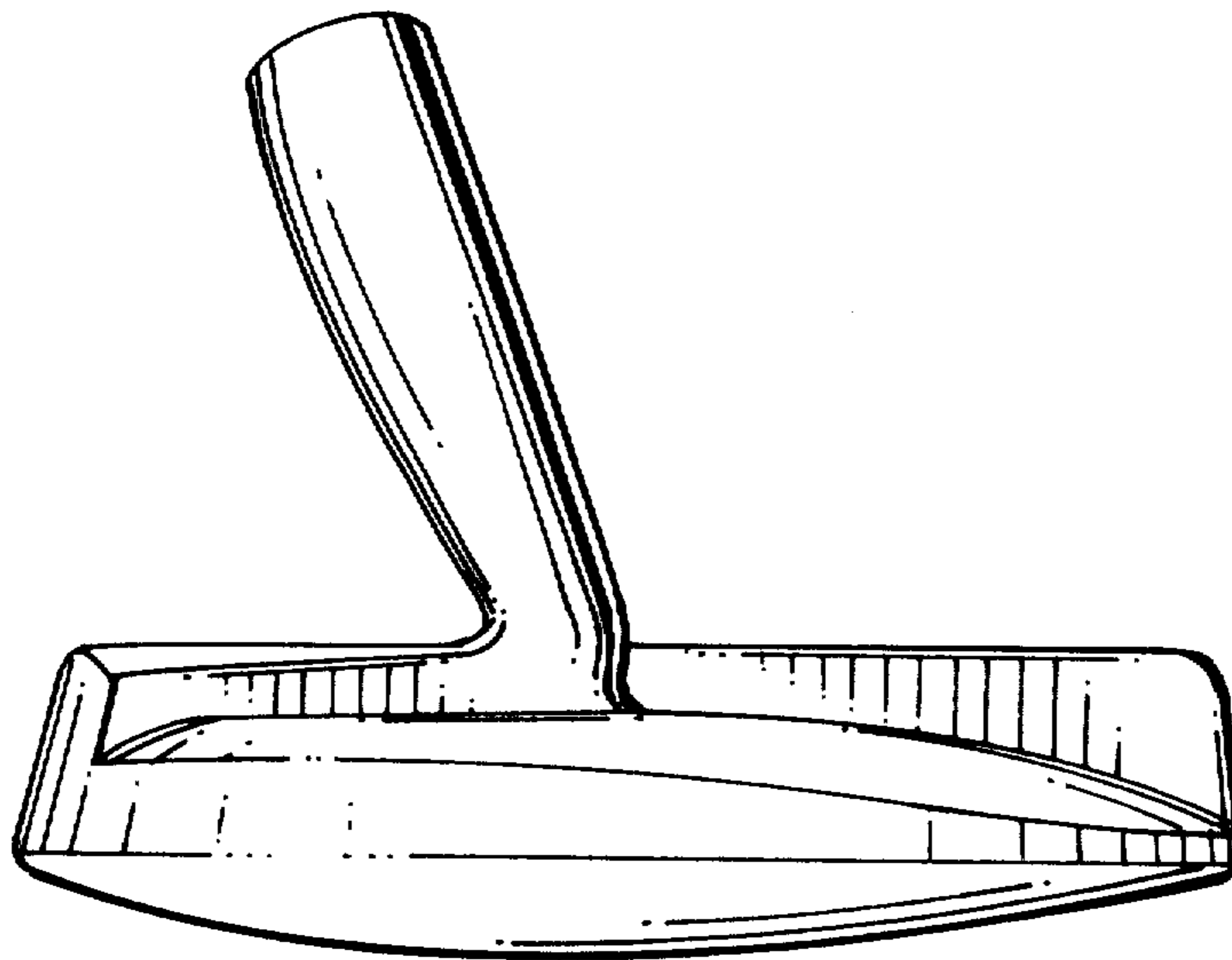

DESCRIPTION

