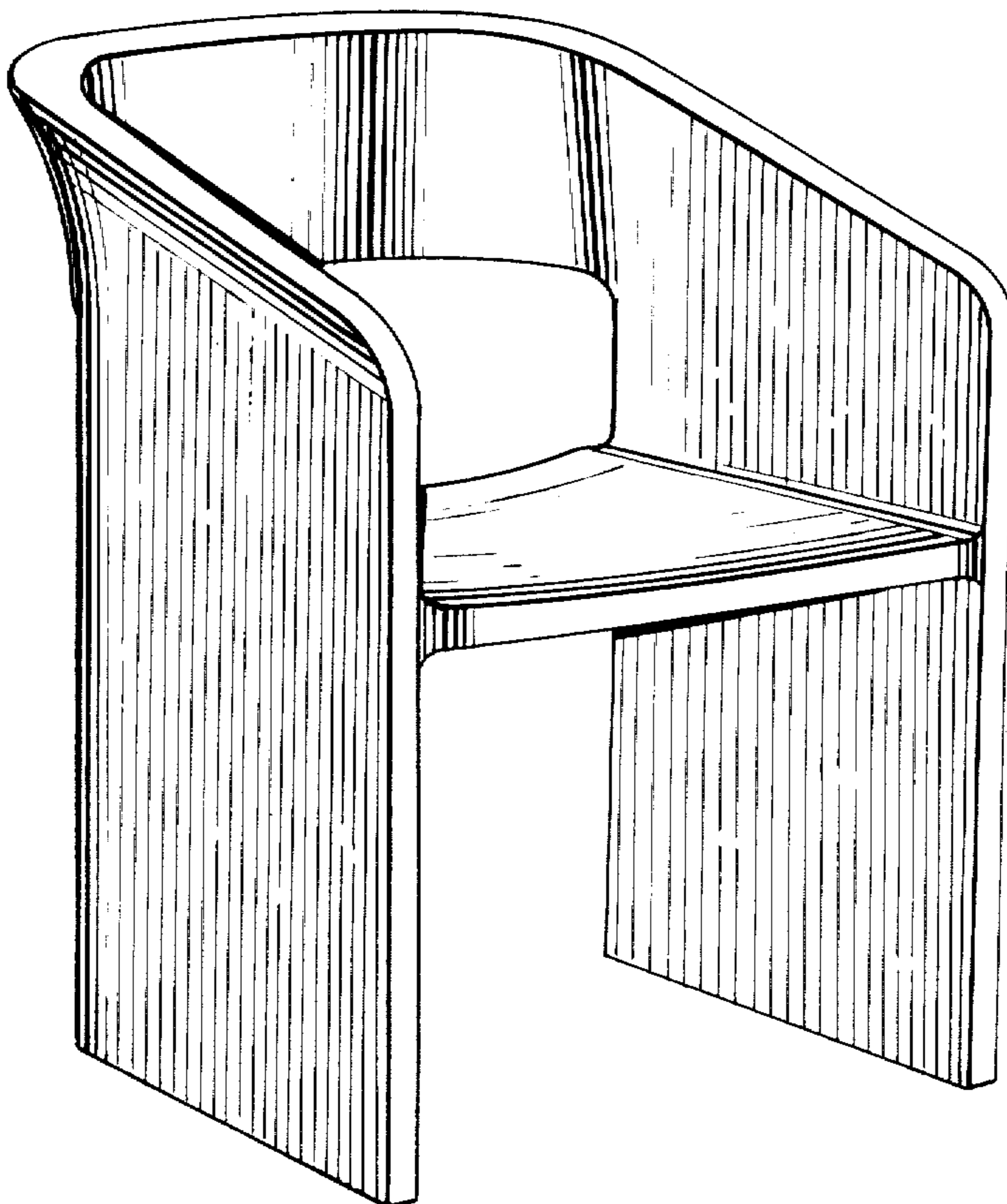

FIG. 4 is a rear view thereof.



