DESCRIPTION

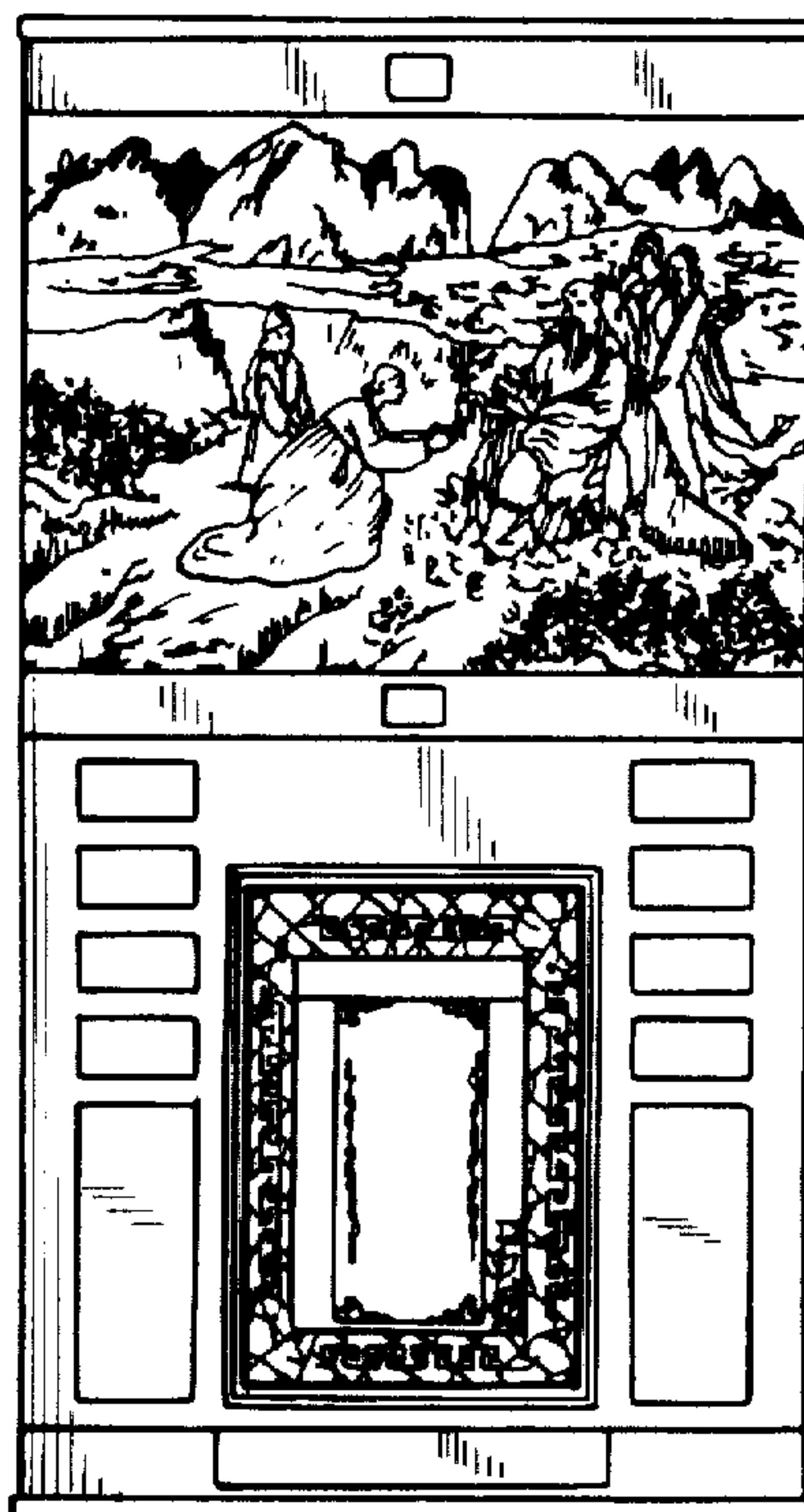
FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a canister showing my new design;

FIG. 5 is a top plan view thereof.



