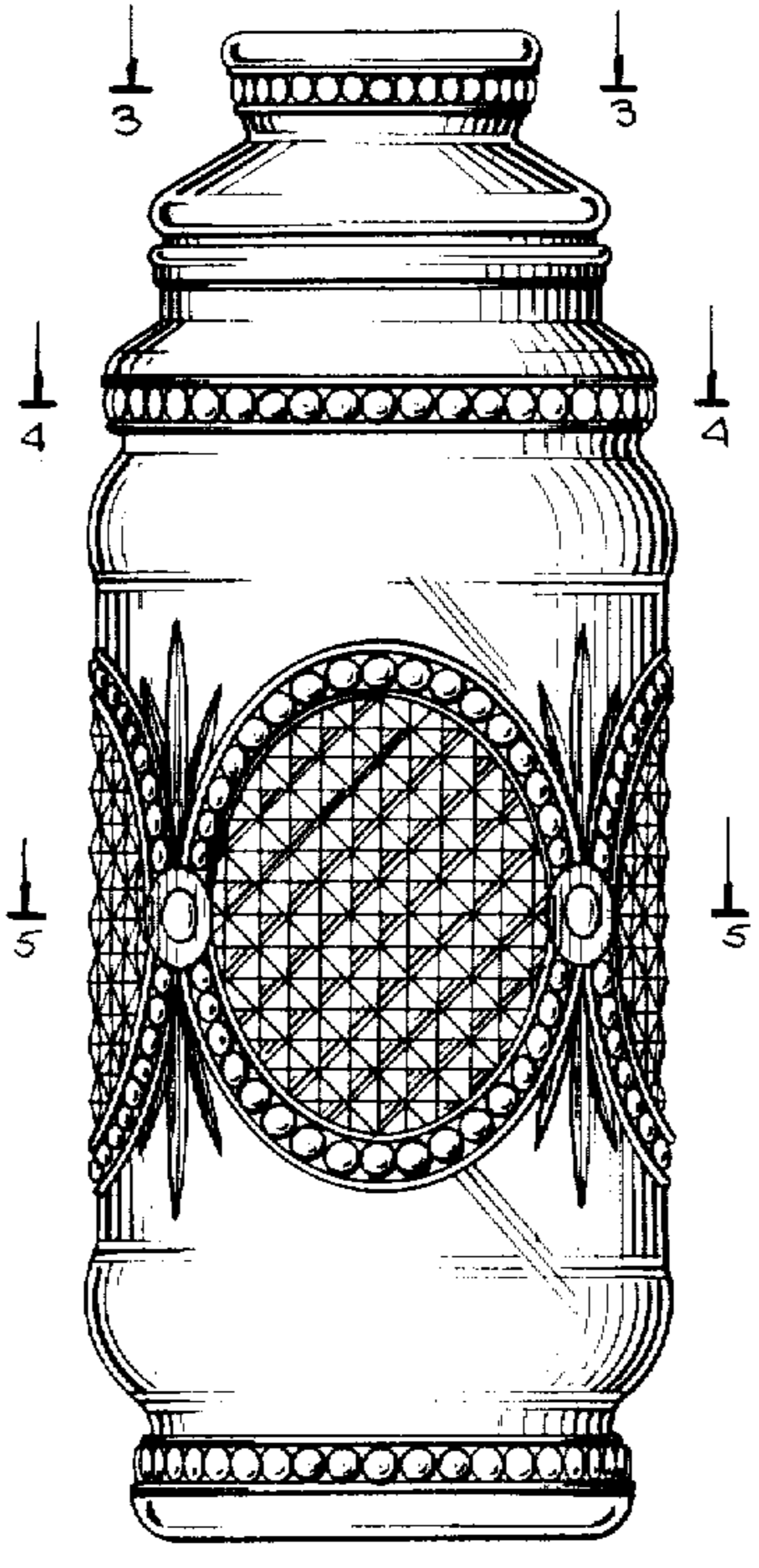

**DESCRIPTION**

thereof.