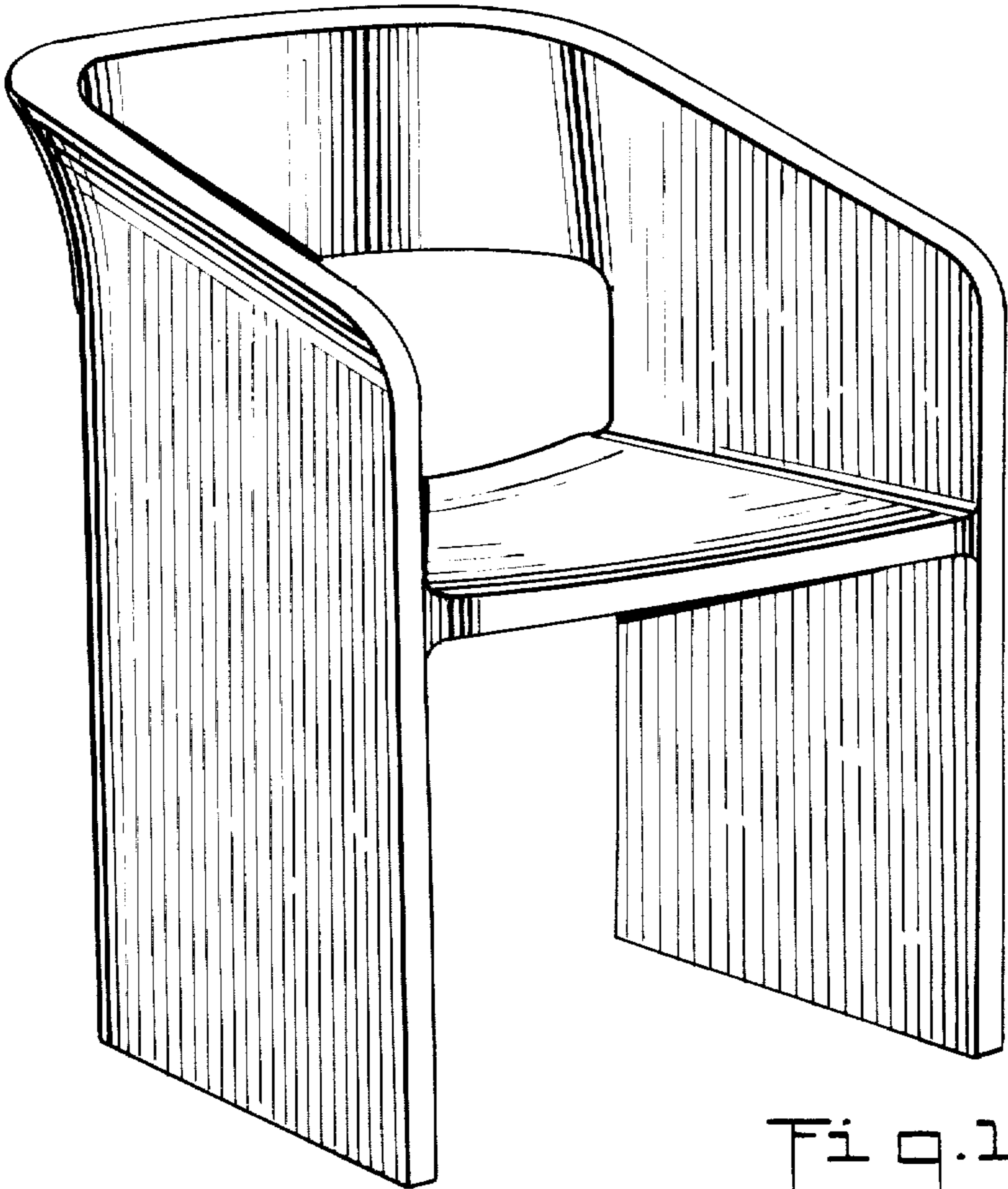
