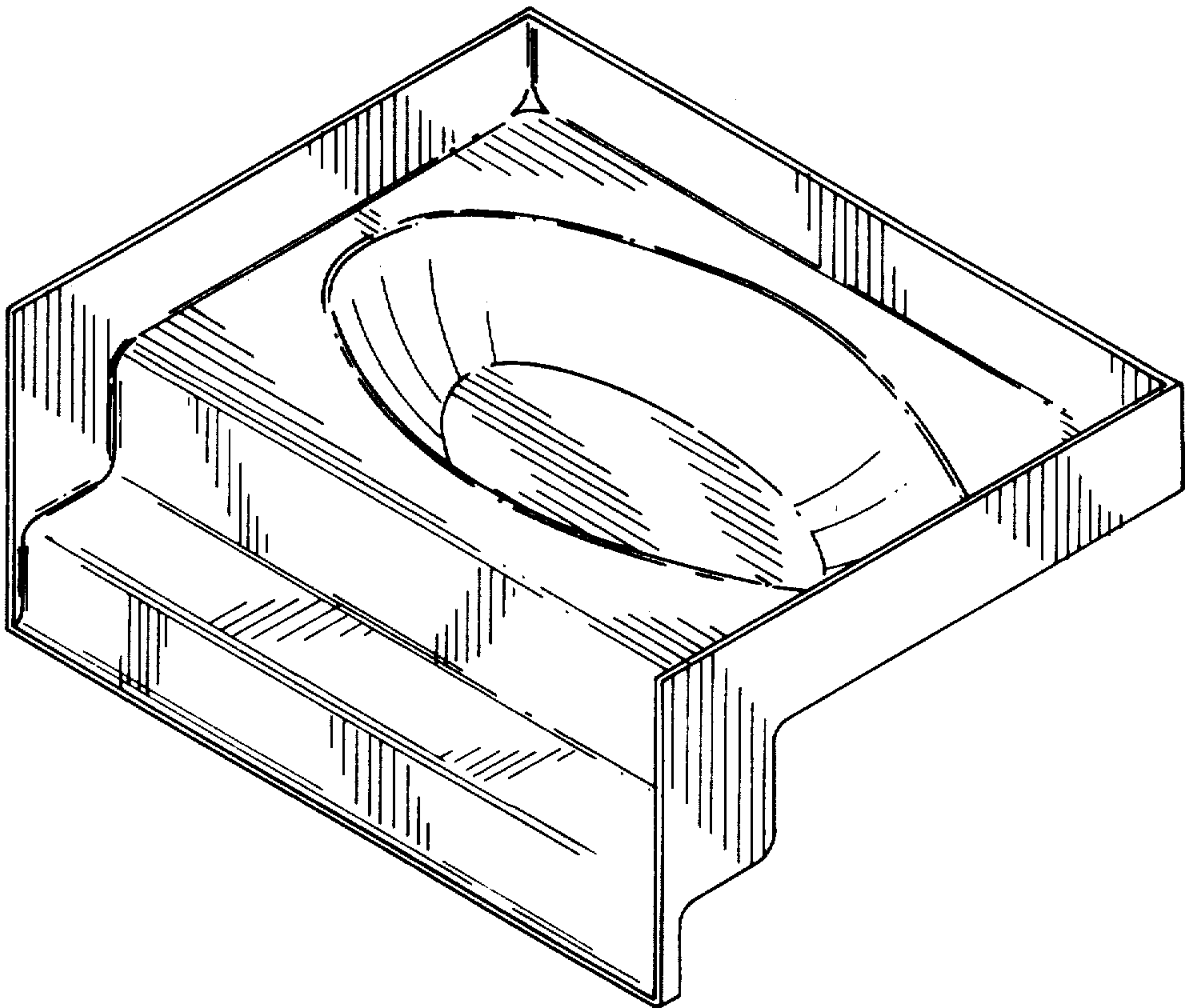

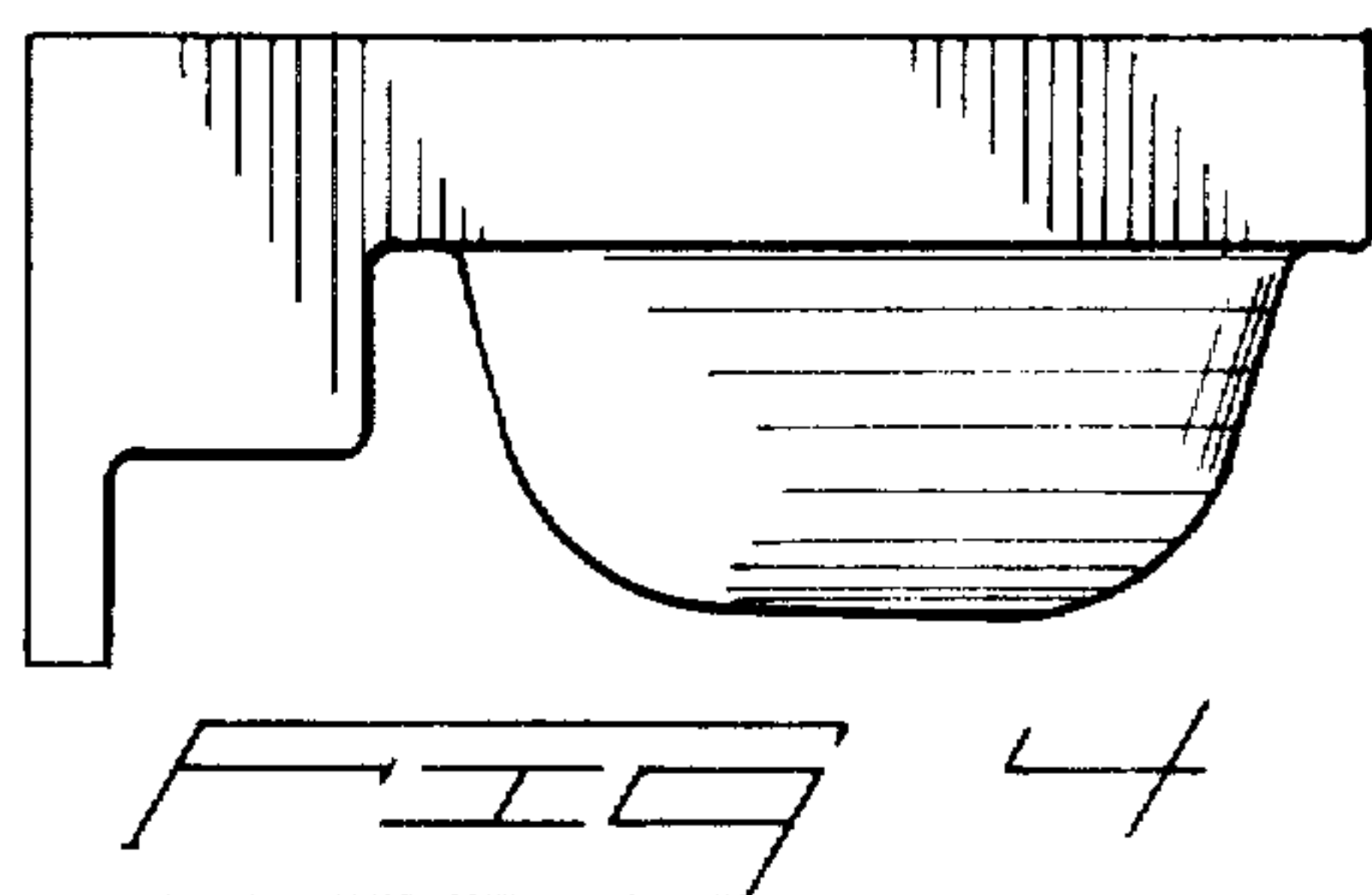
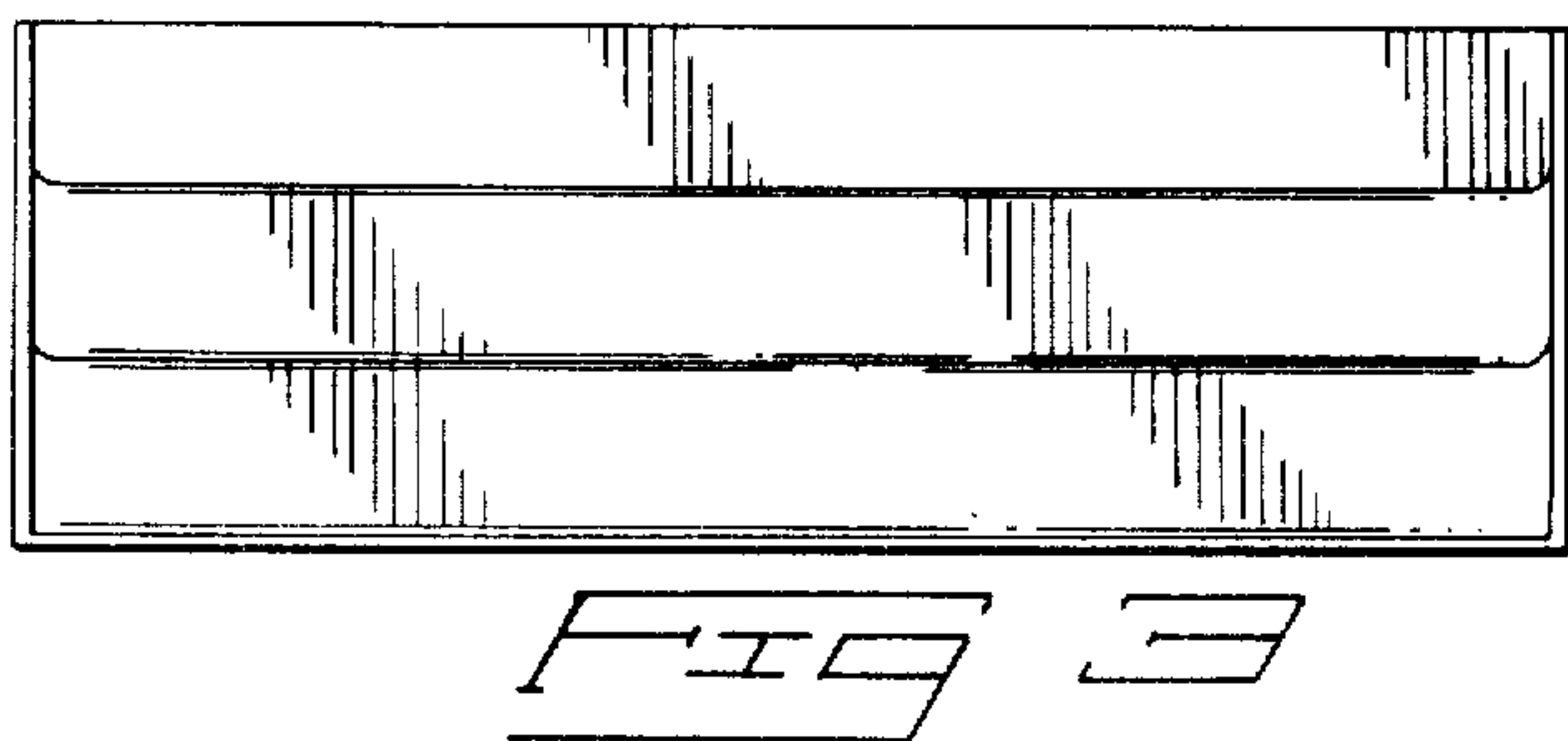
