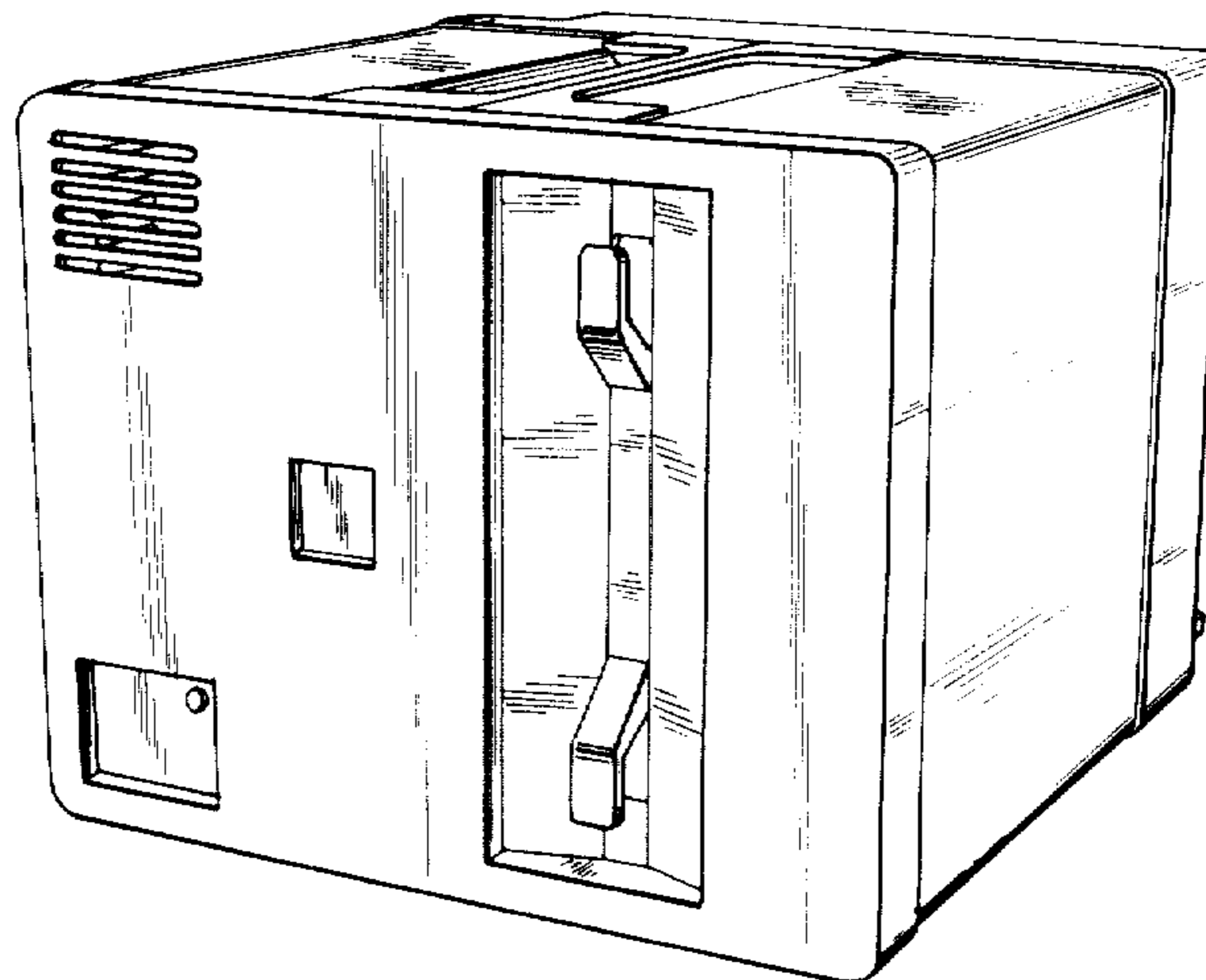
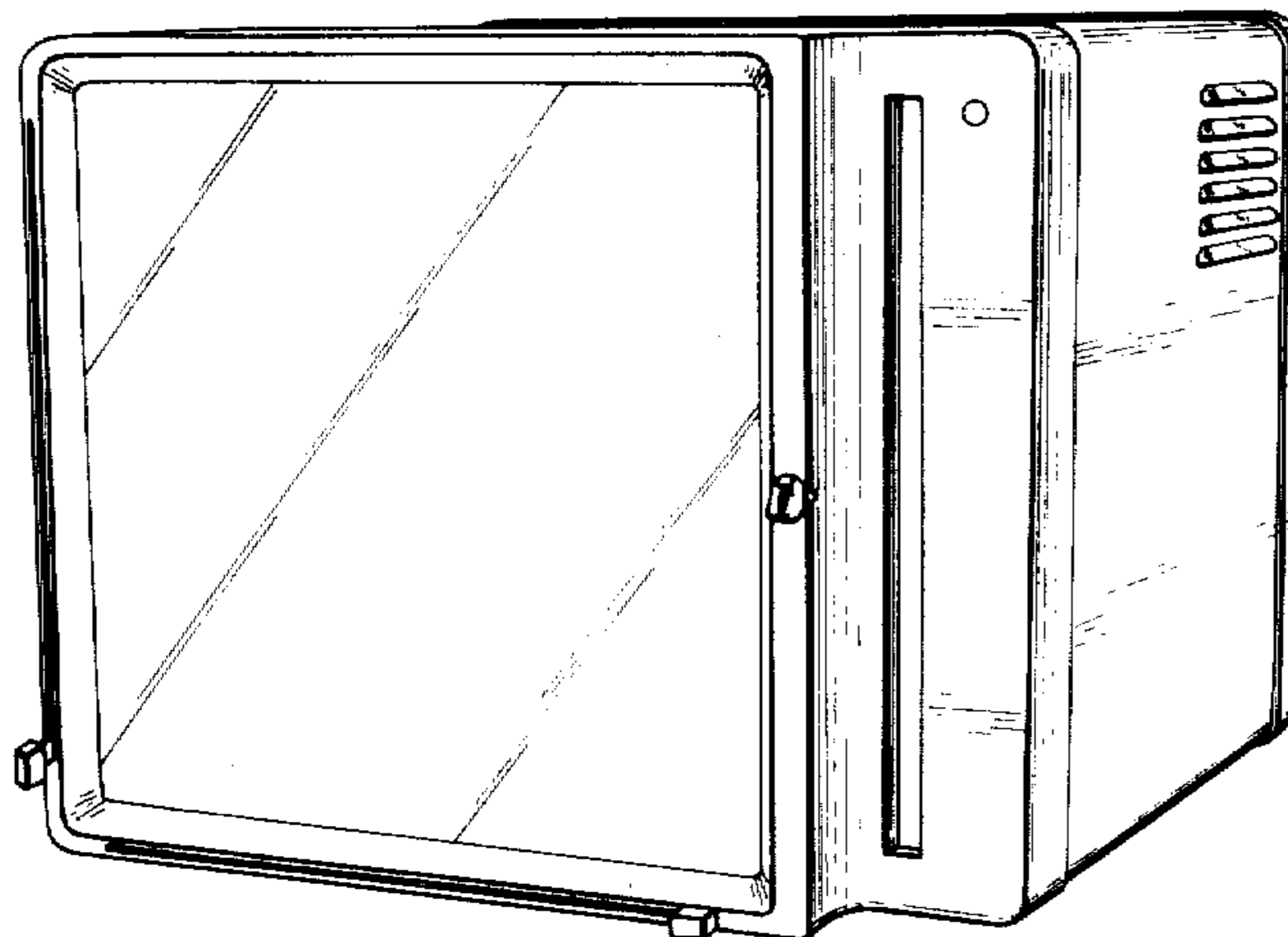

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a right front perspective view, showing the front and one side of my new microfilm reader; FIG. 2 is a left rear perspective view, showing the rear and the other side thereof; FIG. 3 is a top plan view thereof; and FIG. 4 is a bottom plan view thereof.