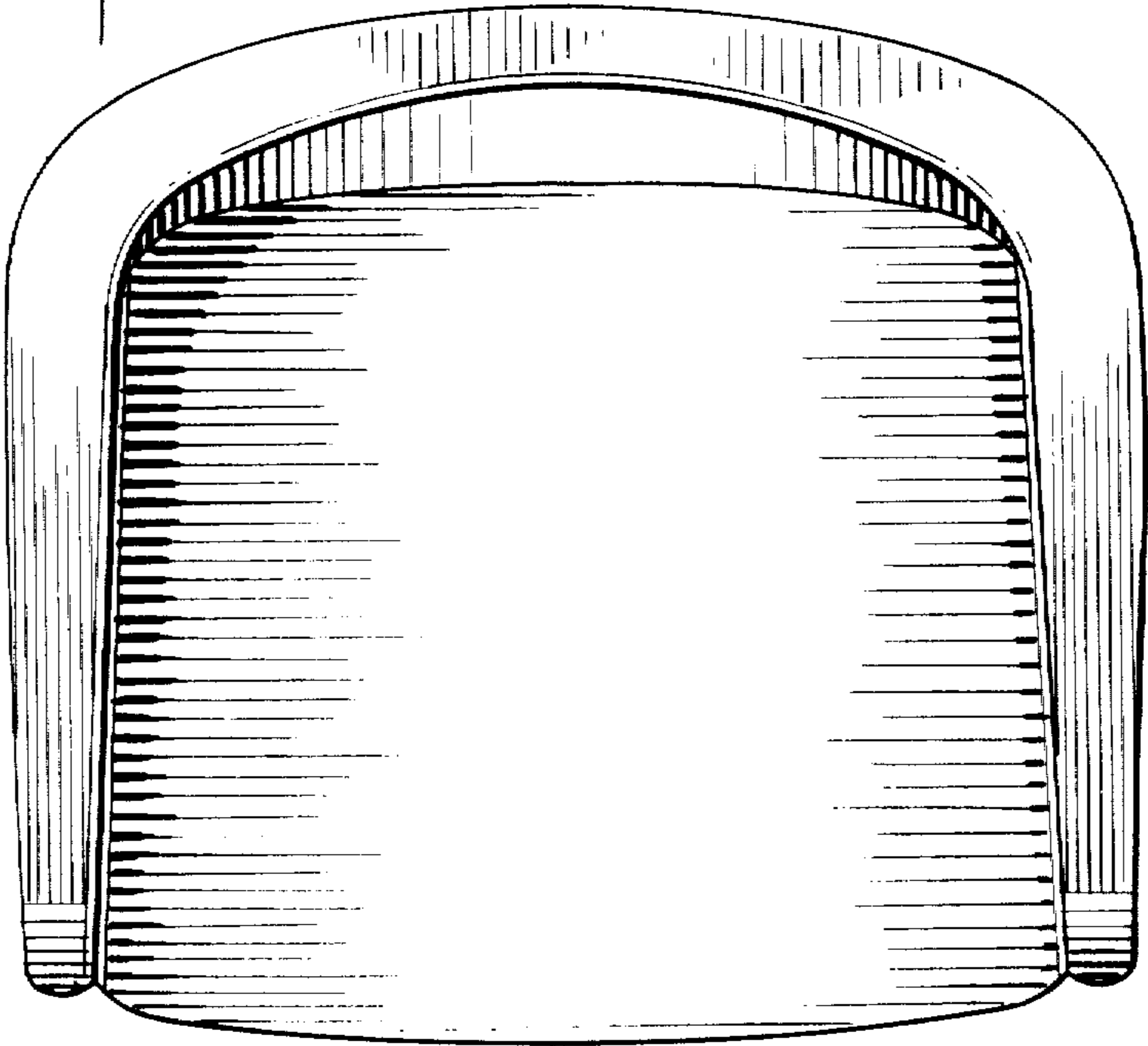