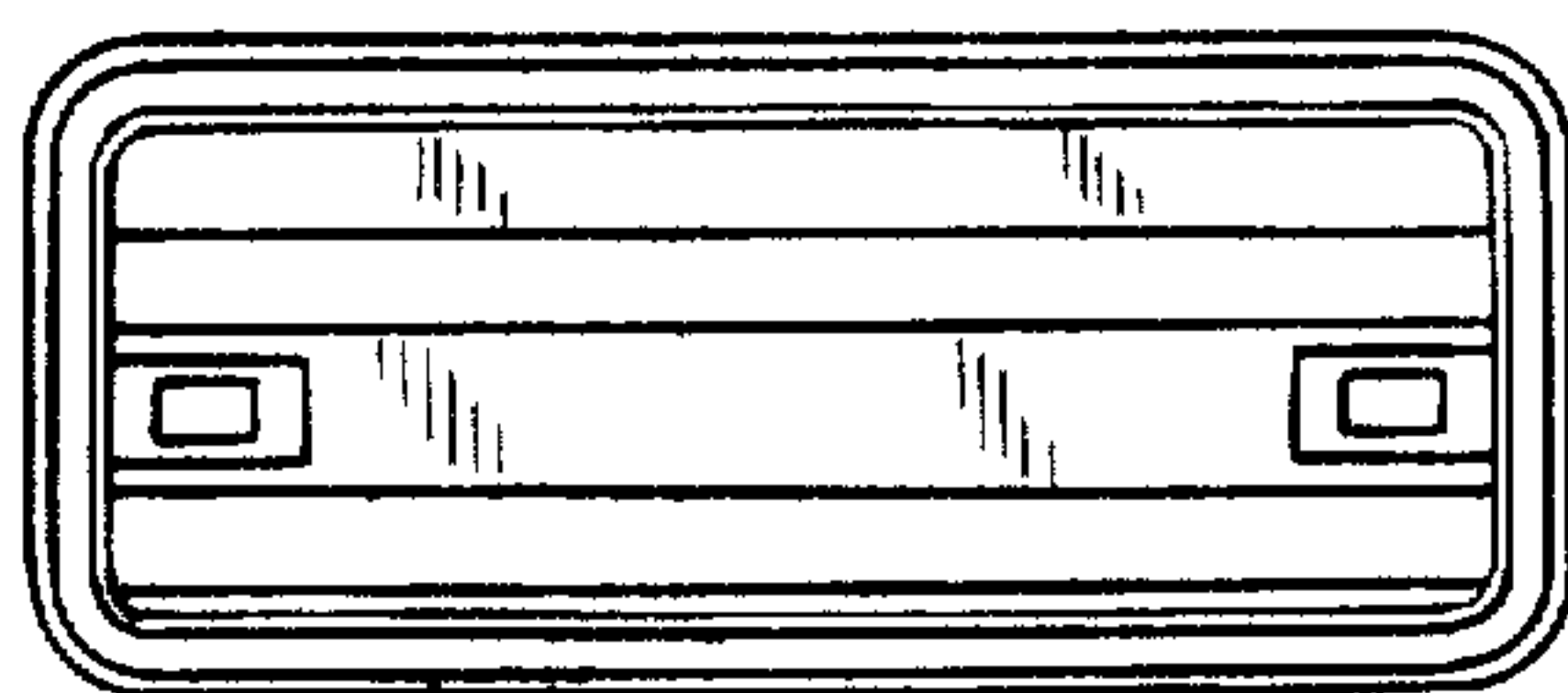

