[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a dresser or the like, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of the dresser or the like showing our new design, the rear thereof being substantially plain and unornamented;

FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof, the bottom being substantially plain and unornamented;

FIG. 3 is a right side elevational view thereof, the left side being a mirror image of that shown; and

FIG. 4 is a front elevational view thereof.