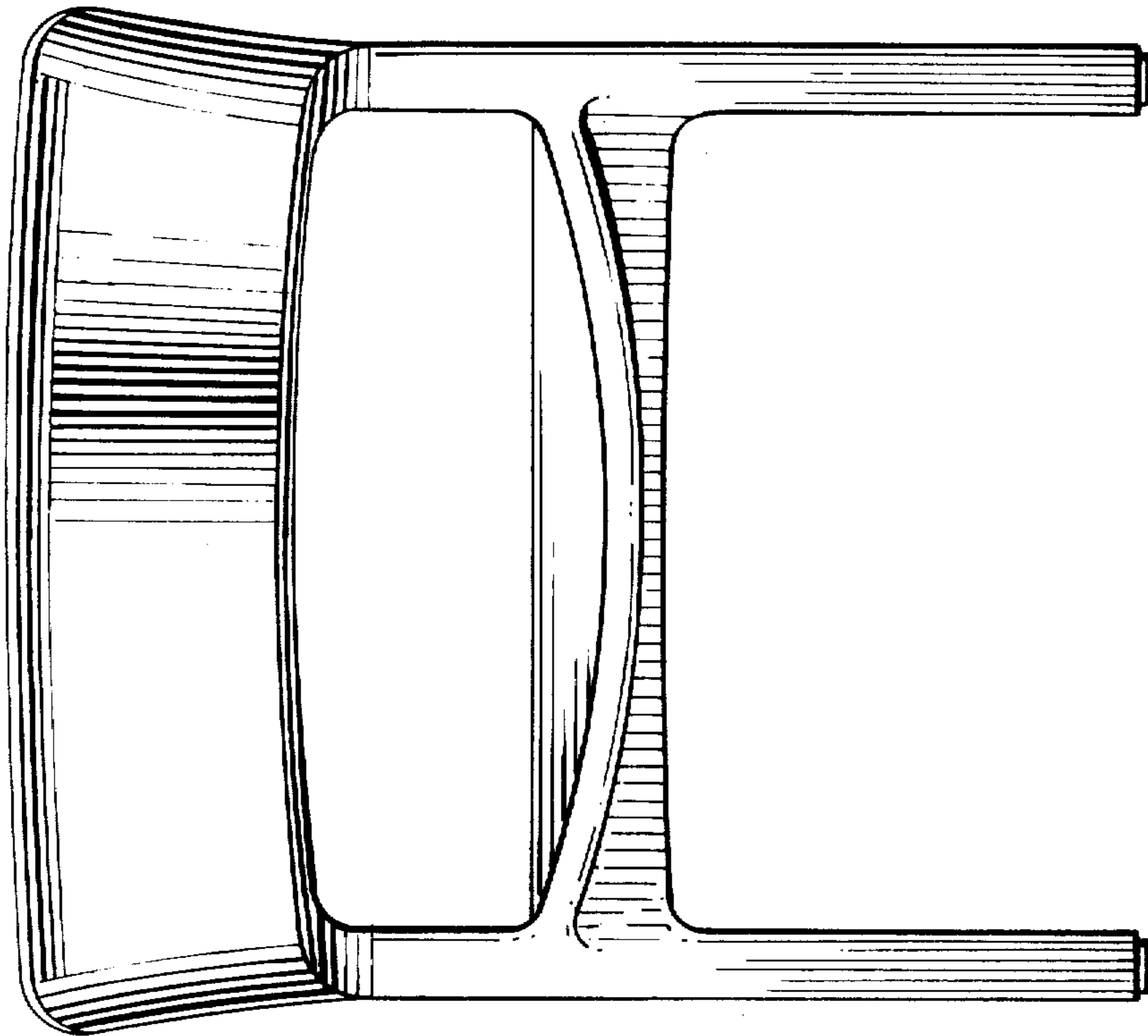