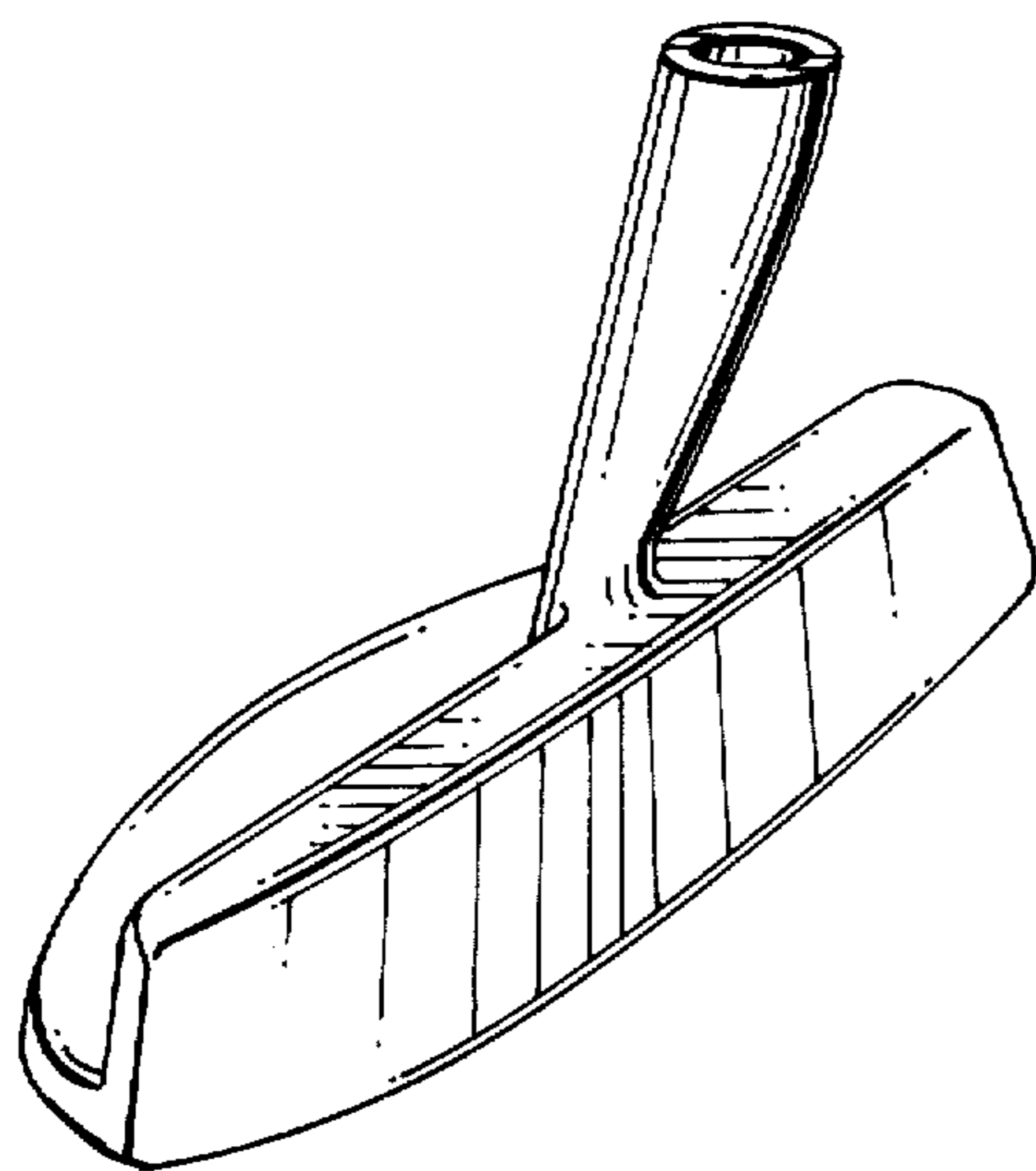

