The ornamental design for an anti-sway attachment for dump trailer, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is an elevational view of one side of an anti-sway attachment for dump trailer, showing my new design, the opposite side being a mirror image thereof, the broken line indicating a towing vehicle draft bar forming no part of the design and being shown merely to illustrate the environment;

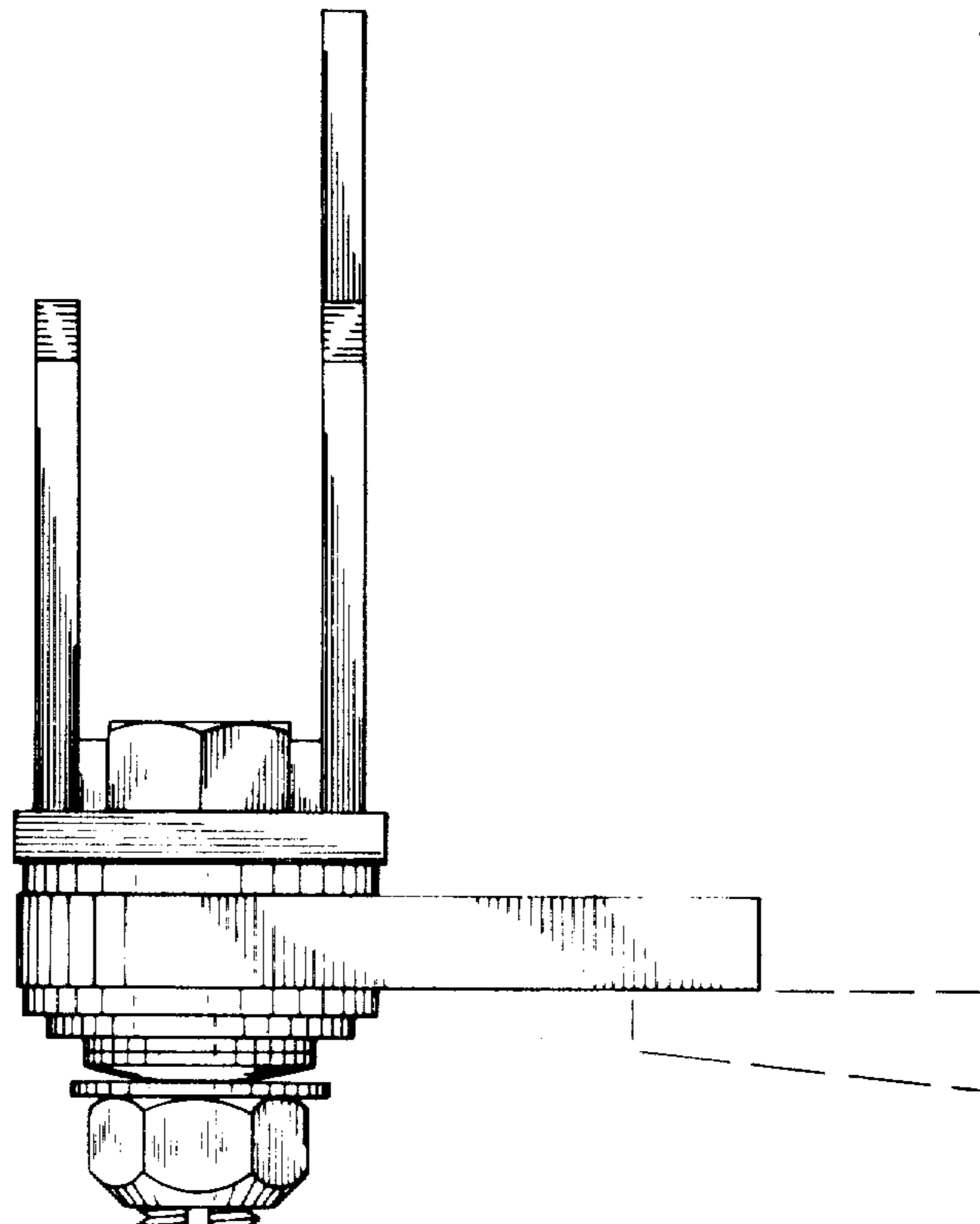
FIG. 2 is a rear elevational view;

FIG. 6 is a sectional view taken along the line 6-6 in FIG. 4.