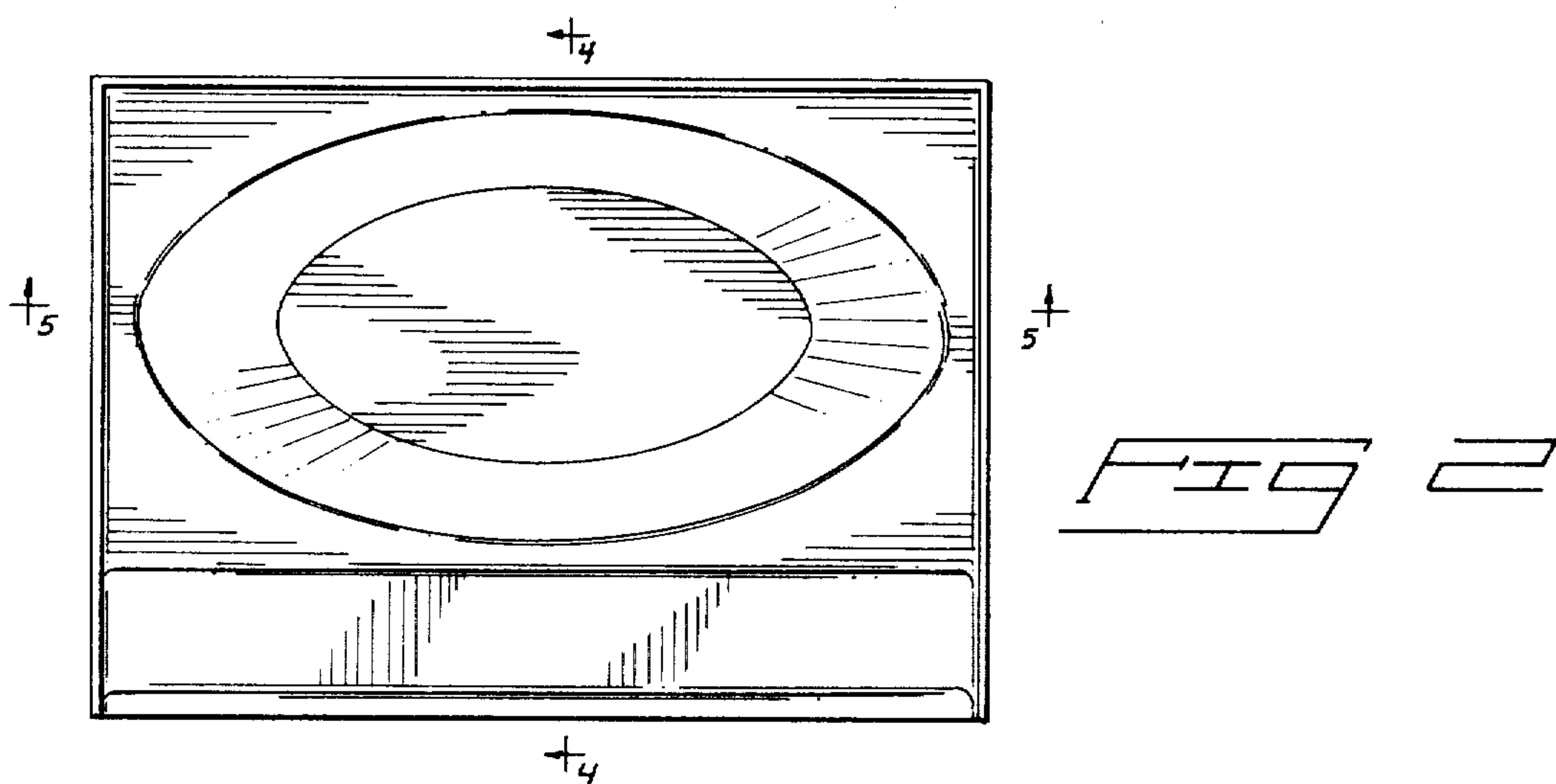
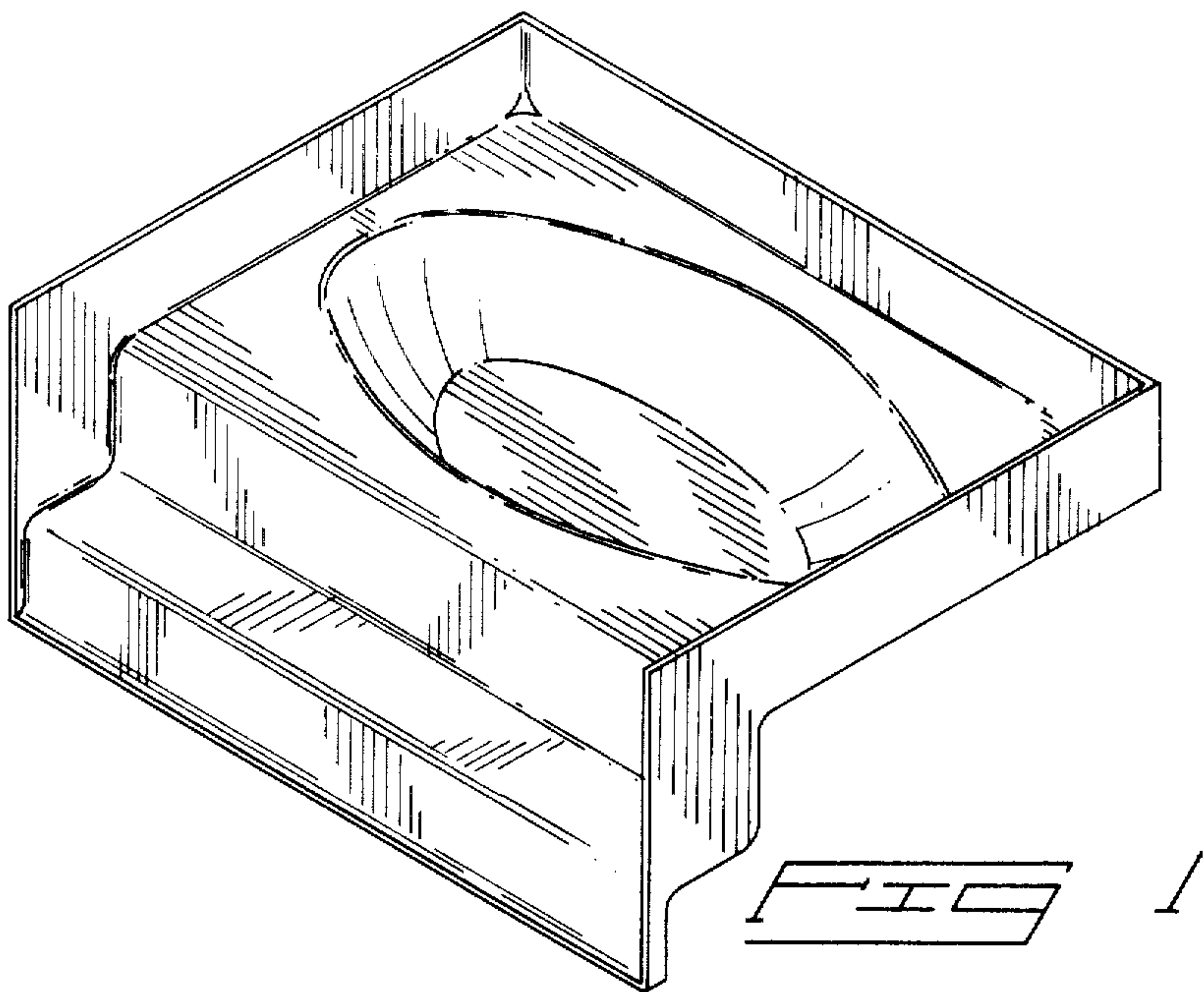
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[57] CLAIM
