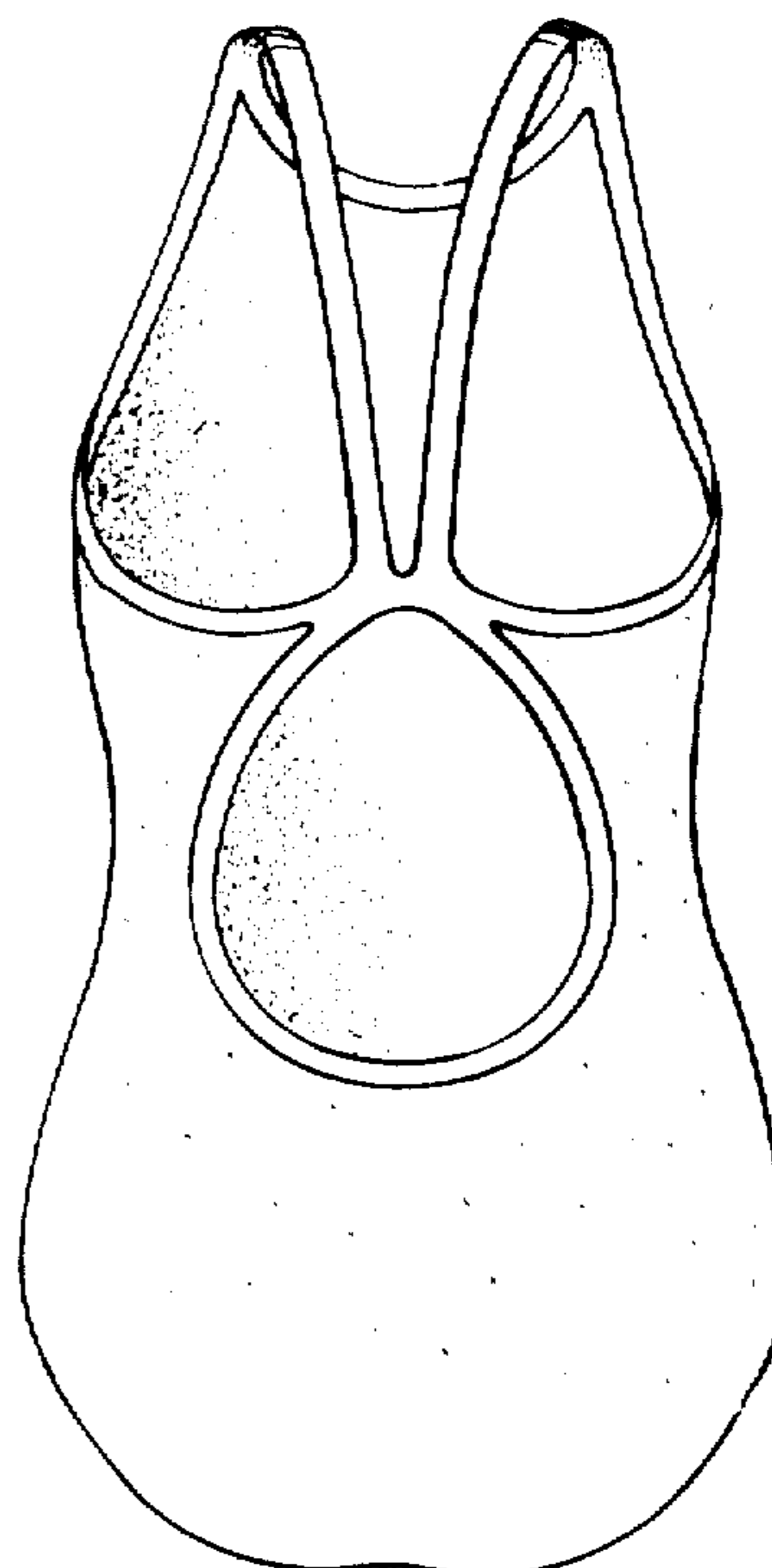
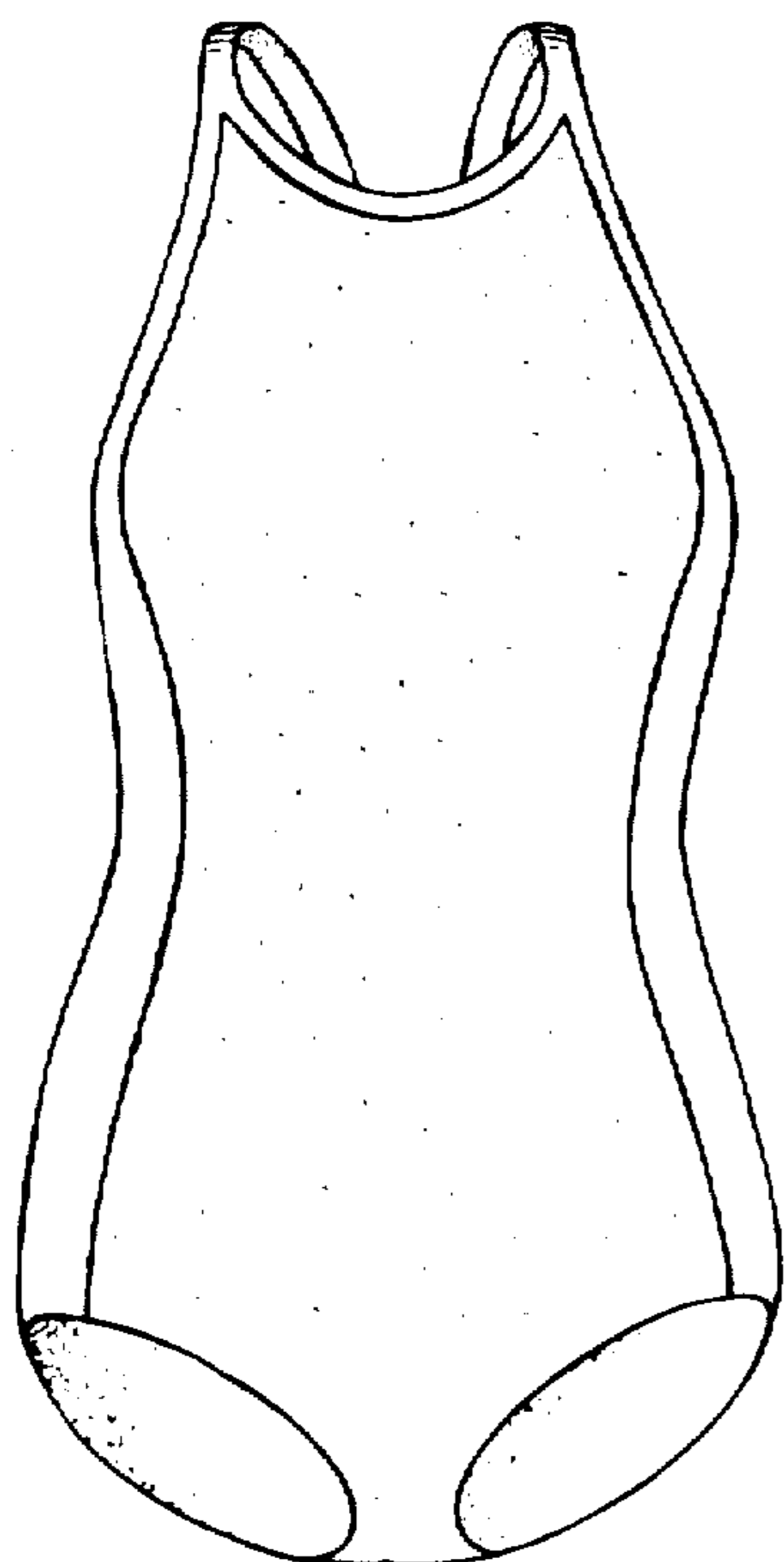