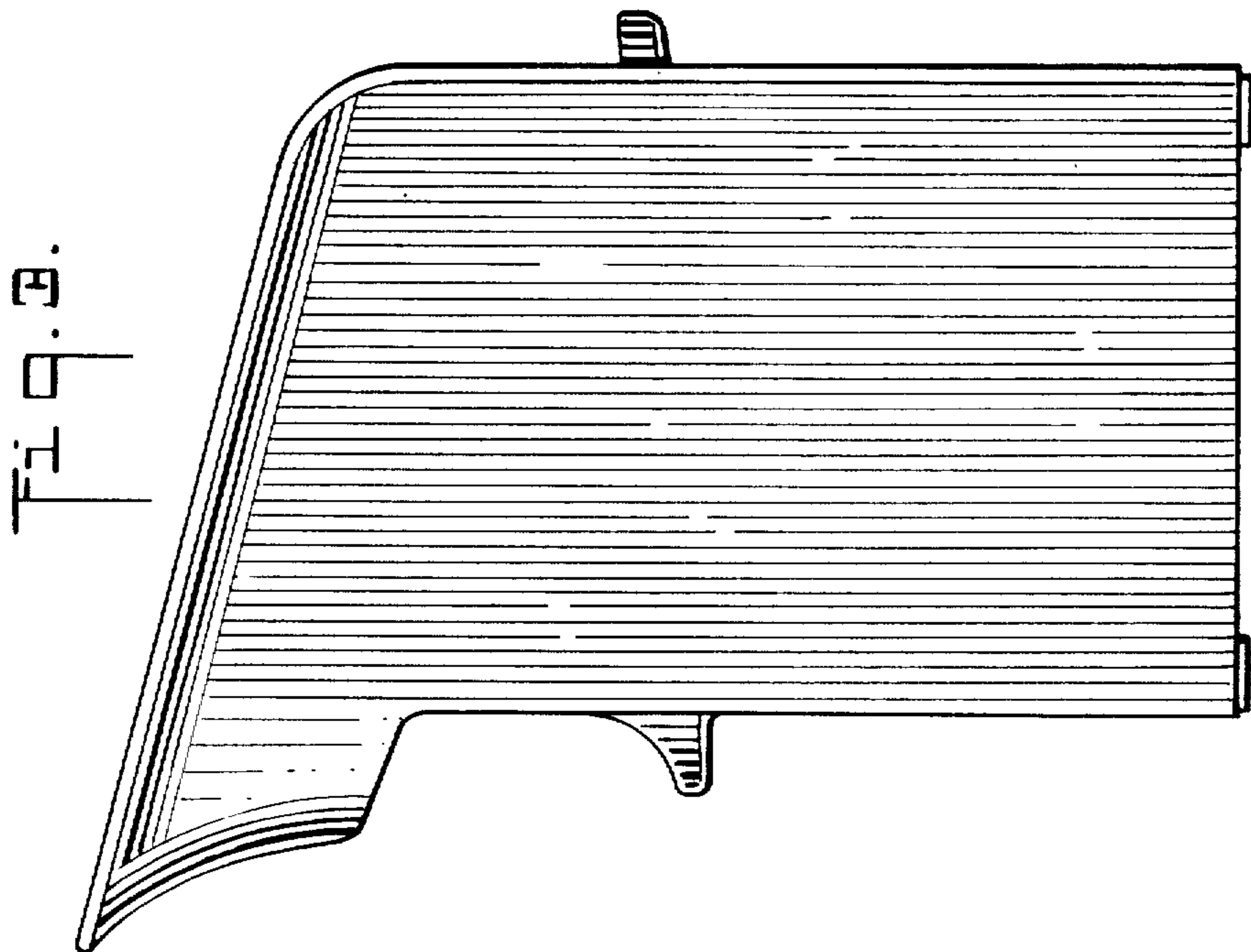
