FIG. 4 is a right side view thereof.

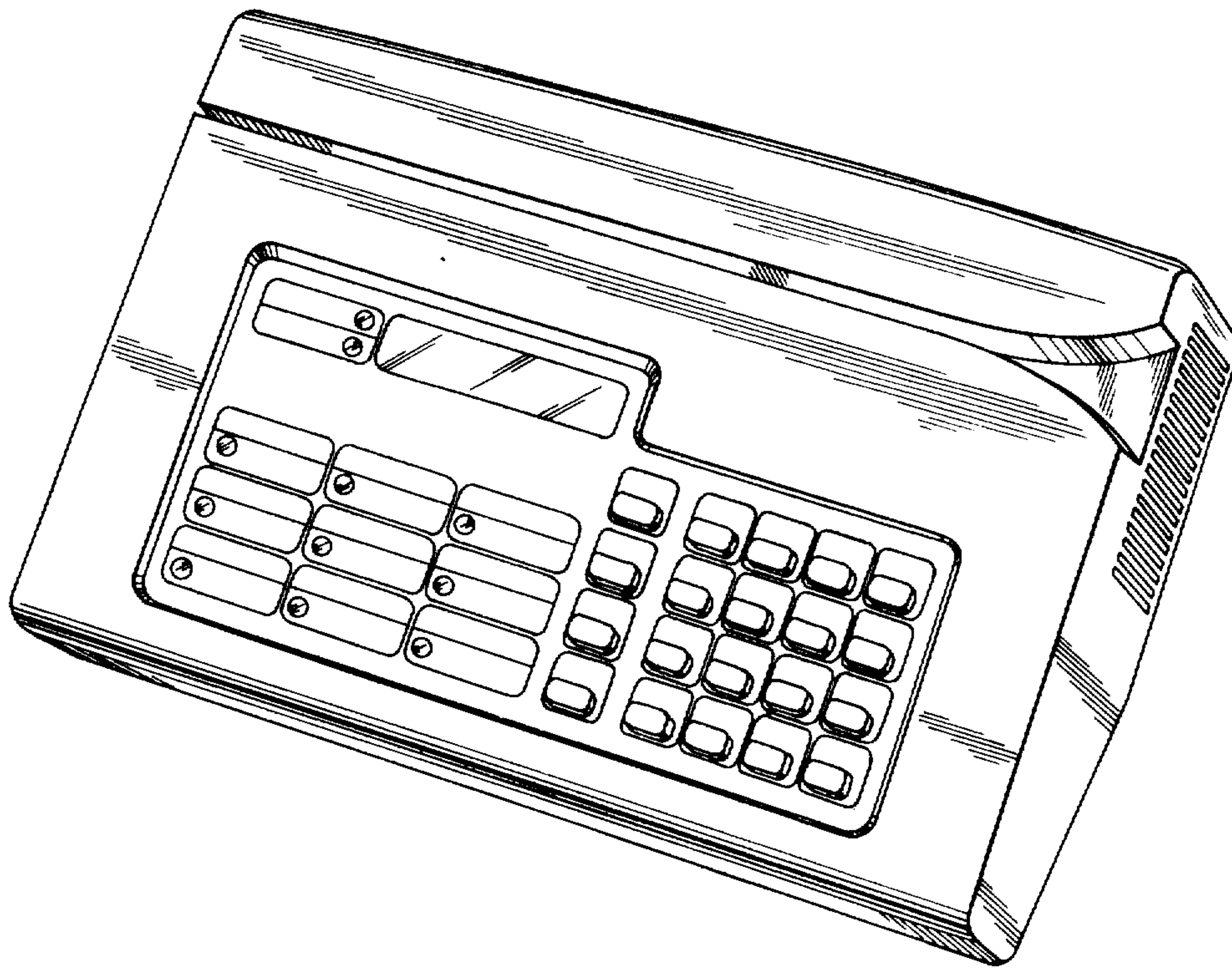

