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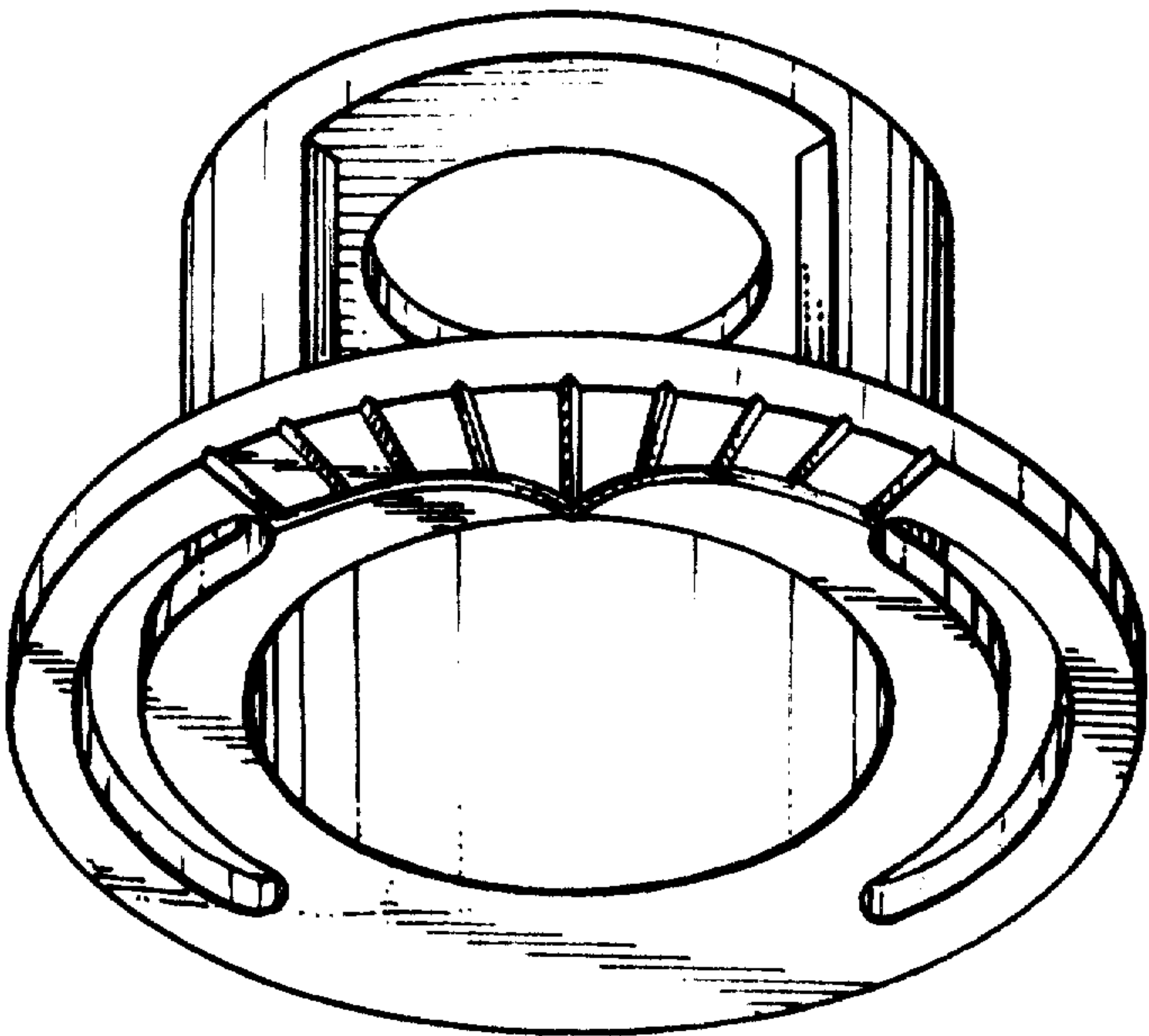

arrows on line 4—4 of FIG. 3.