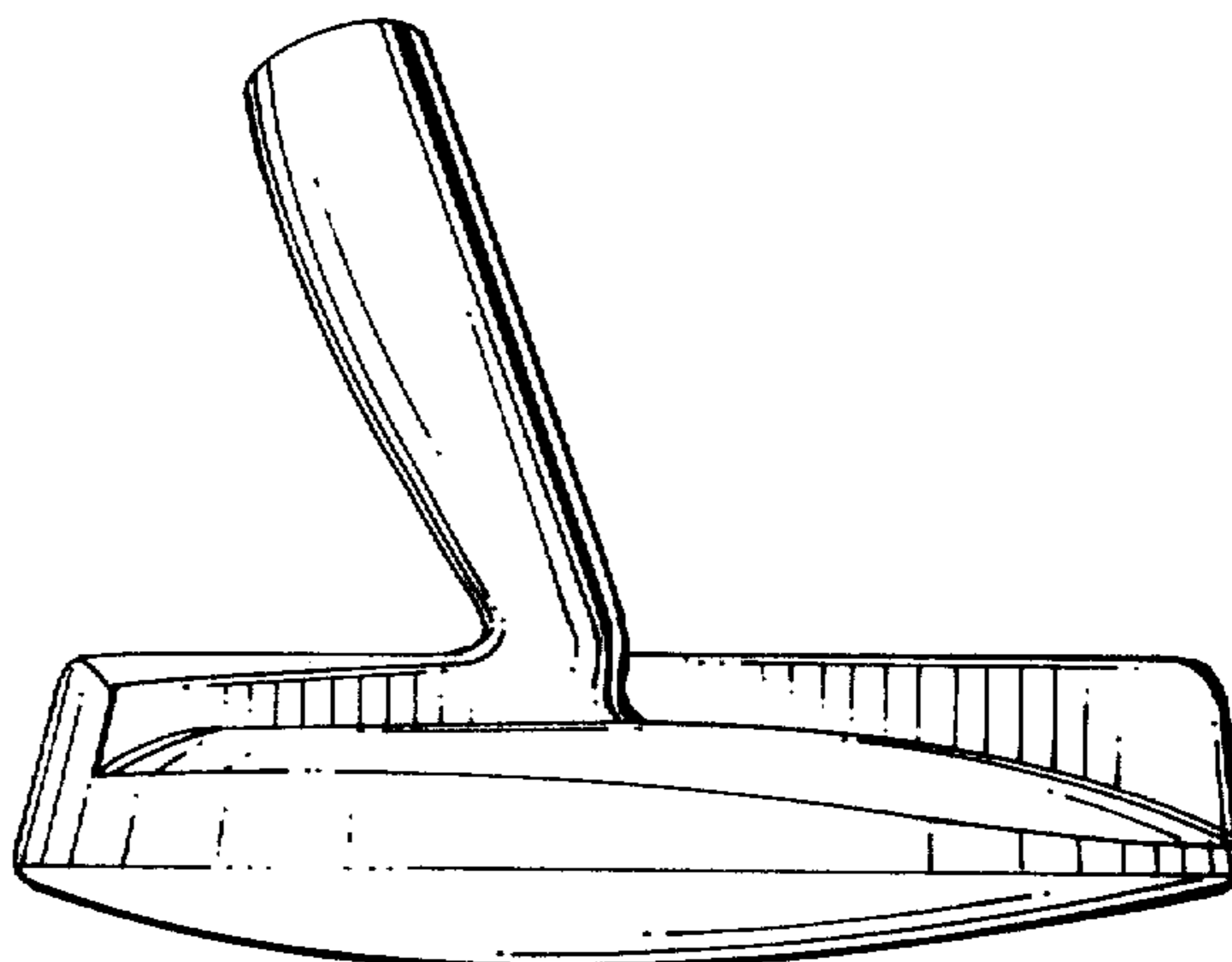