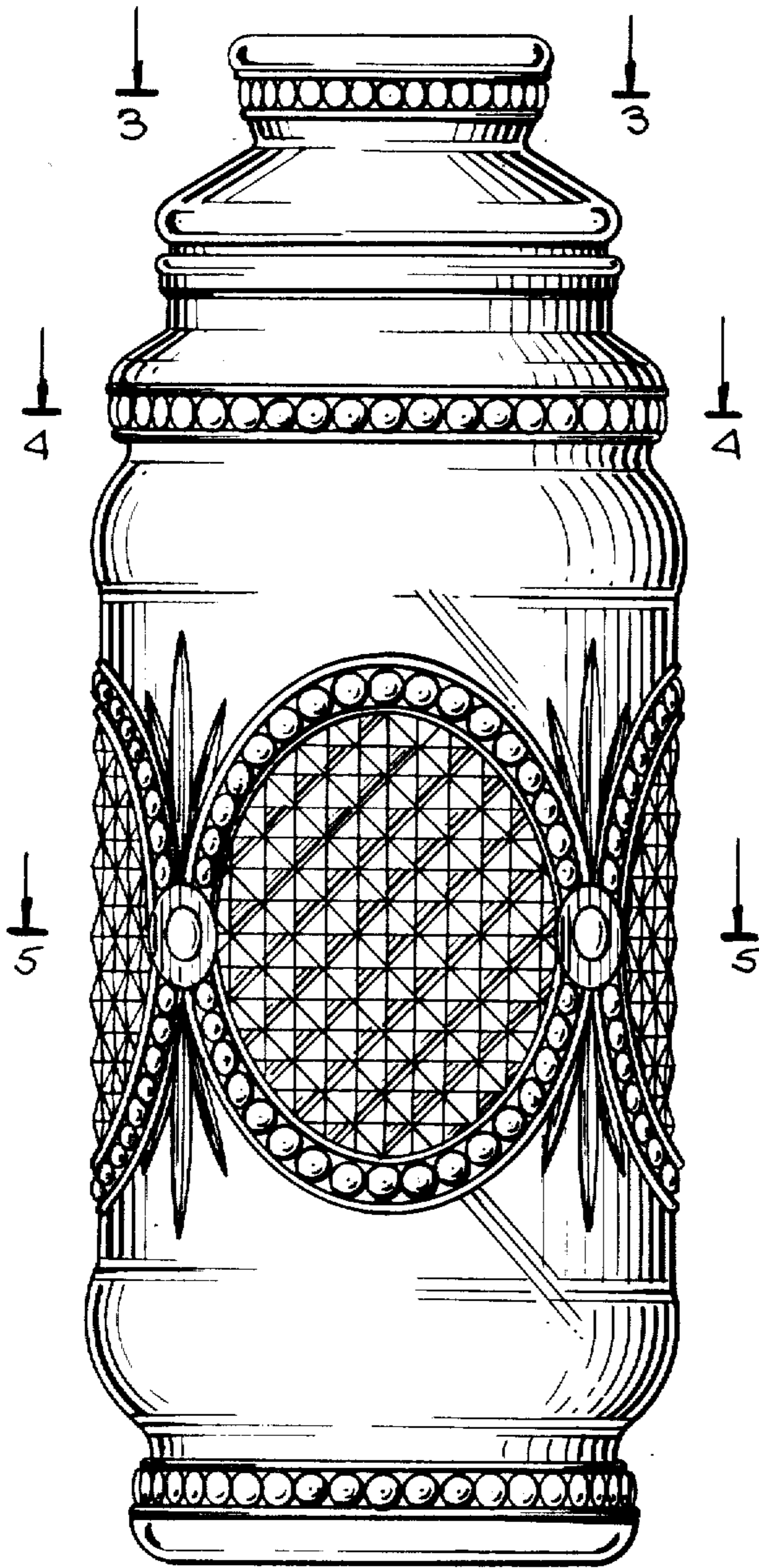