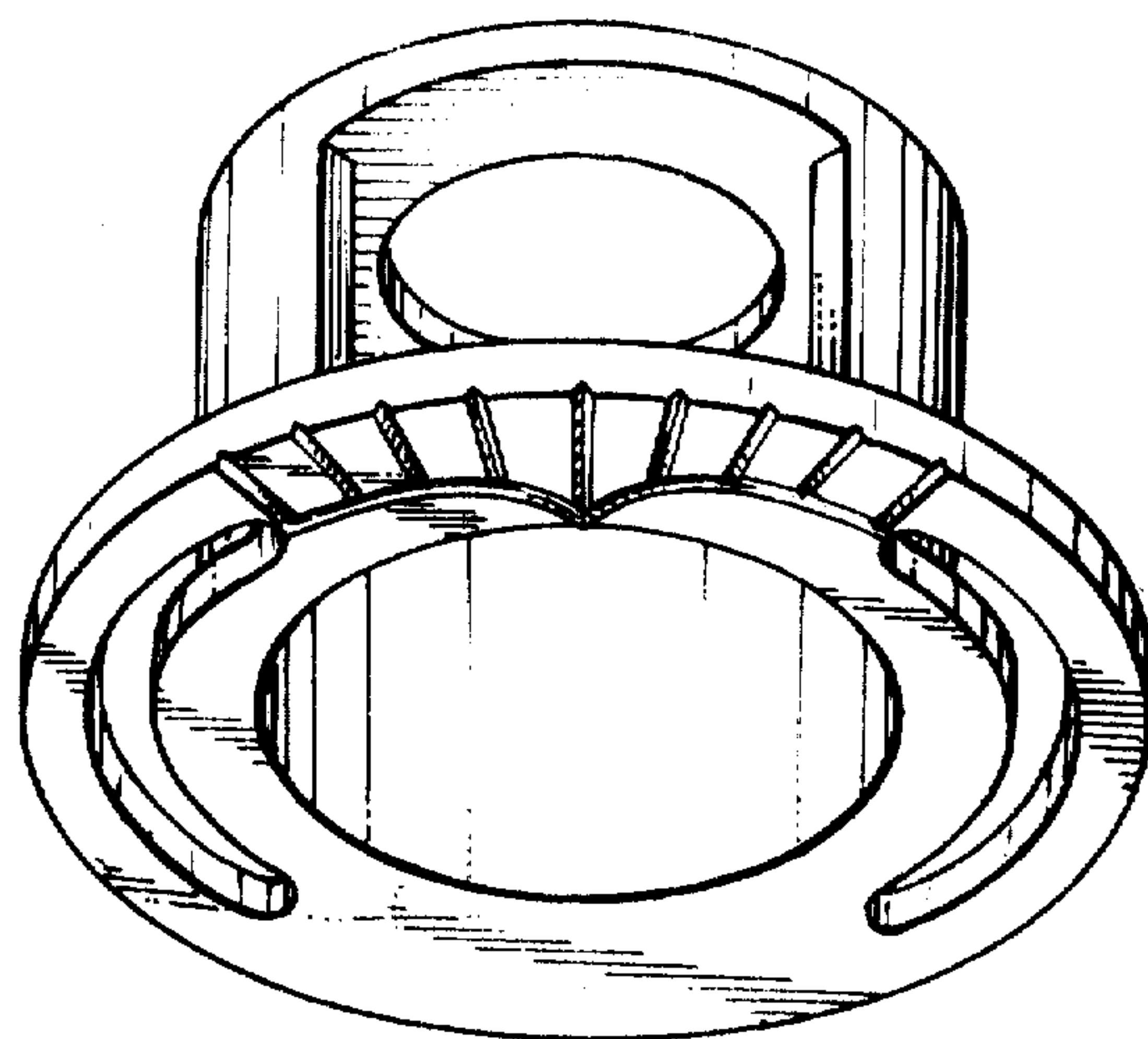

