position;
FIG. 2 is a top plan view of my combined hockey and golf game board shown in FIG. 1;
FIG. 3 is a side elevational view of my combined hockey and golf game board in open position from one side;
FIG. 4 is a side elevational view of my combined hockey and golf game board from the other side thereof;
FIG. 5 is a front perspective view of my combined hockey and golf game board in closed position;
FIG. 6 is a rear elevational view of my combined hockey and golf game board in closed position.

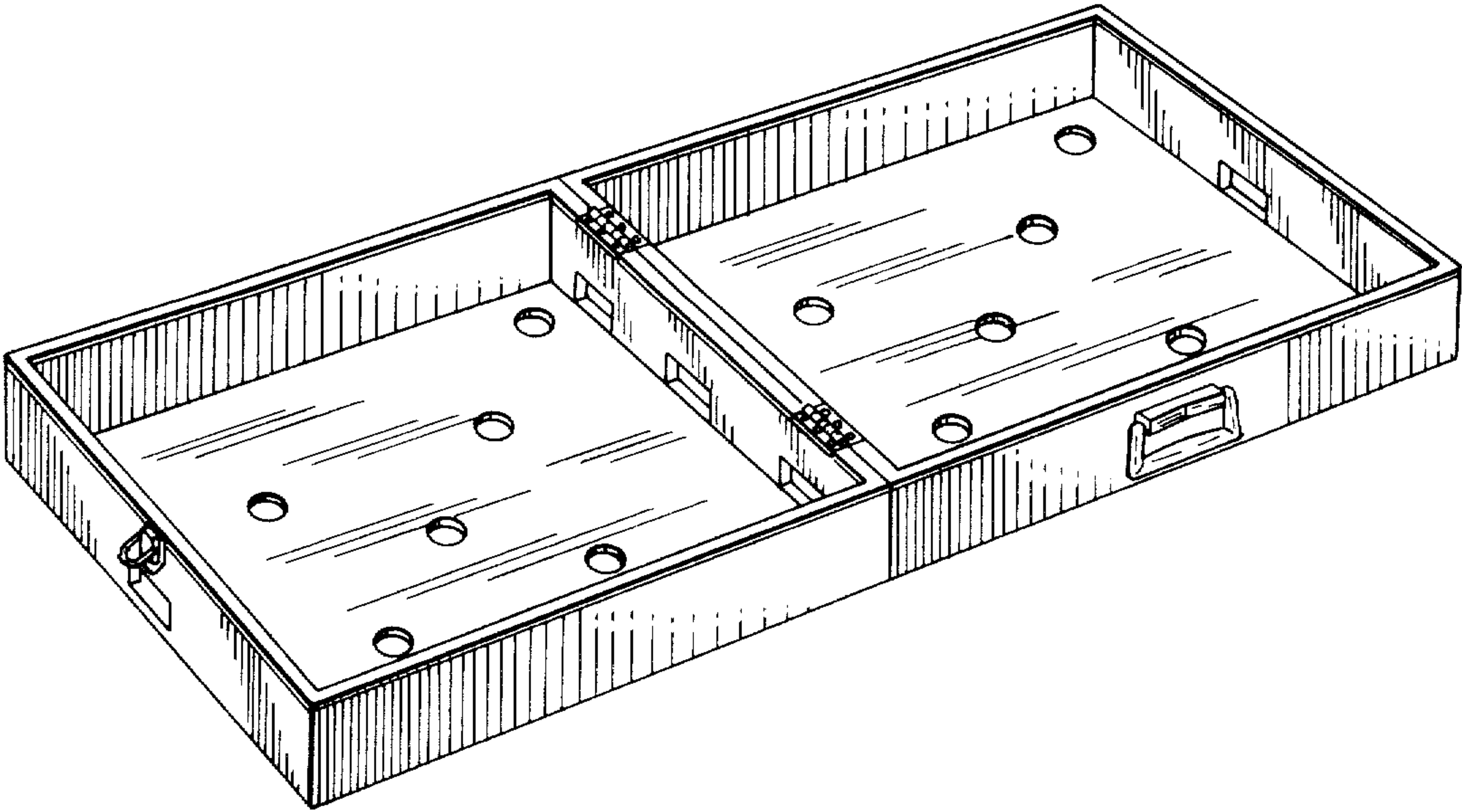