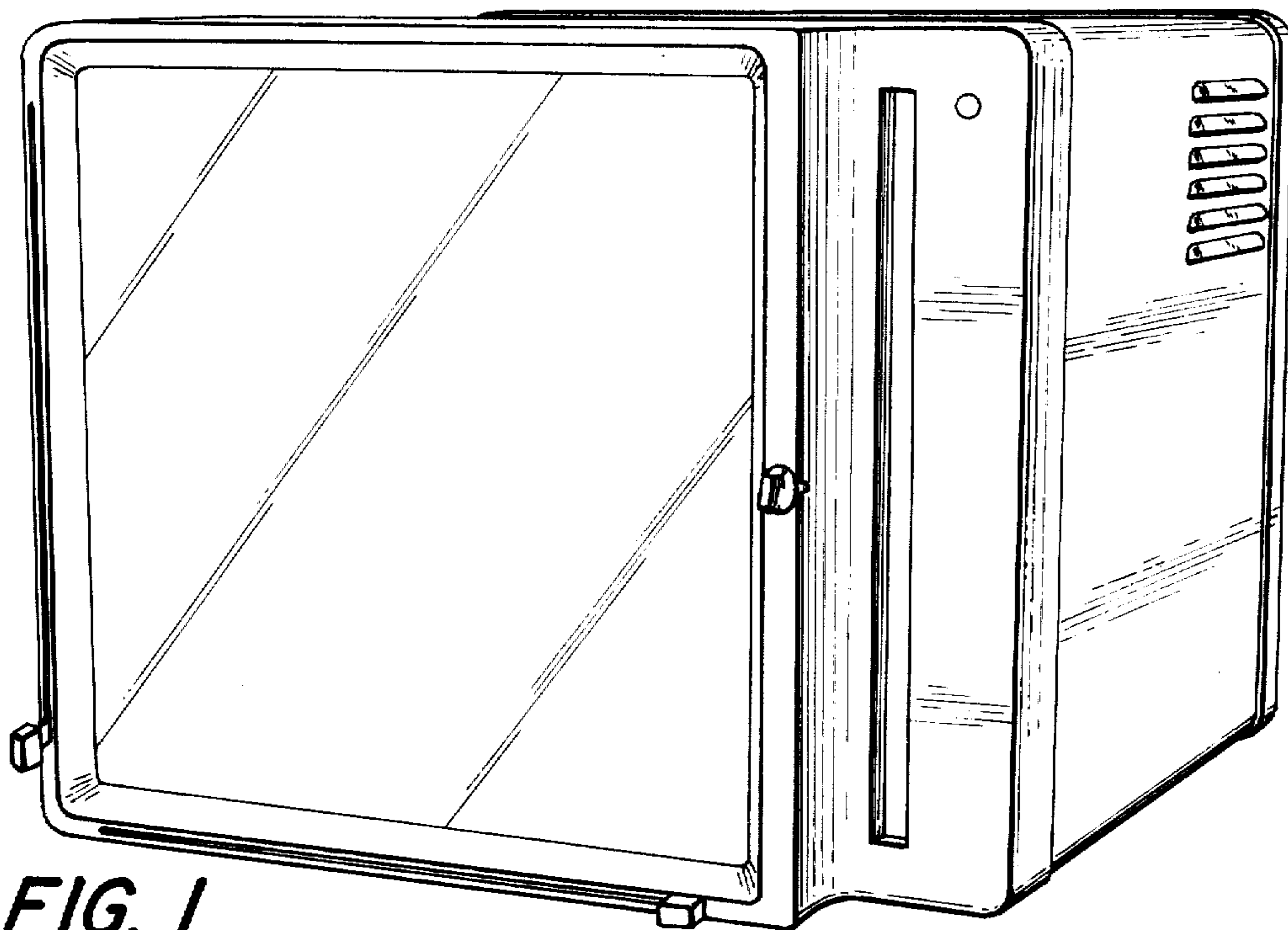

