DESCRIPTION
FIG. 1 is an elevational view of a jar or similar article
showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a top view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a sectional view taken along line 3—3 of FIG.
1;
FIG. 4 is a sectional view taken along line 4—4 of FIG.
1;
FIG. 5 is a sectional view taken along line 5—5 of FIG.
1; and
FIG. 6 is a fragmentary exploded elevational view