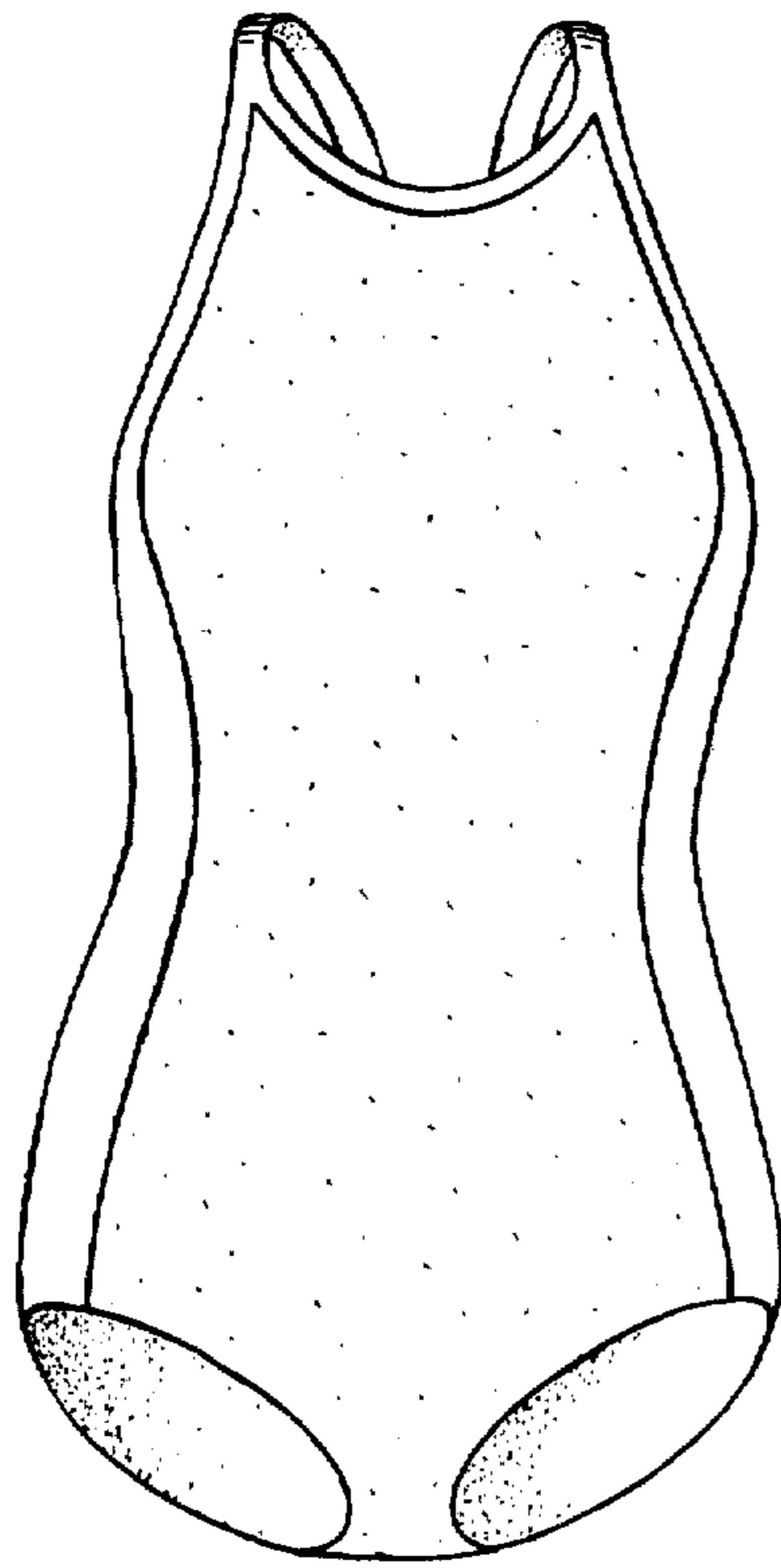
The ornamental design for a bathing suit, as shown and described.