The ornamental design for a hydrotherapy pool, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION
FIG. 1 is a perspective view of the hydrotherapy pool showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a top plan view;
FIG. 3 is a front elevation view, the back being plain and unornamented;
FIG. 4 is an end view, the opposite end being a mirror image;
FIG. 5 is a sectional view along line 5—5 in FIG. 2;
FIG. 6 is a sectional view along line 6—6 in FIG. 2.





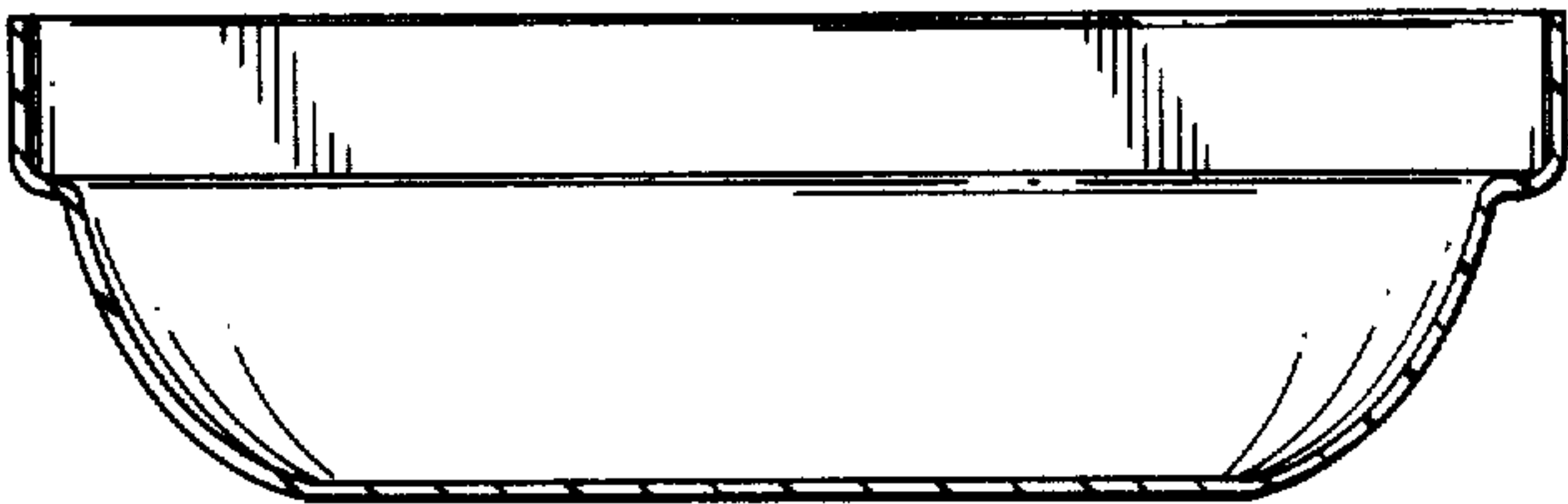

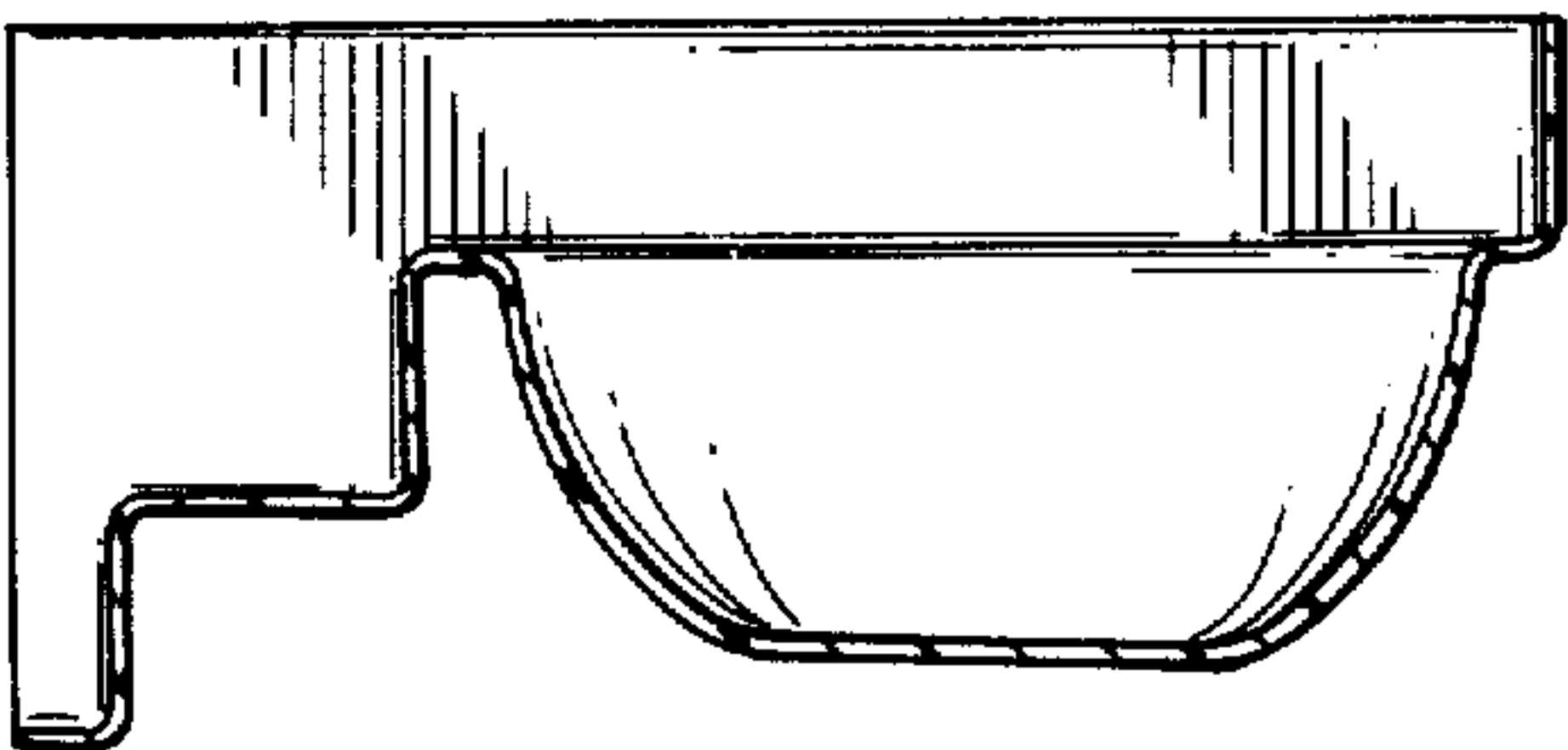