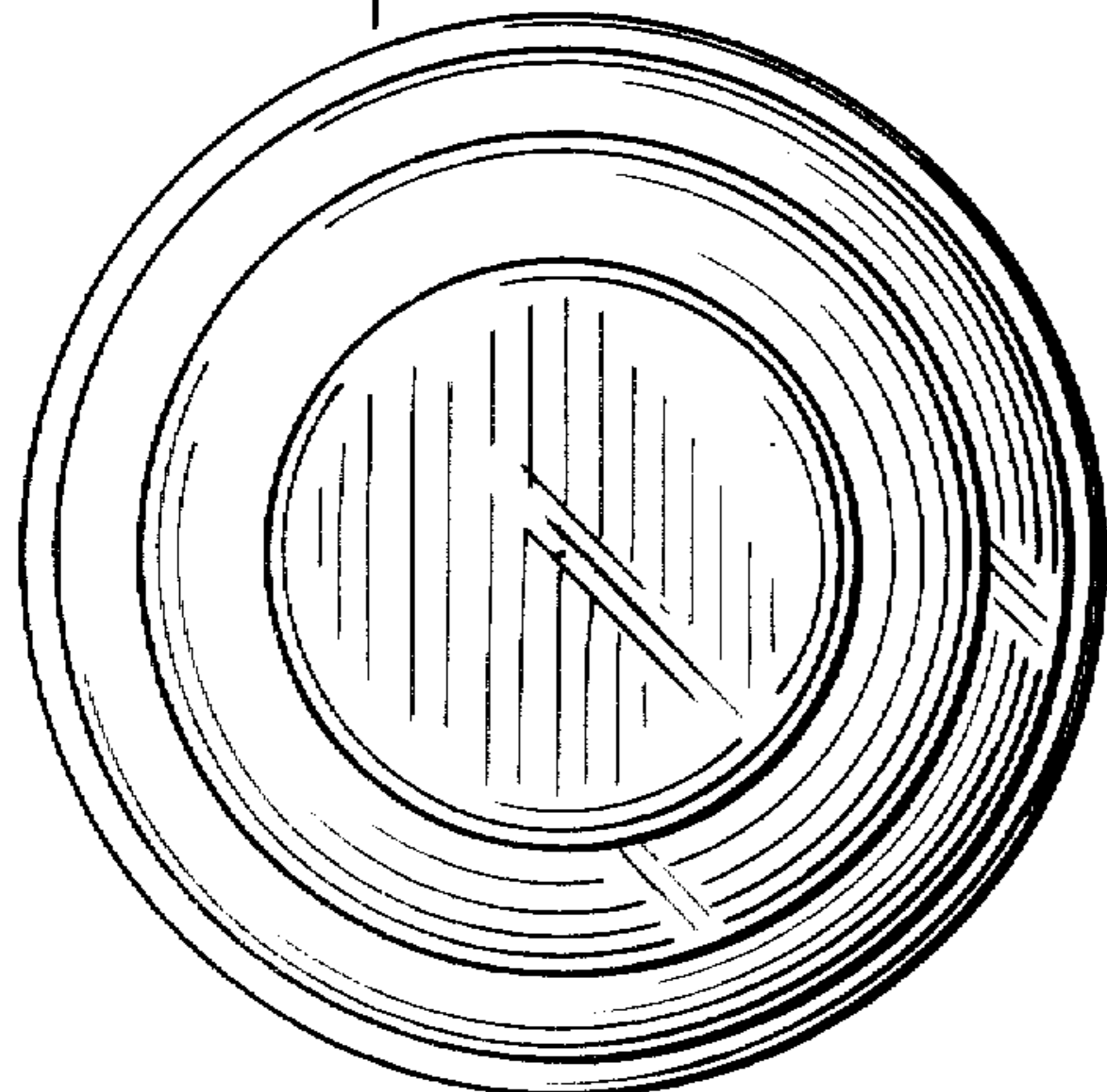