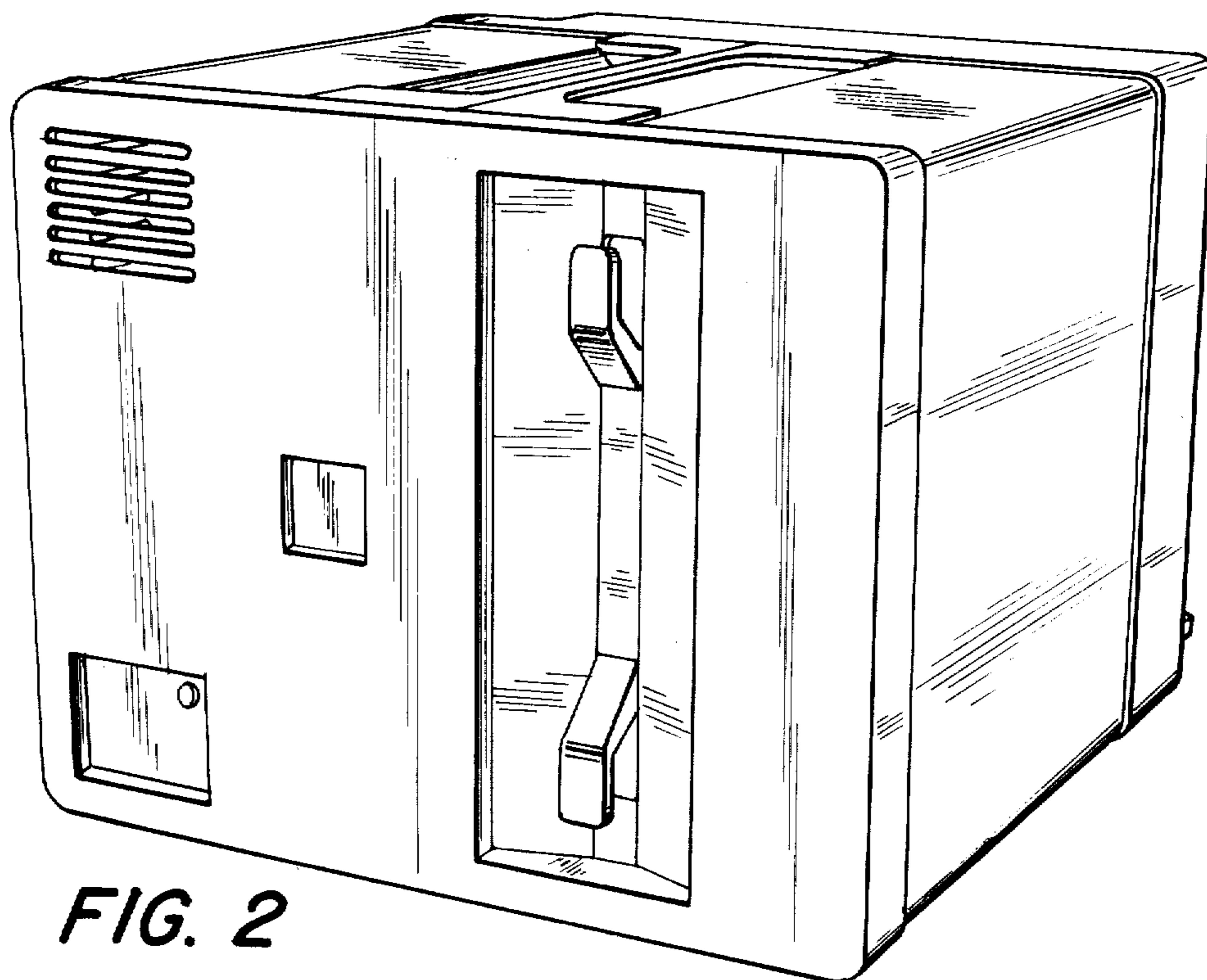