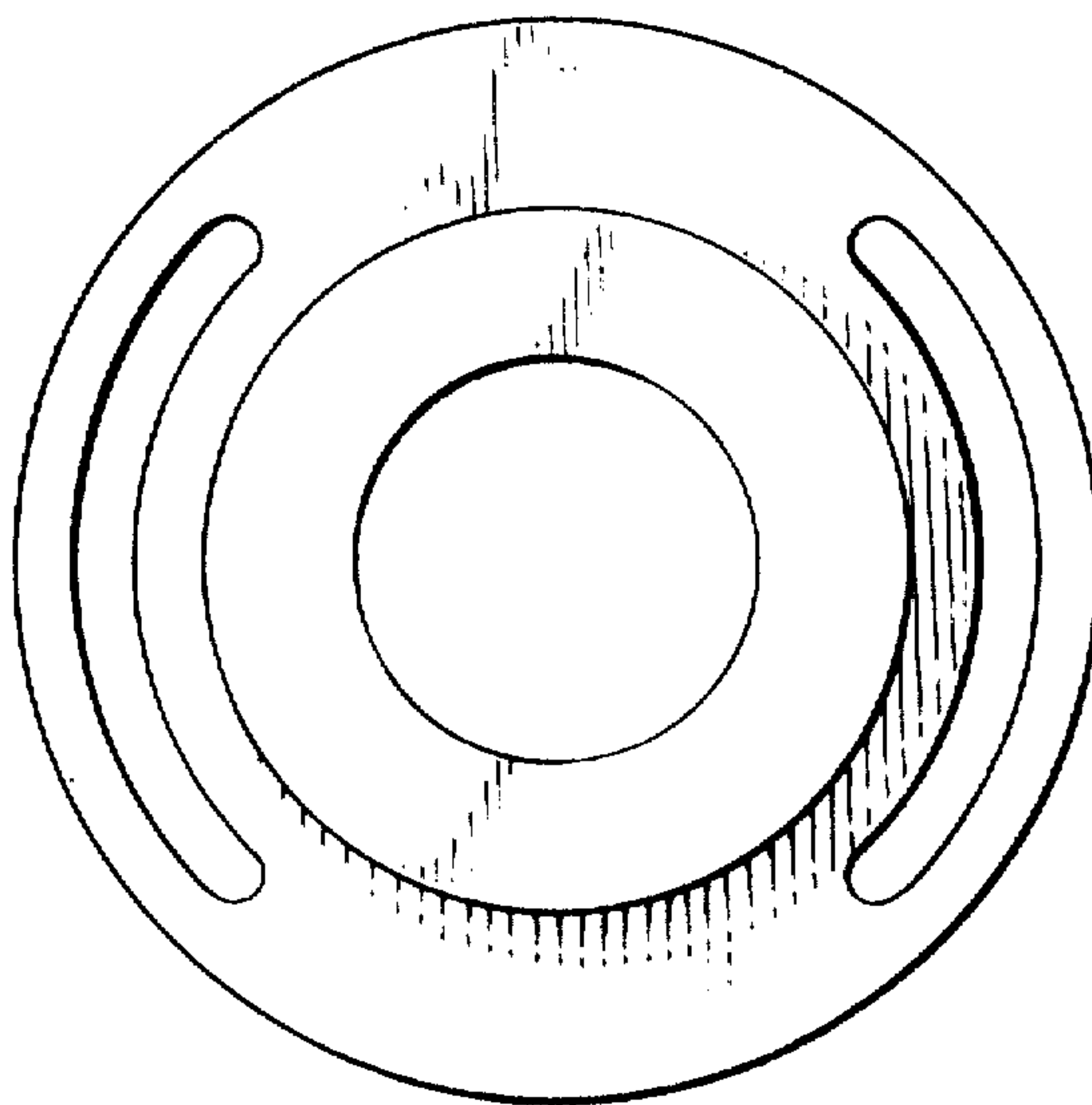