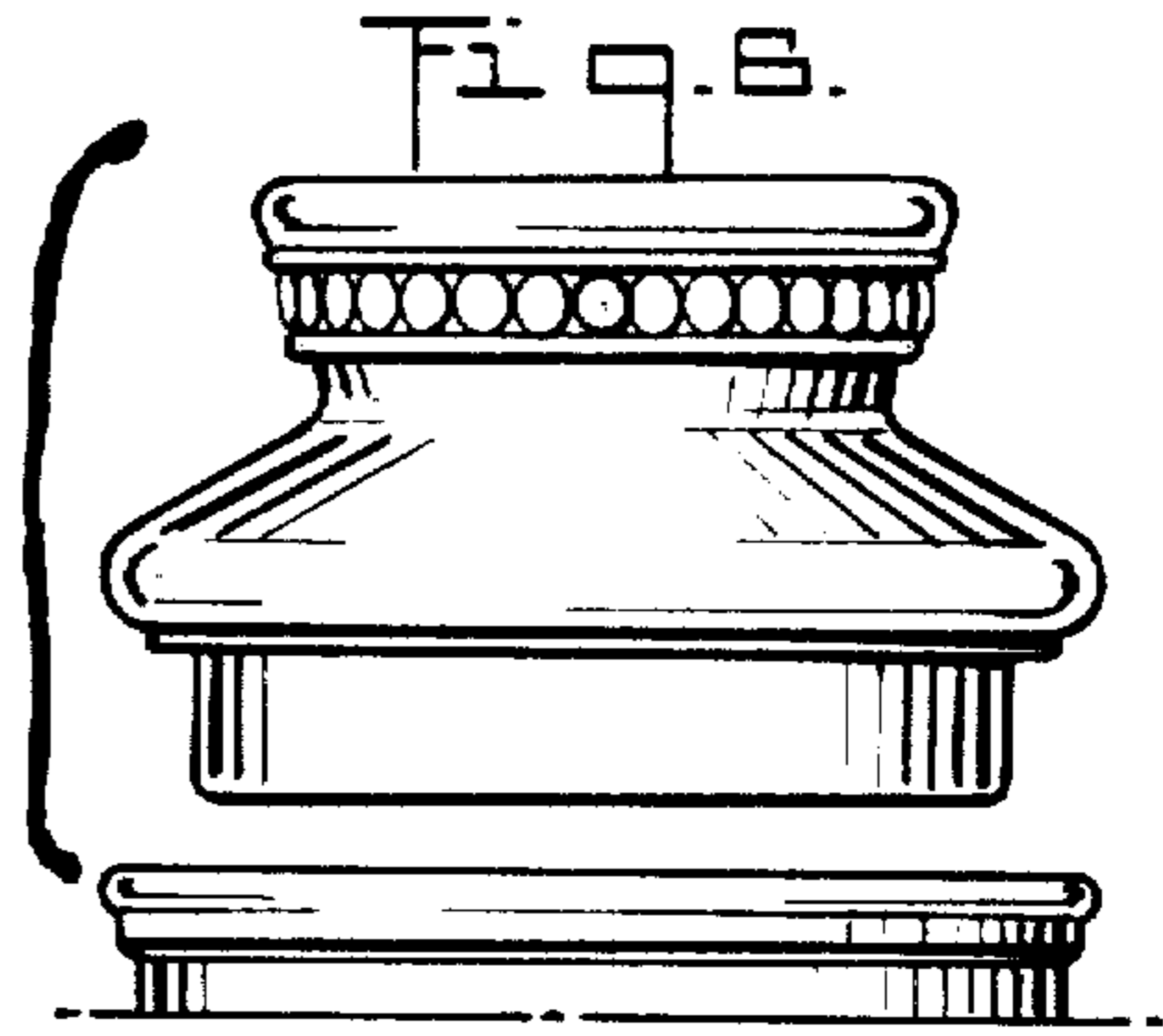

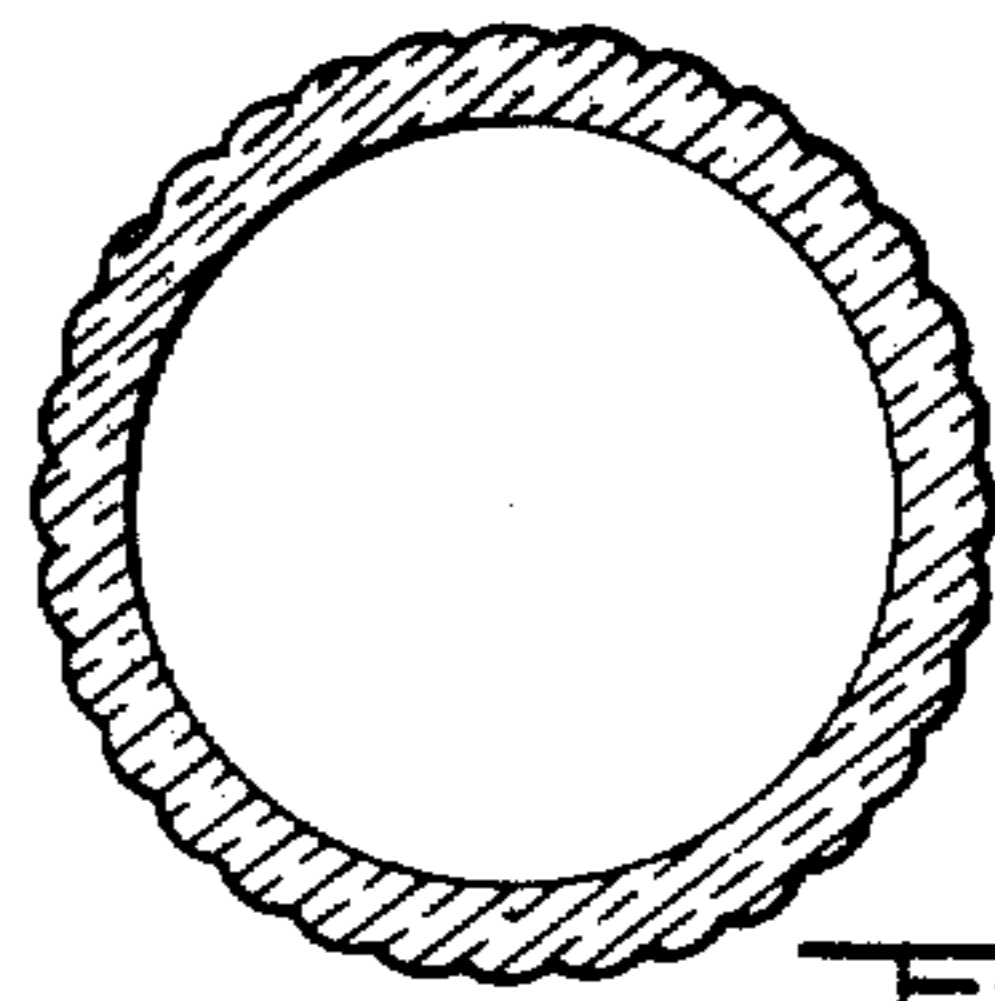