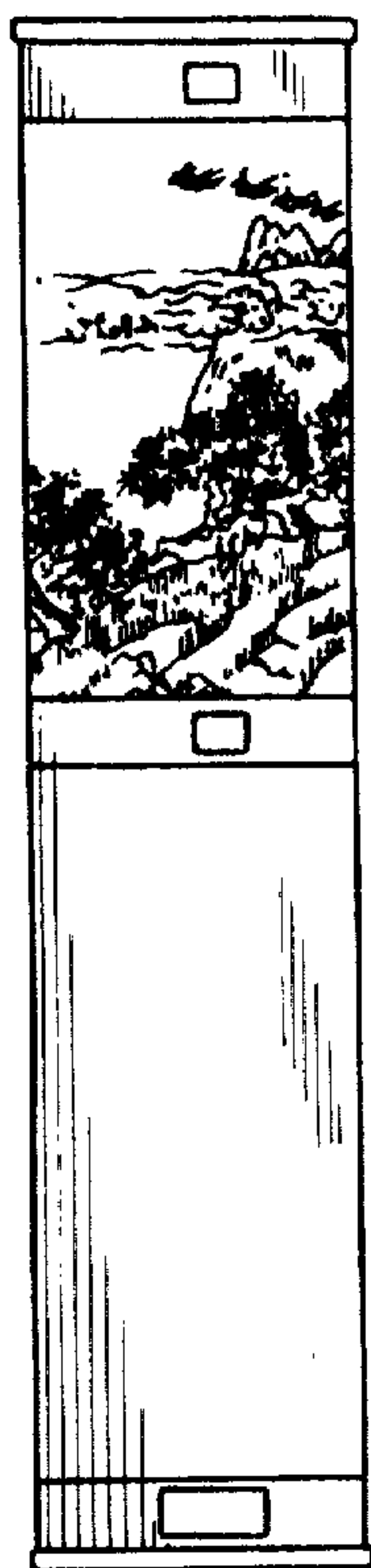