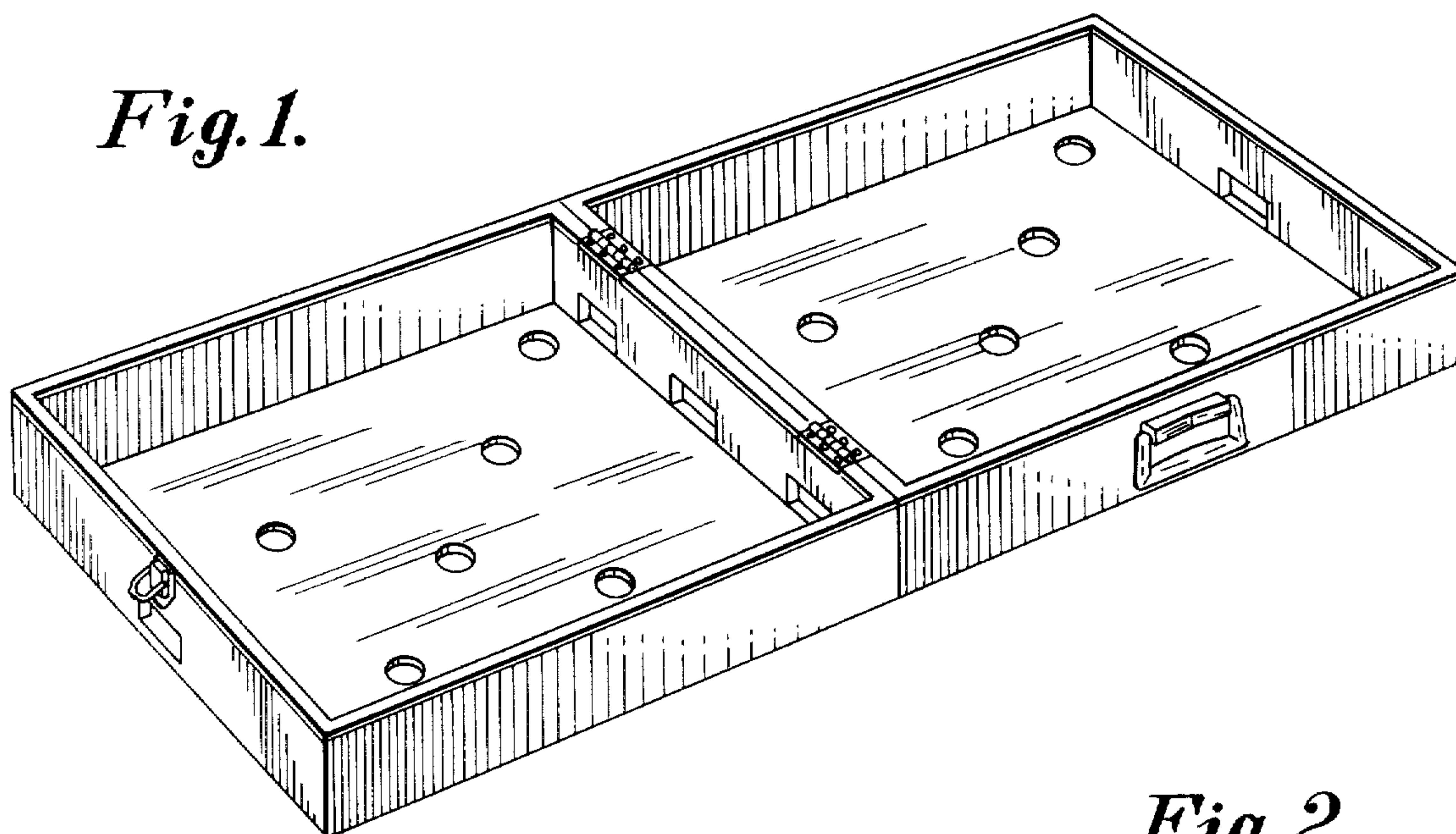

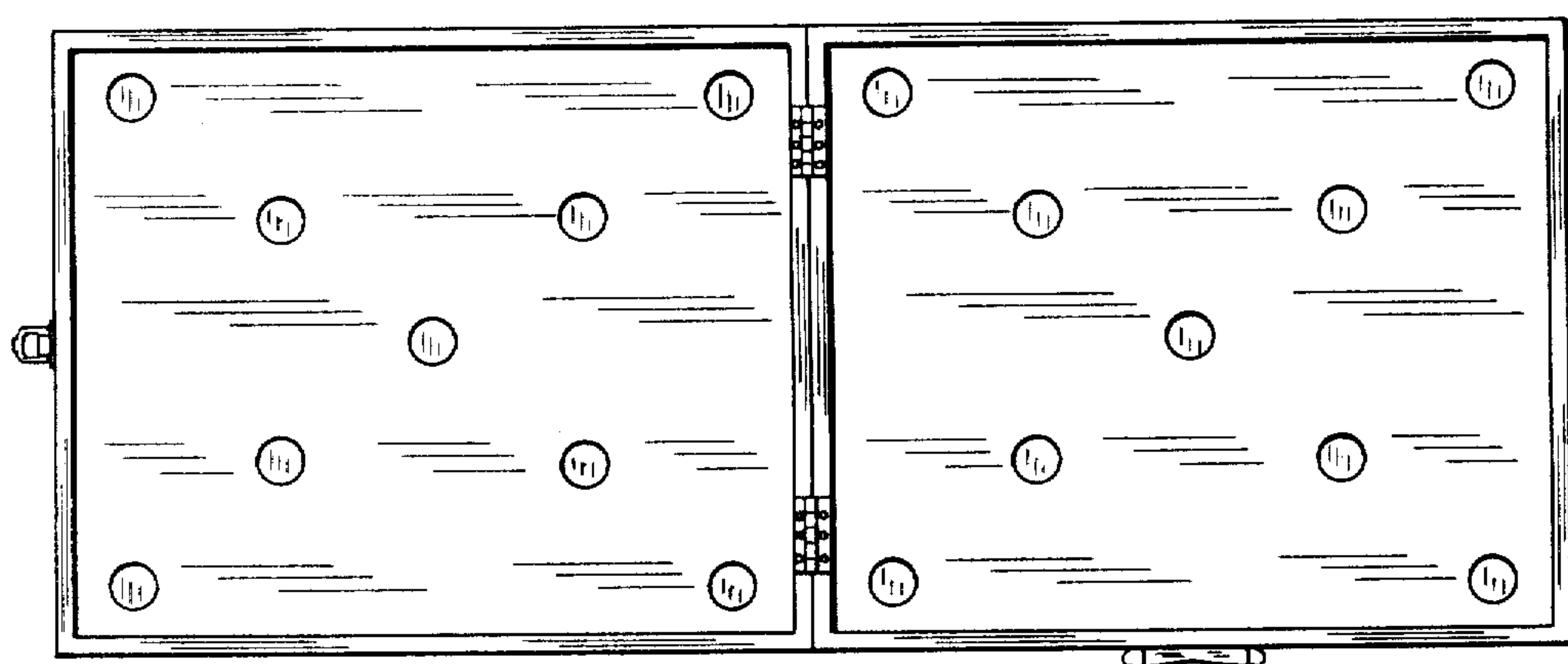

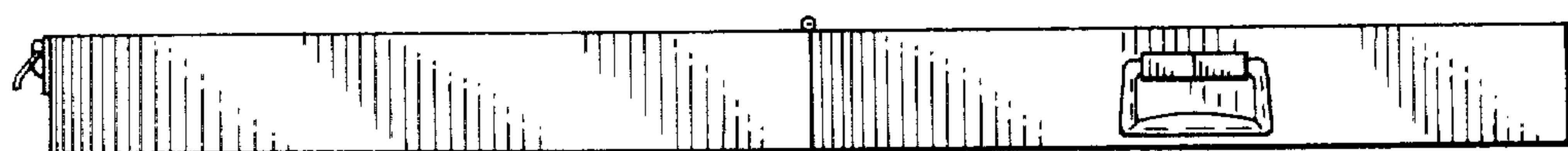

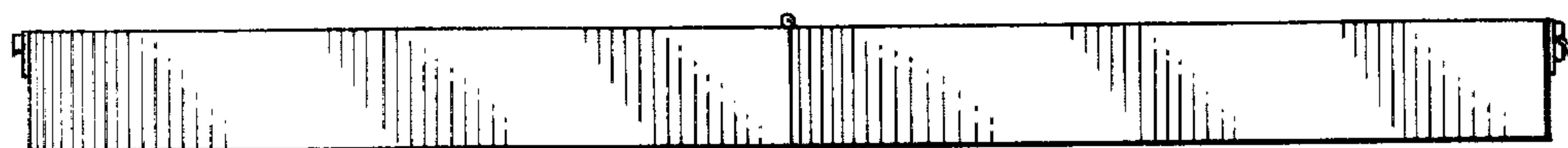

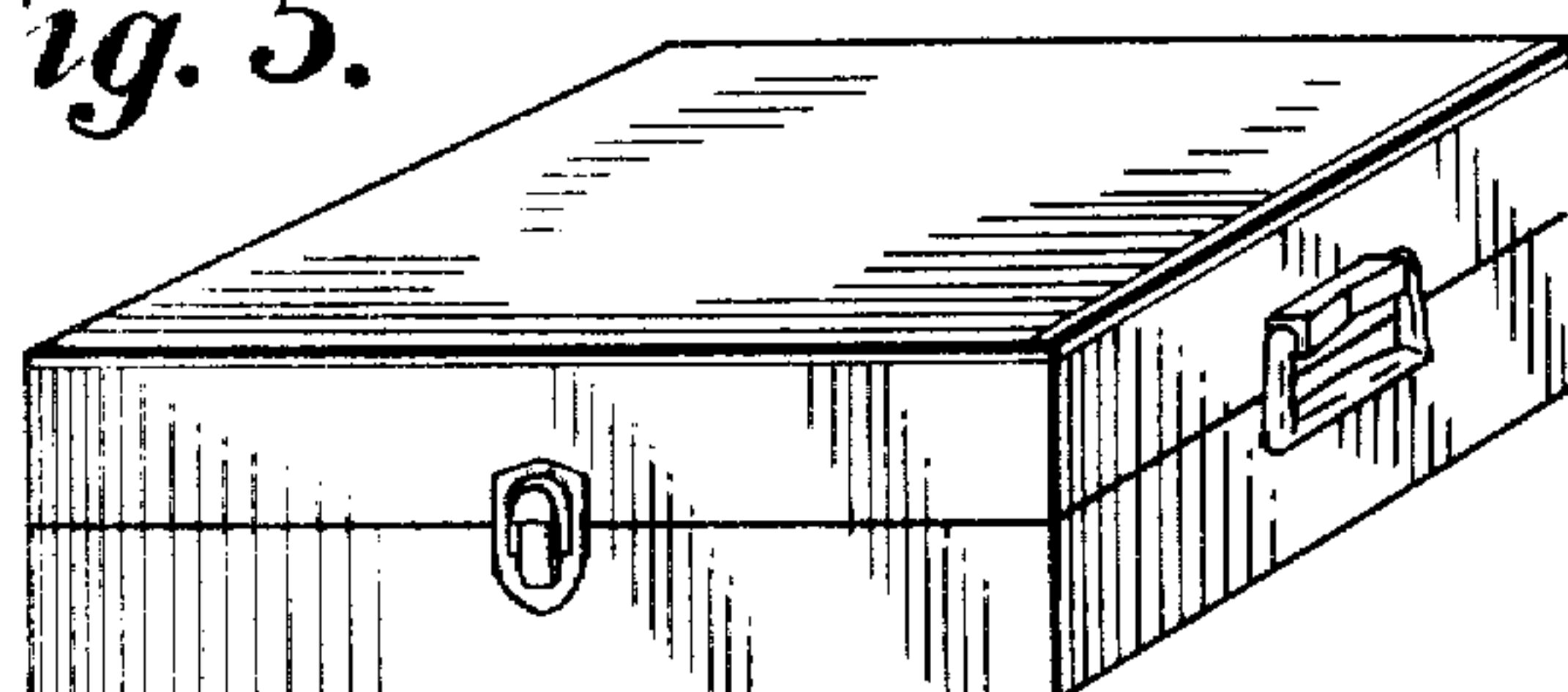