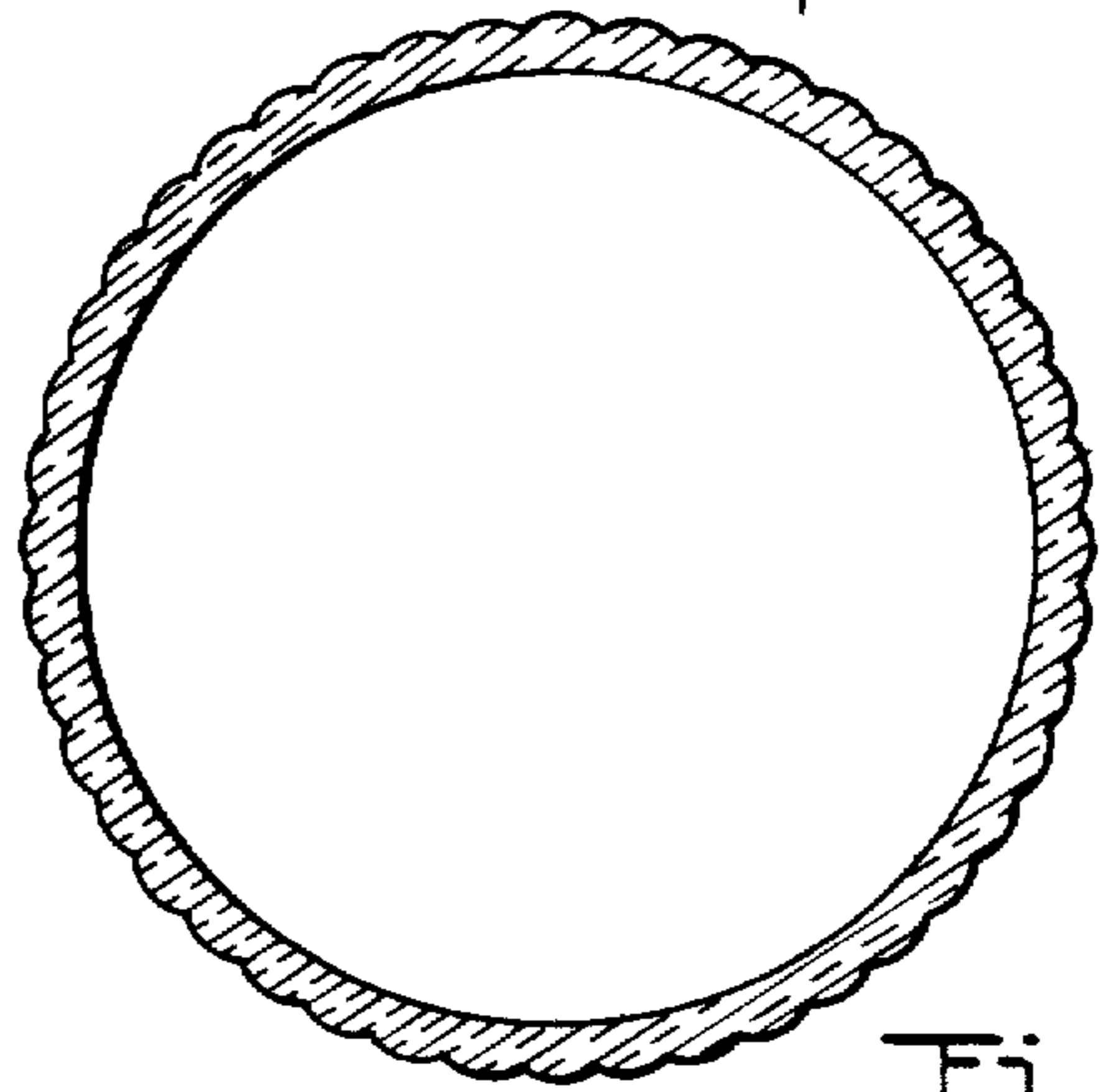