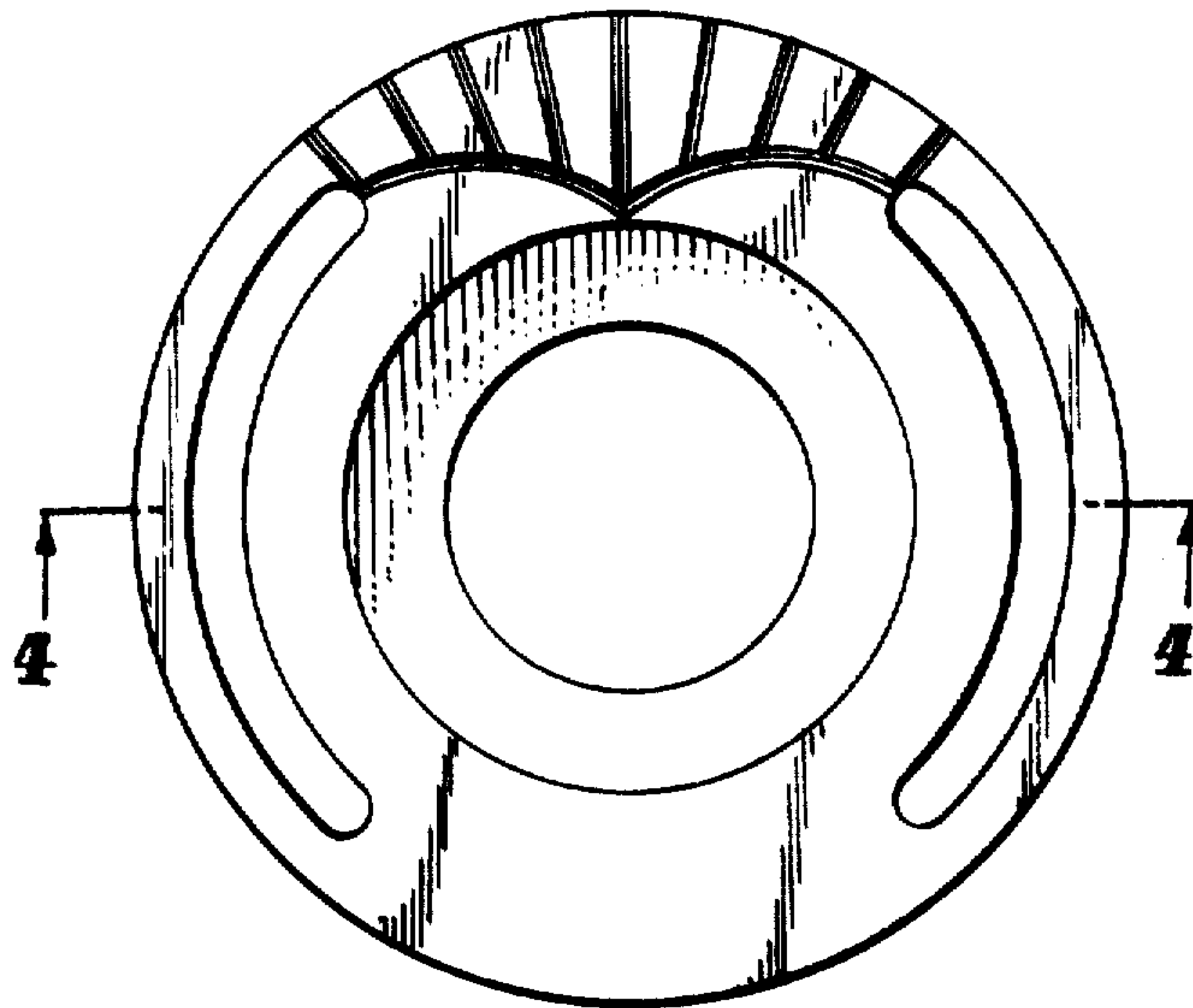