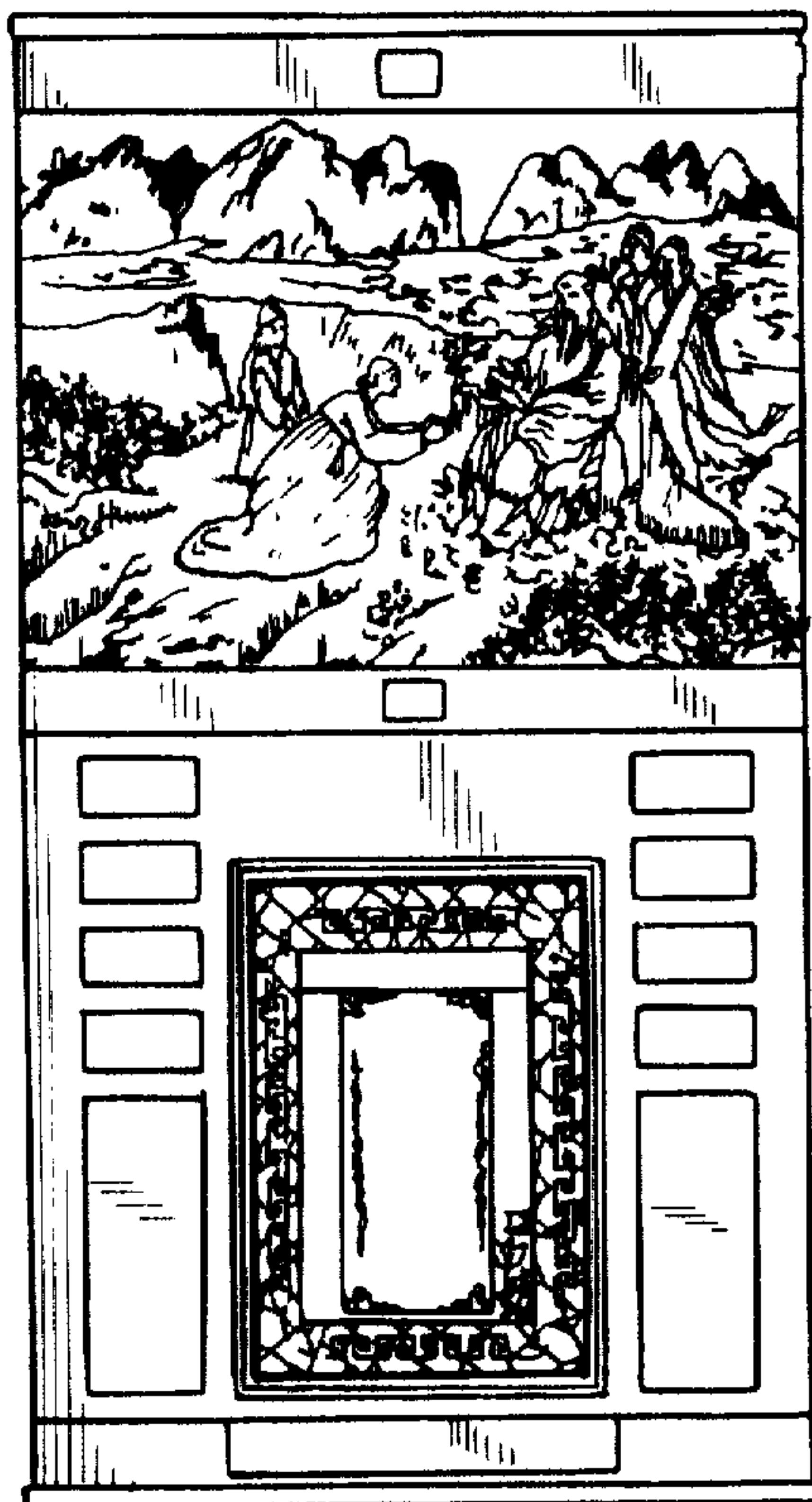

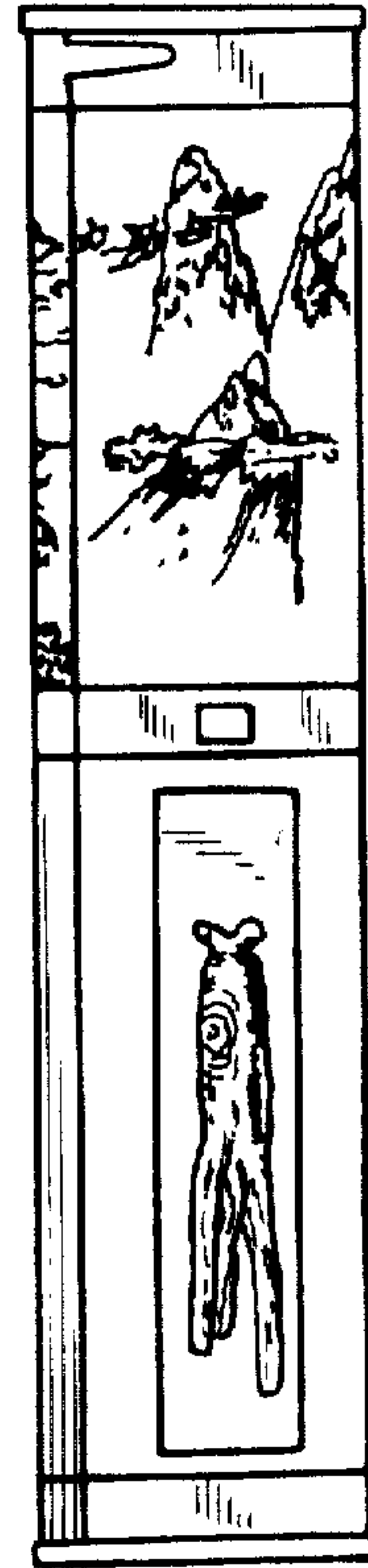