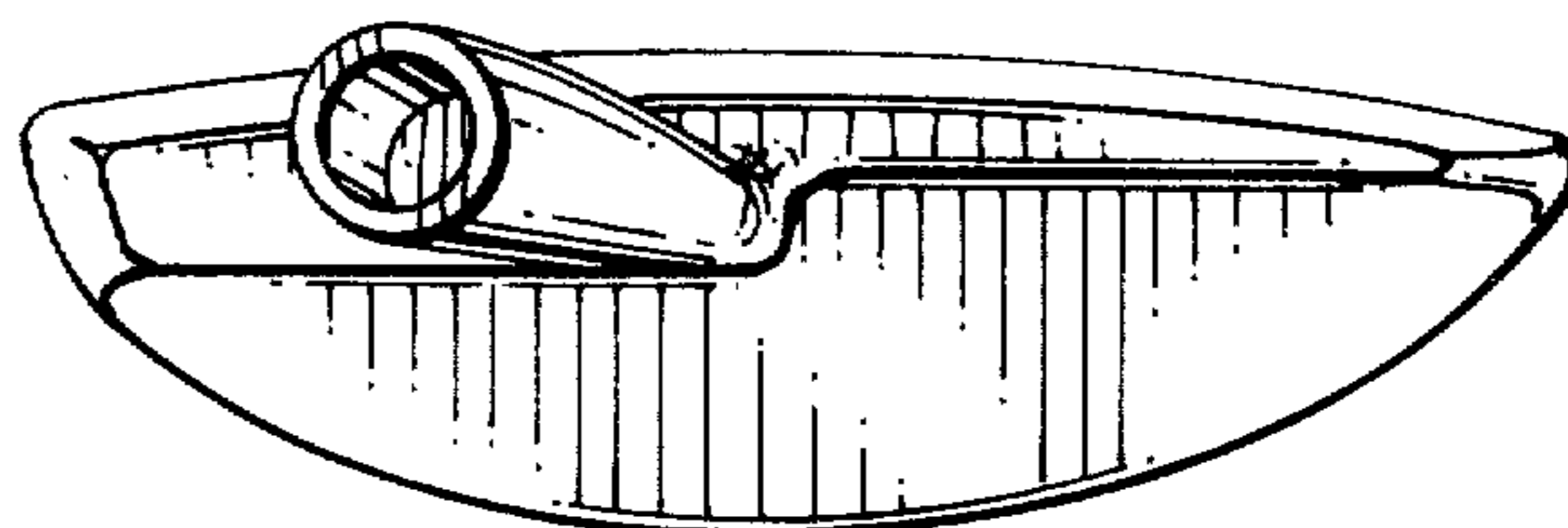

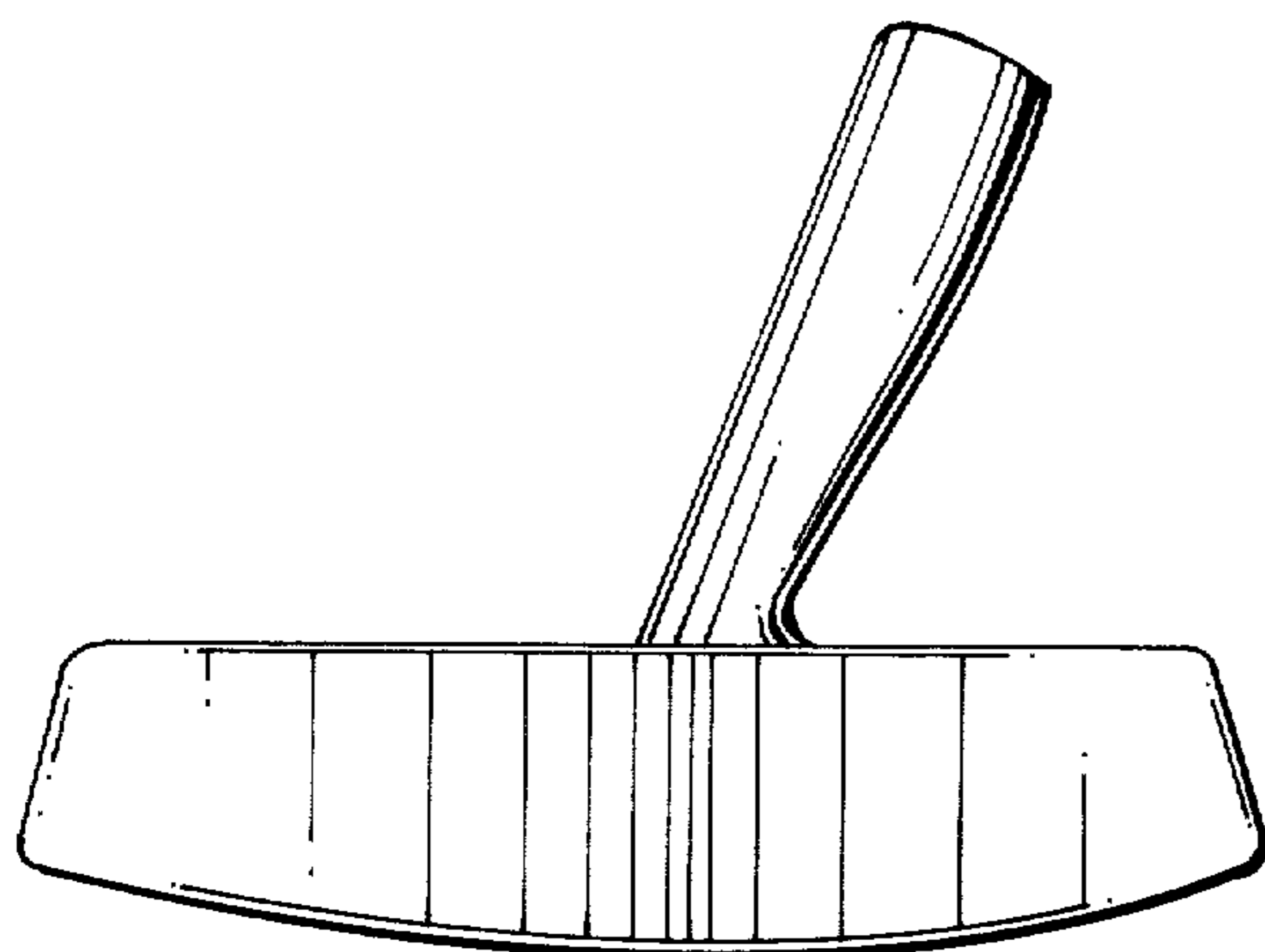

