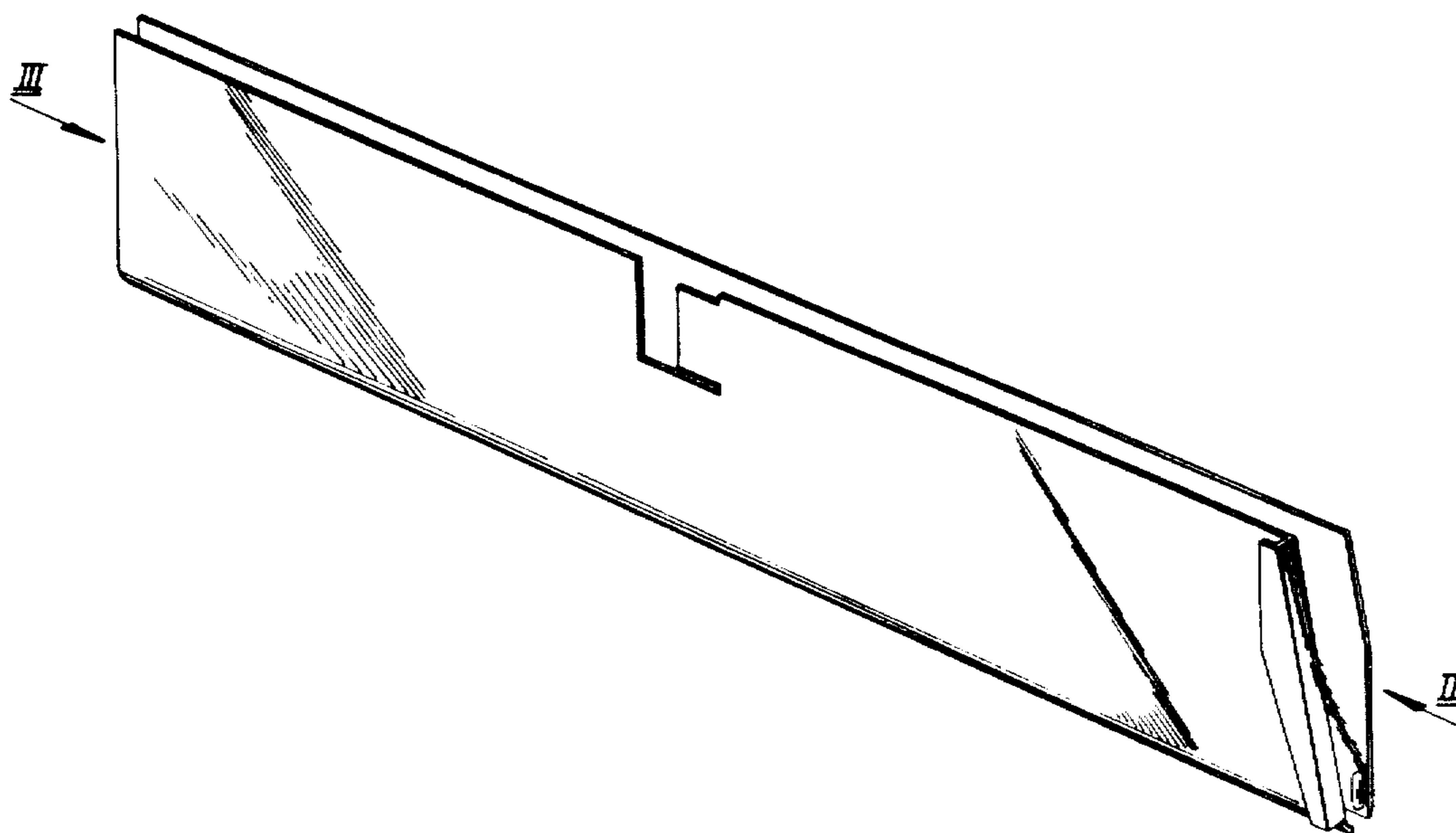

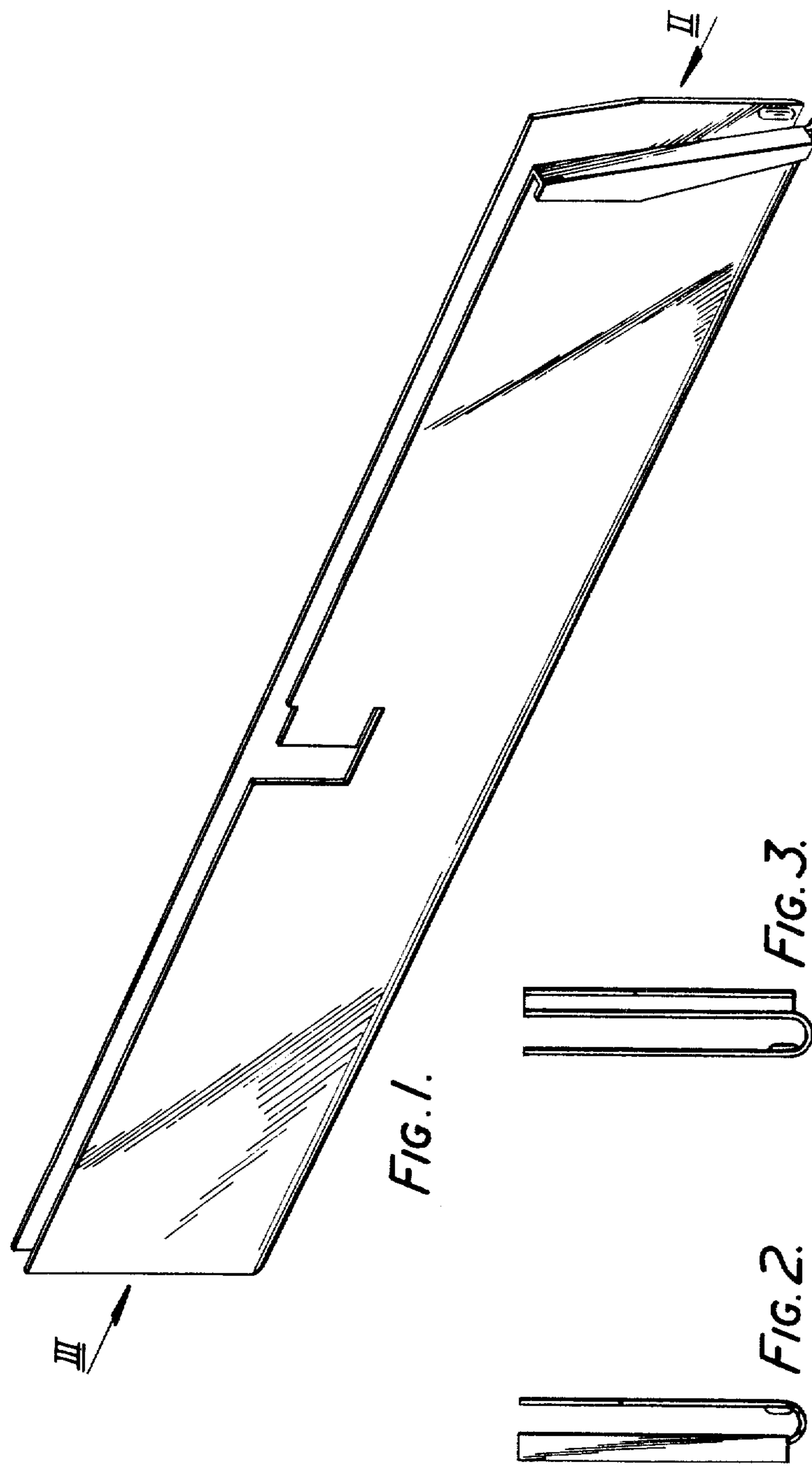
[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a furniture support bracket, substantially as shown.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a furniture support bracket embodying our new design, FIG. 2 is an end elevation as seen in the direction indicated by an arrow II in FIG. 1, FIG. 3 is an opposite end elevation as seen in the direction indicated by an arrow III in FIG. 1, FIG. 4 is a side elevation of the furniture support bracket, FIG. 5 is a top plan view, and FIG. 6 is an opposite side elevation.