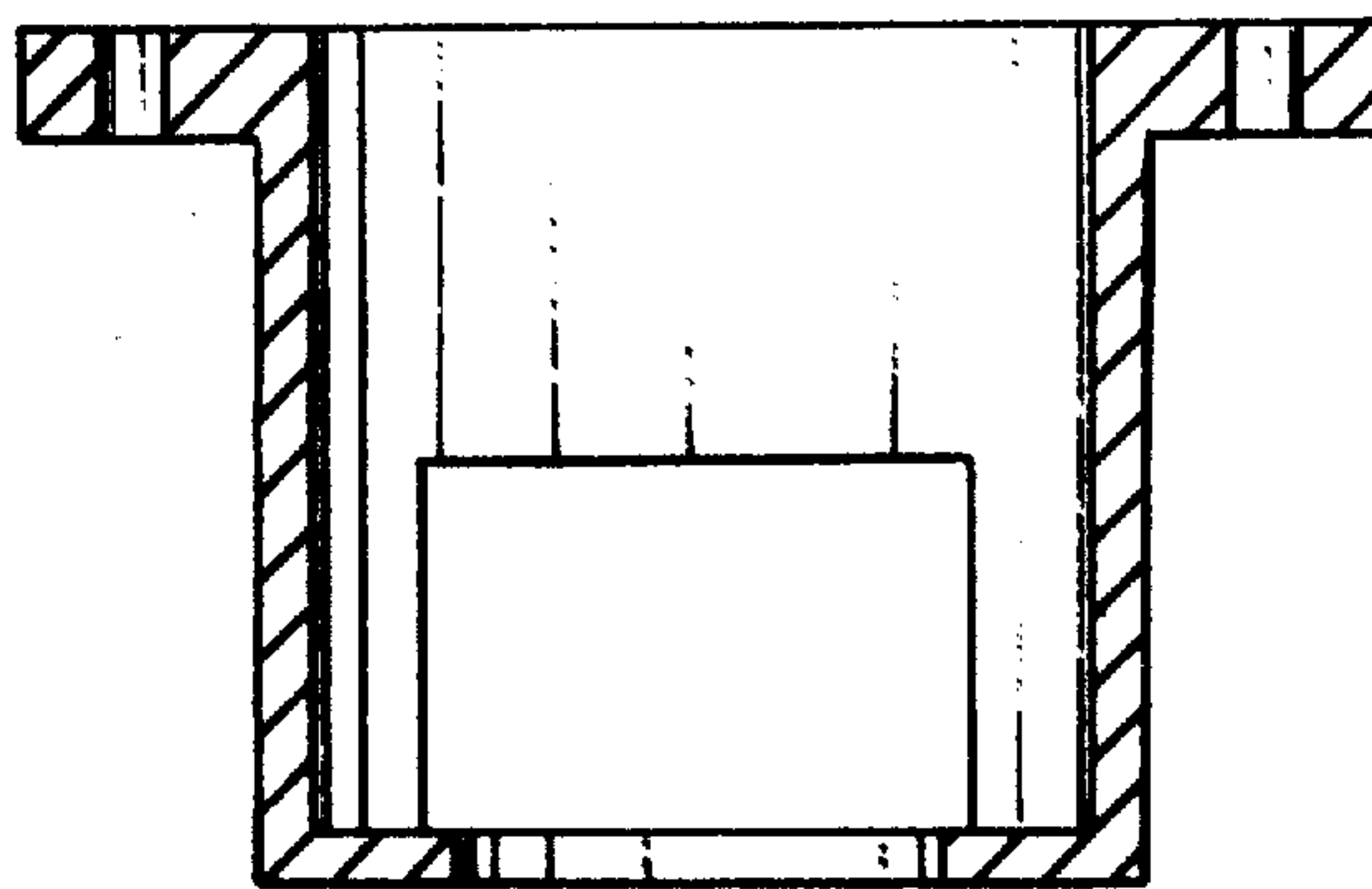