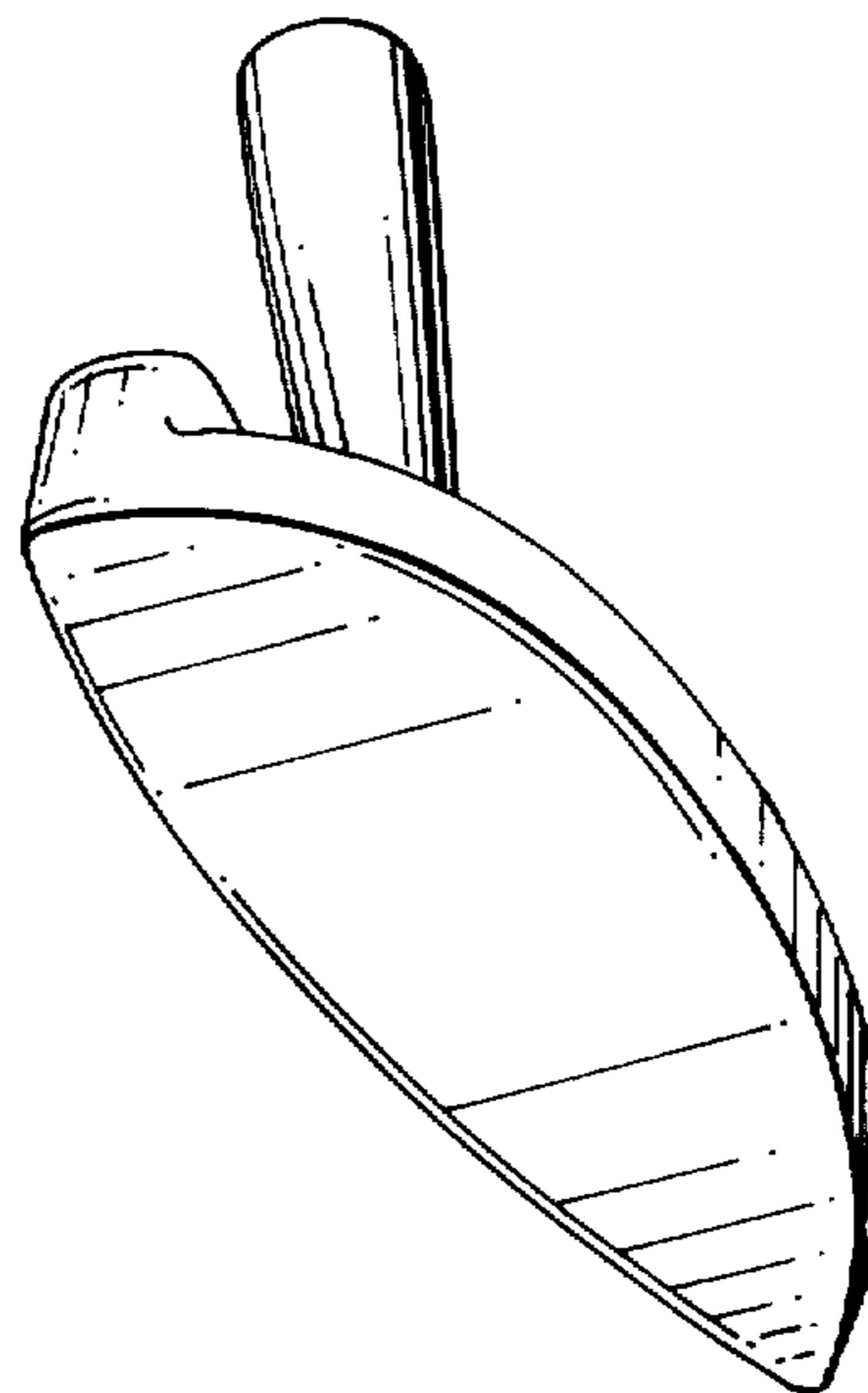

