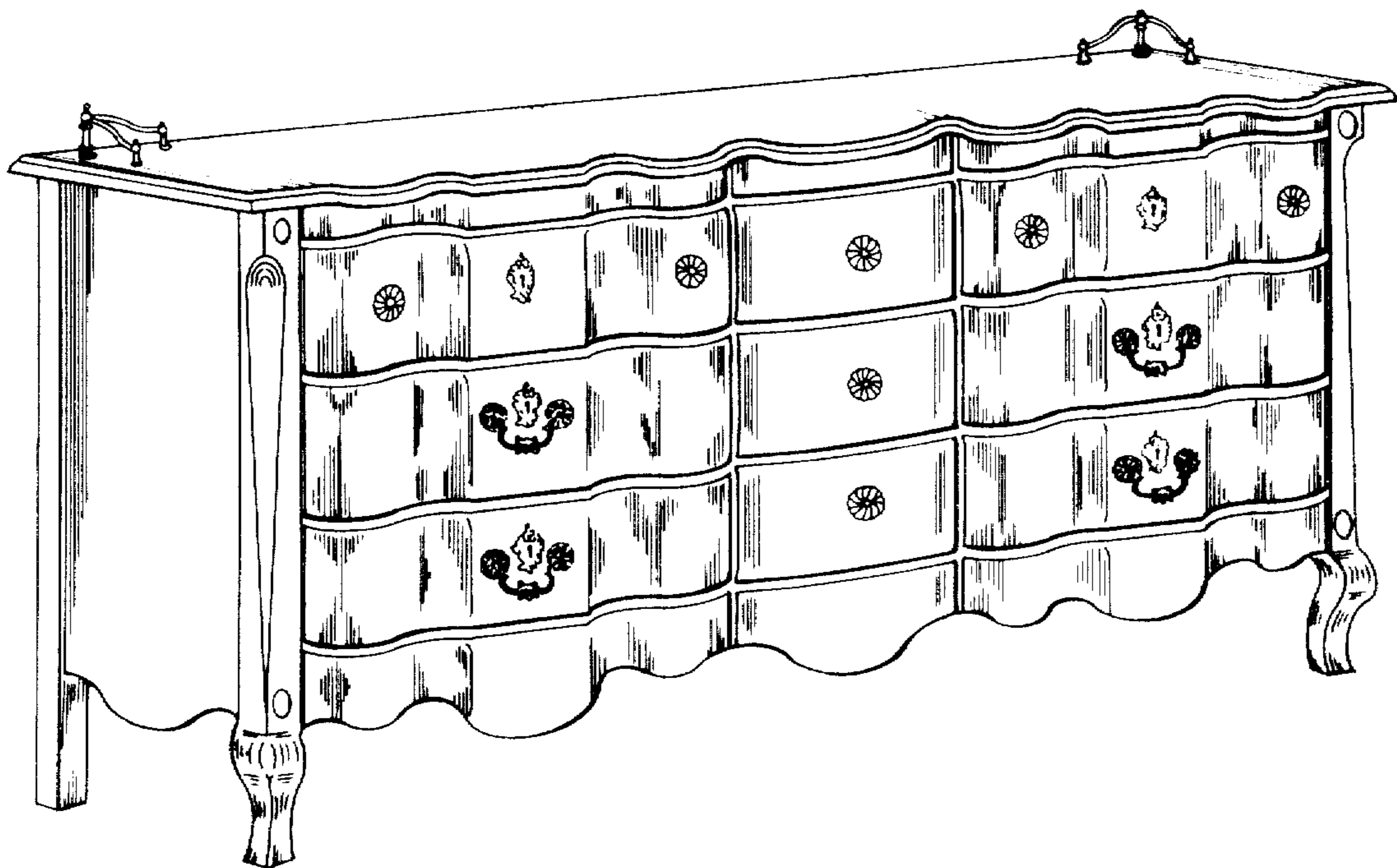

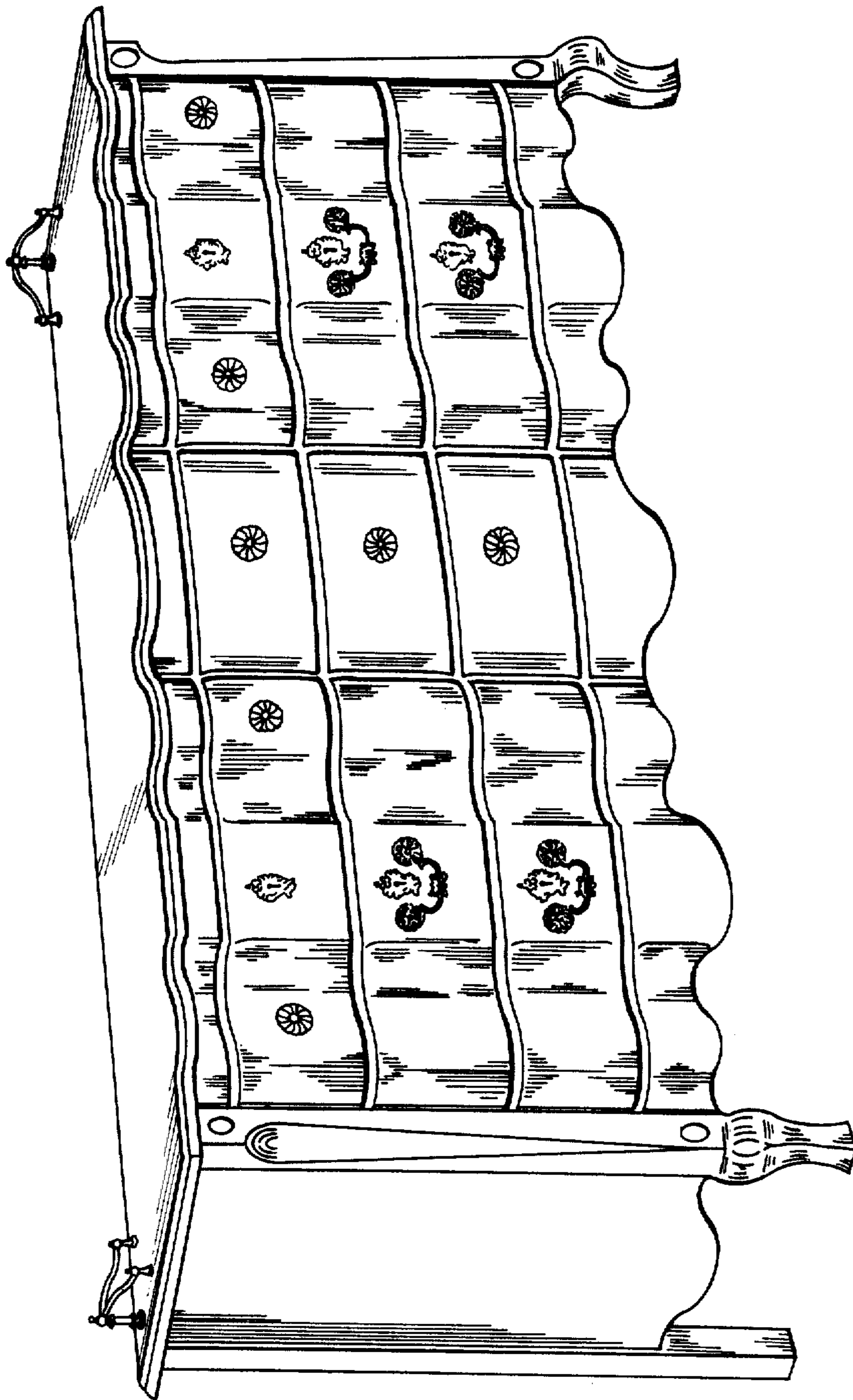