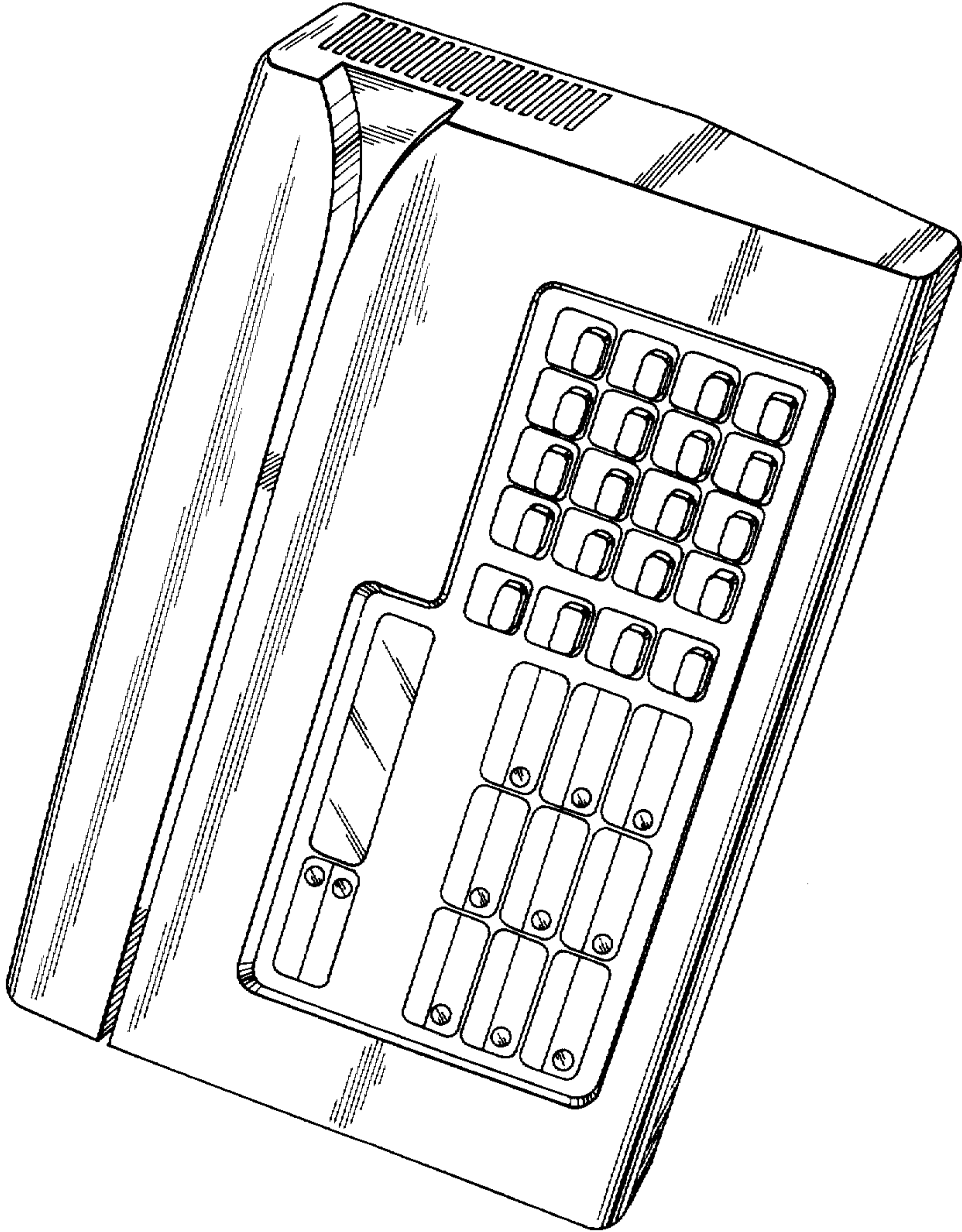