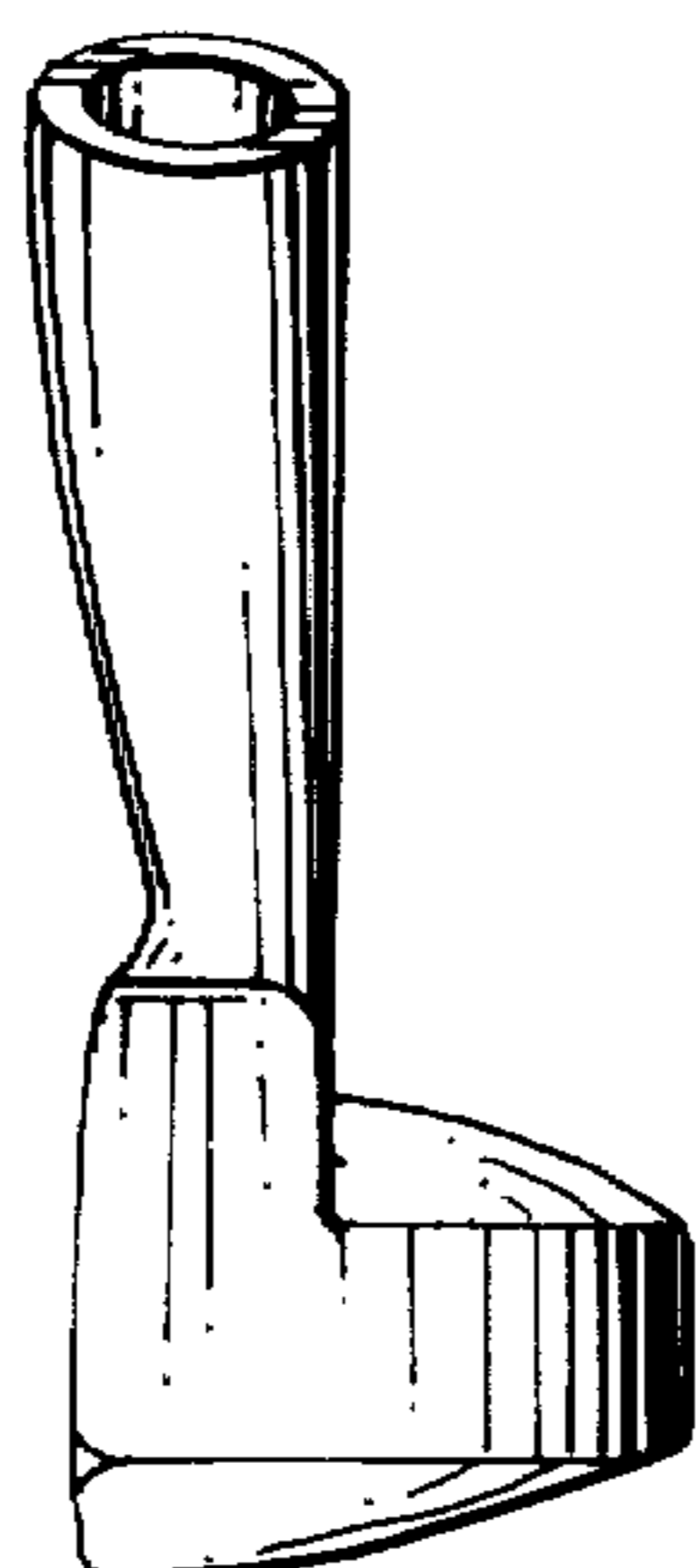