The ornamental design for a dresser or the like, as

**DESCRIPTION**

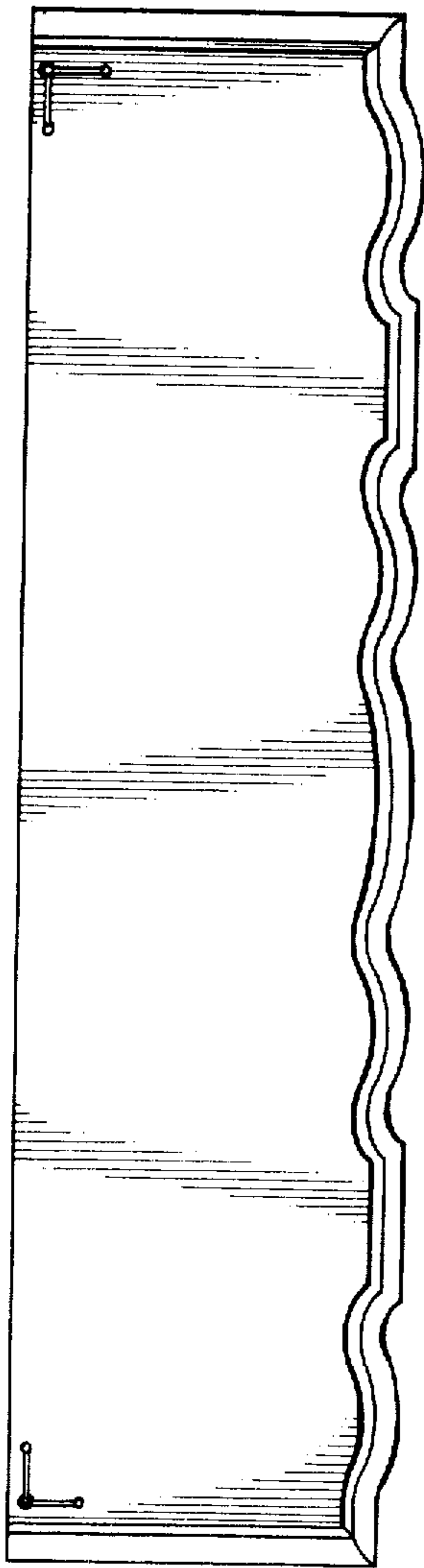
FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of the dresser or the

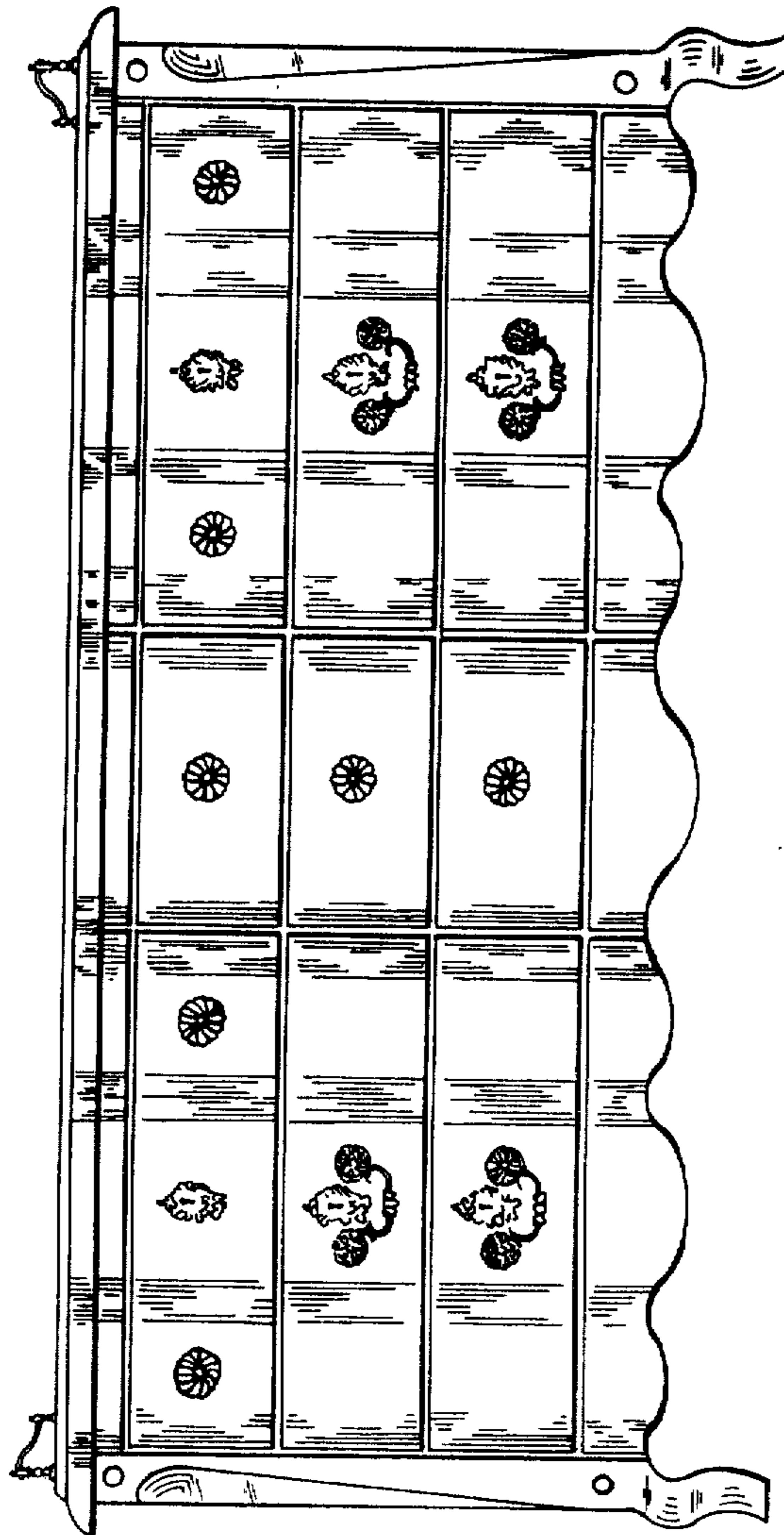




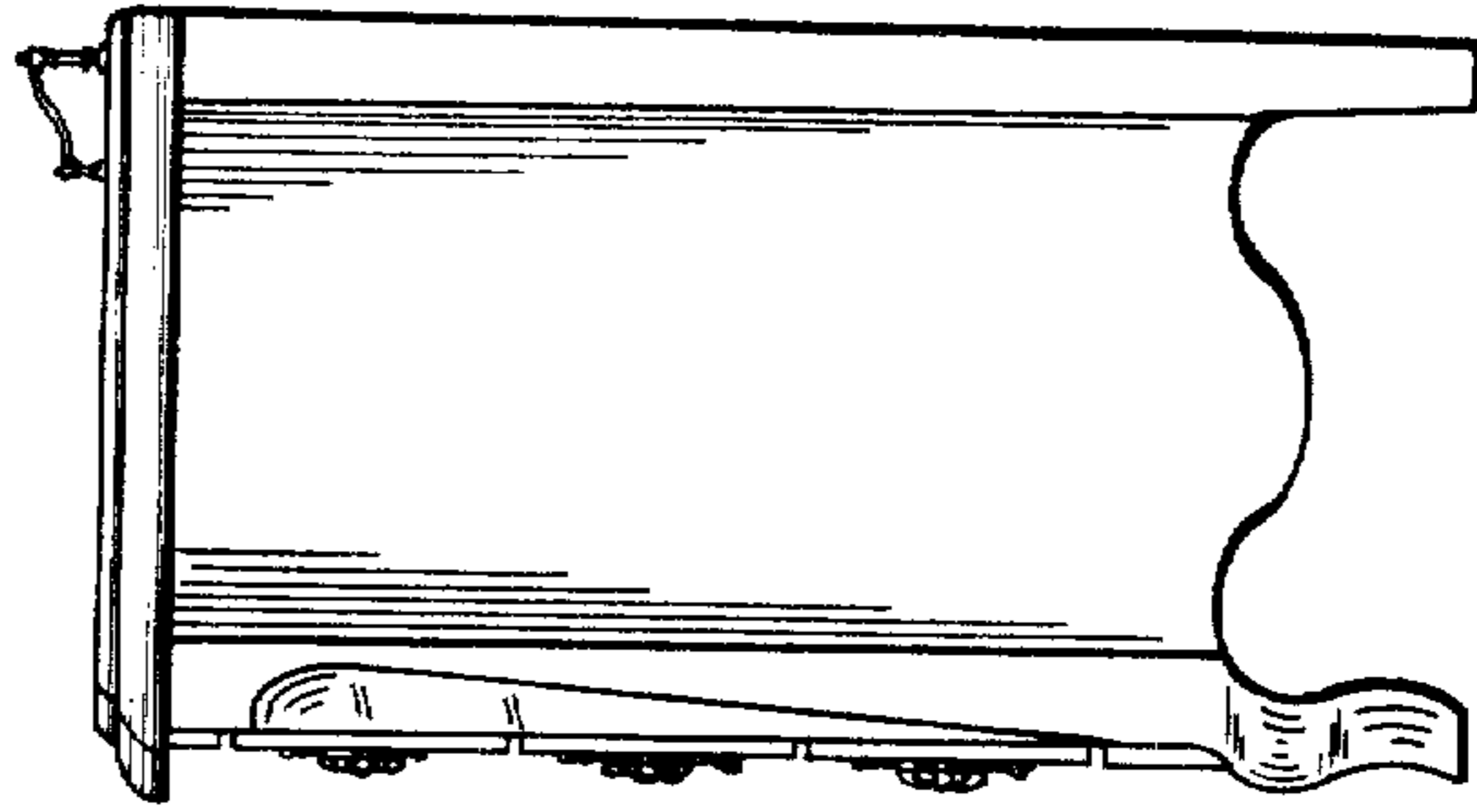