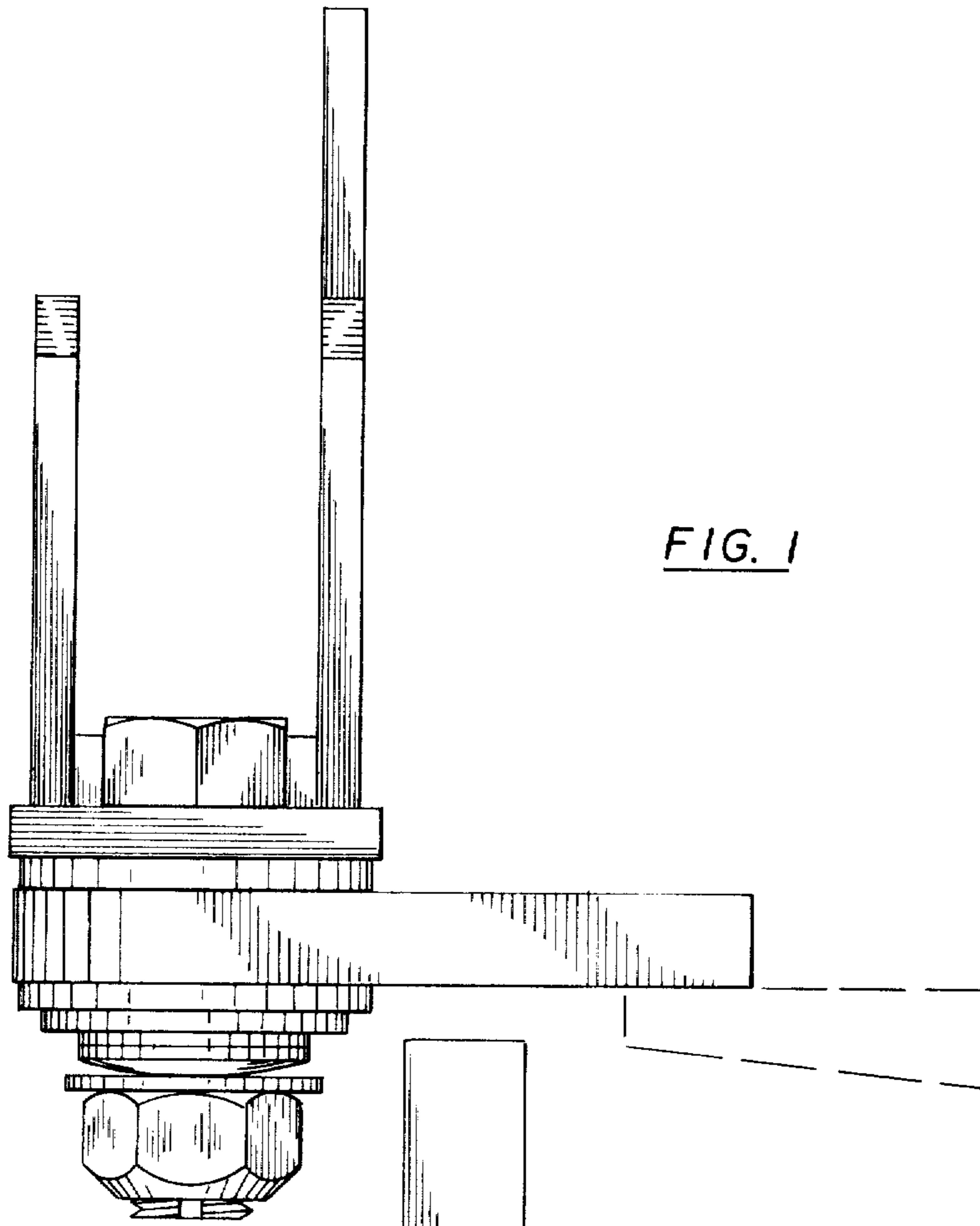

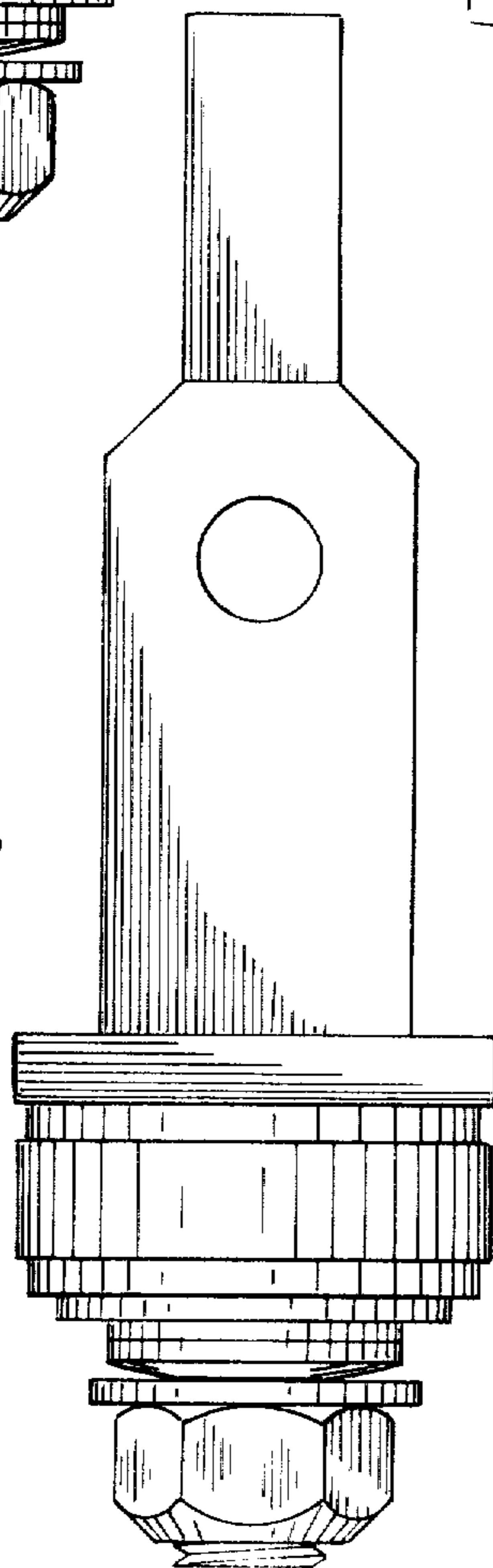