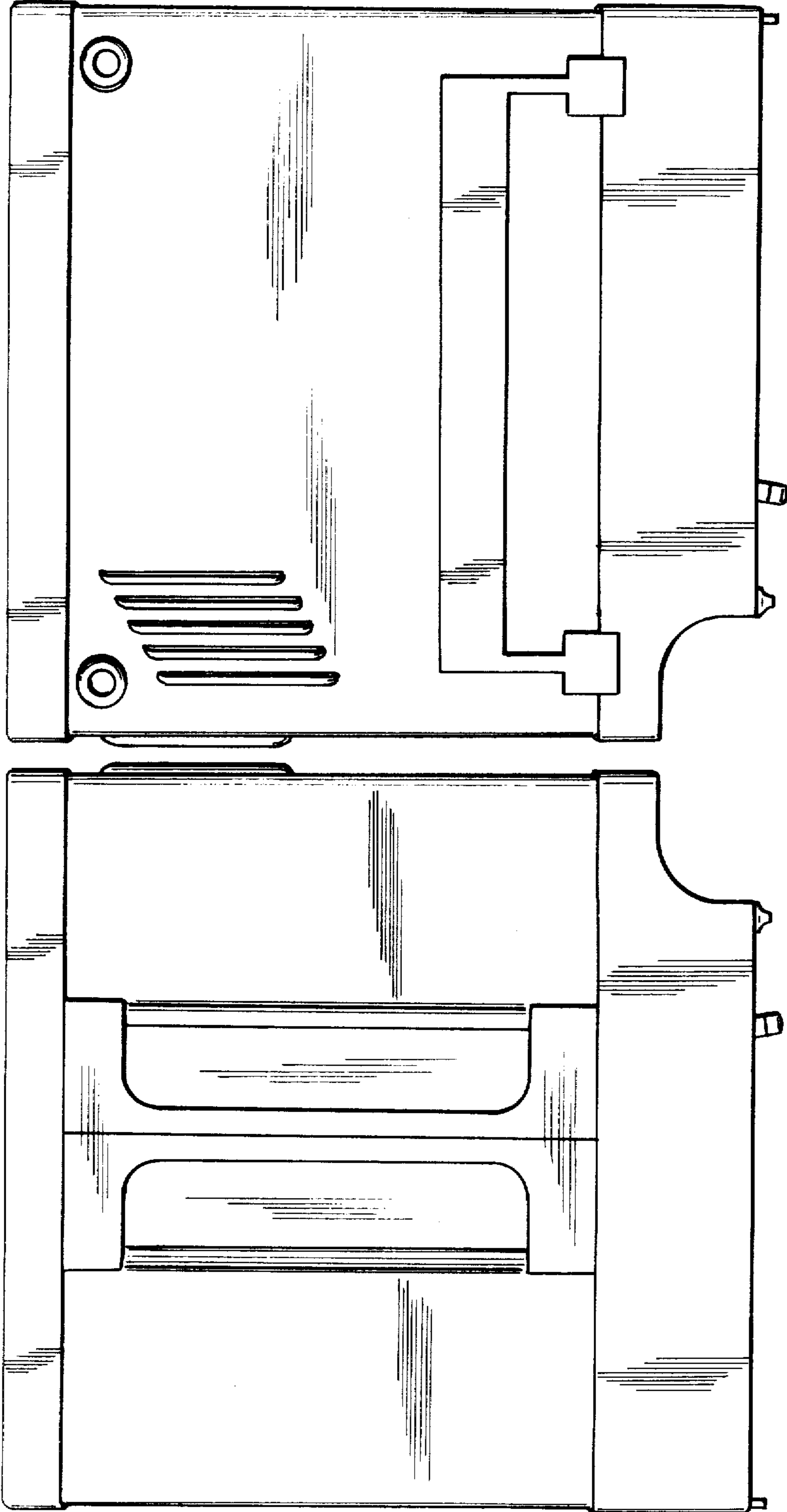