**DESCRIPTION**

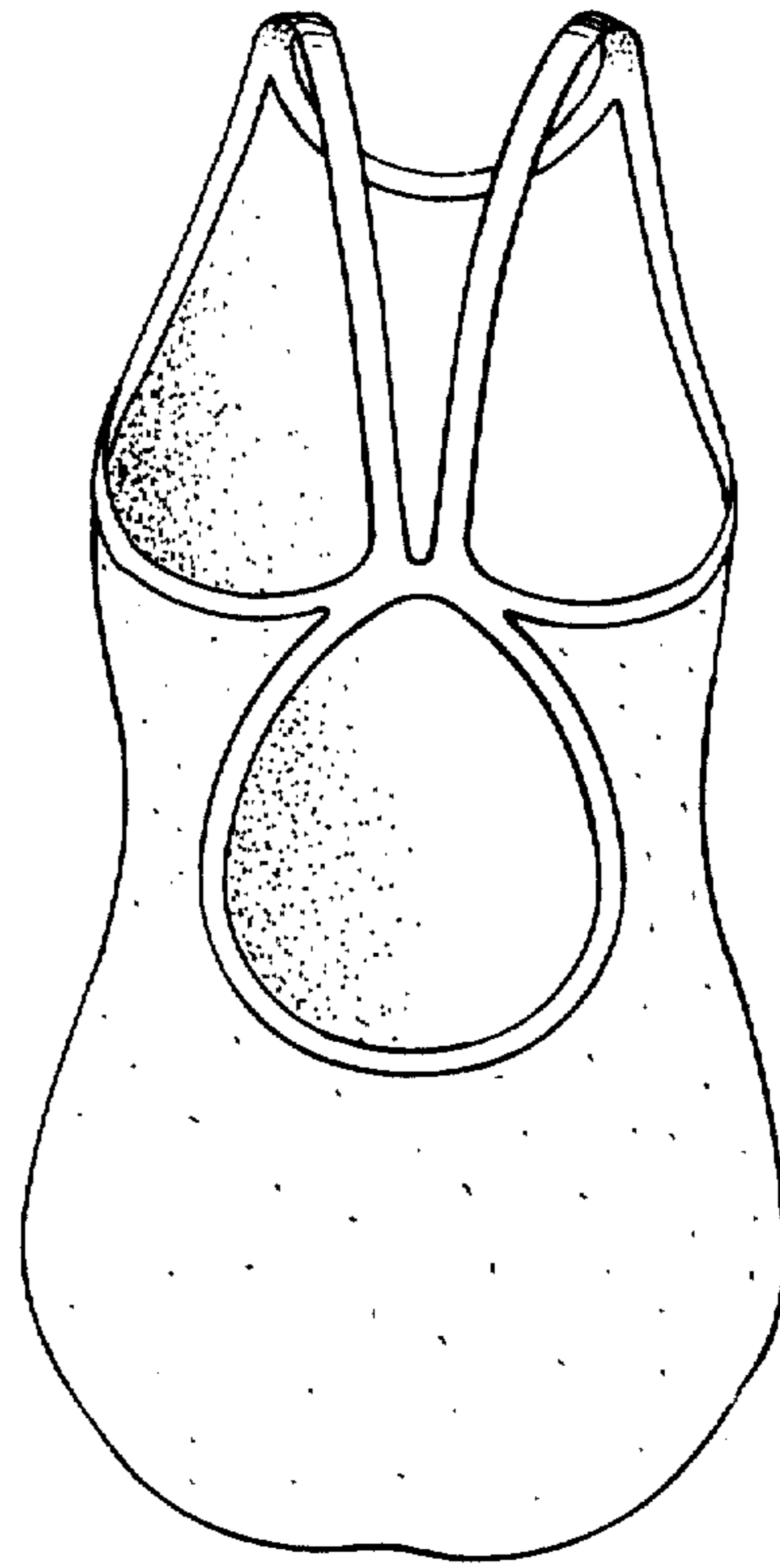
FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a bathing suit showing my new design;