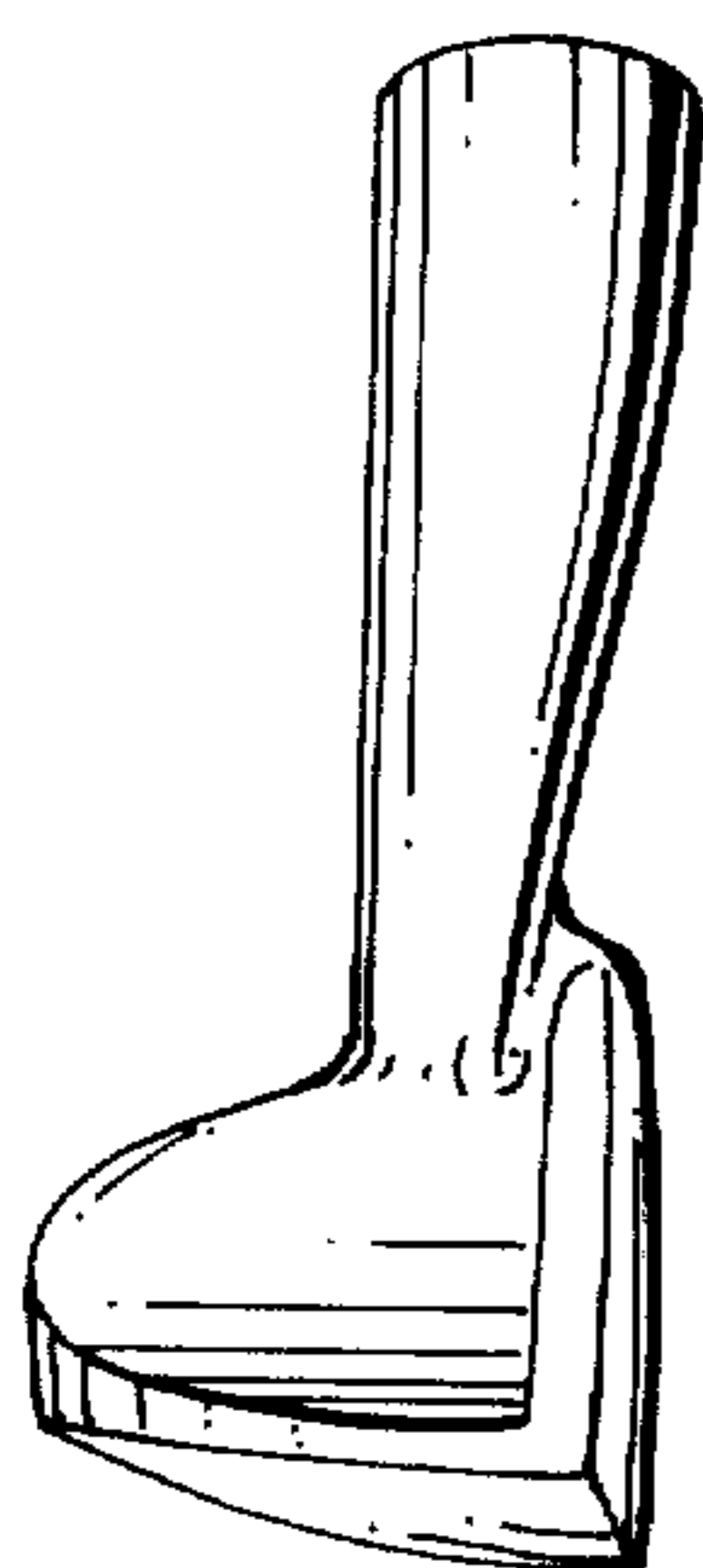


FIG. 6 FIG. 7