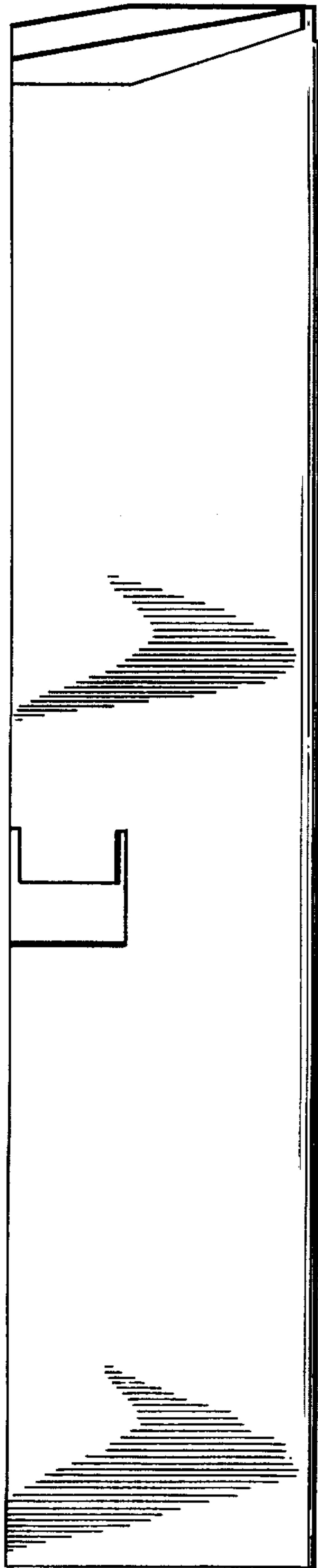

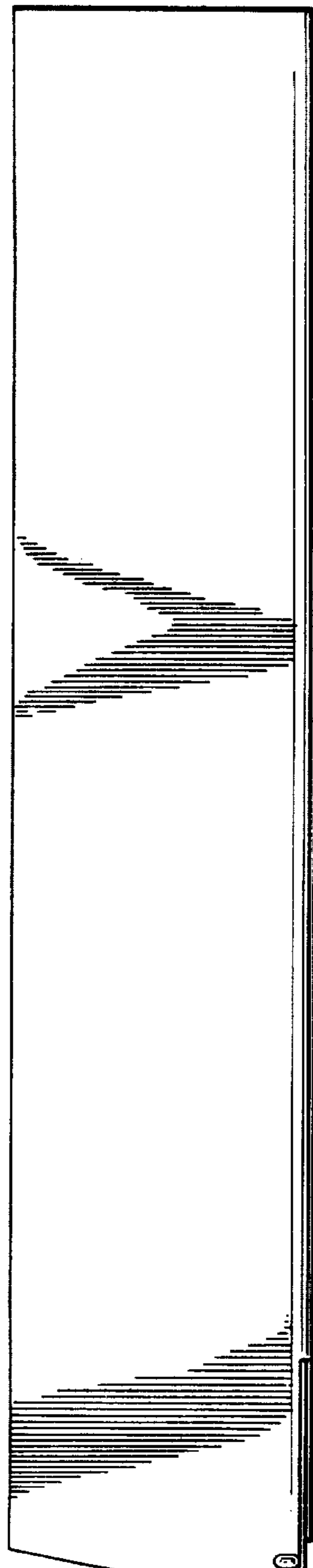