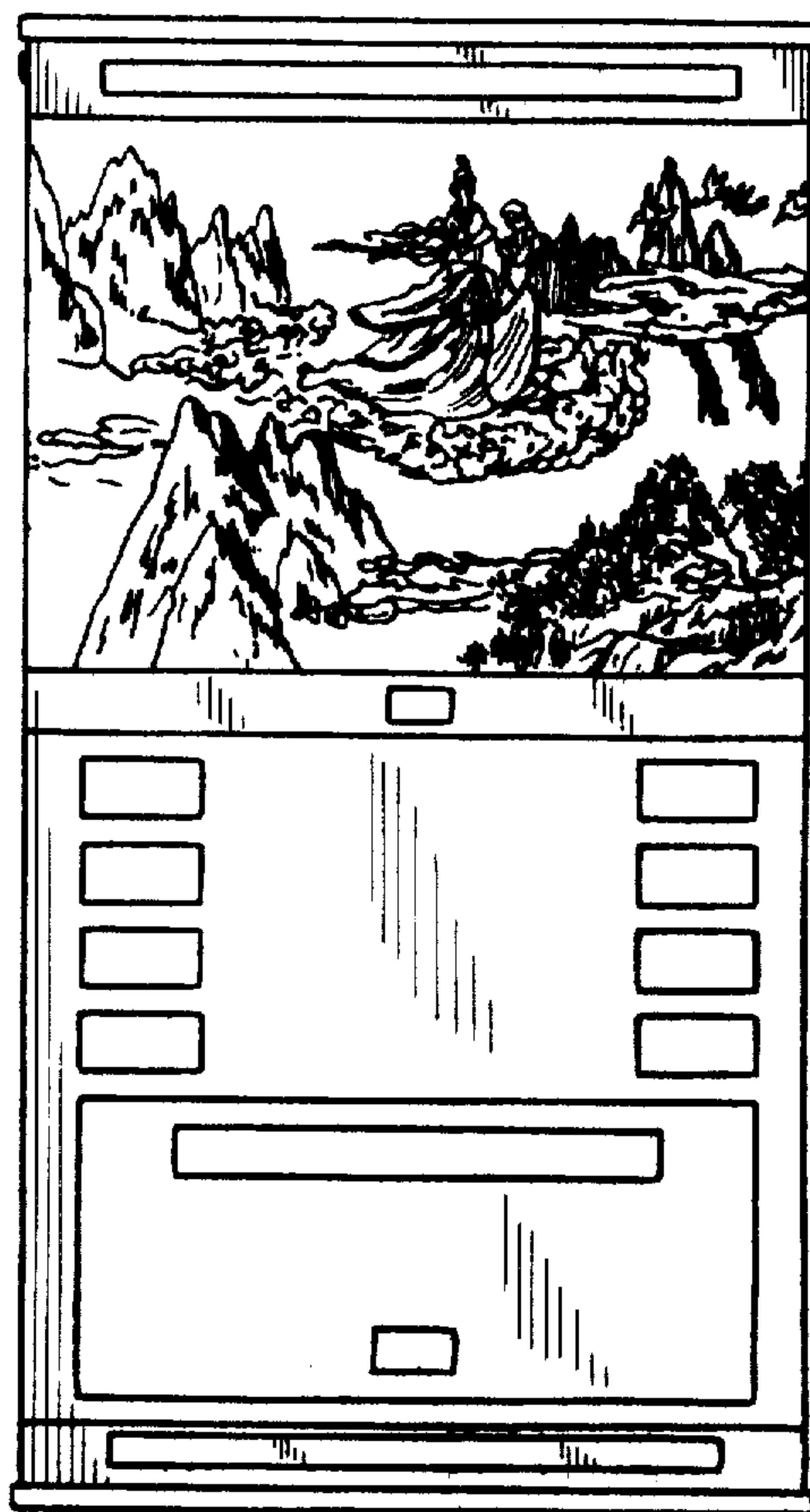
